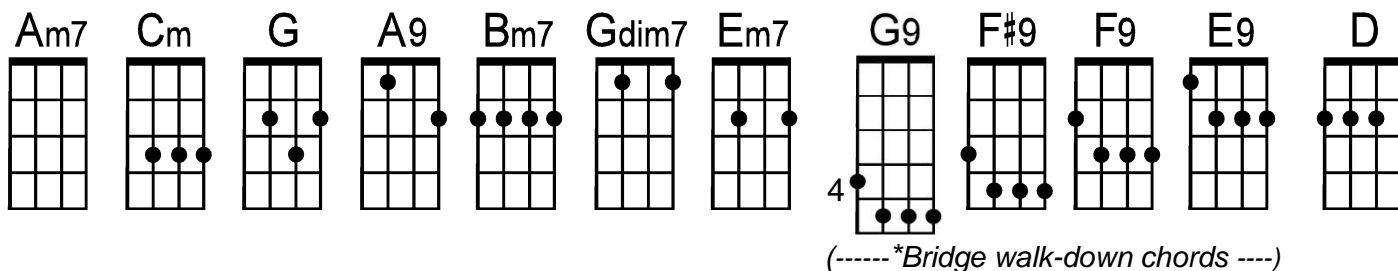


Moonglow
