SEC GYMNASTICS WEEKLY HONORS PRESENTED BY ALLSTATE

SEC Gymnast of the Week – LSU’s Kailin Chio, a sophomore from Henderson, Nev., posted the nation’s second highest all-around of 39.775 as she helped her squad register the school record for a team score in a home opener during the win over Kentucky. Chio recorded a perfect 10 on beam, which was the first perfect score on the event by any gymnast this season, her first on beam and the second 10 in her career. She also put up scores of 9.9+ on the remaining three events for the Tigers, finishing with the highest score on vault and the all-around on top of her beam score.

SEC Specialist of the Week – Florida’s Riley McCusker, a senior from Bradenton, Fla., won the bars title with her score of 9.975 in the win at No. 11 Auburn. McCusker’s score equaled the highest score by any non-all-arounder in SEC competition this past weekend. It was her first bars’ win since recording a perfect 10.0 at the 2025 SEC Gymnastics Championships.

SEC Freshman of the Week – Oklahoma’s Mackenzie Estep, a freshman from Auburn, Wash., posted three career-high marks of 9.9-plus to help her team earn the win over No. 5 Georgia with the highest score in the nation of 198.425, the first team to break the 198 mark in 2026. Estep began the meet with a 9.975 on vault to earn her first event title of the meet. She then earned a share of first place on bars with a 9.925 and later recorded a 9.925 on floor for a share of fourth place.

Competing in front of its home crowd for the first time this season, in front of 9,216 fans, the No. 3 Alabama gymnastics team used a season-high score to defeat the seventh-ranked Missouri Tigers, 197.500 – 197.225.

The team score is also the highest mark posted by Alabama on January 23 since 2004 at LSU (197.600).

A trio of Crimson Tide gymnasts picked up four total event titles in the victory, as freshman Jasmine Cawley won vault (9.925), junior Chloe LaCoursiere claimed the uneven bars (9.975) and senior Gabby Gladieux won both floor exercise (9.975) and the all-around (39.575).

Alabama will remain at home for a matchup with the Oregon State Beavers on Friday, January 30. The meet will begin at 6:30 p.m. CT and will stream live on SEC Network+.

The No. 8 Gymbacks came away with a 197.475-192.675 victory over SEMO on January 23.

Arkansas' team score marked a season high and tied for the sixth-highest score in program history. The floor squad put on quite the show to close out the meet and notched an event score of 49.525, their best in the 2026 slate.

The Gymbacks won every event: Morgan Price on vault (9.900), Morgan Price and Leah Smith on bars (9.875), Joscelyn Roberson on beam (9.950), and Frankie Price, Roberson and Lauren Williams in a three-way tie on floor (9.925).

Morgan Price took the all-around crown with a personal-best score of 39.600. Hailey Klein came in second with a career-high total of 39.350, and Allison Cucci placed third on the day with a 39.200.

Arkansas has its first SEC road test as the Gymbacks take on the Florida Gators in Gainesville on Friday, January 30. The meet is slated for 6:30 p.m. CT and will be broadcast live on ESPN2.

Katelyn Jong returned triumphantly less than a year after an Achilles tear and No. 11 Auburn battled No. 1 Florida to the final rotation before falling 197.1-196.7 on January 23 at Neville Arena.

Auburn grabbed the lead in the second rotation, scoring 49.125 on bars while the Gators struggled with three consecutive vault landings while scoring 48.6. Making her 2026 debut less than a year after her injury, Jong tied for the team high with a 9.85, matching Greaves and Alex Irvine. Charlotte Booth scored a 9.8 and Bryn Bartman added a 9.775 to propel the Tigers to a 98.3-98.225 advantage at the meet's midpoint.

Florida owned a .25 lead after the third rotation. Closing out the meet, The Tigers posted a 49.300 on floor, their highest score of the meet. The Gators equaled the challenge, managing the pressure of finishing on beam by stacking scores with three straight 9.9s or better, scoring 49.45 in the last event to secure the victory.

Marissa Neal won the all-around title with a final score of 39.375. Fellow Tiger Olivia Greaves finished second with a 38.825.

The Tigers compete again in 10 days, heading to Athens, Ga., for a Sunday meet vs. Georgia on February 1 at 5 p.m. CT before returning to Neville Arena for Country Night against Kentucky on Friday, February 6.

Top-ranked Florida gymnastics rallied to take a 197.10 – 196.70 win on January 23 at No. 11 Auburn in front of a sellout Neville Arena crowd of 9,121.

The No. 5 Georgia GymDogs fell to No. 2 Oklahoma 198.425-196.875 on January 23 in Norman, Oklahoma, at the Lloyd Noble Center.

Led by a pair of career highs from Ryan Noonan, Kentucky opened SEC action with its best score of 2026, falling at No. 4 LSU, 198.050-195.775.

Florida won each apparatus title. The high mark of the evening, a near-perfect 9.975, was posted by senior All-American Riley McCusker. Senior All-American Selena Harris-Miranda used a pair of 9.95s to win vault and balance beam for the second consecutive meet. Sophomore Skye Blakely earned a collegiate-best 9.925 to win her first floor exercise title of her Gator career. Auburn's Marissa Neal won all-around at 39.375.

The Bulldogs recorded season highs on three of the four events as a team (vault, bars, and floor) with seven individual scores of 9.9 or higher.

In addition to Noonan's pair of collegiate best scores, Chesney Bennett, Delaynee Rodriguez, and Gabby Van Frayen each set or matched their career highs on an event. Bennett bested her career best mark on the floor exercise with a 9.825, while Rodriguez and Van Frayen each matched their personal bests on beam, scoring 9.925 and 9.850, respectively. Rodriguez also set a season high in the all-around, scoring a 39.425 across all four events.

Florida finishes January action on Friday, January 23 versus Arkansas. The meet will air on ESPN2.

Freshman Kelise Woolford posted a season-high 9.900 on bars, joined by senior Ja' Free Scott with an identical 9.900 season high. Junior Lily Smith anchored the apparatus with a 9.875 to push Georgia to a season high 49.300.

Kentucky will return to Historic Memorial Coliseum on Friday, January 30, taking on Oklahoma at 6 p.m. ET. The meet between the Cats and the defending national champions will be televised nationally on SEC Network.

Anchoring vault, junior Jaydah Battle scored a career-high 9.925, the best vault performance by a GymDog this season. Freshman CaMarah Williams posted a season-high 9.850, and sophomore Nyla Aquino earned a season-high tying 9.900 on the event. The Bulldogs secured a total of 49.400 for a season-high team vault.

C. Williams and Smith each posted a 9.950 on the floor, a season high for C. Williams and the third consecutive 9.950 of the season for Smith. Senior Eryn Williams made her 2026 debut as the GymDogs' floor leadoff, recording a 9.875. Sophomore Harley Tomlin followed with a career-high 9.875 in spot two. Aquino contributed a strong 9.900 to Georgia's season high of 49.550 on the event.

Georgia will be back in Stegeman on Friday, January 30, to host a quad meet against Temple, Fisk, and Central Michigan. The meet will begin at 7 p.m. ET, streaming on SEC Network+.

The No. 4 LSU Gymnastics team put up a school record performance in their 2026 home opener, defeating the Kentucky Wildcats by a final score of 198.050-195.725 on January 23 inside the Pete Maravich Assembly Center.

The Tigers welcomed 13,516 fans for their 2026 home opener, marking the highest attendance for a home opener in program history and the third largest crowd for a gymnastics meet in the Pete Maravich Assembly Center in program history.

LSU's 198.050 on the night also marked their highest score in a home opener in school history, beating the previous record of 197.850 set against Georgia in 2017. The Tigers swept all five event titles on the night. Sophomore Kailin Chio took home three with her perfect 10.00 on beam, 9.950 on vault and a 39.775 in the all-around. Graduate student Courtney Blackson claimed the bars title with her 9.950, and sophomore Kaliya Lincoln took home the floor title with her 9.950.

The Tigers will travel to Columbia for another SEC road matchup against Missouri on Friday, January 30 at 6 p.m. CT on ESPN2.

No. 7 Mizzou gymnastics fell to No. 2 Oklahoma, 197.425-196.925, on January 16 at Mizzou Arena in its SEC opener before a crowd of 4,039 spectators.

The Tigers posted a season-high score of 49.300 on vault. MU topped the Sooners on the floor exercise, 49.425-49.275, and collected six individual scores of 9.900 or better.

With her third-straight floor score of 9.925, Hannah Horton earned the event title with teammate Kennedy Griffin.
