

- Kentucky has won its ITA Kickoff pod in 3 of the past 4 years.
- Kentucky debuted at No. 23 in the ITA Rankings this week.
- Since 2021, the Wildcats are 74-5 (.937) at the Boone. The Cats are undefeated in their last 30 home matches.
- Jack Loutit and Eli Stephenson advanced to the 2025 NCAA Singles Championship, both winning their opening match.
- No. 19 Eli Stephenson, No. 26 Jack Loutit, and No. 124 Mikael Arseneault enter the match with ITA Singles Rankings.
- No. 69 Loutit/Stephenson enter the spring in the ITA Doubles Rankings. The pair earned All-American status last year.


