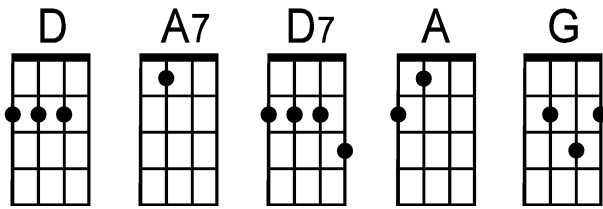


Red River Valley
