CONFERENCE NOTES

Player of the Week

• Khamil Pierre averaged an SEC-best 42.0 points, 18.0 rebounds, and 8.0 steals this week, as Pierre set the Vanderbilt women's basketball single-game scoring record with a 42-point performance against Evansville in a 106-40 win on Dec. 16. She also achieved one of the rarest feats in collegiate basketball, as she outscored Evansville by herself, 42-40. Her 42 points are the most scored by an SEC player this season, while it is tied for the most points scored in a game by an SEC player since the 2020-21 season. The 42 points and 18 rebounds against Evansville establish new career highs for Pierre in each category. Her 42-point performance on Saturday also extends the career-long double-digit scoring streak to 13 games dating back to last season. Pierre also registers her eighth double-double of the season, which is tied for the sixth-most in a season since 1999-00. Her 19 made field goals tie the program record for most field goals made in a game in Vanderbilt history. The 19 made field goals are also the sixth-most in SEC history. Pierre's eight steals established a new career-high mark, while it is tied for the sixth-most steals in a game in program history. Her 18 rebounds are tied for the 16th-most rebounds grabbed in a game by a Commodore in school history. Additionally, Pierre is the fifth NCAA Division I women's basketball player since 1999-00 to have a game stat line of 40-plus points, 15-plus rebounds, and 5-plus steals and she is the first player to accomplish the feat since the 2013-14 season. Pierre is the fifth Commodore since 1999-00 to have a game with 30-plus points and 10-plus rebounds

Freshman of the Week

• Sira Thienou registered 23 points in Ole Miss' lone game of the week, marking the first 20+ performance by a Rebel this season and was the first Ole Miss freshman since the 2020-21 season to put up at least 20 points. Her career-high 23 points was also the most points scored by a SEC freshman this week. Thienou also secured her career-high in free throws with seven and matched her career-high in three-pointers with two makes off of two attempts. She almost secured her rebounds career-high after missing the mark by one board, tallying a Rebel-high seven rebounds. Leading the team in points scored during South Alabama and for the season so far, Thienou extends her double-digit scoring count to six games in her young career. This week, Thienou ranked in the top 5 nationally and second in the SEC in field

goal percentage, shooting 87.5%. Additionally, with her 23 steals through 10 games, Thienou ranks eighth in the conference for steals and steals per game.

Around the League

• South Carolina is the only team in the nation with four wins vs. the current AP Top 25. The Gamecocks are also the only team in the nation with seven wins vs. A4 opponents.

• DeYona Gaston scored 29 points and pulled down 10 rebounds as Auburn picked up its second road victory of the year, defeating Louisiana-Lafayette, 68-51.

• The Gators were defeated by UNC, 77-57 in neutral territory and were led in scoring by freshman Liv McGill with 15 points.

• Missouri women's basketball saw its winning streak end at five, falling to Oral Roberts 76-63

2025 SEC TOURNAMENT

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023, 2024, 2025), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

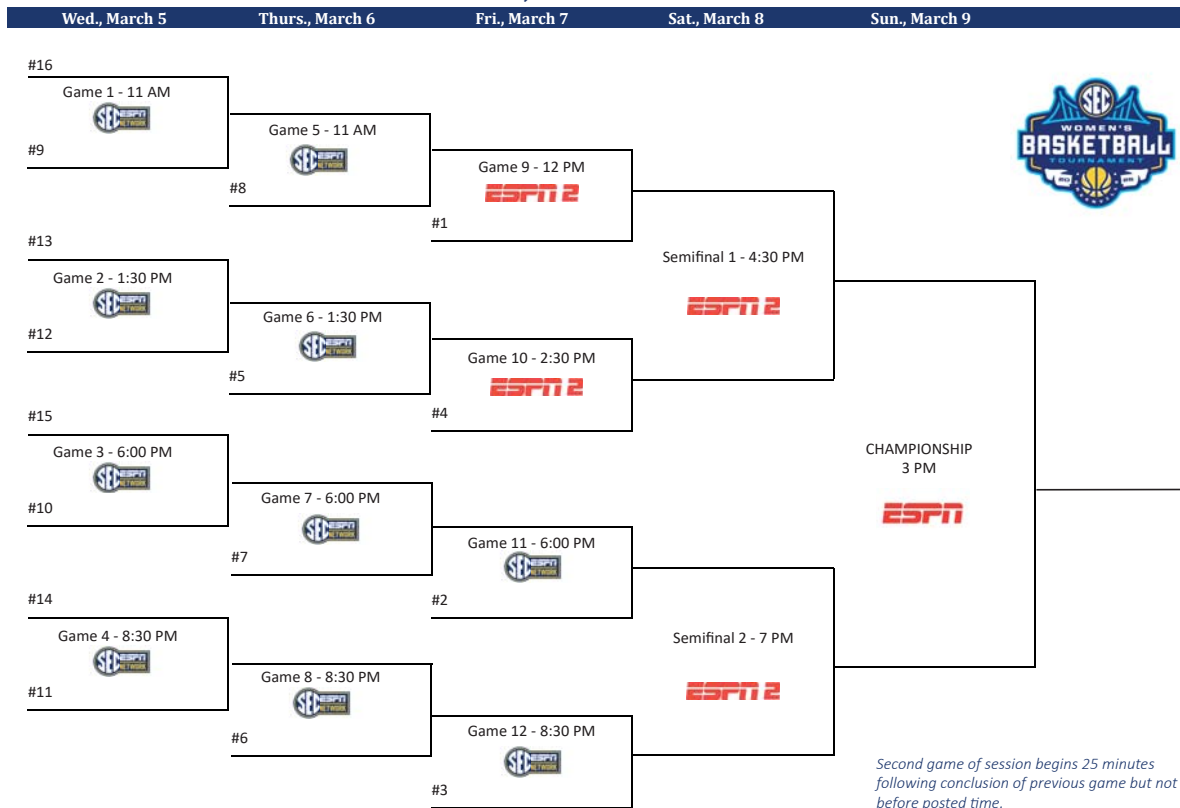
The conference announced a three-year extension with Greenville, S.C. to host the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament in 2026, 2027 and 2028.

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 31 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Four of the last 14 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with eight, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

BY THE NUMBERS

- In regular season games, the SEC has compiled a 6143-1787 (.775) record against other conferences. In the postseason, SEC teams are 560-293 (.657) against non-conference teams. Overall, teams are 6703-2080 (.763).
- The league has recorded 150+ wins in 29 seasons and has recorded a non-conference winning percentage below .700 only once.
- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only six times to place at least four members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).
- The most SEC teams in the final AP poll is seven, which the league has done four times (1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- SEC schools have produced 53 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 49 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, 10 have played for other countries in the Olympics.
- In 2023, a total of 1,146,341 fans passed through SEC turnstiles during home games and conference tournament action. Overall, the league has five of the Top 10 total attendance seasons.
