In the March 8 LSU at Florida dual, five competed as all-arounders. Those five produced the top collection of all-around scores recorded in a single meet this season, with totals ranging from 39.85 to 39.65.

Florida is part of a select group this season alongside Air Force (2x), UCLA and Iowa (2x) as the nation's only teams to feature four all-arounders in a single meet.

Florida became the latest addition to this group March 8 versus No. 2 LSU, while the other three teams each competed four all-arounders in January.

It was the first time in 2026 Florida had four all-around competitors. Florida had no all-arounders in three 2026 meets, marking the first time since the 2013 season no Gators competed as all-arounders.

Florida twice competed four in all-around in 2025. There were eight 2024 meets with four or more all-arounders, including five in the NCAA Regional Second Round. The five was the most for the Gators since the 2009 season.

What's Happening?

No. 3 Florida Gators and No. 22 Kentucky Wildcats close the 2026 regular season Friday night in the Historic Memorial Coliseum, marking the second consecutive year the programs have ended their regular-season schedules against one another. It is also the fourth straight season the two teams meet to close Southeastern Conference regular-season action, continuing a long-standing rivalry that spans 100 previous meetings.

Friday's meet will be Florida's first appearance in Historic Memorial Coliseum since the venue reopened on April 26, 2025. The Gators' most recent trip to Lexington came in 2024, when the dual was held in Rupp Arena. That matchup produced one of the most notable meets in NCAA gymnastics history, as it is among the 12 meets in NCAA history in which both teams posted totals of 198 or higher. Florida edged Kentucky 198.225–198.10, with the 0.125 margin standing as the narrowest in the all-time series between the programs.

Nation's Top Score Powers Gators Past No. 2 LSU

In a meet worthy of the nation's top billing, No. 4 Florida delivered the country's highest score of the season March 8 to edge No. 2 LSU in a showdown between collegiate gymnastics' elite.

Backed by a roaring sellout crowd of 9,229 inside the Exactech Arena at the Stephen C. O'Connell Center, the Gators produced the nation's best 2026 team total of 198.45 to edge LSU, which posted the nation's top road score with a 198.325.

The teams traded the advantage throughout a tightly contested meet that matched the weekend's lofty expectations. Florida and LSU were tied after the opening rotation before the Tigers edged ahead by 0.075 at the midway point. The Gators reclaimed momentum in the third rotation, carrying the slimmest of leads - 0.025 - into the finale.

Florida sealed the victory in dramatic fashion on floor exercise, delivering the nation's second-highest floor total of the season (49.75) while LSU also recorded its season-high balance beam score in the final rotation.

High team totals came with equally impressive individual performances. Each apparatus title was claimed with a perfect or near-perfect mark, and the meet's five all-around competitors produced the top collection of all-around scores recorded in a single meet this season, with totals ranging from 39.85 to 39.65.

MEET COACH ROWLAND



Jenny Rowland begins in her 11th season as University of Florida's head gymnastics coach. Rowland is the seventh head coach for the Gator program, which competes in its 54th season in 2026.

Rowland swept 2020 coaching awards – Women's Collegiate Gymnastics Association (WCGA) National, Region 5 and Southeastern Conference Coach of the Year. She shared the 2016 SEC Coach of the Year honor with Arkansas' Mark Cook. She again was the SEC Coach of the Year in 2021 and three such honors is the most for any league coach in their opening six seasons.

Rowland's experiences from the sport's highest level are the same as many current Gators. She is a former U.S. National Team member, a collegiate All-American and was named a 2015 National Collegiate Assistant of the Year.

Rowland is a Category 3 International Brevet level judge. She served on the judging panel for the 2008, 2012 and 2016 U.S. Olympic Trials.

Rowland served on the NCAA Women's Gymnastics Committee for the 2020-23 seasons.

Rowland's Coaching Career:

At Florida:

Florida advanced to the NCAA Team Final in 2021, 2022, 2023 & 2024, placing fourth (2021 & '24) and second (2022 & 2023). Florida reached the NCAA Super Six team final in each of Rowland's first three seasons, with the Gators, taking fourth in 2016 and third in 2017 & 2018. Rowland swept all coaching awards in 2020 (national, region & SEC) after the Gators finished at No. 2 with a 10-0 record in the pandemic shortened season. She claimed her first SEC Coach of the Year honor in 2016 when the Gators won the SEC Championship meet. Florida won six straight SEC regular-season titles – 2019 (6-1 record), 2020 (7-0), 2021 (7-0), 2022 (6-0-1), 2023 (6-1) and 2024 (6-1).

The Honda Award for gymnastics went to Sloan (2016), McMurtry (2017) and Thomas (2022 & 2023), distinguishing them as the nation's top collegiate gymnast. McMurtry was part of a rare double in 2017 and 2018, claiming both the SEC Gymnast (2017)/SEC Event Specialist (2018) and the SEC Scholar-Athlete awards. Trinity Thomas received the 2020, 2022 & 2023 SEC Gymnast of the Year awards. Leah Clapper earned the 2021 SEC Scholar-Athlete award.

Since 2016, 26 Gators earned 192 All-America honors (at NCAA Championships and WCGA regular season).

At Auburn:

Rowland came to Florida after spending five seasons at Auburn. She joined the Auburn coaching staff as an assistant coach in October of 2010 and was elevated to associate head coach in March of 2013. Rowland worked with all aspects of the Auburn gymnastics program, coordinating all of the program's community outreach efforts and interactions on campus as well as playing an integral role in recruiting and in-gym activities.

She was co-National Assistant Coach of the Year in 2015 after helping AU reach the NCAA Super Six for the first time in 22 years.

Coaching Career Start in Sooner State:

Rowland coached Elite gymnasts at Bart Conner Gymnastics Academy in Norman, Okla., for five years and then joined the Oklahoma coaching staff in June of 2001. At OU, she helped coach the Sooners to the 2004 Big XIII title, three-time team NCAA qualifiers (2004-06) and three Big XIII Gymnasts of the Year.

As a Gymnast:

During her gymnastics career, Rowland was a USA National Team member from 1985-1990 and was part of the U.S.'s 1989 World Championships team. During her collegiate career, she earned All-America honors for the uneven bars in 1993 for Arizona State.

After retiring from competition, she returned to her home state, enrolling at the University of Oklahoma to finish her degree.

2026 NQS

- Includes up to five home scores, taking the lowest five if there are six or more
- Includes all away scores
- Drops high & low scores
- Averages the remaining scores

Implementation of the NQS formula on Road to Nationals follows schedule below:

- Weeks 1-6: Straight NQS average, with a maximum of five (5) home meets.
- Weeks 7+: NQS average, with a maximum of five (5) home meets, dropping the high and low scores.
- Following Conference Championships: Implementation of new NQS formula for Postseason Qualifications/Selections.

For Florida in 2026, the Gators compete in five home and five road meets during the regular season with the SEC Championship meet adding in as a sixth road meet. All of Florida's meets will be computed in the Gators' 2026 NQS. The highest and lowest scores will be dropped with the remaining scores averaged.

Prior NQS formula: Six meets (3 highest road and home scores, dropping the high and averaging the remaining five), regardless of how many meets the team competed in during the season.

The prior NQS formula will continue to be used for individual NQS.

SEC WEEKLY AWARDS



Florida's Selena Harris-Miranda doubles the weekly honors after posting the nation's top all-around score of the weekend, highlighted by a perfect 10.0 on balance beam. She was named Inside Gymnastics National Gymnast of the Week *and* the Southeastern Conference Gymnast of the Week.

Harris-Miranda led the nation in March's opening weekend with a 39.85 all-around total in Florida victory over No. 2 LSU. The meet featured a marquee all-around field, with all five competitors posting scores between 39.85 and 39.65 - each ranking among the nation's top 10 totals for the weekend.

Her 39.85 is the second-highest all-around score recorded in the nation this season.

The latest recognition marks Harris-Miranda's second SEC Gymnast of the Week honor this season, previously earning January's final award. BLAKELY & DICELLO BACK

Florida saw two key gymnasts make long-awaited returns to competition January 9 as **Skye Blakely** and **Kayla DiCello** appeared in multiple events for the Gators.

Both Blakely and DiCello suffered Achilles tears at the 2024 U.S. Olympic Trials, injuries that ended their bids for spots on the U.S. Olympic team after entering the summer as Paris favorites.

Blakely competed only on uneven bars for Florida last season while continuing her recovery. She returned to elite competition in the summer of 2025, winning the uneven bars title and finishing second on beam at the Xfinity U.S. Championships. She earned a place on her third World Championships roster, where she competed on bars and beam at the October championships in Indonesia and advanced to the uneven bars final, finishing fourth.

The Jan. 9 meet marked Blakely's first competitive floor exercise since the 2024 U.S. Championships — a span of 587 days. She scored a 9.875 on floor, made her first appearance in a collegiate beam lineup (9.85) and added a 9.875 on uneven bars.

DiCello's return followed an even longer absence. After earning five All-America honors and Southeastern Conference Freshman of the Year recognition in 2023, she took a gap year to pursue an Olympic berth. Her absence extended another season as both Achilles required surgery. The Jan. 9 meet was DiCello's first collegiate competition in 1,001 days, dating back to the 2023 NCAA Championships team final. She competed in three events, scoring a 9.825 on vault and 9.90 on both uneven bars and beam.

DiCello made her 2026 all-around debut Feb. 13 versus Oklahoma. It was 1,036 days since she last competed a collegiate all-around when she finished third in the 2023 NCAA Team Final. Her last competitive all-around was her bronze medal performance at the 2024 Xfinity U.S. Gymnastics Championships (620 days span).

- **Alyssa Arana** is fluent in Spanish. She converses with her grandmother in Spanish, but suspects Grandma understands more English than she lets on.
- **Skye Blakely** and her sister, Sloane (who completed her All-American career in 2025), participated in ballet and tap before trying gymnastics. They also were child models and Skye appeared in an episode on the *Barney & Friends* show.
- **Jayla Booker** was diagnosed with epilepsy in July 2021. It was a hard moment, but she faced it with determination and grit. Now she hopes to inspire other kids with epilepsy.
- **Lori Brubach** made her first sky-diving leap in summer of 2023. Hasn't made a second jump but it is on her to-do list!
- **Lily Bruce** has a twin brother, Finn.
- **Ly Bui** went right from kindergarten to second grade. Skipping first grade is a major contributor to why Bui went through 2025 as the season's youngest NCAA competitor.
- **Taylor Clark** attended Gator Gymnastics Summer Camp during her club career. She credits UF Associate Coach Adrian Burde with the key words that led to successfully conquering her double layout on floor.
- **Kayla DiCello** is one of two Gators to win Pan Am Games all-around (2024), joining Bridgette Caquatto (2011). Also, her younger sister, Karleigh, is a sophomore on West Virginia's gymnastics team.
- **Amelia Disidore** is one of six Gators who were part of the U.S. Senior National Team as elites. She's also got elite skills in Beat Saber. Prepare to lose if you challenge her in the virtual reality rhythm game.
- **Gabby Disidore** is one of four current Gator gymnasts (also including Kayla DiCello, Skylar Draser and Selena Harris-Miranda) who traveled to the Dominican Republic in June 2025. The Gators Experience includes community service activities as well as fun excursions. She is joined on the team by her sister, Amelia, this season. They are the fourth set of sisters to compete on the same team, joining Lynn and Karen McDonnell (1983 & '84), Mackenzie and Bridgette Caquatto (2013 & '14) and Sloane and Skye Blakely (2025). Another pair of sisters – Alyssa and Rachel Baumann – also competed for the Gators but not in the same season.
- **Maddy Dorbin's** favorite event is beam. A bit of beam wisdom from UCLA's Katelyn Ohashi stuck with her: "If your feet go over the top, then your whole body will stay on beam." Those words roll through her mind as she works through her routine.
- **Skylar Draser's** favorite holiday is Christmas 🎄, not her birthday which also happens to be Halloween 🎃. She's not the only Draser competing collegiately this season as her sister, Madison, is a freshman on Towson's 2026 gymnastics team.
- **Danie Ferris'** floor exercise celebrates her heritage (mom is from Morocco). Her dance and music incorporates a nod to her family culture.
- **eMjae Frazier** earned three 10.0s (two floor, one beam) while with California. After graduating from Cal in May, she enrolled at UF to bring the number of Gators with 10.0 marks this season to six.
- **Selena Harris-Miranda** earned high honors in two different conferences in back-to-back seasons. She was the 2024 Pac-12 Gymnast of the Year honor while with UCLA before transferring to UF in the summer of 2024. Harris-Miranda was the SEC Newcomer of the Year in 2025.
- **Riley McCusker** became the 25th Gator to earn a 10.0 to win the 2025 Southeastern Conference Championship meet. She anchored UF's NCAA record bars set (49.85) to win a share of the 2025 event title. A 10.0 has won the SEC bars title five times – with four of those marks coming from a Gator (Bridget Sloan, Trinity Thomas, Leanne Wong).
- **Anya Pilgrim** keeps track of every Tkatchev she catches since adding the uneven bars skill in 2017.
- **Jocelyn Sasson** isn't the only member of her family performing in the Exactech Arena this season. Her twin, Jenna, is a Gator Dazzler. Both performed in December's Gators Hype Night.



Did You Know...

Every Gator gymnast has a "Gator Chomp" choreographed into her floor exercise routine.

All-American Colleen Johnson was the first to "chomp" in her 1994 floor routine. It has been a part of all Gator floor routines since 1995.

Those signature chomps are going full takeover — they'll now appear in every Gators balance beam routine beginning with the 2026 season. Selena Harris-Miranda first slipped a chomp into her beam choreography during preseason training for 2025, with Riley McCusker quickly joining the fun. As preparations ramped up for 2026, eMjae Frazier added one for her Gator routine. It wasn't long before every Gator beamer was chomping along.

ERNESTINE RUSSELL CARTER WEAVER

Ernestine Russell Carter (Weaver), a pioneering figure in collegiate gymnastics and an influential coach in University of Florida history, passed away Jan. 14, 2026.



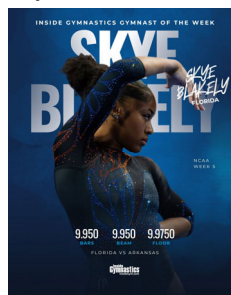
Weaver served as Florida's head coach for 13 seasons from 1980–92, leading the Gators to the 1982 AIAW National Championship—the final national team title of the AIAW era—and five Southeastern Conference championships. Under her leadership, Florida produced its first All-American gymnast in 1981, followed by 12 gymnasts who combined for 31 All-America honors, including five individual national titles. Equally important to Weaver was success beyond the mat, as she took great pride in seeing her student-athletes earn their University of Florida degrees.

A Canadian Olympian, the 1980 U.S. Olympic coach, and a Brevet judge, Weaver was also widely regarded as an innovator in marketing gymnastics to collegiate fans. The electric crowds that filled Florida's arenas during the 1980s inspired programs nationwide, helping shape the modern collegiate gymnastics experience.

INSIDE GYMNASTICS NATIONAL GYMNAST OF THE WEEK

After a trio of collegiate-best marks, sophomore **Skye Blakely** claimed the Week 5 Inside Gymnastics National Gymnast of the Week honor.

Why She Won Week 5:

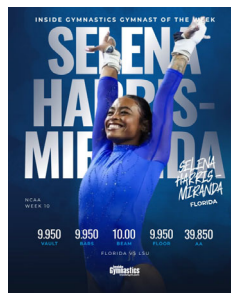


Blakely matched or set her then collegiate best to win at least a share of each event competed in Jan. 30 win versus then No. 6 Arkansas. She used a near-perfect 9.975 to claim her second consecutive floor exercise title. Blakely matched her then uneven bars best of 9.95 to share the event title with Selena Harris-Miranda and used the same mark to share the balance beam win with Kayla DiCello.

She also claimed the SEC Specialist of the Week honor after her performance versus the Razorbacks.

The all-around high of the weekend in the nation's top meet of the weekend (and arguably the top meet of the season according to the SEC Network announcers) that was boosted by a beam 10.0 earned **Selena Harris-Miranda** her second Inside Gymnastics National Gymnast of the Week honor of her career.

Why She Won Week 10:



Harris-Miranda led the nation in March's first weekend with a 39.85 all-around total in Florida's victory over No. 2 LSU. The meet featured a marquee all-around field, with all five competitors posting scores between 39.85 and 39.65 - each ranking among the nation's top 10 totals for the weekend. Her 39.85 is the second-highest all-around score recorded in the nation this season.

She anchored the beam lineup with her second 10.0 on the event of her career. Harris-Miranda also earned the SEC Gymnast of the Week honor – her second of 2026.

GAINESVILLE, Fla. — Florida opened its season Jan. 9 with a big performance, rolling to a quad-meet victory behind the second-highest season-opening score in program history and the current national leader at the Exactech Arena at the Stephen C. O'Connell Center.

The preseason No. 3 Gators posted a 197.725 to win Kids Night presented by GFL Environmental, finishing just shy of the program's opening-meet record of 197.75 set in 2023. North Carolina, ranked No. 24 in the preseason, finished second with a 196.675, followed by Temple (193.875) and West Virginia (193.45) in front of a crowd of 7,237.

Florida gymnasts equaled 2026 national highs to win three meet event titles. Sophomore **Ly Bui** equaled her collegiate best of 9.925 to win her first vault title. Senior All-American **Selena Harris-Miranda** set the season's high of 9.95 for uneven bars and matched the high of 9.975 for beam.

TONIGHT'S MEET

Florida led the meet throughout, including turning in a 2026 national high for team (197.725), vault (49.425) and uneven bars (49.475). A trio of Gators turned in marks of 9.9 or better on uneven bars (**Selena Harris-Miranda** 9.95; **Riley McCusker** and **Kayla DiCello** 9.9). The other events saw a pair of Gators open the season at 9.9 or better:

Competing Again

Florida saw two key gymnasts make long-awaited returns to competition Friday as Skye Blakely and Kayla DiCello appeared in multiple events for the Gators.

Both Blakely and DiCello suffered Achilles tears at the 2024 U.S. Olympic Trials, injuries that ended their bids for spots on the U.S. Olympic team after entering the summer as Paris favorites.

Blakely competed only on uneven bars for Florida last season while continuing her recovery. She returned to elite competition in the summer of 2025, winning the uneven bars title and finishing second on beam at the Xfinity U.S. Championships. She earned a place on her third World Championships roster, where she competed on bars and beam at the October championships in Indonesia and advanced to the uneven bars final, finishing fourth.

Friday marked Blakely's first competitive floor exercise since the 2024 U.S. Championships — a span of 587 days. She scored a 9.875 on floor, made her first appearance in a collegiate beam lineup (9.85) and added a 9.875 on uneven bars.

DiCello's return followed an even longer absence. After earning five All-America honors and Southeastern Conference Freshman of the Year recognition in 2023, she took a gap year to pursue an Olympic berth. Her absence extended another season as both Achilles required surgery. Friday was DiCello's first collegiate competition in 1,001 days, dating back to the 2023 NCAA Championships team final. She competed in three events, scoring a 9.825 on vault and 9.90 on both uneven bars and beam.

GATOR PERFORMANCE NOTES:

- **Selena Harris-Miranda's** 9.975 matches the second-highest beam score in a season opener in program history. She joins Ellie Lazzari (2024) and Trinity Thomas (2020). Thomas set event record with a 10.0 to open in 2023 beam action.
- **Selena Harris-Miranda's** 9.95 matches the program's second-highest bars mark in a season-opener. She has some good company in second, as two of Florida's NCAA bars champions – **Trinity Thomas** (3 times) and **Leanne Wong** (2x) – also opened a season with a 9.95 bars mark. **Melanie Sinclair** set the high season-opening bars mark of 9.975 to win the 2007 Super Six Challenge in Fayetteville, Ark.
- The Gators first competitor of the season – sophomore **Ly Bui** – started off with posting the winning vault mark of 9.925. That score equals her collegiate high for the third time and also marks her first collegiate event win.
- Friday's crowd of 7,237 is the 10th largest home opener in the program's 54 seasons.

GAINESVILLE, Fla. — Top-ranked Florida edged No. 4 Alabama 197.425–197.275 on Friday night at Exactech Arena at the Stephen C. O'Connell Center, opening Southeastern Conference action in front of 7,524 fans for Flashback Friday presented by Publix.

With SEC programs holding eight of the top 10 spots in the national rankings, every league meet is expected to be highly competitive. Friday's conference opener featured the nation's top dual of the weekend in a meet that came down to the final routine.

Florida won or shared three event titles. Senior All-American **Selena Harris-Miranda** captured her second consecutive balance beam title with a 9.95 and shared the vault win with Alabama's Azaraya Ra-Akbar at 9.925. Florida's **Taylor Clark** and **Amelia Disidore** shared the floor exercise title at 9.90 with Ra-Akbar and Jamison Sears of Alabama.

Ra-Akbar won the all-around at 39.60, while Alabama's Chloe LaCoursiere posted the meet's highest score, a 9.975, to win the uneven bars.

TONIGHT'S MEET

Florida opened the meet on vault, where minor steps on landings limited scores. Harris-Miranda anchored the lineup with a stuck landing and a team-high 9.925.

The Gators rebounded on uneven bars, posting a season-high 49.55. All five counting routines scored 9.90 or higher, led by 9.925s from All-Americans **Riley McCusker** and **Anyia Pilgrim**.

Alabama led Florida by 0.025 at the midway point.

Balance beam proved decisive for the Gators. Junior **Skylar Draser** matched her collegiate-best 9.90 in the leadoff spot, followed by a 9.925 from senior All-American **eMjae Frazier**. Harris-Miranda added a 9.95 and All-American Alyssa Arana anchored with a 9.875 in her season debut.

Florida carried a one-tenth lead into the final rotation. Freshman **Jayla Booker** opened floor exercise with a 9.875, and Disidore followed with a 9.90 in her collegiate debut. Clark also turned in a 9.90 Friday. Despite counting an out-of-bounds routine, Florida's floor scores were enough to secure the victory.

No. 2 Florida at No. 7 Missouri

COLUMBIA, Mo. — No. 2 Florida gymnastics opens February with loss at No. 7 Missouri Friday in front of 2,976 at the Mizzou Arena.

The Tigers took the win at 197.20 while Florida finished with a season-low 196.50.

Missouri ended its losses versus the nation's No. 2 this season on Friday. Florida was the third No. 2-ranked team to compete at Mizzou Arena this season, a venue that has proven challenging for the nation's elite. Then-No. 2 Oklahoma trailed Missouri after the opening rotation before rallying for a narrow 0.50 victory Jan. 16, and in January's final Friday, then-No. 2 LSU escaped with a slim 0.175 win.

Friday's meet marks the fourth consecutive matchup between the Gators and Tigers in which both teams carry top-10 rankings. That streak includes all three meetings in 2025. This is the second consecutive loss for the Gators versus the Tigers. In the final meeting of 2025, the Tigers finished second in NCAA Semifinal I to advance to the NCAA Team Final ahead of third-place Florida.

TONIGHT'S MEET

Florida was not its usual self on its opening event, with a miss and steps on landings holding back its uneven bars scores. Leading the Gators on bars were winning marks of 9.90s from both **eMjae Frazier** and **Kayla DiCello**.

Florida posted a 49.25 on vault. Boosting that score was meet-leading vaults from junior **Danie Ferris** (9.90) and **Selena Harris-Miranda** (9.95). The win was Harris-Miranda's third of the season.

The Gators trailed the Tigers by 0.675 after the opening event and still at midpoint as both teams turned in the same total on the second rotation.

Ferris and Harris-Miranda again led the Gators on the next rotation with floor marks of 9.90 as UF tallied a 49.325 on the event.

Florida's finishing event was its top scorer, as the Gators tallied a 49.425 on beam. DiCello matched her season-best of 9.95 for the second consecutive meet to share the win. Harris-Miranda posted a 9.90 to tie for third.

GAINESVILLE, Fla. — No. 5 Florida gymnastics lost 198.075 - 197.575 to top-ranked Oklahoma in the 20th Annual Gators Link to Pink meet presented by UF Health Friday night.

The meet was held in front of a pink-clad sellout crowd of 9,287 at Exactech Arena at the Stephen C. O'Connell Center. It was the 24th sellout for Gators Gymnastics since the 2018 season.

The defeat ended the Gators' home winning stretch dating to Jan. 26, 2024, when Alabama took the win. Friday's result also marked Florida's first back-to-back league losses since the 2006 season, when the program dropped consecutive Southeastern Conference meets at then No. 4 Alabama and then to No. 1 Georgia.

TONIGHT'S MEET

Florida started the meet with some extra steps dinging their vault scores, as the team posted a 48.975. The only Gator to reach 9.90 was junior All-American **Danie Ferris**. It was her second consecutive vault 9.90 and third 2026 mark 9.9 or better. She took third overall tonight, as OU's Addison Fatta posted her first 10.0 of 2026 to win while teammate Faith Torrez was second at 9.925.

The Gators set the nation's uneven bars high of 49.65 on the next rotation. All marks contributing to the nation's 2026 high were 9.9 or better. **Riley McCusker** matched her season-best of 9.975 to win her second bars title of the season. **Kayla DiCello** set her 2026 best to take second at 9.95 and **Skye Blakely** shared third at 9.925 with Oklahoma's Mackenzie Estep.

Florida trailed by 0.250 at the meet's midway point.

Both teams posted a 49.50 on the third rotation. Florida used three marks of 9.9 or better toward its balance beam total of 49.50, which equals the team high for 2026. Selena Harris-Miranda led with her third 9.95 on the event this season. Both Alyssa Arana and Blakely turned in 9.90s. OU's Ella Murphy won beam at 9.975.

On the final rotation, the Gators couldn't keep pace with Oklahoma's balance beam marks, as the Sooners put up the nation's event high of 49.70. Three Gators posted floor marks of 9.9 or better, including Harris-Miranda matching her collegiate-best of 9.975 to win floor. Blakely took second a 9.95, just off her collegiate best of 9.975 set versus Arkansas.

ATHENS, Ga. — No. 4 Florida gymnastics leaned on its consistency Friday night, edging No. 6 Georgia 197.575–197.325 before a sold-out crowd of 10,069 at Stegeman Coliseum.

In a rivalry known for tight finishes, this one followed the script. Five of the 27 dual meetings between the programs in Athens since 1975 have been decided by 0.250 or less — all coming since 2005. Florida improved to 3-1-1 in those narrow contests.

The Gators have now won every dual meet in Athens since 2018, and Friday marked Georgia's first home loss of the season.

FRIDAY'S MEET:

Florida opened with a string of stuck uneven bars landings as the team posted a 49.425 for the event. Kayla DiCello equaled her season best of 9.95 to share the individual high on any event to win bars. UF also got a pair of 9.90s from eMjæe Frazier and Selena Harris-Miranda, which tied for third overall.

Florida equaled its season vault high of 49.425. Marks of 9.90 from DiCello, Danie Ferris and Harris-Miranda led the Gators on the event and shared second overall. Skye Blakely made her collegiate vault debut Friday, earning a 9.875.

The meet was all tied up at the midpoint at 98.85

Florida used scores of 9.85 or better toward its floor total of 49.30. Frazier's 9.90 led the Gators and shared third in the final floor standings. Four other Gators earned 9.85s — Amelia Disidore, Ferris, Blakely and Taylor Clark.

The Gators took a 0.275 advantage into the final rotation as both teams moved to an event that they were ranked No. 2 in the nation — Florida on beam and Georgia on floor exercise.

UF's beam total of 49.425 secured the win. Harris-Miranda anchored the lineup, matching the meet's high individual mark of 9.95 to win her fourth beam title of the season. DiCello shared second at 9.90 with UGA's JaFree Scott.

Harris-Miranda won her second all-around of the season at 39.50. In her collegiate all-around debut, Blakely was second at 39.225.

GAINESVILLE, Fla. – In a meet worthy of the nation's top billing, No. 4 Florida delivered the country's highest score of the season Sunday to edge No. 2 LSU in a showdown between collegiate gymnastics' elite.

Backed by a roaring sellout crowd of 9,229 inside the Exactech Arena at the Stephen C. O'Connell Center, the Gators produced the nation's best 2026 team total of 198.45 to edge LSU, which posted the nation's top road score with a 198.325.

The teams traded the advantage throughout a tightly contested meet that matched the weekend's lofty expectations. Florida and LSU were tied after the opening rotation before the Tigers edged ahead by 0.075 at the midway point. The Gators reclaimed momentum in the third rotation, carrying the slimmest of leads - 0.025 - into the finale.

Florida sealed the victory in dramatic fashion on floor exercise, delivering the nation's second-highest floor total of the season (49.75) while LSU also recorded its season-high balance beam score in the final rotation.

High team totals came with equally impressive individual performances. Each apparatus title was claimed with a perfect or near-perfect mark, and the meet's five all-around competitors produced the top collection of all-around scores recorded in a single meet this season, with totals ranging from 39.85 to 39.65.

TONIGHT'S MEET

The meet was tied after each team opened with totals of 49.375. Florida's total came on the vault, as both Kayla DiCello and Selena Harris-Miranda led the Gators with season-high 9.95s. Scores were high for both teams during the second rotation. For the second week in row, Skye Blakely posted her collegiate-best of 9.975 to share her third uneven bars win with LSU's Konner McClain. Harris-Miranda took third after matching her season-high 9.95. LSU owned a 0.075 lead at the midpoint after posting the nation's second-highest vault total of the season (49.70). Florida took the narrowest advantage, 0.025, into the final rotation after posting a 49.70 on balance beam. Anchoring that beam lineup was Harris-Miranda's second 10.0 of her career. Florida also got back-to-back 9.95s from eMjæe Frazier and DiCello plus Blakely earned a 9.925. All six Gators in the floor lineup turned in marks of 9.90 or better Sunday. Blakely and Frazier shared the event title with LSU's Kaliya Lincoln as each posted a near-perfect 9.975.

Sunday's meet featured five all-arounders – all with totals among the nation's top nine tallies of 2026. Harris-Miranda took the win with a season-high 39.85 – the nation's No. 2 total of the season. Her former club teammate, LSU's Kailin Chio, was runner-up at 39.775. DiCello (39.725), Blakely (39.70) and Frazier (39.65) all turned in season bests.
