## CORNER CATS

Through the first two games of their season, the Wildcats lead the country in corner kick attempts with 27 and attempts per game (13.50).

## OUTMANED, OUTNUMBERED, OUTSHOT

The Wildcats have outshot their opponents 56-5 so far this season, which leads the SEC in shots so far with 56 shots and is sixth in the NCAA. Kentucky is also in the top 10 in the NCAA in goal differential (6th, 11), shots on goal per game (7th, 13.0), total goals (5th, 11), goals per game (5th, 5.50), total points (6th, 28), and points per game (6th, 14.0).

## RAYO DOMINATES THE BELL

In all three of her appearances at The Bell in her college career, Juliette Rayo has scored a goal. Her first came when she visited with Oklahoma in 2025, second during the 2026 season opener for the blue & white, and once again this week against Kent State.

## WELCOME BACK

Junior Michelle Moskau got a warm welcome back in the season opener, playing 77 minutes in the starting centerback spot. She returns after starting 20 games in 2024.

## RAMADAN STRIKES

Nadia Ramadan scored two penalty kicks against Detroit Mercy on 8/12/26. She is perfect from the stripe at 2-0 this season and leads the team in points and goals.

## CENTER (BACK) OF IT ALL

In the opening week against Detroit Mercy and Kent State, senior Katherine Truitt was the only Wildcat to play all 180 minutes. She & the Kentucky defense allowed just five shots on goal through the first two games.

## HISTORIC 2025

Last season, Kentucky Women's Soccer experienced the program's most successful season in a decade. Some highlights include:

- Second consecutive NCAA Tournament Appearance, first time the Wildcats have gone to the Big Dance in back-to-back years since 2013-14
- Third consecutive year defeating a top 10 ranked opponent (No. 8 South Carolina in 2026, No. 9 UCLA in 2025, No. 9 Alabama in 2023)
- 12 wins (Most since 2014)

## HEAD COACH KNOWS BALL

Heading into the 2025 season, Head Coach Troy Fabiano boasted the fourth best winning percentage amongst active Division I coaches at .736. Fabiano won his 350th career match as a head coach with a 4-0 win over Tennessee to close the 2024 regular season. Additionally, Fabiano's 12 wins from a season ago were his most at Kentucky to date.

## DEFENDING THE BELL

The Cats have only lost at home four times in the past three seasons and Fabiano has a career record of 32-8-7 (.755) in matches at the Bell.

## LOST PRODUCTION

The Cats have to replace 7 starters from the 2025 squad, which marks the second consecutive year that only four starters will return to the squad.

## YOUNG CATS

The Wildcats feature a young roster compared to seasons past. 14 of the 25 players (8 freshman, 6 transfers) are new to the program and 15 of the 25 squad members are underclassmen.

## PORTAL POWER

Kentucky has brought in six transfers to the 2026 squad, all bringing coveted experience and accolades to a young roster. MF Juliette Rayo (Oklahoma) and MF Nadia Ramadan (Alabama) played in every match in 2025 for their respective SEC squads, while MF Alexa Pino (South Carolina) brings a talent that was highly sought after coming out of high school. D Isabella Winton (Idaho State) brings experience from the Big Sky, totalling 11 starts in 2025, while D Jordyn Dunn (UCLA) looks for a fresh start after using a redshirt year. GK Emilie Maihs (North Carolina) also joins the squad after being a part of a championship level program in UNC.

## NON-CON CATS

Kentucky has gone undefeated in the regular season non-conference portion of its schedule in two of the past three seasons (2023,2024). Overall, Fabiano's squads at Kentucky are 28-3-1 in regular season non-conference play.

## FAST STARTS

For the past three seasons, Kentucky has dominated its early season slate. In 2025, the Wildcats started the season 5-0. In 2024, the Cats were unbeaten through their first nine matches. The Wildcats began the 2023 season unbeaten through their first 13 matches for the first time in program history. The previous record was 11 straight results to start the 2005 season.

## CATS ON NATIONAL TELEVISION

The ESPN family of networks and the Southeastern Conference have announced two nationally televised games for the Wildcats. You can watch Wildcats at South Carolina on Sept. 24 on SEC Network, as well as when they host Arkansas on Nov. 1 on ESPN.

## THE BELL

Kentucky opens its 12th season at the Bell this year since the facility was constructed in 2014. The Wildcats opened the 2014 season with a 5-0 win over Francis Marion. Kentucky has accumulated a program record of 76-42-15 at the Bell.

## GATORADE PLAYER OF THE YEAR X3

The 2026 roster boasts three Gatorade Players of the Year on the pitch. Junior Anna Sikorski won the 2022-23 and 2023-24 award for Wisconsin and redshirt-freshman Teagan Myers was named the 2024-25 Colorado POY. They are now joined in company by 3x Connecticut Gatorade Player of the Year in

sophomore transfer Alexa Pino.

## ALL ROADS LEAD TO LEXINGTON

21 members of Kentucky's roster this season are from the United States with one current member (Truitt) coming from the state of Kentucky. The squad represents 11 of the 50 states with the most coming from Texas & Illinois (4). The remainder represent California (2), Colorado (2), Georgia (2), Pennsylvania (2), Connecticut (1), New York (1), Virginia (1), and Wisconsin (1). The four international student-athletes come from England, Germany, The Netherlands, and Tokyo.

## STARS & STRIPES

Freshman McKenzie Godfrey was called up to the United States U-18 National Team Training Camp in Fayetteville, Ga. in late June '26. She was one of 24 players invited, all of which were born in 2008.

## GOLD, GOALS, & THE WORLD CUP

Sophomore transfer Alexa Pino was called up to the Philippines' National Team this year. She helped her team win gold at the Southeast Asian Games, converting a penalty kick during the gold medal game shootout. She also scored a hat trick against Malaysia to help clinch a knockout berth at the SEA Games as well as a qualifying spot in the 2027 FIFA Women's World Cup.

## PRO CATS

14 former Wildcats are currently playing professionally around the world. In the United States, Arin (Gilliland) Wright ('14) is the captain of NWSL side Racing Louisville, while Sophia Mattice ('24) plays for Angel City FC, Marz Josphson ('24) is a member of Lexington SC, Hannah Richardson ('22) is playing with the DC Power, Julia Grosso ('21) and Maggy Henschler ('23) are at FTL United, Catherine Rapp ('25) is with Spokane Zephyr FC, and Grace Phillpotts ('24) and Maddie Kemp ('24) are with Sporting JAX. In Iceland, Makala Woods ('24) plays for Wellington Phoenix FC in New Zealand, Jordyn Rhodes ('23) is with Halifax Tides FC, Mia Bookhard ('24) is a member of Stallion Laguna FC, and Ulfa Ulfarsdottir ('23) is a member of Stjarnan FC, and Khadijah Cisse ('26) just signed with FC Barcelona Femini B.

## PK PRESSURE

In each of the last three seasons, Kentucky has been faced with a penalty kick shootout in the postseason. In 2023, the Cats defeated LSU, 4-2 to advance to the SEC Quarterfinals. In 2024, Kentucky defended the Bell in the opening match of the NCAA Tournament by toppling West Virginia via the same scoreline. This past season, the Wildcats were narrowly defeated at the line by (6) Louisville, 5-4.

## START 'EM YOUNG

Two members of the Wildcat roster boast SEC All-Freshman Team accolades. F Lexi Tylanda picked up the honor in 2024 and newcomer M Nadia Ramadan recived the honor at Alabama in 2023.

## KENTUCKY'S COACHING STAFF

Now in his fifth year at the helm of Kentucky women's soccer, Troy Fabiano is joined by new associate coach Brenton Saylor and assistants Marco Fabiano and Jelena Sever.

Saylor brings nearly 20 years of coaching experience to the Wildcats. He has experience coaching at the club, collegiate, and professional ranks, most recently serving as an assistant coach for the Chicago Stars of the NWSL. Saylor has six years of total NWSL experience, spending four seasons with the Houston Dash from 2018-2022 before spending 2024 and 2025 with the Stars. In between stints in the NWSL, Saylor served as the Director and Head Coach of the HTX Soccer Club Girls Academy. In this role, Saylor oversaw six teams while coaching two more and had multiple players called to United States Youth National Team camps. Saylor's tenure in the Bluegrass marks his return to college soccer for the first time since 2018. Saylor was the assistant coach for goalkeepers and recruiting coordinator at Rice from 2016-2018, coaching the CUSA Goalkeeper of the Year in 2017 and leading the owls to a top 15 national ranking and 2017 NCAA Tournament berth. He also held stints at Mercer, UT Martin, and is back in the Bluegrass State after spending 2010-12 at ECU.

Marco Fabiano, son of Troy, arrived in Lexington after spending two seasons with Mercer. During his time in Macon, the Bears earned double digit wins in 2024 and 2025 and advanced to the Southern Conference Tournament championship match in 2025. His resume also includes a year as an assistant with Wisconsin-Parkside and as a club coach for Red Star soccer Club in Kenosha, Wisc. Fabiano played collegiate soccer as Milwaukee from 2017-2019 and Wisconsin-Parkside from 2019-2021. He graduated from Wisconsin-Parkside with a bachelor's degree in Sport Management in 2021 and a Master of Business Administration in 2022.

Sever enters her second year as a coach following her collegiate career playing under Fabiano in Milwaukee. Sever scored 24 goals across her four years of college soccer, winning four Horizon League titles and making four NCAA Tournament appearances. She was a three-time All-Horizon League selection and is known for scoring the fastest goal in NCAA soccer history just 3.2 seconds into Milwaukee's game against Youngstown State in 2018. Post college, Sever played for ZFK Spartak in Serbia for one season, winning the title in the Super Liga, the top Serbian League.

### DID YOU KNOW?

- A native of Kenosha, Wisconsin
- Was twice named All-Northeast Conference First Team as a player at Robert Morris
- Earned Northeast Conference Player of the Year as a senior in 1993, leading the conference with 19 goals and 43 points.
- Was inducted into the RMU Athletic Hall of Fame in 2001
- Led UW-Parkside to 16 straight winning seasons during his 17 years as head coach of the Rangers, including eight NCAA DII Tournament appearances and five Great Lakes Valley Conference championships
- Coached Milwaukee to six Horizon League regular-season titles during seven-year tenure and four conference tournament championships.
- Fabiano's Panthers posted five undefeated seasons in conference action, going unbeaten for a span of 1,617 days.
- Under Fabiano's guidance, Milwaukee compiled a 16-0-4 mark in 2018, the lone undefeated record in the nation
- During his time at Milwaukee, Fabiano saw 23-student-athletes land on the All-Horizon League First Team, 15 on the Second Team and 11 on the All-Freshman Team. A total of 17 players were also named to United Soccer Coaches All-Region teams, while one earned All-American status.
- Between 2017-21, Fabiano led the Panthers to a ledger of 77-7-7, the best win-loss record of any team across NCAA DI soccer during that five-year span.
- Is the fourth head coach in Kentucky Women's Soccer history following Warren Lipka, Jon Lipsitz and Ian Carry.

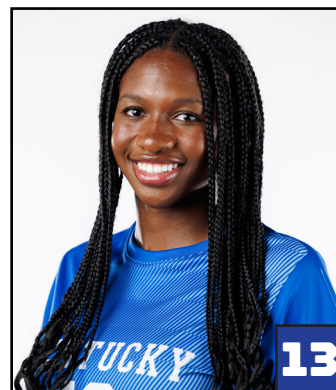

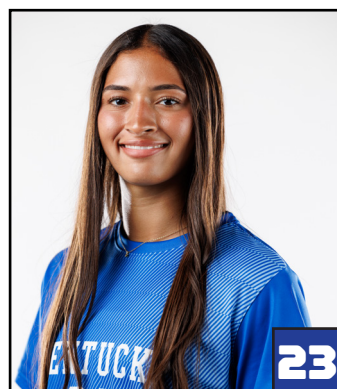
