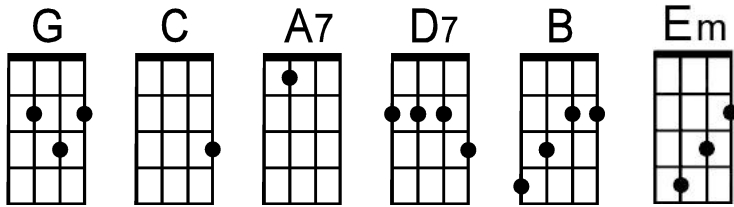


# The Fountain in the Park
