KNOW YOUR FOE

No. 20 Kentucky is 3-0 with a game against Louisville on Saturday before welcoming the Mastodons on Monday. UK beat USC Upstate, Northern Kentucky and Wofford by at least 29 points each. 6-foot-5 center Clara Strack is averaging a team-best 17.7 points per game in her first year at UK after transferring from Virginia Tech.

THE SERIES

Purdue Fort Wayne and Kentucky have met just once in the history of the two programs: a 2003 game that resulted in a 79-59 victory for the Wildcats.

LAST TIME OUT

Purdue Fort Wayne beat Defiance 104-31 at the Allen County War Memorial Coliseum on November 12. The Mastodons had all 13 players score all least two points. Lauren Ross led with 15 points, pushing her over the 1,000-point milestone for her career.

COMING UP

The Mastodons will hit the road again on Thursday (Nov. 21) when they visit Eastern Michigan for the first time since 2019. After that, the Mastodons will head to Atlanta to play in the GSU Thanksgiving Classic against Georgia State, Campbell and Furman.

WHY MASTODONS?

It all started about 10,000 years ago...

That's when mastodons roamed the southern Great Lakes region of North America. These stocky versions of modern elephants reached heights of about ten feet at the shoulder, with tusks that curved upward that were six feet or more in length. Mastodons were browsers who fed mostly on leaves and twigs from small trees and shrubs. One such mastodon found its final resting place about two miles south of Angola, Indiana, on land that would eventually become part of Orsie Routsong's farm. In the fall of 1968, Routsong decided to expand a small pond on his property. An excavator was hired and instructed to pile the excavated material around the edge of the pond. Several days after the excavation was finished a heavy rain storm pounded the piles of dirt.

The next day, a young neighbor boy of Routsong's discovered a large bone in one of the dirt piles. Routsong knew it was something out of the ordinary, so he called Jack Sunderman, chair of the Geology Department, to identify the bone, and to ask for advice on what to do with it. Sunderman says his first question was, "How big is the bone?" with Routsong's answer being "pretty big, maybe 3 or 4 feet long."

When Sunderman got to the farm, he identified the bone as a leg bone of a mastodon. He told Routsong a skeleton like this would have scientific and instructional value if a large portion of it could be located. Routsong agreed, and also agreed to have the Geology Department do the excavation. Sunderman got two more faculty members, Geoffrey Matthews and Bernd Erdtmann, and several geology students to help in the project.

After all the mastodon bones were collected, cleaned and preserved, Routsong agreed to have the adult mastodon skeleton placed on permanent display at Purdue Fort Wayne; the skull of a nearby baby mastodon is now on loan to Science Central.

In the spring of 1970, The Communicator (student newspaper) began a drive to come up with a mascot for Purdue Fort Wayne (then IPFW). Some of the suggested choices included the Boiler-Hoosiers, Warhawks, Marauders, Frontiersmen, Pioneers, Elves and Hobbits. Those names and others came from student suggestions. Steve Pettyjohn, who served as the student body president in 1968-69, wrote a letter to the editor about the school mascot. In his letter, Pettyjohn extolled the virtues of choosing the mastodon as IPFW's mascot: "It sounds different, strange - that's exactly why. It's different and yes, even strange. For God's Sakes, let's have the courage to be a little different."

In the meantime, former Indiana Congressman Mark Souder, who served as student body president in 1969-70, recalls being lobbied by the Geology Club to choose the mastodon.

According to Nusbaumer, "Souder appointed a committee in student government to select a name although he was lobbying hard for the mastodon." After some discussion on the subject, Souder says a vote was taken by the committee and the mastodon came out the winner. Souder finished his recollection with these thoughts. "History shows that the advocacy of the geology club was correct. The fast, decisive action of the elected student government—though it did not please everyone and was not a precedent that the University desired to see—has also been upheld by history as Purdue Fort Wayne regularly scores high in any list of unique university nicknames; even in this era when everybody strives to be different. We did it decades ago."

As a part of university changes on July 1, 2018, we respectfully ask to refer to any athletic-related subjects as "Purdue Fort Wayne" or the "Purdue Fort Wayne Mastodons." PLEASE DO NOT IN ANY CONTEXT refer to any team as "IPFW" or "Indiana University - Purdue University Fort Wayne" as it no longer exists. Please DO NOT use "Lady 'Dons" when referring to women's teams. Although we are officially the Mastodons, using 'Dons on second reference is also acceptable.

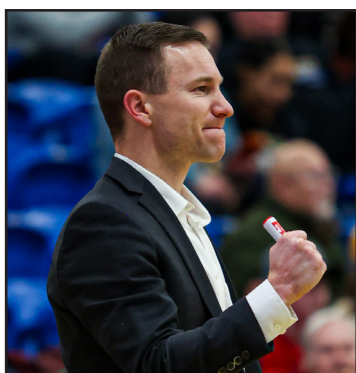

COACHING STAFF



Steven Asher was hired as an assistant coach under head coach Maria Marchesano on April 30, 2021. He was promoted to Associate Head Coach prior to the 2024-25 season.

Prior to coming to Purdue Fort Wayne, Asher was fresh off a Women's National Invitational Tournament championship with Division I Rice University. In Asher's one season with the Owls, he helped lead the team to a 23-4, 12-2 Conference USA record. The Owls defeated Arizona State, Fresno State, California Baptist, Delaware and Ole Miss in their road to the WNIT championship.

Prior to his time at Rice, Asher spent four years as an assistant coach for the men's basketball program at NCAA Division II Catawba College. Asher and the Indians advanced to the NCAA Tournament in both 2019 and 2020 while winning the South Atlantic Conference in 2020. He also helped lead NCAA Division III Lycoming College to an NCAA Tournament appearance and conference title in 2016. Asher was a member of the University of Maryland's men's basketball staff for three years, two as a graduate assistant and one as an intern. While with Maryland, the Terrapins advanced to the semifinal of the Big Ten Tournament and the Round of 32 in the 2015 NCAA Tournament.



Jazmyne Geist was hired as a graduate assistant coach under head coach Maria Marchesano on April 30, 2021. She was promoted to a full-time assistant role prior to the 2022-23 season.

She returned to Fort Wayne after spending four seasons as a player at fellow Horizon League member Northern Kentucky. A Homestead High School graduate, Geist was a role player on her first two Norse teams before having her career cut short with injuries. At Homestead, Geist led the team to an IHSAA Class 4A state title as a senior. She made the state semifinals in each of her three years on varsity.



Quincy Cunningham was named the graduate assistant coach for the Purdue Fort Wayne women's basketball team on June 27, 2022. He was promoted to a full-time assistant coach role in the offseason prior to the 2023-24 season.

Cunningham spent the 2021-22 season as a Player Development Assistant for the University of Maryland women's basketball program. While Cunningham was working with Maryland, the Terrapins went 23-9 and went to the Sweet 16. The Terps also had five wins over AP Top 25 teams. Cunningham assisted in individual player and team on-court workouts, served as a practice player, and assisted in film breakdowns. Maryland spent the entire season in the AP Top 25, climbing as high as No. 2.



Shayla Sellers was hired as an assistant coach under Maria Marchesano on July 1, 2024.

Sellers spent five seasons as a member of the Purdue Fort Wayne women's basketball team (2019-24).

She played in more games in a Mastodon uniform than anyone else. She ranks in the top-10 in the program's career record book in points (1,332), 3-point field goals made (213), free throw percentage (.807), rebounds (573), blocks (99) and steals (226). Sellers led the Mastodons on the court for five seasons, leading an 18-win improvement from her freshman year to graduate year.

She graduated from Purdue Fort Wayne in 2023 with a general studies bachelor's degree and later earned her master's degree in organizational leadership in 2024.

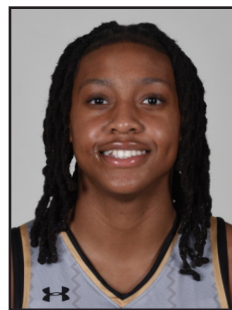
