BEACH BOUND

With its victory over No. 8 South Carolina, Kentucky clinched its spot in the SEC Tournament with two matches to go. The Cats have now advanced to Pensacola for the third consecutive season.

STATEMENT: MADE

Kentucky closed out its home slate with a 3-2 win over No. 8 South Carolina on October 16. The Wildcats became the first team to beat the Gamecocks in SEC play this year. Kentucky was also the first team to score three goals on SC in 2025 and held the Gamecocks to a season-low four shots.

O, CANADA

Freshman GK Khadijah Cissé has been named to the Canada U-17 WNT for the 2025 FIFA Women's World Cup in Morocco from October 17-November 8. The Montreal native helped her squad qualify at 2025 CONCACAF Qualifiers and won also bronze at the 2024 CONCACAF U-17 Championship. Cissé comes to Kentucky by way of CF Montreal Academy and reclassified from the Class of 2026.

THREE-HEADED MONSTER

Kentucky's offense has been led by three players who have all scored at least 15 points this year. Alexis Tylenda (7G, 4A) and Anna Sikorski (7G, 4A) lead the squad at 18, while Catherine Rapp (5G, 6A) has added 16 points this season.

CORNER KICK, KENTUCKY!

Kentucky is currently leading the country in corner kicks per game, averaging 8.47 tries in each match. The Cats have a season high of 18 corner kicks, achieved twice this year, and have earned 144 corners this season, 19 more than the next closes team in Division I.

THE POWERHOUSE

Kentucky is ranked in the NCAA's top tier in mutliple offensive categories. Kentucky is first in the NCAA in corner kicks/game (8.47) and PKs drawn (12) while sitting at 17th in total goals (37), and 21st in goal differential (+22).

TOP TEN TAKEDOWNS

Kentucky has earned a top ten victory in each of the last three seasons. The Wildcats' win over No. 8 South Carolina on Thursday was the highest ranked win under Fabiano and was joined by upsets over No. 9 Alabama in 2023 and No. 9 UCLA in 2024.

UPSET ALERT

With wins over No. 20 Oklahoma, No. 25 Alabama, and No. 8 South Carolina, Kentucky has defeated multiple top 25 teams in the same season for the first time under Fabiano. The three ranked wins in a single season is the most for Kentucky since the 2006 SEC Tournament Championships team. Kentucky is 3-3 against ranked teams in 2025.

BREAKING BOUNDARIES

With four wins and 15 points in conference pplay, Kentucky has enjoyed its most successful conference season under Fabiano, eclipsing the identical 3-3-4 (13 pts) marks

from the 2023 and 2024 teams. With three wins in its first four SEC matches, the Wildcats also recorded the program's best league start since 2013.

IT JUST MEANS MORE HISTORY

Kentucky's 2-1 win over No. 20 Oklahoma in its SEC opener was a historic step for Fabiano's club, as it marked the program's first SEC-opening win since 2015. Fabiano is now 1-1-2 in league lid-lifters.

LOCKDOWN D

Kentucky has held opponents to five or fewer shots in seven matches this season, including a zero shots allowed performance against UWG. Kentucky has only allowed more than ten shots two time this season. The Cats lead the SEC with only 104 shots conceded. Vanderbilt is the next closet team with 127.

BALL HOGS

Kentucky has won the possession battle in all but two match this season (Georgia, LSU). The Cats controlled a season-high 72% of possesion against Mercyhurst and have totaled at least 60% in eight matches.

FROM THE SPOT

Kentucky leads the nation with 12 penalty kicks drawn this season, scoring nine times in 12 tries. From the spot, Gabi Poretto leads the team in attempts at a 4/5 clip while Anna Sikorski is a pristine 4/4. Cat Rapp is 1/2 and Sophie Harlan is 0/1 to round out the tries.

OUT THE GATES

Kentucky has scored in the first ten minutes of the match in seven matches this season, including a first minute goal against UWG.

T-MO GOALS

Senior Thalia Morisi has enjoyed a breakthrough second season in Lexington, scoring five goals to set a new career high-and match her five goals scored during her first three seasons. Morisi scored twice on opening weekend and has added goals against Florida, South Carolina, and LSU-her first career SEC goals.

MENACE MODE

Tanner Strickland has posed a major challenge for defenses, drawing a penalty kick in seven matches this year, including the game winners against Mizzou, No. 25 Alabama and No. 8 South Carolina. Strickland's seven PKs drawn this season is more than all but three Division I teams.

GAME-WINNING GABI

Gabi Poretto has tied the Kentucky freshman record for game-winning goals in a season with four. All four of Poretto's goals have come from the penalty spot and each one of them has been a game-winner. Poretto ranks 12th in the NCAA and 2nd in the SEC in GWG. The freshman also has the GWG in three of Kentucky's four SEC wins.

ON TARGET

Sophomore Anna Sikorski leads the SEC in shot accuracy, with nearly 60% (22 of 37) of her attempts going on frame.

TDS MIDSEASON TOP 100 FRESHMEN

Two Wildcats checked in on the Top Drawer Soccer Midseason Top 100 Freshmen list. Defender Gabi Poretto was slotted at No. 18 and goalkeeper Khadijah Cissé was ranked No. 21.

FULL 90

In the matches where Kentucky has elected to use players for a full 90 minutes, Katherine Truitt and Skye Leach have played the complete game in all 12. In total, ten different players have compiled at least one complete match.

RECORD START

The Wildcats scored 21 goals through the first five matches of the season, a new program record. The previous best goal total through five contests was 16 goals in 2005.

IN GOAL

Khadijah Cissé and Megan Holland have split time in goal this season. In non-conference play, Cissé started the first six matches before Holland started the final two. In SEC play, Cissé started all six matches before departing for the U-17 WWC.

FAMILIAR FOES

Kentucky will play five opponents this season that have matched up with the Cats in each of Fabiano's previous three seasons: Georgia, Florida, Vanderbilt, South Carolina, and LSU. Entering 2025, Fabiano owns his best record against LSU (1-1-1), while also boasting a win over Vanderbilt (1-2-0). Fabinao is looking for his first career win over Georgia (0-3-1), Florida (0-0-3), and South Carolina (0-2-1).

WHAT IS THIS FEELING?

Kentucky's 2-1 loss to Illinois was an uncharacteristic performance on multiple levels. It was the first home loss for Kentucky since October 2023 vs. Mississippi State, snapping a unbeaten streak of 19 straight home contests. It was also the first time since that MSU match in 2023 that UK conceded multiple times at the Bell. Finally, it was the first regular season non-conference loss at home under Fabiano and just the second defeat in that category in his four seasons.

BREAKOUT THREATS

Five Wildcats have matched surpassed their career goal total entering 2025 with their goal total during the current season. Thalia Morisi recently matched her previous career total while Alexis Tylenda, Anna Sikorski, Tanner Strickland, and Skye Leach have all surpassed their cumulative career marks in 2025.

BRACE FOR IMPACT

A Kentucky player has scored a brace four times this season. Alexis Tylenda leads the team with two multi-goal matches, coming in back-to-back outings against UWG and ETSU. Anna Sikorski scored the Cats' first brace of the year against Jackson State and Cat Rapp added her brace against PFW.

PERFECT START

Alexis Tylenda was able to convert each of her first five shots on frame this season into goals, helping her score five times in the first three matchs. It was not until the fourth match of the year against Detroit Mercy when a Tylenda SOG was saved.

SENIOR DAY STARS

Three different seniors scored the first three goals for Kentucky in its 7-0 Senior Day win over West Georgia. Thalia Morisi, Skye Leach, and Catherine Rapp all found the back of the net, with the latter two scoring their first goal as a Wildcat. Rapp also added two assists in the match.

WELCOME BACK

Graduate student Dana Dahm officially made her return to the pitch on Thursday, playing 19 minutes against Jackson State. Dahm started her first 11 games as a Wildcat in 2022 before suffering a season-ending injury. Dahm would also suffer season-ending injuries that derailed her 2023 and 2024 seasons.

SUMMER STAR

Cat Rapp was named to the 2025 All-USL W-League Second Team with Minnesota Aurora FC.

HEAD BALL COACH

Head Coach Troy Fabiano boasts the fourth best winning percentage amongst active Division I coaches at .734. Fabiano won his 350th career match as a head coach with a 4-0 win over Tennessee to close the 2024 regular season. Additionally, Fabiano's 11 wins from a season ago were his most at Kentucky to date.

HISTORIC 2024

Last season, Kentucky Women's Soccer experienced the program's most successful season in a decade. Some highlights include:

- First NCAA Tournament Appearance since 2014 (No. 5 Seed)
- Hosted First Round of NCAA Tournament
- Advanced to Second Round of NCAA Tournament by defeating West Virginia in PKs
- Undefeated home season (9-0-4)
- 11 wins (Most since 2014)
- Second straight SEC Tournament appearance
- Def. No. 9 UCLA (second Top-10 win of Fabiano era)

DEFENDING THE BELL

Kentucky concluded the 2024 season undefeated at home with a 9-0-4 record. It was just the second undefeated season at home in program history and first since 2011. The Cats have only lost at home once in the past three seasons and Fabiano has a career record of 32-8-7 (.755) in matches at the Bell.

LOST PRODUCTION

The Cats have to replace 7 starters from the historic 2024 squad, inclduing SEC Newcomer of the Year with All-SEC First Team forward Makala Woods, All-SEC First Team defender Grace Phillpotts, and All-SEC Third Team Maddie Kemp. Another departed player of note is goalkeeper Marz Josephson, who minded the net for the Cats for the last two seasons. 25 of the 32 goals scored, 14 of 21 assists, and all 1,900+ minutes of goalkeeping by Kentucky players from last year have graduated.

NON-CON CATS

Kentucky has gone undefeated in the regular season nonconference portion of its schedule in each of the past two seasons. In 2024, the Cats completed a perfect 8-0-0 slate before the SEC season to complement a 7-0-1 mark in 2023. Overall, Fabiano's squads at Kentucky are 28-3-1 in regular season non-conference play.

FAST STARTS

Each of the past two seasons, Kentcky has gone deep into the season without sustaining a defeat. In 2024, the Cats were unbeaten through their first nine matches. The Wildcats began the 2023 season unbeaten through their first 13 matches for the first time in program history. The previous record was 11 straight results to start the 2005 season. That same year, Kentucky also went without a loss through its first six SEC matches of the year, tying a 2003 program record for the most matches without a defeat to begin SEC play.

BACK LINE BOOST

Much of Kentucky's success in the past two seasons can be attributed to wonderful defending and goalkeeping. Across 2023 and 2024, the Cats shut out their opponents 18 times and only allowed one goal 17 times. Opponents have only been able to score multiple goals on the Cats just seven times since the start of 2023.

THE BELL

Kentucky opens its 11th season at the Bell this year since the facility was constructed in 2014. The Wildcats opened the 2014 season with a 5-0 win over Francis Marion. Kentucky has accumulated a program record of 75-41-15 at the Bell.

GATORADE PLAYER OF THE YEAR X3

The 2025 roster boasts three Wildcats who earned Gatorade Player of the Year honors in their prep careers. Senior Mallory Glass was the Kentucky GPOY in 2020-21, sophomore Anna Sikorski won the 2022-23 and 2023-24 award for Wisconsin, freshman Teagan Myers was named the 2024-25 Colorado POY.

REPRESENTING THE U.S.A.

27 members of Kentucky's roster this season are from the United States with two current members (Glass and Truitt) coming from the state of Kentucky. The squad represents 14 of the 50 states with the most coming from New York (4). The remainder represent Illinois (3), Pennsylvania (3), California (2), Colorado (2), Florida (2), Texas (2), Wisconsin (2), Georgia (1), Ohio (1), Missouri (1), North Carolina (1), and South Carolina (1).

YOUNG CATS

The Wildcats feature a young roster compared to seasons past. 15 of the 29 players (10 freshman, 5 transfers) are new to the program and 19 of the 29 squad members are underclassmen.

ACROSS THE POND

Freshman M Elkie Bowyer comes to the Bluegrass with some serious accolades. Once a member of the England U-16 YNT, Bowyer has senior club experience playing for Watford and Ipswich Town, including winning the FA Women's National League with the latter.

PORTAL POWER

Kentucky has brought in five transfers to the 2025 squad, all bringing coveted experience and accolades to a young roster. MF Skye Leach (Baylor) and MF Sophie Harlan (Kansas State) started every match in 2024 for their respective Big 12 squads, while MF Mimi Dominguez (UC Riverside) and F Kendall Campbell (Washington State) earned All-Conference Freshman Team honors last year. MF Catherine Rapp helped FIU complete the CUSA double in 2024 and was named to the All-CUSA Second Team and the All-CUSA Tournament Team.

PRO CATS

11 former Wildcats are currently playing professionally around the world. In the United States, Arin (Gilliland) Wright ('14) is the captain of NWSL side Racing Louisville, while Sophia Mattice ('24) plays for Angel City FC, Hannah Richardson ('22) is a member of Lexington SC, Julia Grosso ('21) is at FTL United, and Grace Phillpotts ('24) and Maddie Kemp ('24) are with Sporting JAX. In Iceland, Makala Woods ('24) plays for UMF Tindastoll, Jordyn Rhodes ('23) is with Valur Reykjavik, and Ulfa Ulfarsdottir is a member of Stjarnan FC. In the Philippines, Mia Bookhard ('24) recently signed with Stallion Laguna FC.

PK PROWESS

In each of the last two seasons, Kentucky has earned a postseason advancement in penalty shootouts. In 2023, the Cats advacned to the SEC Quarterfinals by knocking out LSU, 4-2. In 2024, Kentucky defended the Bell in the opening match of the NCAA Tournament by toppling West Virginia via the same scoreline.

KENTUCKY'S COACHING STAFF

Now in his fourth year at the helm of Kentucky women's soccer, Troy Fabiano is joined by returning assistant Steve Golas and assistants Maddie Dobyns and Jelena Sever.

Golas spent six seasons alongside Fabiano in Milwaukee serving as Assistant Coach from 2015-18 and then again from 2020-2021. During this time, the Panthers won five conference titles and won three conference tournament championships. In 2019, Golas held the head coaching position at Dixie State, leading the Trailblazers to a 12-4-6 record and their second NCAA DII Tournament appearance in program history. Golas hails originally from Sandwich, Mass. and played collegiately at Coe College.

Dobyns arrived in Lexington after spending two seasons with the Iowa State Cyclones. She previously coached at the University of Cincinnati as well as at her alma mater, the University of Kansas. As a coach in Ames, Dobyns worked with former ISU keeper, Jordan Silkowitz, who was selected by the Kansas City Current with the 18th overall pick in the 2023 NWSL Draft. Dobyns played her collegiate soccer at Kansas from 2013-17, appearing in 60 matches and helping KU reach the second round of the NCAA Tournament in 2016. She left the program ranked second in goals against average (1.06), third in shutouts (14) and fourth in wins (29).

Sever begins her first stint as a coach following her collegiate career playing under Fabiano in Milwaukee. Sever scored 24 goals across her four years of college soccer, winning four Horizon League titles and making four NCAA Tournament appearances. She was a three-time All-Horizon League selection and is known for scoring the fastest goal in NCAA soccer history just 3.2 seconds into Mlwauekee's game against Youngstown State in 2018. Post college, Sever played for ZFK Spartak in Servia for one season, winning the title in the Super Liga, the top Serbian League.






