2026 SEASON CAT SCRATCHES

- Kentucky won the 2020 NCAA Volleyball National Championship with a 3-1 win over Texas, becoming the first SEC school to ever win the national title.
- 2026 is Craig Skinner's 22nd season as the head coach at Kentucky. He is the longest-tenured coach in the SEC, not including Texas, who joined the SEC in 2024.
- Kentucky graduate and 2020 NCAA National Champion, Avery Skinner, was on the 2024 USA Olympic Team for volleyball and won a silver medal.
- UK has won nine-straight SEC Championships ('17-'25)
- Kentucky has four players on the AVCA National Player of the Year Watch List, the most of any team in the NCAA.
- The Wildcats start the year at #3 in the AVCA Coaches' Top 25, its highest-ever starting position.
- UK returns All-Americans Brooklyn DeLeye, Kassie O'Brien and Molly Tuozzo
- Kentucky has qualified for 21-straight NCAA Tournaments
- UK has advanced to eight of the last nine Sweet 16's
- Transferring into Kentucky are two players in 2025, Brynn Covell (Arizona St.) and Morgan Gaerte (Notre Dame)
- Craig Skinner currently sits on 497 career wins as a HC
- Kentucky will play a new program record six of its non-conference matches away from Lexington. None of those six will be true road matches, however, as all of them are neutral site.
- Craig Skinner has won three SEC Coach of the Year awards (2023, 2024, 2025).
- Kentucky liberos have won SEC Libero/Defensive Player of the Year in 11 of the last 16 years.
- Brooklyn DeLeye was named the 2024 SEC Player of the Year, one year after winning the 2023 SEC Freshman of the Year award from the league coaches.

TUOZZO IN YOUR TIMELINE

Molly Tuozzo reached two milestones in the late 2025 season as she recorded her 100th-career ace against Wisconsin in the NCAA National Semifinal, and her 1,000th-career dig vs. Auburn in the quarterfinal round of the 2025 SEC Tournament in Savannah.

SEC DOMINANCE

Since the start of the 2017 SEC season, during UK's nine-year run as champions, the Wildcats in SEC regular season and conference tournament play are 136-11 (.925) in league matches.

IT JUST MEANS MORE

UK has won 26-straight SEC regular season matches dating back to 2024 (Texas, Oct. 13, L, 3-0). Counting the SEC Tournament, that number expands to 29-straight match wins over SEC opponents.

SEC TOURNAMENT CHAMPS!

Kentucky won its sixth SEC Tournament on Nov. 25, 2025 with a 3-2 reverse sweep of Texas. It was the first SEC Tournament held in 20 years. The win gave Kentucky the automatic qualification spot out of the SEC.

NATIONAL ATTENTION

UK placed a nation-best four players on the 2026 American Volleyball Coaches' Association National Player of the Year Watch List. Brooklyn DeLeye, Morgan Gaerte, Kassie O'Brien and Molly Tuozzo were all named to the list with Kentucky's four players the most of any team in the nation as both Nebraska and Purdue had three. This is DeLeye's third season being named to the preseason AVCA NPOY finalist list with Gaerte, O'Brien and Tuozzo all making their maiden voyage on the list.

STANDING IN THE HALL OF FAME

On July 25, Craig Skinner was inducted into the Delaware County Athletics Hall of Fame in his hometown of Muncie, Indiana.

Also, Leah Edmond (2016-19) was selected as an inductee to the UK Athletics Hall of Fame, where she will be enshrined on Sept. 26 at the home football game vs. South Alabama.

Since being tabbed Kentucky's head coach in December 2004, Craig Skinner has rejuvenated the Kentucky volleyball program into national prominence and is the program's all-time winningest head coach. He will enter his 22nd season in 2026.

He reached the pinnacle of the sport in April of 2021, winning the 2020 NCAA National Championship at the CHI Health Center in Omaha, Nebraska. In doing so, he became the head coach of the first volleyball team in Southeastern Conference history to win a national championship. He was named the AVCA's National Coach of the Year in 2020-21.

Skinner has directed the Wildcats to 21 consecutive NCAA Tournaments - a feat only nine other schools in the nation have achieved. That run includes 10 Sweet Sixteen appearances since 2009, three Elite Eight appearances, the 2020 NCAA Final Four and back-to-back-to-back-to-back-to-back-to-back-to-back-to-back-to-back SEC titles in 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020-21, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024 and 2025. Furthermore, the Wildcats have captured 17 or more victories in all 21 seasons under Skinner's direction, including tallying 20 or more wins in 18 of the last 20 seasons.

MEMORIAL COLISEUM

Historic Memorial Coliseum re-opened to the public on August 30, 2024 after a 15-month, \$83 million renovation project.

The Wildcats have compiled a 515-171 record, good for a .749 winning percentage in the facility.

In the last 21 seasons under Coach Skinner, Kentucky is an astounding 263-53 (.861) at home in both Rupp Arena (2023) and Memorial Coliseum.

It played host to NCAA Regionals in 2011, 2013, 2015 and 2017. Memorial also currently serves as the home court for the UK women's basketball and gymnastics teams. The storied gymnasium also housed some of the greatest moments in UK men's basketball history as its home for 26 seasons from 1950 to 1976.
