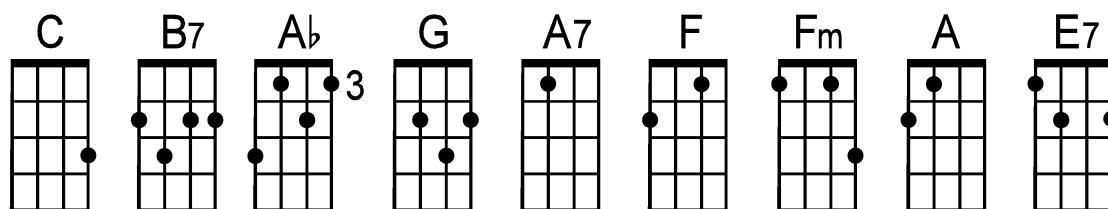


Dream a Little Dream of Me
