- >> The Bears travel to Rupp Arena with a 7-4 overall record after dropping its last contest at #8 Kansas, 87-53 (Dec. 22).
- >> Brown's 7-3 record through the first 10 games of the season was the best 10-game start under Martin '04 and the best 10-game start since the 2001-02 season.
- >> On Nov. 16, Kino Lilly Jr. connected on his 258th career three-pointer, making him the all-time program leader, Lilly Jr. now stands alone with the most triples made in program history (284). Lilly Jr. ranks third in program history with 1,626 career points and is 43 points away from being second all-time.
- >> The Bears are 3-2 on the road this season.
- >> This will be the first time in program history Brown will play an AP top-10 team in backto-back games and the first time they will take on Kentucky.




PROJECTED STARTING FIVE (BASED ON LAST GAME)

HISTORY MADE, THE CHASE CONTINUES

- >> Kino Lilly Jr. is now the all-time leader in program history with 284 three-pointers made.
- >> Lilly Jr. also sits third all-time in career points with 1,626, he is 43 points away from being second all-time. The full

1K-point club and three-pointers made are listed on page 16.

>> Lilly Jr. looks to become the fourth Bear to earn First Team
All-lvy honors in three consecutive seasons, the last player to do so was Jason Forte (2003-05).

>> Last season, Lilly Jr. topped the lvy League with 18.8 points

per game, Lilly Jr. also ranked third in the nation and first in the lvy League with 38.1 minutes per game in 2023-24.

>> Lilly Jr. finished the 2023-24 season second in three-pointers made in a season (90) in Brown history (Sean McGonagill hit 93 in 2013-14. He also finished last season

third in program history in total points in a season (564).

PRESEASON NOISE

>> Ahead of the 2024-25 season, Kino Lilly Jr. was named to the Bracketeer.Org All-American Watch List.

KINO'S WORLD

>> On Nov. 19, Lilly Jr. was also named to the Lou Henson Award Early-Season Watch List.

>> Lilly Jr. has scored 23 points in three out of the last four games.

> Lilly Jr. is averaging 20.0 points on 41.2 shooting from the

>> Lily Jr. is averaging 20.0 points on 41.2 shooting from the field and 42.7 shooting from three-point range this season. >> The senior is averaging 4.0 three-pointers per game and is on pace to hit 108 triples, which would break Brown's single-season record of 93 set by Sean McGonagill during the 2013-14 season, Lilly Jr. hit 90 triples during the 2023-24 campaign. 24 campaign.

>> Lilly Jr's 4.0 three-pointers ranks third in the nation and

his 40 total triples ranks 10th in the nation. His 20.0 points per game also ranks 17th nationally.

>> Lilly Jr. ranks fourth all-time on the lvy League three-point field goals made list, he is four triples away from being third

in Ivy League history.

>> Lilly Jr. also sits third in the nation with 37.1 minutes per

>> The senior has 59 double-digit scoring efforts 35 20-point games as a Bear.

COOLEY CONTINUES TO IMPRESS

Aaron Cooley is averaging 12.5 points and 7.6 rebounds per game, the senior has double-figure scoring efforts in nine out of 11 games and has three double-doubles.

Cooley scored a career-high 19 points in Brown's 84-80 double overtime win over Rhode Island (Dec. 10), he also had a career-high four blocks against the Rams.

 Cooley also had a career-high 15 rebounds in Brown's

season opener at Siena (Nov. 4).

>> Cooley's 15 rebounds is the most by an Ivy League player this season, he's recorded double-digit rebounds in four

Cooley is shooting 47.3 percent from the floor this season and leads the lvy League with 5.82 defensive rebounds per contest.

LEWIS' LEAP

> In the absence of Nana Owusu-Anane, Landon Lewis has scored in double figures in 10 out of 11 games this season.

> Lewis netted a career-high 21 points in Brown's win over Bryant (Dec. 6) on 9-12 shooting from the floor.

> Lewis recorded his first career double-double in Brown's win over Sacred Heart (Nov. 17) with 14 points and 11 rebounds, he backed up that effort with 17 points (8-11) shooting at Canisius (Nov. 23).

> Lewis' 3.0 offensive boards per game ranks first in the lvy League, his 7.0 rebounds per game is fifth in the lvy League.

> Lewis' 63.2 field goal percentage ranks 17th in the nation.

> The Los Angeles, Calif. native is averaging 13.9 points and 7.0 rebounds per contest.

 >> On the defensive end, Lewis has recorded four or more blocks on three separate occasions, the junior most recently had four rejections against Rhode Island (Dec. 10).
 >> Lewis' 1.82 blocks per game ranks 50th in the nation and his 20 total blocks sits 58th in the nation. Lewis also recorded five blocks gainst Holy Cross (No. 16). recorded five blocks against Holy Cross (Nov. 16),

BROWN AGAINST SEC & RANKED OPPONENTS

- >> This is the second time in program history Brown will play a ranked opponent in back-to-back games, Brown played Providence in back-to-back games (Jan. 5 & 9, 1978), Providence was ranked #17 in the first contest and then #14 in the rematch.

- >> Brown has never defeated a ranked opponent.
 >> The Bears are 3-6 all-time against the SEC, Brown is 2-0 against Georgia and picked up a win against Texas.
 >> Brown earned a 75-68 win at Georgia (Dec. 20, 1966) and a 79-75 win against the Bulldogs (Dec. 19, 1974), both wins were on the read were on the road.
- >> The Bears earned an 80-77 win aganst Texas (Dec. 4, 1987) at the Apple Invitational hosted by Stanford.

- > Brown's six-game winning streak was the second time under Mike Martin '04 that the Bears have won six consecutive games and the second time in as many seasons, Brown ended the 2023-24 regular season on a six-game winning streak. > This winning streak also matched the longest non-conference winning streak under Martin '04 (2018-19), this is the longest non-conference winning streak against D1 opponents. Brown's six came non-conference winning streak deciral the 2018-10.
- six-game non-conference winning streak during the 2018-19 season featured a win over Salve Regina (D3).

 >> Brown's 7-3 record through the first 10 games of the season is the best 10-game start under Martin '04 and the best 10-game start since the 2001-02 season.
- After starting 0-2, Brown has rattled off six consecutive wins
- and seven wins in eight games, including three consecutive road victories before falling at #8 Kansas (Dec. 22)

 >> On Dec. 10, Brown knocked off previously unbeaten Rhode Island (9-0), 84-80 in double overtime at the Pizzitola Sports Center (Dec. 10) for its then sixth consecutive win.
- >> Two out of the six wins came against the class of the America East in Vermont (Dec. 3) and Bryant (Dec. 6), both wins were on the road and both teams beat the Bears during the 2023-24 season.
- 24 season.
 > Vermont has won the America East in five out of the last six seasons, including three in a row. The Catamounts' loss to the Bears snapped their 14-game home winning streak and they suffered just their third loss at Patrick Gymnasium in the
- last three seasons.

 >> In-state rival Bryant was picked third in the America East, Brown's win at Bryant featured 26 lead changes and Kino Lilly Jr.'s go-ahead three-pointer with 2.2 second left gave the Bears a 76-75 win.
- >> Brown also earned wins against Sacred Heart (Nov. 17), at Canisius (Nov. 23), and against Stony Brook (Nov. 27) during this streak, the win against Canisius was on the road.

 >>> Brown is 13-4 in its last 17 regular season games dating
- back to last season.

THE EMERGENCE OF DABO

- >> N'famara Dabo had a career night in Brown's 84-80 double overtime win over Rhode Island.
- The sophomore had a career-high seven points, seven rebounds, three blocks, and two steals in a career-high 24 minutes played.
- >> Against Bryant (Dec. 6), Dabo had seven rebounds in 21 minutes played.
- >> Six of Dabo's seven rebounds came in the second half, he played 14 minutes and was +11 in the second half, which was a game-high.

 >> Dabo also had two rejections in the second half at Bryant.
- >> Dabo recorded four blocks at #8 Kansas and has nine blocks to go along with three steals in the last three games.

 > All five starters for Brown against Sacred Heart scored in double figures on a combined 27-40 from the field.

 > Brown is 6-1 since inserting Malcolm Wrisby-Jefferson into the starting lineup.

 >> When Lesburt Jr. went down with an ankle injury ahead of the Brown's game at Vermont, Lyndel Erold replaced Lesburt Jr. in the lineup. Erold has started four consecutive games.

MALCOLM JOINS THE LINEUP

- For Brown's game against Sacred Heart (Nov. 17), Malcolm Wrisby-Jefferson cracked the starting lineup for the first time in his career.
- >> The sophomore scored a career-high 11 points in Brown's 89-70 win over the Pioneers while shooting a perfect 5-5 from the floor.
- >> Brown is 6-1 since Wrisby-Jefferson was inserted into the starting lineup.
- Wrisby-Jefferson recorded a career-high four steals in Brown's win at Bryant.

BLOCK PARTY

- Brown ranks 15th in the nation and first in the Ivy League with 5.6 blocks per game, the Bears have accumulated at least five blocks in seven out of 11 games this season.
- >> Brown recorded a season-high 11 blocks against Rhode Island (Dec. 10).
- >> The Bears have two players who have recorded at least five blocks in a game this season: N'famara Dabo (Nov. 15) and Landon Lewis (Nov. 16).
- Lewis and Dabo have recorded three or more blocks in three games this season.
- Dabo leads the lvy League in blocks per game with 2.0, Lewis ranks second in the lvy League with 1.82 blocks per game.
 Brown has the top four games in total blocks by an lvy League team this season, highlighted by its 11 rejections against Rhode Island.

ROAD DOGS

- >> The Bears have won three out of the last four games away from the Pizzitola Sports Center, their three-game road winning streak was snapped with am 87-53 loss at Kansas (Dec. 22).
- >> The last two wins on the road came against Vermont (Dec. 3) and Bryant (Dec. 6).
 >> Brown won its last four road games to wrap up the 2023-
- 24 regular season and have won seven out its last nine road games dating back to last season.
- >> During its three-game road winning streak, the Bears shot 48.9 percent (24-49) from three-point range and averaged

- >> The Bears rank second in the Ivy League in scoring defense (69.7)
- >> Brown's three-point percentage defense ranks second in the Ivy League (31.8%).
- >> In its win over Vermont, the Bears held the Catamounts to just six points in the final 8:18 of the contest.
- >> Brown held Stony Brook to just one three-pointer made (1-16), the fewest since the Bears allowed one triple against Colorado (Nov. 22, 2021).
- >> Brown is averaging 5.6 blocks per game and 6.4 steals per game.

 >> Brown has had double-digit assists in nine out of 11 games
- this season and 20 or more assists three times.

 >> Brown had 20 assists in its win over Stony Brook and had
- 14 assists on 17 made field goals in the first half against the Seawolves.
- >> The Bears also had 20 assists on 32 made field goals in their win over Rhode Island, Kino Lilly Jr. matched a career-high with 10 assists in the win.
- >>> Brown is averaging 13 assists over the last four contests.

PROVIDENCE THREE PARTY

- The Bears shot 40.6 percent (59-145) from distance during their six-game winning streak, they recorded double-digit made triples in three games during the streak.
- >> Brown's 15 three-pointers against Sacred Heart was the most since they hit 16 against Dartmouth (Mar. 2, 2024), this is the only time Brown has connected on more than 15 threepointers since the 2008-09 season.
- >> Since the 2015-16 season, Brown has hit 15 triples on five separate occasions.
- >> Brown nailed 11 three-pointers in its 83-76 win over Canisius
- >> Brown shot 6-15 from distance at Bryant, including 4-5 in the second half. Kino Lilly Jr. shot a perfect 3-3 from beyond the arc in the second half against the Bulldogs.

JJ ENTERS UNCHARTED WATERS

- >> Freshman Jeremiah Jenkins earned a starting nod in Brown's season opener at Siena.
- >> Jenkins became the first freshman to start a season opener for Brown since Desmond Cambridge and Matt Dewolf did so in the 2017-18 season opener.

COLLEGIATE DEBUTS

- >> Newcomers Jeremiah Jenkins and David Rochester made
- NewComers Jeremian Jenkins and David Rochester made their collegiate debuts in Brown's season opener at Siena.
 Jenkins earned the start in his collegiate debut and scored Brown's first two points of the 2024-25 season, the New Britain, Conn. native produced six points, three rebounds, two assists, and two steals in 27 minutes played.
- >> David Rochester saw the floor for eight minutes while grabbing two rebounds and dishing out one assist.
- >> Wyatt DeGraaf came off the bench to make his collegiate debut in Brown's home opener against Maine (Nov. 10), the freshman grabbed two rebounds in seven minutes of action. >> DeGraaf scored his first collegiate bucket at Canisius (Nov.
- >> Jerrell Barron Jr. made his collegiate debut against Stony Brook (Nov. 27), he connected on his first-ever three-pointer while dishing out one assist.

NEW HEIGHTS IN 2023-24

- >> Eight Ivy League regular season wins in 2023-24 was tied for the most under Head Men's Basketball Coaching Chair
- >> Brown's six-game winning streak to end the 2023-24 regular season was the longest streak since the Bears won six consecutive contests during the 2018-19 season.
- >> Brown has had a winning streak of five or more games four times under Martin '04.
- >> Brown's seven-game winning streak ahead of the 2023-24 Ivy League Championship Game was the longest streak under Martin '04.

BEARS ON TV

- >> Brown will play five linear TV games during the 2024-25 campaign, the two home games are Nov. 17 against Sacred Heart (NESN) (Nov. 17) and against Rhode Island (NESN+) (Dec. 10).
- >> The three TV road games for Brown will be at Kansas (ESPN) (Dec. 22), at Kentucky (ESPNU) (Dec. 31), and at Yale on ESPNU (Jan. 11).

IVY LEAGUE MEDIA DAY

>> "We are super excited for what lies ahead, excited about a new journey with the group we have here. Obviously, a lot of familiar faces but then a lot of new faces and familiar faces that are going to be in new roles for this group." - Head Men's Basketball Coaching Chair Mike Martin '04.

IVY MADNESS COMING TO PROVIDENCE

>> Brown will host the 2025 lvy League Men's and Women's Basketball Tournaments.

IVY LEAGUE PRESEASON POLL

- >> Brown checked in third in the Ivy League preseason poll, released on Oct. 8.
- >> In the poll, the Bears earned 92 total votes and were the Ione team besides the Ivy League favorite Princeton to receive a first-place vote.
- >>This is the second consecutive season the Bears have been picked in the top-four in the lvy League preseason poll, Brown was picked fourth ahead of the 2023-24 season.
- >> Third is the highest preseason projection for the Bears under Head Men's Basketball Coaching Chair Mike Martin '04.

NANA OWUSU-ANANE OUT INDEFINITELY

- >> Nana Owusu-Anane will be out indefinitely to begin the 2024-25 season after successfully completing left shoulder surgery in early October.

- >> Lottich joins the program as Associate Head Coach and Price arrives to College Hill as the Operations Coordinator.
- >> Most recently serving as Special Assistant to the Head Coach at Missouri in 2023-24, Lottich served as the portal recruiting coordinator and helped secure the fifth-ranked high school recruiting class per 247 Sports.
- >>Prior to his season at Missouri, Lottich spent seven seasons as the head coach at Valparaiso and helped the Beacons win the 2017 Horizon League and earn a berth to the NIT. He compiled 108 victories and sits as the third-winningest coach in program history.

- >> Sorrentine departed Brown as a member of the New England Basketball Hall of Fame.

GAINEY '22 G LEAGUE BOUND

- >> Jaylan Gainey '22 was selected 25th overall in the First Round of the G League Draft by the Salt Lake City Stars.
- >> Gainey was a two-time Ivy League Defensive Player of the Year at Brown (2020 & 2022).
- >> Gainey finished his career with Brown with the highest all-time field goal percentage (.699) in program history, the highest single-season field goal percentage (.703), and third all-time in blocked shots (125).

RHODE ISLAND LEGEND

- >> As a player, assistant coach Tyson Wheeler was a four-year member of the men's basketball team at Rhode Island from 1994-98. He was a four-time all-conference honoree, earning All-Rookie honors as a freshman and was selected to the A10 First Team as a junior and senior. In 1998, Wheeler was selected in the NBA Draft by the Toronto Raptors.
- >> Wheeler is a member of the University of Rhode Island Hall of Fame and his number 21 is retired.

>> Brown features two Canadians on the squad as Nana Owusu-Anane and Adrian Uchidiuno hail from Canada. Owusu-Anane appeared on the Canadian National Team in the summer of 2023 as part of GLOBL Jam.

FAMILY TIES

- >> Brown Manager of Broadcasting and Voice of Men's Basketball Scott Cordischi and basketball student manager Jack Cordischi work with the Brown Bears men's basketball program.
- Cordischi was one of the nominees for the 2024 National Sports Media Assocation Rhode Island Sportscaster of the Year

GONE BUT NEVER FORGOTTEN

- >> Mike Cingiser '62, a member of the Brown Athletic Hall of Fame and Head Coach of the 1986 Ivy League Championship Team, passed away in late December at the age of 84. Cingiser played for the Bears from 1959-62 before being the head coach of the Bears from 1981-91.
- >> Mike Cingiser was named First Team All-Ivy League in all three varsity seasons with the Bears, one of only nine players in Ivy League history to be so honored at the time. Cingiser graduated as Brown's leading scorer in scoring (1,331 points) and field goals made (490). Cingiser's 17.8 points per game still ranks tied for fourth in program history. Cingiser was also named to the Brown 100th Season's All-Decade Team (1960's).
- >> While in school, Cingiser helped the United States to a gold medal at the 1961 Maccabiah Games alongside Larry Brown, who would become the only coach to win an NCAA national championship and an NBA title.
- >> After graduating with a bachelor's degree in English Literature from Brown University in 1962, Cingiser was selected in the ninth round of the NBA draft by the Boston Celtics but instead chose to coach and teach. He spent 11 years as head coach and English teacher at Lynbrook (NY) High School, winning two Long Island South Shore Championships and twice being named Long Island Coach of the Year. Cingiser also spent two years at Hofstra University as an assistant coach, winning back-to-back East Coast Conference Championships and appearing in two NCAA Tournaments.
- >> Cingiser returned to his alma mater in 1981 and coached the Bears for 10 seasons, the third-longest tenure in program history behind his own head coach L. Stanley Ward and current Head Men's Basketball Coaching Chair Mike Martin '04. Cingiser's 93 total wins at the helm of his alma mater are tied for the third-most wins for a head coach in program history. Paramount among Cingiser's accomplishments as head coach in Providence was leading the Bears to their lone lvy League championship and an NCAA Tournament appearance in 1985-86, Brown's first NCAA postseason berth since 1938-39.



He also helped the Class of 2004 to a school-record 39-17 lvy League mark during that period -- the best by an Ivy League team other than Penn and Princeton since 1970.

CAREER PRIOR TO COACHING AT BROWN

>> Martin averaged 11 points per game for Brown as a senior. He also played a major role on the Bears' 2003 team that posted a 12-2 lvy League mark and earned a berth in the National Invitation Tournament (NIT). When he graduated, Martin ranked third all-time at Brown in career three-pointers (143), ninth in career steals (113), and tenth in career assists (232).

After graduating from Brown, Martin spent the 2004-05 season playing professionally for Dart Killester in Ireland's top division of professional basketball.

Martin launched his coaching career at Brown on head coach Glen Miller's staff as an assistant coach in 2005-2006. He joined Miller at Penn in 2006-2007 as an assistant coach and enjoyed a memorable season, with the Quakers posting a 22-9 record, winning the Ivy League Championship with a 13-1 League mark, and advancing to the NCAA Tournament.

At Penn, he helped head coach Jerome Allen and the Quakers post 20 wins overall in 2011-2012 for the first time since 2006-07, finishing second in the Ivy League at 11-3, one game behind Harvard in the standings. Penn then played in the postseason College Basketball Invitational, defeating Quinnipiac in the opening round before falling to Butler in the quarterfinal round.
