CONFERENCE NOTES

Player of the Week

• Tennessee's Talaysia Cooper averaged 25.5 points, 9.5 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 3.0 steals while shooting 55.6 percent from the field, 33.3 percent from beyond the arc and 100 percent at the free-throw line as her team improved to 4-0 on the season. She carded her first double-double as a collegian vs. Middle Tennessee, leading UT to an 89-75 victory over the Blue Raiders with 18 points and a career-high 10 rebounds against the preseason CUSA favorite. Cooper dished out four assists and tallied four steals and a block while connecting on eight of 16 shots from the field and both tries at the charity stripe. On Saturday afternoon, Cooper narrowly missed a second straight double-double, firing in a career-best 33 points and yanking down nine caroms in a 109-93 win over Liberty. She added four assists and two steals while connecting on 60 percent (12-20) of her field goal attempts, 50 percent of her three-point tries (2-4) and all seven of her opportunities at the charity stripe. Cooper became one of 26 Lady Vols all-time to net 33 or more points and joined Candace Parker and Rennia Davis as the only UT players since 2002-03 to do so as a freshman or sophomore. Cooper also is the only Tennessee player since at least 2004-05 to record at least 33 points, nine rebounds, four assists and two steals. Only Parker (3 times), Rickea Jackson, Rennia Davis (3 times) and Cooper have produced at least 33 points and nine boards during that time span.

Freshman of the Week

• Mikayla Blakes led all SEC freshmen in scoring this week at 22.5 points per game to help Vanderbilt go 2-0 on the week, as the Commodores improve to 4-0 overall for the second straight season. Blakes averaged 22.5 points, 2.5 steals, and 2.0 rebounds in wins over South Florida and Butler. Blakes is the first Vanderbilt freshman since 2009-10 to score 15 or more points in each of the first four games of a season. She shot 46.9 percent from the floor (15-of-32) and connected on 35.3 percent (6-of-17) of her 3-point field goal attempts. The highlight of her week came in Sunday's 81-62 home win over Butler, where she scored a career-best 29 points. Blakes' 29-point performance tied her for the fifth-most points scored in a game by a Vanderbilt freshman, tying her with three other Commodores. She also became the fifth Vandy freshman to score 29 or more points

in a game, becoming the first since Iyana Moore's 32-point performance vs. Alabama State in 2021. Blakes opened the week by scoring 16 points in her first collegiate road game, helping the Commodores post a 62-49 win at South Florida. She hit two 3-pointers and added two steals to her stat line.

Around the League

- Sophomore forward/center Quanirah Montague scored a career-high 17 points to lead Mississippi State women's basketball past Jacksonville, 80-35, inside State Farm Field House at the 2024 WBCA State Farm Showcase on Sunday.
- South Carolina women's basketball lost for the first time since the 2023 NCAA Final Four, falling at No. 5/6 UCLA 77-62 on Sunday afternoon.

2025 SEC TOURNAMENT

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023, 2024, 2025), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The conference announced a three-year extension with Greenville, S.C. to host the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament in 2026, 2027 and 2028.

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 31 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Four of the last 14 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with eight, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

- The council consists of one women's basketball student-athlete from each of the SEC's 16 institutions. The goal of the leadership council is for student-athletes to serve as a conduit of communication from their teams to the conference office on issues related to student-athlete experience, student-athlete wellness, and to provide feedback on proposed rules governing the SEC and NCAA.

BY THE NUMBERS

- In regular season games, the SEC has compiled a 6073-1766 (.775) record against other conferences. In the postseason, SEC teams are 559-259 (.683) against non-conference teams. Overall, teams are 6631-2024 (.766).
- The league has recorded 150+ wins in 29 seasons and has recorded a non-conference winning percentage below .700 only once.
- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only six times to place at least four members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).
- The most SEC teams in the final AP poll is seven, which the league has done four times (1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- SEC schools have produced 53 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 49 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, 10 have played for other countries in the Olympics.
- In 2023, a total of 1,146,341 fans passed through SEC turnstiles during home games and conference tournament action. Overall, the league has five of the Top 10 total attendance seasons.
