GAME NOTES

THE KENTUCKY-USC UPSTATE SERIES

- Kentucky leads USC Upstate in the all-time series, 4-0, which began in 2007.
 - The Wildcats won the last meeting, 82-54, on Nov. 11, 2023 inside Rupp Arena.
 - The two teams have never before played each other in back-to-back seasons.
 - The Wildcats' largest margin of victory was 100-34 on Nov. 25, 2012.
- Three of the four games in the series have been played in Historic Memorial Coliseum.

KENTUCKY IN SEASON OPENERS

- Monday's game is the home and season opener for Kentucky.
- UK is 42-8 all-time in season openers, and it has won 15 in a row.
- UK is 46-4 all-time in home openers, and it has won 15 in a row.
 - Last season, Kentucky defeated ETSU in its season opener at the Clive M. Beck Center at Transylvania University, 74-66.

BLUEGRASS REBOOT

- Kenny Brooks' women's basketball team is ranked 22nd in the Preseason Associated Press Top 25 and the Preseason USA Today/Coaches Top 25 and is projected as a sixseed in Charlie Creme's latest bracketology report.
- The Wildcats boast a balanced and experienced roster, consisting of three freshmen, three sophomores, four juniors, a redshirt senior and two graduate students.
 - Brooks' roster features two returners, including Cassidy Rowe and Saniah Tyler, and 11 newcomers, including All-American, fifth-year point guard Georgia Amoore.
 - Three players, including Amoore (1,853), Dazia Lawrence (1,170) and Jordan
 Obi (1,142), are 1,000-point scorers, while Amelia Hassett, who played two seasons at Eastern Florida State College and was named a National Junior College
 Athletic Association Division I All-American in 2023-24, is close behind with 919
 points.
 - Brooks also signed a couple of freshmen with a lot of potential, including unanimous four-star guard Lexi Blue and 6-7 center from Portugal Clara Silva, who will tie Anna Cole (2010) as the program's tallest player on record. In November 2023, Shane Laflin from ESPN said this about Silva, "If she was a player in the U.S., she'd safely land in the top 10 in the recruiting rankings."

KENTUCKY KENNY

- Kenny Brooks, who took Virginia Tech to the 2023 NCAA Final Four and won the 2024
 Atlantic Coast Conference regular-season championship, was named the ninth head
 coach of the University of Kentucky women's basketball program on March 26, 2024.
- Boasting a 517-204 (.717) career record through 22 seasons as a head coach, he has
 only had one losing season during that more-than-two-decade stretch and that was all
 the way back in 2003-04.
- Brooks has compiled five Colonial Athletic Association Tournament titles, four CAA regular-season titles, one ACC Tournament title, one ACC regular-season title, 10 NCAA Tournament appearances and one Final Four.

TALL BALL

- This is Kentucky's tallest team in program history and Kenny Brooks' tallest team in his 22 seasons as a head coach.
- Eight of UK's players, more than half of the team, are 6'1 or taller, including four players that are 6'3 or taller.
- In fact, 6'7 center Clara Silva ties 6'7 center Anna Cole (2009-10) as UK's tallest player in program history.

INTERNATIONAL FLAVOR

- The Wildcats have five international players on their team two from Australia in Georgia Amoore and Amelia Hassett, one from Canada in Tanah Becker, one from Portugal in Clara Silva and one from the Czech Republic in Dominika Paurová.
- The Cats also have one international coach in assistant coach and recruiting coordinator Radvile Autukaite (pronounced like O-to-Kay-ta), who goes by Coach Rad, who is from Lithuania.

BEEN-AROUND BACKCOURT

- Kentucky boasts one of the oldest backcourts in the country in graduate student Georgia Amoore and redshirt senior Dazia Lawrence, who are both 23-years-old.
- Combined, they have 217 career games, 185 career starts and three conference championships.
- Amoore (1,853) and Lawrence (1,170) also are 1,000-point scorers, while they're
 coming off their most productive seasons yet, scoring 602- and 565-points last season, respectively.

IT JUST MEANS A-MOORE

- Kenny Brooks affectionately refers to All-American Georgia Amoore, a Ballarat, Australia, native, as his mini-me and an extension of him on the court.
- Amoore, who played some with the Australian National Team and was invited to Kelsey Plum's Dawg Class for the second straight summer in 2024, averaged 18.8 points per game and 6.8 assists per game as a senior at Virginia Tech in 2023-24.
 - She concluded the season ranked first in the Atlantic Coast Conference and fourth in the nation in assists per game and fifth in the conference and 41st in the nation in points per game.
 - She shot 41.9 percent from the field and 85.9 percent from the line, while she also made 85 3-pointers on the season, which ranked second in the league and 20th in the nation.
 - Her 85 3-pointers also marked the fourth most in a single season in Virginia Tech program history.
 - In 2023-24, the then-senior collected two 30-point games and 16 20-point games, while she also recorded nine double-doubles, all of which were on points and assists. She was the only player in the league to put up at least five games with at least 10 assists, and she did so nine times.
- She is already receiving some preseason praise, this time in Blue and White, including the following:

ALL-AMERICAN AUSTRALIANS WITH AN "S"

- That's right, Kentucky has not one but two All-American Aussies.
- In addition to Georgia Amoore's All-America recognition the last two seasons, Amelia Hassett, a transfer out of Eastern Florida State College, was named to the National Junior College Athletic Association Division I All-America Third Team in 2023-24.
 - Amoore is from Ballarat, Victoria, Australia, while Hassett is from Albury, New South Wales, Australia. That is about a 4.5 hour drive on the National Highway between the two hometowns.

THE PERFECT FIT

• Lexington, Kentucky, the Horse Capital of the World, is the perfect place for Georgia Amoore to spend her last year of college basketball. Georgia grew up on a horse farm and her grandfather and mother worked in the horse industry in Australia.

HOW IT GOT STARTED

- Georgia Amoore's first basketball game was actually played in flip flops.
 - She was at her cousin's basketball game as a spectator at five-years-old, and a player fouled out, so Amoore, wearing flip flops, was called in.
- Amoore actually grew up playing and was passionate about the game of footie. She
 played with the boys until they turned into teenagers, and she was so fast, boys would
 even attempt pulling her ponytail to bring her down.

QB₁

- Georgia Amoore requested a football helmet and football gloves to her preseason photoshoot.
- Coach Brooks posted a photo on his Instagram with the caption, "That's my quarterback."
 - That adds up for the All-American point guard. Coach Brooks often refers to her as an extension of him on the court.

MEET D-LAW

- Dazia Lawrence, a redshirt senior from Greenville, North Carolina, who won the 3-point contest at Big Blue Madness on Oct. 11, would describe her style on the court as aggressive, observant and smooth.

RESERVED SEASON TICKETS SOLD OUT

- Excitement abounds for the University of Kentucky women's basketball team, as reserved season tickets sold out for 2024-25, it was announced Oct. 25.
 - It is the first time in program history that reserved seating has sold out.
- More than 3,200 season tickets have sold for the upcoming season, over half of the approximate capacity within the new configuration of the renovated Historic Memorial Coliseum.

RHYNE HOWARD WINS OLYMPIC MEDAL

- Rhyne Howard, University of Kentucky alumna and Atlanta Dream guard, claimed a bronze medal for Team USA at the 2024 Olympic Games.
- Through nine games in Paris, she scored 34 points, grabbed 15 rebounds and had a team-lead four blocks.





606 STRONG

- Cassidy Rowe's family and community were directly affected by the Eastern Kentucky floods in Summer 2022.
 - The Virgie, Kentucky, native and junior guard tells a great story about how her parents had to trudge through knee-deep water to evacuate to their neighbor's house on higher ground.
 - Meanwhile, Rowe texted her father to see if her childhood basketball goal was
 ok. He told her it wasn't, it had been washed away. He ended up finding it floating down the flood stream.
 - Her home ended up being ok, just some property damage. However, many, many folks around neighborhood were not so fortunate.
 - Rowe and her family were and continue to be very active in their community in the aftermath of the flooding, handing out meals and cleaning.
- Rowe and alumnae Emma King, Blair Green and Maci Morris all natives of Eastern Kentucky or otherwise known as the 606 - hosted a "606 Camp" for 606 residents at North Laurel High School in August 2022.
 - The cost to attend was \$40 per player or \$60 for two in a family, while all proceeds from the camp went directly to the Foundation for Appalachian Kentucky Crisis Fund.

About Kenny Brooks:

- Kenny Brooks, who took Virginia Tech to the 2023 NCAA Final Four and won the 2024 Atlantic Coast Conference regular-season championship, was named the ninth head coach of the University of Kentucky women's basketball program on March 26, 2024.
- Boasting a 517-204 (.717) career record through 22 seasons as a head coach, Brooks has compiled five Colonial Athletic Association Tournament titles, four CAA regular-season titles, one ACC Tournament title, one ACC regular-season title, 10 NCAA Tournament appearances and one Final Four.
- Brooks arrived in Lexington after serving eight seasons as the head coach at Virginia Tech. Under his guidance, the Hokies enjoyed eight consecutive winning seasons (2017-24) and made four straight appearances in the NCAA Tournament (2021-24). He also produced a record amount of ACC win totals, ranked wins and postseason accolades in that time.
- Most recently, Virginia Tech is coming off the program's first ACC regular-season championship and a four seed in the NCAA Tournament in 2024. Just a season before that, he led Tech to the program's first ACC Tournament title and earned a one seed in the NCAA Tournament. That same season, the Hokies defeated Chattanooga, South Dakota State, Tennessee and Ohio State to advance to the program's first Final Four.
- A 1992 graduate of James Madison, Brooks played for three seasons under coach Lefty Driesell and made two NIT appearances, while also earning a degree in business management. He began his coaching career as a part-time assistant for the 1993-94 JMU men's squad that won the CAA Tournament and advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Then, after four seasons as an assistant for the men's program at Virginia Military Institute (1994-98), he moved back to his alma mater as a men's assistant from 1998-2002. He was named interim women's head coach on Dec. 6, 2002 before taking over those duties on a full-time basis on March 21, 2003.
- Brooks and his wife, Chrissy, have four children, Kendyl, Chloe, Gabby and Nicholas.


