OPENING TIP

► Oklahoma (11-11, 1-8 SEC) looks for its first-ever win against Kentucky (12-9, 3-5) when it meets the Wildcats on Wednesday at 8 p.m. CT at Rupp Arena in Lexington, Ky.

► Wednesday's game will be televised by ESPN2 with **Tom Hart** (play-by-play) and **Dane Bradshaw** (analyst) announcing. It will air on the Sooner Sports Radio Network (KRXX 107.7 FM in Oklahoma City; KTBZ 1430 AM in Tulsa; Varsity Radio App) with **Toby Rowland** and **Kevin Henry** on the call.

► Oklahoma is 3-7 away from home and 1-5 in true road games (lone true road win was at Wake Forest). In its four SEC road contests, OU is shooting 41% from the field and 30% (31 for 105) from 3-point range while opponents are shooting 44% and 30% (27 for 89). Kentucky is 11-2 at home on the season (3-1 in SEC play).

► Junior guard **Xzayvier Brown** has scored at least 13 points in 12 of the last 13 games, and has four outings of at least 20 points (23 vs. Ole Miss, 24 vs. Florida, 21 vs. Alabama, 22 at South Carolina). He is averaging 18.4 points a game over the last 13.

► **Nijel Pack**, a first-year Sooner who is in his sixth year overall (only played nine games last season at Miami), is one of just three active players with 2,000 career points (2,103; Gonzaga's Graham Ike has 2,314 and Indiana's Tucker DeVries has 2,296 through Monday). Over the last three games, Pack is averaging 23.3 points and has made 14 3-pointers on 27 attempts (52%). He ranks third in the SEC with his 3.2 3-pointers per contest.

► Oklahoma's 82.8 scoring average is its highest through a season's first 22 games since 2017-18 and fifth highest in the last 32 years. Similarly, OU's 9.7 3-pointers per game are its third most through 22 contests in the 40-year 3-point era.

► Oklahoma has committed single-digit turnovers 11 times, already its most such outings for an entire season in six years (11 times in 2019-20). OU averages just 10.1 turnovers per contest.

SATURDAY'S OU-TEXAS RECAP

- ▶ Oklahoma jumped out to a 23-9 lead in the 108th Red River Rivalry men's basketball meeting but was outscored 70-46 the rest of the way in a 79-69 loss to Texas at Lloyd Noble Center on Saturday.
- ▶ The Sooners started hot, making six of their first eight field goal attempts and holding the Longhorns to just three makes on their first 14 shots. But Texas flipped the script and went 27 for 35 (77%) over the final 30 minutes to hand OU its eighth consecutive defeat. For the game, UT shot an opponent-season-high 61% from the floor and was 22 for 28 (79%) from two-point range.
- ▶ **Nijel Pack** led three Sooners in double-figures scoring with his game-high 23 points. It was his third straight outing over 20. The guard was 9 for 22 from the field and 3 for 8 from 3-point range while tying for the team lead with three assists.
- ▶ **Xzayvier Brown** and **Derrion Reid** each contributed 15 points and a team-high five rebounds. **Kirill Elatontsev** finished with nine points — his second most this season — to go along with four boards, a career-high three assists and two steals, and **Dayton Forsythe's** five points were his most since Nov. 20.
- ▶ Texas took its first lead of the day at 41-40 with 15:49 remaining, but OU went back up 61-55 with 8:38 to go, only to see Texas score seven straight.
- ▶ Brown's follow shot with 5:56 to go put the Sooners back in front 63-62, but it was their last lead of the game as the Longhorns posted a 17-6 advantage over the last 5:32. OU held the lead for 30:22.

SCENE SETTERS

- ▶ Oklahoma has lost its last eight games but has held a halftime lead in four of the last five. In fact, it has held a double-digit first-half lead in three of the last five outings. In each of the last three contests, the Sooners have led with less than six minutes remaining, including with one second left in regulation and overtime at Missouri (the Tigers hit buzzer-beating 3-pointers in both instances) and with 22 seconds to go against Arkansas.
- ▶ OU is the only SEC team and one of just seven out of 361 nationally to start the same lineup every game this season. Its starters have been guards **Xzayvier Brown** and **Nijel Pack**, forwards **Tae Davis** and **Derrion Reid** and center **Mohamed Wague**. Kentucky has started nine different lineups.

- ▶ In OU's four SEC road games, Reid is averaging 13.8 points and a team-high 6.0 rebounds. He is shooting 57% from the field and 55% (6 for 11) from 3-point range in those contests, and has attempted a team-high 23 free throws. At Texas A&M on Jan. 10, he logged 19 points and a career-high 11 boards.
- ▶ Kentucky is in its second year under head coach **Mark Pope**, who is in his 11th year overall. Pope, who is 39-19 with the Wildcats and 226-127 overall, owns a 2-1 record against Oklahoma. UK won both meetings last year by one point, while the Sooners beat his BYU team 82-66 in Norman in 2023-24, which was the Cougars' first year and OU's last in the Big 12 Conference.

- ▶ Pope played his last two seasons at Kentucky under head coach **Rick Pitino** and was a senior on UK's 1995-96 national championship team. He averaged 7.6 points and 5.2 rebounds in 20 minutes per game that year.

SERIES HISTORY

- ▶ Oklahoma has faced Kentucky five times but has yet to beat the Wildcats. OU is 0-2 in the series in Lexington, 0-1 in Norman and 0-2 at neutral sites.
- ▶ Prior to last season's two meetings, the most recent matchup came in a Maui Invitational first-

round contest in 2010-11 in Lahaina, Hawai'i, which the Wildcats won 76-64.

- ▶ In a rare non-conference regular season finale in 1986-87, unranked Kentucky edged No. 12 OU 75-74 in Lexington. Guards **Ed Davender** (21) and **Rex Chapman** (20) combined for 41 points for the Wildcats, who were coached by **Eddie Sutton**. **Harvey Grant** led four Sooners in double figures with 20 points while **Darryl "Choo" Kennedy** added 18. **Billy Tubbs'** OU squad finished 24-10 on the year and advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16.
- ▶ The other matchup in Lexington came in the 1945-46 season at UK's Alumni Gymnasium and marked the first series meeting. **Adolph Rupp's** Wildcats beat **Bruce Drake's** OU squad 43-33.

LAST YEAR VS. THE WILDCATS

- ▶ OU lost a pair of one-point games to Kentucky last season, falling 83-82 in Norman and 85-84 in the SEC Tournament quarterfinals in Nashville. UK's **Otega Oweh**, a former Sooner, hit game-winners in the waning seconds in both contests.
- ▶ In the Feb. 26 game, which was UK's first-ever trip to Norman, Oklahoma led 82-81 but Oweh hit a twisting runner in the lane with six seconds left to put the Wildcats up by one. OU's **Jeremiah Fears**, who hit a buzzer-beating layup at the end of the first half after driving the length of the court, attempted to replicate the play at the end of regulation but his shot was blocked just before the buzzer. Senior forward **Jalon Moore** scored a team-high 20 points for OU while Fears registered 18 points and game highs of eight rebounds and six assists. Oweh scored 23 of his career-high 28 points in the second half, including UK's last 18.
- ▶ In the SEC Tournament meeting, No. 6 seed Kentucky used an 11-0 run to take a 77-65 lead with 4:31 left, but the 14th-seeded Sooners responded with a 19-6 run and went up 84-83 with five seconds remaining on a Fears driving lay-in. After a timeout, Oweh dribbled 75 feet along the right sideline and hit the game-winning five-foot baseline runner with half a second to go. OU trailed 83-77 but in the

OU'S RICH HOOPS HISTORY

Oklahoma's storied men's basketball history is the envy of most SEC programs. The Sooners' five Final Four appearances are exceeded in the SEC by only Kentucky (17), Arkansas (6) and Florida (6). OU, which played in the 1947 and 1988 national title games, has participated in 34 NCAA Tournaments and has played in the postseason in 36 of the last 43 years.

Oklahoma has also generated 18 first-team All-Americans, including Hollis Price, Blake Griffin, Buddy Hield and Trae Young since the turn of the century. Griffin and Hield were consensus national players of the year. OU has produced two of the six Wooden Award winners from current SEC schools (Kentucky/Texas two each).

span of less than 30 seconds hit a 3-pointer, got two steals and a pair of two-point baskets to take the lead in the final seconds. Fears tallied 28 points, including 10 in the last 1:19, four rebounds and game highs of five assists and three steals. Moore recorded 12 points and seven rebounds. Center **Mohamed Wague** made his third straight start and recorded nine points and six boards in 17 minutes.

PACK MENTALITY

- First-year Oklahoma guard **Nijel Pack** surpassed the 2,000-point mark Jan. 11 at Texas A&M and has 2,103 for his career to rank third nationally among active players.
- Pack's current three-game streak of at least 20 points is the third of his career (also in 2022-23 with Miami and 2021-22 with Kansas State). He has never scored 20-plus in four straight outings.
- Pack ranks third in the SEC with his 3.2 3-pointers per game and fourth with his .428 3FG percentage.
- Pack has made at least one 3-pointer in 20 of 22 games, at least three in 14 contests and at least four in 10 outings. He buried at least three treys in six consecutive games between Nov. 11 and Dec. 2, the first Sooner to accomplish the feat since consensus national player of the year **Buddy Hield** during OU's 2015-16 Final Four campaign.
- A sixth-year collegian, Pack spent his first two seasons at Kansas State (he was a first-team All-Big 12 pick as a sophomore when he averaged 17.4 points and made 95 3-pointers and shot a league-high .436 from behind the arc) and the last three at Miami, Fla. (he helped the Hurricanes to their first Final Four his junior season and was named the Midwest Region Most Outstanding Player). He has started 143 of his 144 career games.

OU's 'X' FACTOR

- Junior guard **Xzayvier Brown** has scored at least 13 points in 12 of the last 13 games and at least 18 points in nine of those 13 outings. He is averaging 18.4 in the 13 contests on 48% field goal, 39% (27-for-70) 3-point and 92% (48-for-52) free throw shooting. Included were four 20-point games in SEC play (23 in a win over Ole Miss, a season-high 24 against No. 19 Florida, 21 vs. No. 18 Alabama and 22 at South Carolina).
- Brown leads the SEC by shooting 91% from the free throw line (72 for 79). His streak of 27 makes ended Jan. 13 vs. Florida but he has made 50 of his last 54 attempts (93%). He did not go to the line in either of the last two games.
- After scoring at least 20 points in 14 of 35 games last year at Saint Joseph's, Brown has a team-high nine games of 20-plus in 22 outings this season (**Nijel Pack** ranks second with six such efforts). Brown has 29 career games of at least 20.

ELATONTSEV MAKING AN IMPACT

- OU announced Dec. 28 the signing of 23-year-old **Kirill Elatontsev** (pronounced kee-REEL EE-el-uh-tahn-suv), a center from Russia who is averaging 5.5 points and 3.0 rebounds in 16.6 minutes per contest over his 10 games. He is shooting 56% from the field, 44% (8 for 18) from 3-point range and 69% (11 for 16) from the free throw line. He has made at least one 3-pointer in five of the last six games.
- On Jan. 13 vs. No. 19 Florida, Elatontsev scored 17 points on 4-for-4 field goal shooting (all 3-pointers)

after totaling two points over OU's first three league games. Over the last six contests he is averaging 7.8 points on 15-for-25 (60%) field goal and 8-for-17 (47%) 3-point shooting and has nine steals.

► From Krasnoyarsk, Russia, the 6-11, 240-pound Elatontsev has one semester of eligibility remaining. He most recently played for Lokomotiv Kuban in the VTB United League, which is regarded as the top tier of Russian professional club basketball. In February 2024 he was called up to the Russian National Team.

MORE OU NOTES AND NUGGETS

- Oklahoma has led for at least 22 minutes in four of the last five games, all losses. It led for over 30 minutes Saturday against Texas.
- The Sooners have scored at least 85 points in 11 of their 22 games (50%), already their most 85-point efforts in a season since 2017-18. For comparison, OU's last four teams scored 85-plus a combined 21 times in 133 games (16%; nine times last year, six in 2023-24, two in 2022-23 and four in 2021-22).
- OU's top four scorers are all transfers in their first year in the program. **Nijel Pack** averages a team-high 16.3 points per game, while **Xzayvier Brown** (16.2), **Tae Davis** (12.5) and **Derrion Reid** (11.9) also average double figures. **Mohamed Wague** rounds out the starting five with his 6.5 per contest.
- Reid has scored at least 12 points and shot at least 50% from the field in each of the last five games. He is averaging 13.6 points (56% field goal shooting) and 6.4 rebounds during the stretch.
- Wague (3.1) and Davis (2.5) rank third and eighth in the SEC in offensive rebounds per game. Davis had 11 offensive boards against Arkansas-Pine Bluff, OU's most in a contest since at least the 1995-96 season. He surpassed 1,000 career points and 500 rebounds this season (has 1,158 and 561).
- Davis went 41 for 66 (62%) from the free throw line over OU's first 17 games, but is 16 for 17 (94%) over the last five.
- Wague's three highest career point totals have come this season (16 in the opener vs. Saint Francis, 20 vs. Oral Roberts and 15 vs. Stetson), as have his two highest rebound totals (14 at Wake Forest and 15 vs. Ole Miss in the SEC opener).

► Long Beach State transfer **Jadon Jones** is averaging 5.7 points in 19.9 minutes per game over his 18 outings. He has also drawn 10 fouls while attempting a 3-pointer. The 2021-22 Big West Conference Defensive Player of the Year has 10 steals and eight blocks over the past five games.

► Redshirt freshman forward **Kuol Atak** ranks third on the team with his 26 3-point makes (shooting 39%) despite averaging just 12.1 minutes over his 17 games. He is 19 for 39 (49%) from long distance in home contests, including 10 for 19 (53%) over his last three outings at Lloyd Noble Center. He has played in just one of the last five games (one minute at South Carolina).

► Nine of the 15 players on OU's roster are new in 2025-26, and three more were on last year's team but redshirted.

Praised for his ability to create culture and his never-tiring energy, University of Oklahoma head men's basketball coach Porter Moser is in his fifth season leading the Sooners in 2025-26. Moser was hired on April 3, 2021, becoming the 15th head coach in program history after a stellar 10-year run as head coach at Loyola Chicago that included NCAA Final Four and Sweet 16 appearances.

The 2024-25 season was Moser's most successful at OU, guiding his team to a 20-14 record and a No. 9 NCAA Tournament seed. The Sooners, who won their first 13 games and climbed to as high as No. 10 in the Coaches poll and No. 12 in the AP version, played one of the nation's toughest schedules, with 14 games against AP top-25 opponents and 22 of 34 contests against teams that made the NCAA Tournament. OU went 3-0 to win the Battle 4 Atlantis tournament in the Bahamas in November before navigating its first season in the rugged Southeastern Conference, a league that placed a record 14 teams in the NCAA Tournament. The Sooners also set a program record with their .795 free throw percentage, obliterating the previous mark of .767 by the 2001-02 Final Four team.

Point guard Jeremiah Fears was named to the 2024-25 SEC All-Freshman Team and was selected No. 7 overall in the 2025 NBA Draft by the New Orleans Pelicans to become Moser's highest draft pick. Fears was one of just three Power Four conference players (the only one in the SEC and the only freshman) to average at least 17.0 points, 4.0 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 1.5 steals per contest.

In 2023-24, Moser guided OU to a 20-12 mark, ranking as high as seventh in the AP poll. The Sooners reached 20 regular season wins for the first time since 2015-16 and began the season 10-0, tying the 1991-92 and 2003-04 seasons for the seventh-best start in program history. OU bested Iowa and USC at the Rady Children's Invitational, claiming its second consecutive midseason tournament title, and Javian McCollum and Jalon Moore earned All-Big 12 honorable mention accolades.

Moser completed his second season in Norman in 2022-23, recording four AP Top-25 victories and winning the 2022 ESPN Events Invitational. Tanner Groves became only the second two-time College Sports Communicators (formerly CoSIDA) Academic All-American in program history, receiving third-team honors in 2023 and first-team accolades in 2022. In addition to the Sooners' success in the classroom, Milos Uzan was named to the Big 12 All-Freshman Team. Grant Sheffield and Jalen Hill received All-Big 12 Honorable Mention acclaim.

In 2021-22, Moser led the Sooners to a 19-16 mark and five victories over teams ranked in the top 25 at the time of competition. Oklahoma was selected as a No. 1 seed in the National Invitation Tournament, earning an opening-round victory over Missouri State at Lloyd Noble Center.

Umoja Gibson, Jordan Goldwire, Groves and Elijah Harkless earned All-Big 12 honorable mention honors, and C.J. Noland earned a spot on the Big 12 All-Freshman Team. In addition to the on-court success, Groves was tabbed a Senior CLASS Award Finalist and named to the CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team.

Moser received the keys to the Oklahoma men's basketball program as one of the most successful coaches of the prior half-decade. He has been entrenched in creating and developing team culture at all his stops.

Before his time in Norman, Moser led the Loyola Ramblers to remarkable success during his 10-year run as head coach, including a run to the Final Four in 2018 and Sweet Sixteen in 2021.

He amassed 188 wins (188-141, .571), including five seasons with 20-plus victories. He led Loyola to the postseason every year it was available from 2017-21, winning the 2017 CBI title and qualifying for the 2019 NIT. The 2020 postseason was canceled due to COVID-19.

In addition to his team success, he coached 12 all-conference selections, two Missouri Valley Player of the Year honorees, two Associated Press Honorable Mention All-Americans, two Academic All-Americans, a MVC Defensive Player of the Year, two MVC Sixth Man of the Year honorees and a pair of MVC Freshman of the Year selections.

Moser was one of three coaches in Loyola's history to record 150-plus wins. He guided the 2017-18 squad to a school record 32 victories and an appearance in the Final Four – Loyola's first appearance since winning the 1963 NCAA Championship.

After assembling a 25-5 regular season record (15-3 in MVC play), Moser guided Loyola to seven straight postseason wins, claiming the 2018 Missouri Valley tournament title and making a historic run to the pinnacle event of college basketball as a No. 11 seed.

The Ramblers were just the fourth No. 11 seed to advance to the Final Four, beating Miami, Tennessee, Nevada and Kansas State.

Loyola finished the 2017-18 season ranked No. 7 in the final USA Today Coaches Poll. Moser was named the Missouri Valley Conference (MVC) Coach of the Year and the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) District 16 Coach of the Year.

The 2017-18 team ranked second nationally in personal fouls per game (just 13.9), third in field goal percentage (.507) and sixth in scoring defense (62.6 ppg).

During the 2017-18 season, Rambler guard Clayton Custer was named MVC Player of the Year and earned Associated Press (AP) Honorable Mention All-America honors, becoming the first player in Loyola history to receive both in the same season.

Cameron Krutwig earned MVC Freshman of the Year honors and Ben Richardson was named MVC Defensive Player of the Year. In addition to his on-court success, Custer was named CoSIDA Academic All-District. He is in his fourth year working with the Sooners and second as an assistant coach in 2024-25 after two seasons as the director of video operations and player development from 2021-23

Moser boasts six NCAA Tournament wins from 2018-21 – tied for the seventh most nationally in that time frame. Loyola, Gonzaga and Houston were the only teams outside major conferences to reach two Sweet 16s during the three-year run.

In his final season at Loyola (2020-21), Moser led the Ramblers to a 26-5 record and Missouri Valley Conference regular season and tournament titles. As an eighth seed in the NCAA Tournament, his squad upset No. 1-seed Illinois in the second round to advance to the Sweet 16 for the second time since 2018.

The 2020-21 Rambler squad ranked second in adjusted defensive efficiency (KenPom.com), allowing only 87.0 points per 100 possessions. Loyola's 16-2 record in MVC play set a program record for most wins in conference action.

After 19 wins during the 2014-15 season, the Ramblers earned a bid to the College Basketball Invitational (CBI), advancing to Loyola's first postseason appearance since the 1985 season. Loyola made the most of its chance at postseason play, winning the CBI Championship over Louisiana-Monroe with back-to-back victories in the best-of-three championship series.

After rebuilding during the 2013-14 season, Moser led the Ramblers to a 24-13 mark next season. The 24 victories were the most by a Moser led team and the most for Loyola since 1985.

In the early stages of building Loyola to a mid-major powerhouse, Moser led the Ramblers to an eight-game improvement in the win column from his first season at the helm to his second in 2012-13. The improvement was the most by a coach from his first year to his second in program history.

Owner of a 359-287 (.556) career record, Moser was hired for his first head coaching job in 2000 at Arkansas-Little Rock. In three seasons with the Trojans, Moser took over a program that went 4-24 during the season before his hiring and went 18-11 just one year later.

The Trojans ranked last in the conference in several defensive categories before his tenure. Moser turned the program around in one season, finishing with the Sun Belt's best field goal percentage defense and second-best scoring defense.

He steered the Trojans to a 54-34 overall record before heading to Illinois State in 2003.

After his 2003-04 squad notched a 10-19 record, Moser improved to 17-13 in 2004-05 despite being picked to finish last in the league in the preseason poll.

Following four years at Illinois State, Moser worked under legendary coach Rick Majerus at Saint Louis as an assistant coach from 2007 through 2011. He returned to a head coaching role by being named Loyola's head coach before the 2011-12 season.

A Chicago area native, Moser grew up in Naperville, Ill. He was a two-year starter at Creighton and helped lead the Jays to the 1989 Missouri Valley Conference title and a berth in the NCAA Tournament. He graduated in 1990 with a degree in business management.

Immediately following his collegiate playing career, Moser began his path in coaching at his alma mater as a graduate assistant. He left Creighton for an assistant coach role at Texas A&M for four seasons followed by a year at Wisconsin-Milwaukee. Moser returned to Texas A&M for two more seasons (1996-98) on the Aggies' bench, then served as an assistant coach at Little Rock for two years before his promotion to head coach.

Moser and his wife, Megan, have four children – Jordan, a former OU's women's basketball player, Jake, a former OU men's player, and Max and Ben.
