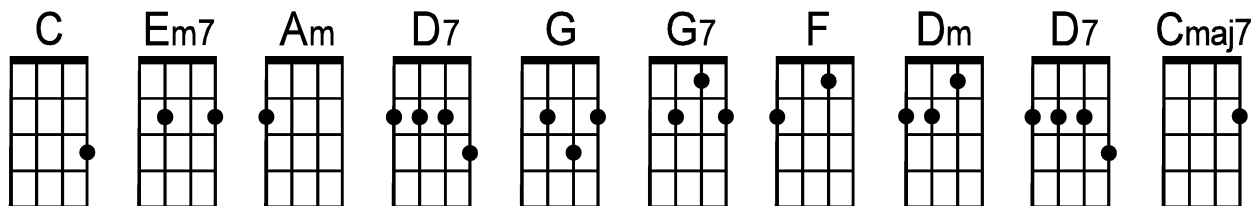


Star Spangled Banner/Take Me Out to the Ballgame
