KAY YOW SERVANT LEADERSHIP AWARD



► Zora Fray-Chinn

USC Upstate's women's basketball's Zora Fray-Chinn has been recognized as a Kay Yow Servant Leader for the 2025-26 season. She's the first USC Upstate student-athlete to receive the honor since the award's inception ahead of the 2024-25 season and is one of six Big South honorees this season.

The Kay Yow Servant Leader Award honors the legacy of legendary NC State head coach Kay Yow, who had a 22-year, on-again, off-again battle with breast cancer. Her hope was to inspire others to make a difference in a fight that impacts each and every one of us—counting on the sports community of coaches, players, officials, and fans to propel the cause.

The award honors the legacy and the young people who carry the fight forward. It is presented annually to student-athletes who best embody the characteristics of Coach Kay Yow—people with a servant's spirit and a commitment to selfless leadership both on and off the court and athletic field.

Kay Yow Servant Leader Award winners are recognized by a patch they wear on their uniform in the year they win the award. The patch embodies the character traits of Kay Yow—uplifting, powerful, drawing and giving strength. It is a representation of the "ripple effect" of servant leadership and the positive impact it can make in the fight against all cancers affecting women.

OPENING TIP

- ◊ Closing the Spartans' two game stretch against Southeastern Conference foes, USC Upstate and Kentucky meet for the sixth time in the Spartans' Division I era (2007-pres.) Wednesday, meeting for the third straight season. The Wildcats lead the series 5-0 with all five meetings played in Lexington, Ky. (four inside Memorial Coliseum and one inside Rupp Arena).
- ◊ Kentucky holds a special place in the history of the USC Upstate women's basketball program as the Wildcats were the first Division I opponent for the Spartans on Nov. 11, 2007. Upstate made the transition to NCAA Division I on July 1, 2007.
- ◊ Reaching double-figures versus Georgia Monday, redshirt sophomore guard Cassie Gallagher is the first Spartan since Isabell West (12 points) versus Georgia Tech on Dec. 20, 2023, to score in double-figures against a Power-Four opponent. Her 20 markers are the most points scored by a Spartan against a Power-Four foe since Dec. 2, 2020, when McKinley Brooks-Sumpter notched 21 points versus Alabama.
- ◊ Dropping 20 points against the Bulldogs, Monday's contest marked the second career 20-point scoring game for Gallagher. The game also stands as the first 20-plus point scoring game for a Spartan during the 2025-26 campaign and the first since Gallagher dropped her career-best 25 points versus Longwood on March 1, 2025.
- ◊ En route to tying her career-high scoring total in a Spartan uniform--Kierscht spent her first two collegiate seasons at Presbyterian--with 16 points last Thursday against Erskine, redshirt junior guard Aubrie Kierscht knocked down five three-pointers in the game—also a career-high total in an Upstate uniform. Through two games, she's drained eight triples, leading the Big South and ranking 25th in the NCAA in the category.
- ◊ In her career as a Spartan, eight games as she missed much of last season due to injury following a transfer from Presbyterian, Kierscht shoots 48.8 percent (20-of-41) from distance.

- ◇ Hitting 10 three-pointers as a team against the Flying Fleet Thursday, Upstate's total marked its most in a single contest since hitting 11 threes versus Longwood on March 1, 2025, the team's 2024-25 regular season finale.
- ◇ Thursday versus Erskine, Upstate dished out 21 assists, the most since passing out 21 versus Lees-McRae on Dec. 19, 2024. Sophomore guard Gwen Jenkins led the Spartans with seven assists, the most by a Spartan since Jeni Levine notched seven against Longwood on March 1, 2025.
- ◇ Opening the season on Nov. 3 at Clemson, six Spartans made their USC Upstate debuts as sophomore guard Lexi Castator, redshirt freshman forward Madison Miller, graduate student forward Aijah Palmore, freshman guard Kinley Paterson, sophomore forward Zoe Richardson, and freshman guard Jessa Troy earned their first action in an Upstate uniform.
- ◇ In all, each of the 13 available Spartans made their season debuts at Clemson on Nov. 3. Eleven of the 13 Spartans found marks in the scoring column of the box score, headlined by six points apiece from redshirt sophomore forward Emma Blair and redshirt junior guard Aubrie Kierscht.
- ◇ Headlining a group of nine returners, reigning Big South Freshman of the Year, redshirt sophomore guard, Cassie Gallagher is a Preseason Second Team All-Big South selection, as chosen by league head coaches. She was a six-time Big South Freshman of the Week honoree a season ago while also featuring as an Honorable Mention All-Big South and Big South All-Freshman Team selection.
- ◇ Joining Gallagher on the list of returners are junior guard Gracie Barnes, redshirt sophomore Emma Blair, redshirt senior forward Zora Fray-Chinn, sophomore guard Gwen Jenkins, redshirt junior guard Aubrie Kierscht, redshirt freshman forward Madison Miller, redshirt junior forward Vera Söderblom, and junior guard Macy Wike.
- ◇ The Spartans' roster supplements its returners with six newcomers as sophomore guard Lexi Castator, graduate student guard Ylenia Expósito Pérez, graduate student forward Aijah Palmore, freshman guard Kinley Paterson, sophomore forward Zoe Richardson, and freshman guard Jessa Troy join the program for 2025-26.

HEAD COACH JASON WILLIAMS



Jason Williams enters his fourth season as the head women's basketball coach at USC Upstate during the 2025-26 season after being introduced as the program's 16th head coach on April 22, 2022.

The 2024-25 campaign saw Cassie Gallagher earn Big South Conference Freshman of the Year honors as she also brought home Honorable Mention All-Big South and Big South All-Freshman Team nods. Gwen Jenkins joined Gallagher on the league's All-Freshman Team with the duo com-

bining to win eight of the possible 15 Big South Freshman of the Week awards during the season. Underclassmen played a significant role for the Spartans during the campaign with eight different underclassmen featuring as the team's leading scorer at least once with a combined 35 double-figure scoring games put forth by underclassmen.

Upstate finished the year leading the Big South in rebounding margin, defensive rebounds per game, and rebounds per game with Rebekah Gordon leading the league in rebounding.

Williams' second season at the helm of the Spartan program saw Upstate qualify for its highest level of postseason basketball in the Division I era (2007-pres.), earning a bid to the 2024 WNIT. The bid followed the program's best regular season finish in the D1 era, finishing second in the Big South standings and earning the No. 2 seed in the Big South Women's Basketball Championship. The Spartans advanced to the semifinal round of the Championship for the first time in program history.

Following the regular season, guard Trinity Johnson earned Big South Defensive Player of the Year honors, becoming the program's first conference Defensive Player of the Year. Under William's guidance, the Spartans led the Big South in three-point percentage and free-throw percentage in 2023-24.

The 2022-23 campaign, Williams' first helming the Spartans, saw Upstate reel off the program's best start to conference play since 2010-11, winning each of its first three Big South games, including the program's first-ever victory over High Point.

Prior to joining the Spartan program, Williams spent the last nine seasons as the head coach at Belmont Abbey College (Belmont, N.C.), leading the program to 171 wins, three NCAA Division II Tournament appearances, including the program's first-ever Elite Eight appearance in 2021-22, two Conference Carolinas regular season championships, and one Conference Carolinas tournament championship.

During his tenure at Belmont Abbey, Williams led the Crusaders to five 20-win seasons and has won 19 or more games in seven of his nine seasons, including a streak of five straight seasons. For his efforts, he's been named Conference Carolinas Coach of the Year on four occasions, taking home the honor in 2013-14, 2017-18, 2019-20, and 2020-21.

Leading the Crusader program, Williams' teams claimed consecutive Conference Carolinas championships, taking the regular season championship in 2019-20 and 2020-21 while winning the conference tournament championship in 2020-21. Under his leadership, the program appeared in three NCAA Division II Tournaments, earning the program's first tournament victory in 15 years during his first season in 2013-14 and advancing to the Elite Eight for the first time in program history in 2020-21 after earning the No. 1 seed in the NCAA Southeast Regional.

With 171 wins over the past nine seasons—making him the second-winningest NCAA women's basketball head coach in the state of North Carolina behind only NC State's Wes Moore—three combined conference titles, three NCAA appearances, and four conference Coach of the Year selections, Williams was selected as the next head coach in 2022.

Under his guidance, McKenzie Owens earned Conference Carolinas Player of the Year honors and an Honorable Mention All-American nod during the 2014-15 season, making her one of four Crusaders to earn the honor in program history. She also garnered back-to-back First Team All-Conference Carolinas selections in 2013-14 and 2014-15, becoming the first player in nearly 10 years to be named First Team in back-to-back seasons.

Under Williams' tutelage, Maria Kuhlman became Belmont Abbey's second Conference Carolinas Freshman of the Year winner in program history in 2017-18 before wrapping her career with three consecutive First Team All-Conference selections, becoming the first player in program history to earn First Team honors in three straight seasons.

In addition to the program's major award winners and 21 All-Conference Carolinas selections, Williams' Crusader program has seen 29 Academic All-Conference Carolinas selections with his teams holding a 100 percent graduation rate. His program has also claimed three Messick Sportsmanship Awards—an award given to the institution that demonstrates the best overall sportsmanship as voted on by conference coaches—from Conference Carolinas, most recently in 2021-22.

Prior to rejoining the Belmont Abbey athletic department as its women's basketball head coach, Williams spent a season on staff at Jacksonville State University in 2012-13 following eight seasons on the Crusaders' men's basketball staff from 2004-2012.

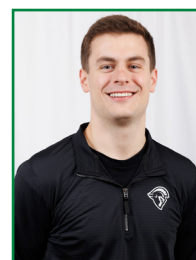

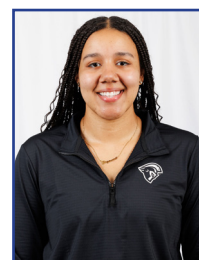
