CONFERENCE NOTES

Co-Players of the Week

• Auburn's DeYona Gaston averaged 32.0 points and 8.8 rebounds in the Tigers' two wins over Louisiana-Lafayette and Alabama State, sending the Tigers into the holiday break on a four-game winning streak. In Wednesday's road game in Lafayette, Gaston scored 29 points on 12-of-20 shooting and pulled down 10 rebounds for her fourth double-double of the season in Auburn's 68-51 win. It was Auburn's highest individual scoring total in a road game since 2019. Three days later, she came within one point of matching her career high with a 35-point performance in just 25 minutes of action in an 83-40 win over Alabama State. Gaston hit 14-of-17 attempts from the field and now owns the two highest-scoring games by an Auburn player – men or women – in Neville Arena history, and she is now the first Auburn player with two 35-point games in the same season in program history.

• Aneesa Morrow continued her impressive start to the season as she continues the lead the nation with 12 double-doubles and 14.0 rebounds per game. With double-doubles in both is LSU's games, Morrow has 86 career double-doubles as she moved past Stanford's Chiney Ogumike for the sixth most in NCAA DI history. Morrow was named MVP of the Basketball Hall of Fame Showcase with 24 points, 19 rebounds, 3 steals, 2 assists and a block. It was her fifth game this season with at least 20 points and 15 rebounds. It was also her fourth straight game with at least 15 rebounds. Morrow got her homecoming game against UIC as LSU played in her hometown of Chicago. During a visit to her high school, Morrow's No. 24 Simeon jersey was retired. She went on to record 19 points, 13 rebounds, 4 steals, 3 assists and 2 blocks.

Freshman of the Week

• Justice Carlton scored 19 points and grabbed nine rebounds to help the Longhorns to a 103-57 win over South Dakota State on Sunday. In the game vs. La Salle in addition to her 17 points and six rebounds, Carlton had a season-best four steals. For the week, Carlton converted 16-of-25 field goals for a 64 percent shooting percentage. Carlton has scored in double figures in five games this season.

Around the League

• Texas held South Dakota State 15 points below their season scoring average and scored 39 points more than the Jackrabbits were allowing to opponents this season in a 103-57 win at Moody Center on Sunday. The Texas freshmen trio of Justice Carlton, Jordan Lee and Bryanna Preston combined for 41 points on 17-of-27 shooting (63 percent) from the field.

• Raegan Beers matched a career high with 28 points, as Oklahoma rolled past Omaha 111-65 on Sunday. Beers made 11 of 13 field goals and grabbed nine rebounds to help Oklahoma win its fifth straight since an overtime loss to Duke.

2025 SEC TOURNAMENT

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023, 2024, 2025), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

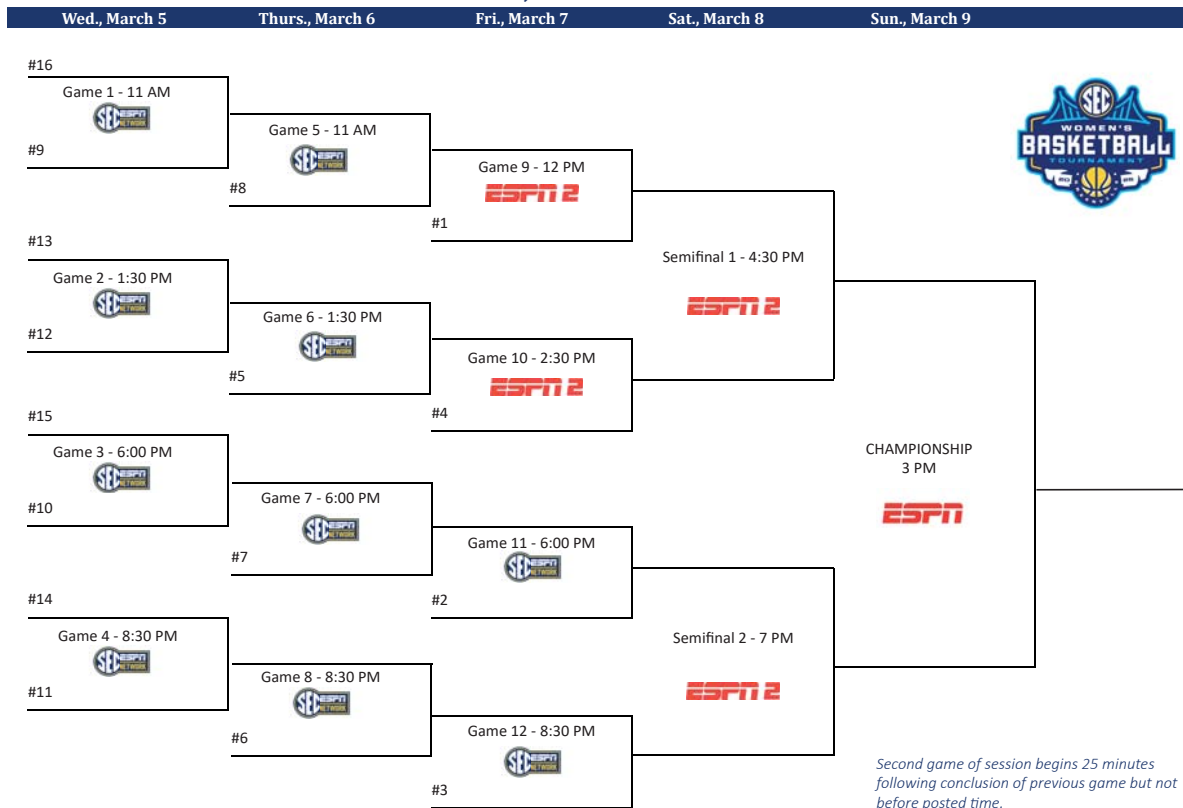
The conference announced a three-year extension with Greenville, S.C. to host the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament in 2026, 2027 and 2028.

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 31 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Four of the last 14 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with eight, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

BY THE NUMBERS

- In regular season games, the SEC has compiled a 6160-1788 (.775) record against other conferences. In the postseason, SEC teams are 560-293 (.657) against non-conference teams. Overall, teams are 6720-2081 (.764).
- The league has recorded 150+ wins in 29 seasons and has recorded a non-conference winning percentage below .700 only once.
- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only six times to place at least four members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).
- The most SEC teams in the final AP poll is seven, which the league has done four times (1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- SEC schools have produced 53 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 49 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, 10 have played for other countries in the Olympics.
- In 2023, a total of 1,146,341 fans passed through SEC turnstiles during home games and conference tournament action. Overall, the league has five of the Top 10 total attendance seasons.
