ABOUT THE HOYAS

- The 2025-26 season marks the third year under Head Coach Ed Cooley. In his second season, Cooley guided Georgetown to doubling its wins from the season before and finishing with an overall record of 18-16 and 8-12 in BIG EAST play. The squad earned a bid to the inaugural College Basketball Crown, advancing to the quarterfinals before falling to eventual Crown Champions Nebraska.
- The Hoyas return 10 players from a year ago, but with only the trio of Malik Mack, Caleb Williams and Kayvaun Mulready seeing playing time in more than 20 games. Mack leads the returners with 12.9 ppg during his sophomore season and a squad-best 4.3 apg.
- Caleb Williams averaged 4.3 ppg and 3.8 rpg while Mulready managed 1.4 ppg to go along with 0.7 rpg.
- The Hoyas will look to Julius Halaifonua to make an impact after a shortened freshman campaign after an injury six games into the season. The Hoyas will also look to Seal Diouf and Jayden Fort, a pair who redshirted their freshman seasons.
- In the offseason, GU added six players from the transfer portal: Isaiah Abraham (UConn), DeShawn Harris-Smith (Maryland), Vince Iwuchukwu (St. John's), KJ Lewis (Arizona), Langston Love (Baylor) and Jeremiah Williams (Rutgers).

ABOUT THE CATS

- Kentucky enters the 2025-26 campaign following a 24-12 season, which included a 10-8 record in SEC play. The Wildcats advanced to the Sweet 16 of the 2025 NCAA Tournament, their first appearance since 2019, before being edged by Tennessee, 78-65.
- The Wildcats earned a No. 9 ranking in the preseason Associated Press (AP) Top 25 as well as in the first edition of the USA Today Sports Men's Basketball Coaches Poll.
- In its first exhibition matchup of the 2025-26 season, Kentucky defeated the Purdue Boilermakers 78-65 at Rupp Arena. Three Cats reached double figures, led by Jasper Johnson with 15 points, while Trent Noah and Otega Oweh added 10 apiece.
- · Jaland Lowe, a transfer from Pittsburgh, was named to the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame's preseason watch list for the 2026 Bob Cousy Award. Additionally, senior guard Oweh was named to the 2026 Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award preseason watch list. Oweh was also selected as the SEC Preseason Player of the Year.
- The Cats added six transfers to its 2025-26 roster, highlighted by 2025 National Champion Denzel Aberdeen (Florida), two-time Sweet 16 participant Mouhamed Dioubate (Alabama), All-ACC performer Lowe (Pitt), Reece Potter (Miami of Ohio), National Defensive Player of the Year finalist Jayden Quaintance (Arizona State), and AAC All-Freshman honoree Kam Williams
- Kentucky welcomed four collegiate newcomers in Braydon Hawthorne, Andrija Jelavic, Jasper Johnson and Malachi Moreno.
- The 2025-26 season marks Head Coach Mark Pope's second season with the Wildcats.

PRESEASON ALL-BIG EAST

- Georgetown University's KJ Lewis was named to the Preseason All-BIG EAST Second Team and Malik Mack was named to the Preseason All-BIG EAST Third Team.
- KI Lewis is coming off a sophomore season at Arizona where he appeared in all 37 games, making six starts.
- The El Paso, Texas native averaged 10.8 points per game and 4.6 rebounds per game in his second season with the Wildcats.
- Lewis registered career highs in assists (106), blocks (31) and steals (49) while also scoring in double figures 22 times.
- In the preseason exhibition against George Washington on October 18, Lewis led GU with a contest-best six steals while also chipping in six points, a block and four rebounds.
- Malik Mack is coming off a sophomore season where he played in and started 32 games.
- The Oxon Hill, Maryland native averaged 34.8 minutes, 12.9 points, 4.3 assists and 3.6 rebounds per game while shooting 35.5% from behind the arc.
- Mack tallied double digits 21 times in 32 games scoring a career-best 37 against Washington State in the first round of the College Basketball Crown. The sophomore dished out five or more assists 12 times and had 14 games where he drained two or more triples.
- Mack received BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll honors once last season.
- In the preseason exhibition against George Washington, Mack totaled 16 points on 5-for-8 (62.5%) shooting from the floor and 5-for-7 (71.4%) from the free throw line. The junior also pulled down four rebounds, dished out four assists and recorded two steals.
- The Hoyas were selected sixth in the Preseason Coaches' Poll, as announced by the BIG EAST Conference ahead of BIG EAST Men's and Women's Basketball Media Day at Madison Square Garden.

GLOBL JAM

- During the summer, the squad represented the United States at GLOBL JAM, competing against teams from host Canada, Japan and Brazil. The Hoyas went 2-1 in the round robin phase, defeating Brazil and Japan while falling to Canada. Their record was enough to advance to the gold medal game against Brazil, however, the Blue & Gray fell 77-73 in the rematch against Brazil to earn
- In the four-game tournament, Mack led a trio of Hoyas in double figures with 13.8 ppg, followed by Harris-Smith (12.3 ppg) and Jeremiah Williams (10.0 ppg).
- Harris-Smith grabbed a squad-best 7.5 rpg followed by Caleb Williams (5.8 rpg) and Iwuchukwu (5.3 rpg) at GLOBL JAM, while Mack's 7.5 apg in Toronto paced the offense

HOYAS X 2025 NBA DRAFT

- Following the season, Thomas Sorber and Micah Peavy were both selected in the 2025 NBA Draft.
- · Sorber, a unanimous selection to the BIG EAST All-Freshman Team and tabbed All-BIG EAST Third Team, was drafted in the first round, 15th overall, to the reigning NBA Champions Oklahoma City Thunder.
- Peavy, an All-BIG EAST First Team selection, was selected by the Washington Wizards before the hometown team traded the draft rights of Peavy to the New Orleans Pelicans.
- It marked the first time a Hoya duo has been drafted since 2008.

HOYA KEY RETURNERS MALIK MACK

2024-25

- Played in and started 32 games; missing a pair due to injury. Averaged 34.8 minutes, 12.9 points, 4.3 assists and 3.6 rebounds per game while shooting 35.5% from behind the arc.
- Named to the BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll on January 6 after GU posted a 2-0 week with wins over Coppin State (83-53) and Xavier (69-63). Mack averaged 20.5 ppg on 48.1% shooting, including 42.9% from beyond the arc. Over the twogame stretch, the sophomore chipped in 7.0 apg and 2.5 rpg.
- Posted 20 points in a half twice over the course of the season with the first instance coming on January 3 when Mack scored 20 in the second half against Xavier. Mack did it a second time on March 31, against Washington State in the College Basketball Crown, as the sophomore recorded 20 points in the first half.
- Tallied double digits 21 times in 32 games scoring a season-best 37 against Washington State in the first round of the College Basketball Crown. The sophomore dished out five or more assists 12 times and had 14 games where he drained two or more triples.

CALEB WILLIAMS

2024-25

- Played in 29 games, starting 14 of those contests. Averaged 20.3 minutes, 4.3 points, 0.9 assists and 3.8 rebounds while shooting 32.6% from behind the arc.
- Reached double figures in four contests with his season-high 13 points coming against Washington State on March 31 in the College Basketball Crown.
- Pulled down a season-high nine rebounds in back-back contests against Coppin State on December 28 and Xavier on January 3.

Following his second year on the HIlltop, Cooley owns a 361-261 record over 19 seasons. His second season on the sidelines (2024-25) for Georgetown saw the Hoyas double their wins from the year before with an overall record of 18-16 and a postseason appearance in the inaugural College Basketball Crown held in Las Vegas. Following the year, the duo of Thomas Sorber and Micah Peavy were both selected in the 2025 NBA Draft with Sorber going in the first round with the 15th pick to the reigning NBA Champions Oklahoma City Thunder. Peavy was selected in the second round, 40th overall, by the Washington Wizards before his rights were traded to the New Orleans Pelicans. It was the first time since 2008 the Hoyas had a pair of draft picks and the two draft picks marked the first two NBA Draft selections of Cooley's tenure on the HIlltop.

> In two seasons, Cooley has coached a pair of athletes who went on to earn All-BIG EAST honors with Peavy earning a nod to the first team (2025) and Sorber earning a spot on the third team (2025). Sorber was also a unanimous selection to the All-Freshman Team.

> Cooley arrived on the Hilltop ahead of the 2023-24 season after spending the previous 12 seasons at Providence College. At PC, Cooley posted a 242-153 record, which included seven trips to the NCAA Tournament, advancing to the Sweet 16 in 2022, a BIG EAST regular season title (2022) and a BIG EAST Tournament title (2014). In 2022, Cooley was the recipient of the Naismith Coach of the Year Award, named the Sporting News Coach of the Year, the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, the NABC District 5 Coach of the Year and the USBWA District 1 Coach of the Year.

Cooley was responsible for turning around the Friar program. Prior to his arrival in 2011, Providence had finished under .500 in six of the 10 previous seasons and made just one trip to the NCAA Tournament (2004) in that 10-year span. Following Cooley's arrival, he led the Friars to nine postseason tournament berths, including seven straight from 2013-19. In 2022, he guided the team to the NCAA Sweet 16 and the program's first BIG EAST regular season title. In 2014, he led the team to the BIG EAST Tournament title.

During his time at Providence, Cooley has coached five All-Americans. He also has had players earn two BIG EAST Player of Year honors, two BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Year accolades, three BIG EAST Most Improved Player awards, one BIG EAST Tournament MVP, five BIG EAST All-Tournament Team accolades, two BIG EAST All-Rookie Team awards, one BIG EAST Sportsmanship honor and 12 All-BIG EAST honors.

Prior to his time at Providence, Cooley guided Fairfield University to a school-record 25 wins and a Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference regular season title in 2010-11. He was named the 2011 MAAC Coach of the Year and the 2011 United States Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) District I Coach of the Year honors as his squad advanced to the second round of the

In five seasons at Fairfield, Cooley's teams posted a 92-69 mark, including a 58-32 record in MAAC action. In 2010 Cooley was the first recipient of the Ben Jobe Award, presented annually to the top minority men's basketball coach in the nation.

Prior to taking the Fairfield position, Cooley spent 10 seasons as an assistant coach for Al Skinner (Rhode Island - 1996-97; Boston College - 1997-2006). During his time with BC, the Eagles advanced to five NCAA Tournaments and one NIT, secured the 2001 BIG EAST Tournament title and three BIG EAST regular season titles (2001, 2003 and 2005).

A 1994 graduate of Stonehill College, he was a three-time captain for the basketball team and was inducted into its Athletics Hall of Fame in 2019. Cooley began his coaching career at UMass-Dartmouth. He helped lead UMass-Dartmouth to a 25-4 mark and a No. 3 national ranking (1994-95). He returned to his alma mater to serve as an assistant coach for one season (1995-96).

Cooley is a native of Providence, Rhode Island and attended Central High School, earning two Rhode Island High School Player of the Year honors. He did a postgraduate year at New Hampton Prep before attending Stonehill. He and his wife Nurys have a daughter Olivia, who attends Georgetown University, and a son Isaiah.


