## 2025 RECAP

The Cats sent eight qualifying athletes to Virginia Beach, Va. for the 2025 NCAA Indoor Championships. Those qualifiers included Carlie Makarawu (M 200m), Kate Powers (W Weight Throw), Luke Brown (M Triple Jump), Alexis Glasco (W 60m Hurdles) and the women's 4x400m relay team, which consisted of Hannah Douglas, Cha'iel Johnson, Oneika McAnnuff and Stacey Onyepunuka. By the meet's end, Makarawu came away with his first NCAA Division I National Championship in the men's 200m final, beating out NCAA No. 1 Makanakaishe Charamba with a school record 20.13 time.

22 Wildcats qualified for the NCAA Outdoor Championships in Eugene, including 2x NCAA Champion Carlie Makarawu and SEC Steeplechase Champion Collins Kiprop Kipngok. Makarawu would go on to win his second NCAA title of 2025 and 11 more Cats would earn First or Second Team All-American status in their respective events, highlighted by the men's 4x100m relay team finishing sixth and Emmi Scales placing 11th in the women's 100m hurdles.

## NEW KIDS IN THE BLOCKS

The Wildcats feature a star-studded class of newcomers, highlighted by transfers Tyrique Johnson, Theo Mudzengerere, Takudzwa Pahuwa and Denzel Simusialela on the men's side and Kaylee Daniel, Sarah Ferguson, Skyler Reynolds and Sanaa Washington on the women's team. Head Coach Lonnie Greene also added 11 athletes in the transfer portal, highlighted by Tyrique Johnson, Theo Mudzengerere, Denzel Simusialela on the men's team and Kaylee Daniel, Ann Lemirisho, Rukia Nusra Omulisia, Skyler Reynolds and Sanaa Washington on the women's team.

## POWERS HOUR

Kate Powers surged into national title contention during her sophomore season as a Wildcat, throwing three personal bests in three starts and currently ranking 4th in the NCAA in the event. She has broken the school record twice this season, first in a winning performance at the McCravy Memorial, throwing 21.64m to earn her first school record. A week later, Powers broke that record by over three feet, throwing 22.63m at the Vanderbilt Invite to finish as the top collegian and go ahead of the then-national leader. For her efforts in Nashville, Powers was named the SEC Field Athlete of the Week. At the 2025 SEC Indoor Championships in College Station, Powers earned the first gold medal of her career in the women's weight throw with a mark of 20.80m.

## 2x NATTY CHAMP

Former Wildcat Carlie Makarawu, prior to turning pro in July, became the third athlete in Kentucky program history to win a NCAA Championship in the same indoor and outdoor event, winning both men's 200m finals during the 2025 season. His 19.84 time at the outdoor championships in Eugene featured as the UK program record, the Zimbabwe national record, the collegiate best time for the season and the world No. 2 time.

## HOPPIN AND SKIPPIN AND JUMPIN

South Carolina transfer Theo Mudzengerere has set the tone during the early going of the 2025-26 season, breaking into the UK all-time top 10 ranks for the men's triple jump event. In his first event for the Wildcats, Mudzengerere broke his career-best mark with a 16.04m final distance at the Commodore Winter Challenge in Nashville in December. In the first event of the new year, the Wildcats senior posted an even better mark of 16.39m, the second-best mark of all-time for Kentucky.

## STAR-STUDED STAFF

The Kentucky Track & Field staff of Volunteer and Graduate Assistants is full of some of the top names in track, headlined by 2024 100m Hurdles Olympic Gold Medalist—and Kentucky alumna—Masai Russell. 60m Hurdles World Record Holder and two-time Olympic finalist Devynne Charlton is also a volunteer coach on staff. Keaton Daniel—2024 NCAA Indoor and Outdoor Champion in the Pole Vault joined the staff after graduating from Kentucky in the spring of '24. 2x NCAA Champion Carlie Makarawu is the latest addition to the volunteers staff after turning pro following the 2025 season.

## PRO-CATS 2025 ROUNDUP

- Former Wildcats had a stellar 2025 season, headlined by a program-best performance at the 2025 USATF Championships and the World Athletics Championships.
- **Sydney McLaughlin-Levrone** won the fifth World Athletics Gold Medal of her career in Tokyo at the outdoor championships in August. It was the first time in her career winning a gold medal in the women's 400m event on the world stage.
- **Masai Russell** broke the American 100m hurdles record at a Grand Slam Track event in Miami with a time of 12.19.
- **Jasmine Camacho-Quinn, Russell, McLaughlin-Levrone, and Alexis Holmes** all signed with Grand Slam Track for the 2025 season.
- **Camacho-Quinn and McLaughlin-Levrone** were inducted into the UK Athletics Hall of Fame in September of 2024.

## XC ROUNDUP

Kentucky Cross Country saw success in the 2025 season, highlighted by **Ed Bird** and **Collins Kiprop Kipngok's** advancement to the national meet. The All-SEC Third Team members placed 101st and 193rd at the NCAA Championships, respectively. Freshman women's runner **Dorica Minsari Iose** produced a breakout campaign in 2025, placing inside the top 10 in each of her first three races, running a season-best time of 19:55.7 in the 6k at the Pre-National Invitational. At the SEC Championships, Minsari Iose earned All-SEC Second Team honors with a 12th-place finish in Knoxville.

## TRACKTOWN LEX

Kentucky is set to host the 2026 NCAA Outdoor Track and Field East First Round in Lexington from May 27-30, marking one of five championship meets in the Bluegrass in a six-year span. The UK Outdoor Track and Field Complex hosted the 2024 NCAA East First Rounds and is set to host the event again in 2028.

## COLLEGIATE RECORDS

Four Wildcat greats still hold collegiate records from their days as a Wildcat. Abby Steiner holds a pair of marks, including her 21.80 200m performance that won her the 2022 NCAA Outdoor title. Steiner also holds the indoor 300m record at 35.80 seconds from the 2021-22 season. Masai Russell was the most recent Wildcat to break a collegiate record, setting the 100m hurdles mark at 12.36 seconds at the 2023 Texas Relays. Four-time Olympic Gold Medalist Sydney McLaughlin-Levrone set a seemingly untouchable standard in her signature 400m hurdles, running 52.75 seconds to win the 2018 SEC Championship. Steiner and Russell also broke indoor records during their time at Kentucky that have since been broken. Steiner's 22.09 200m at the 2022 SEC Championships set a standard that held for a little over a year. Russell set a 60m hurdles record of 7.75 in January 2023 at the Red Raider Open, but that mark was broken by Arkansas's Ackera Nugent at the 2023 NCAA Indoor Championships. The 2022 Outdoor 4x400m team of Karimah Davis, Dajour Miles, Abby Steiner, and Alexis Holmes ran 3:21.93 to win the SEC Championships and set a collegiate record at the time. The team also won the NCAA title that year.


