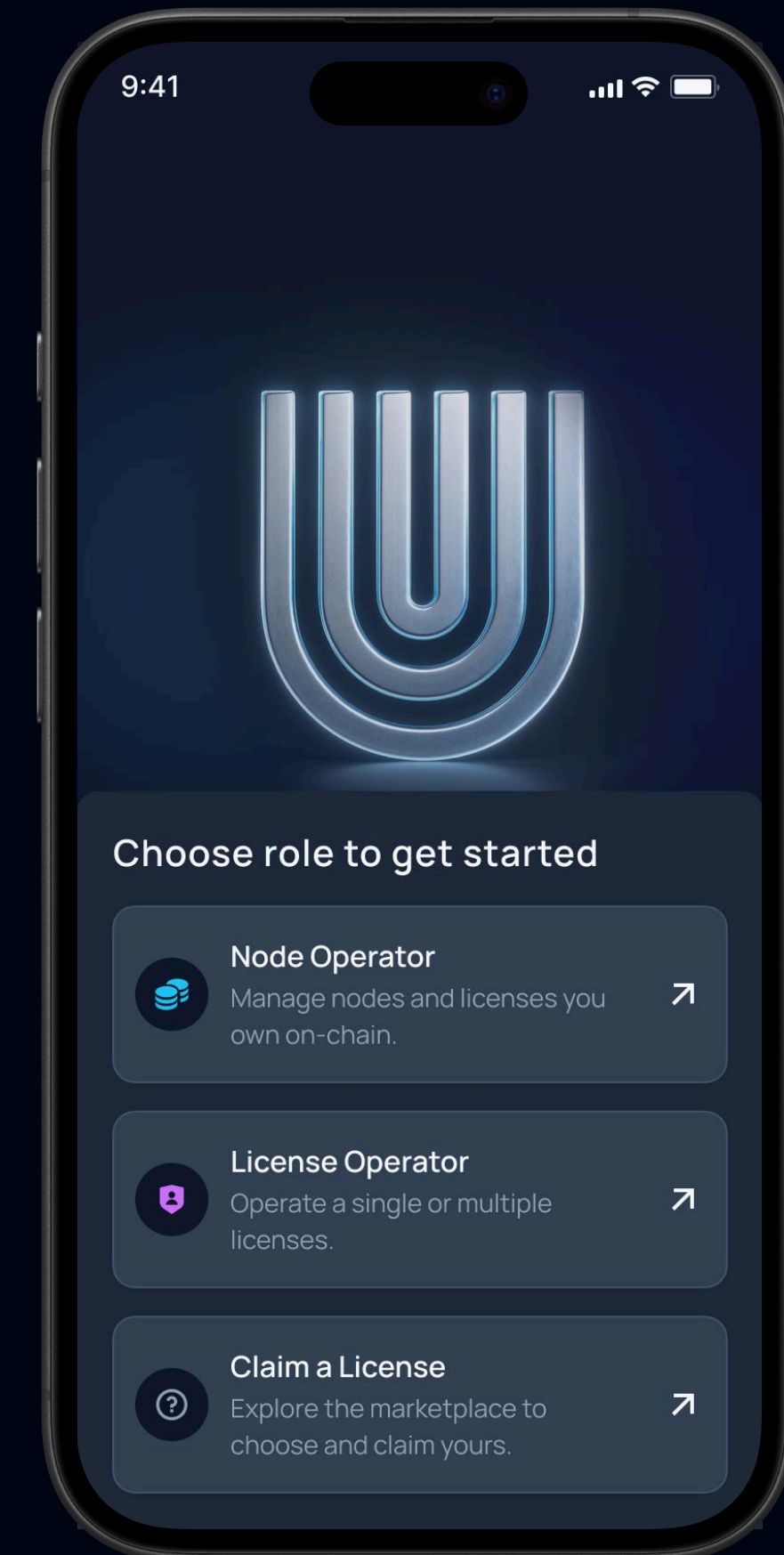
Welcome to Unetwork

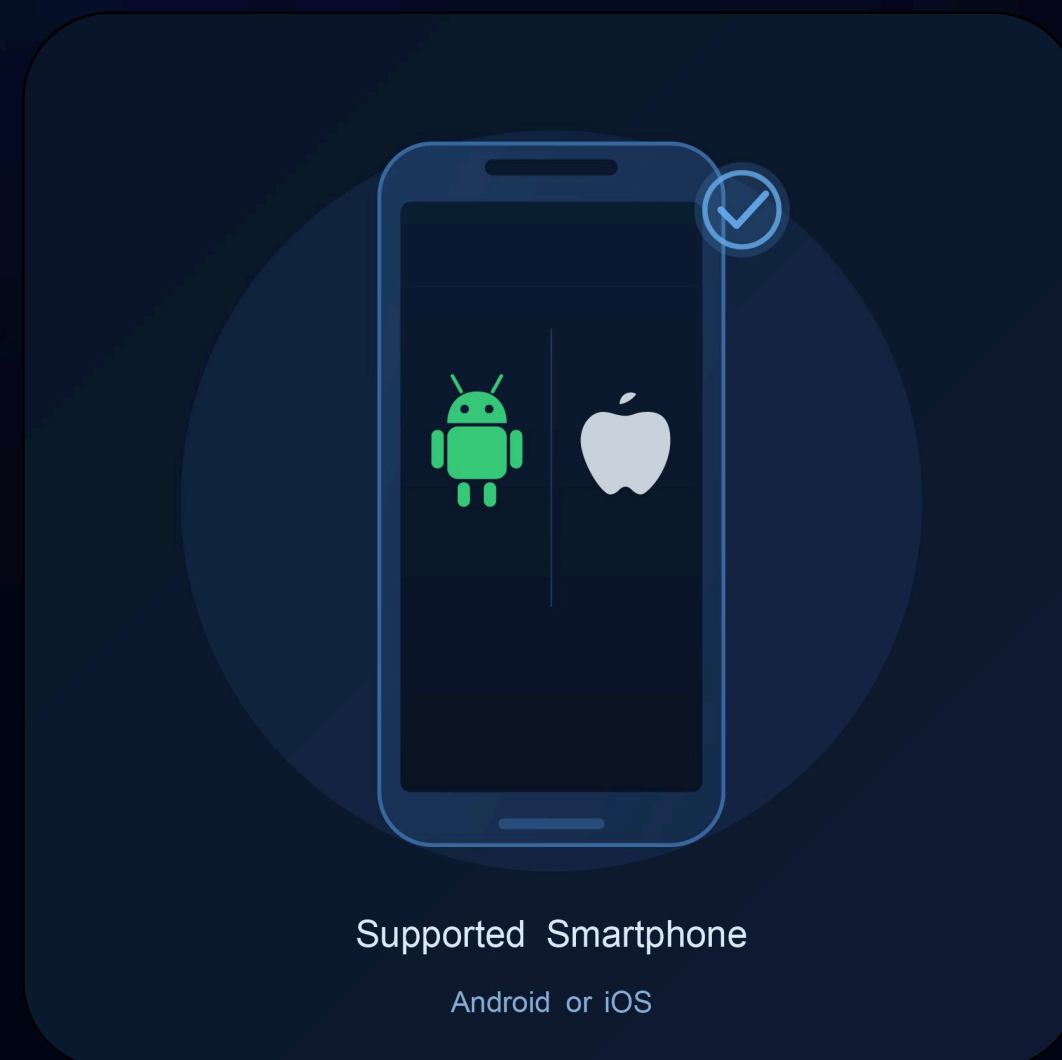
What Is a Unetwork License Operator (ULO)?

A Unetwork License Operator (ULO) is anyone who operates a Unetwork Operator Software License on a smartphone using the Unetwork app.

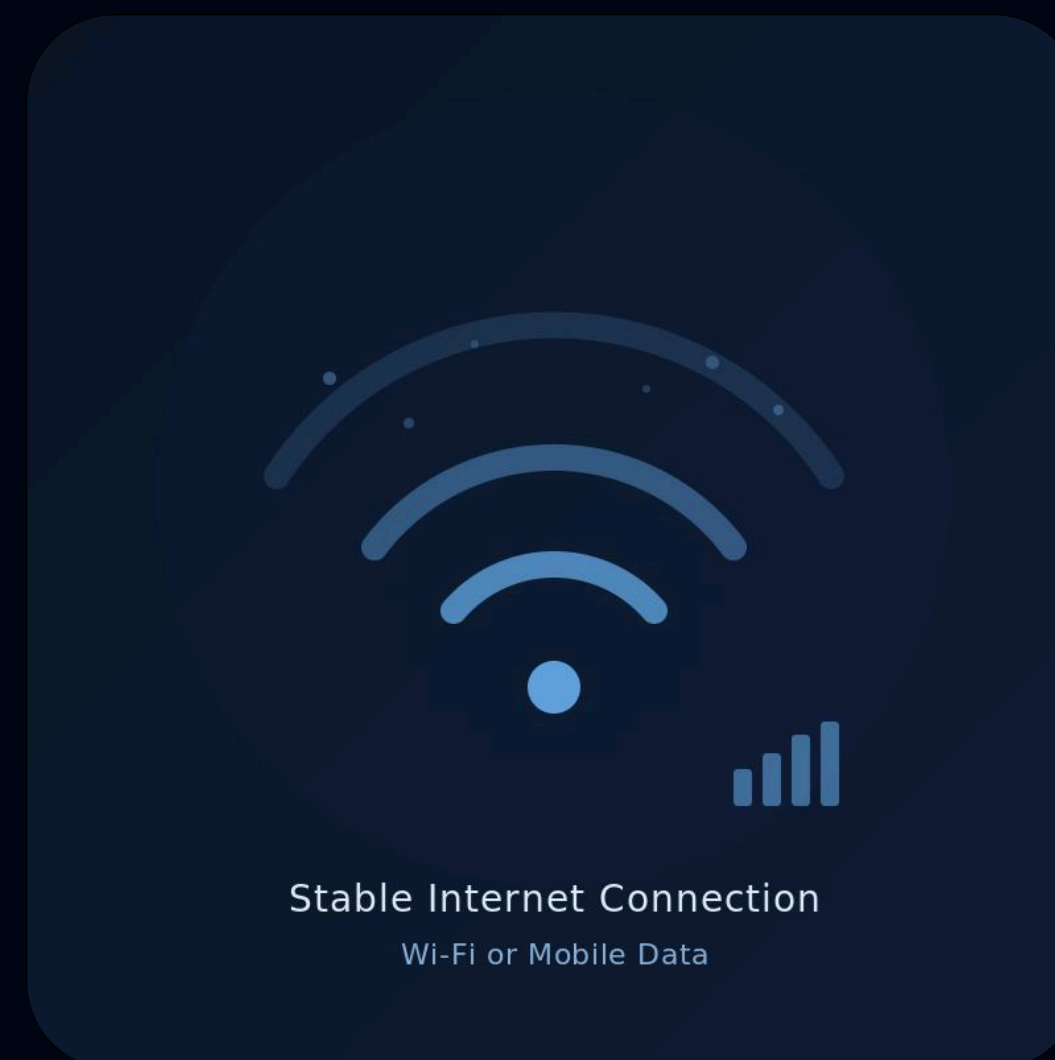
As a ULO, you contribute to Unetwork's global edge network by performing verification tasks from your smartphone and receiving network incentives for verified participation.



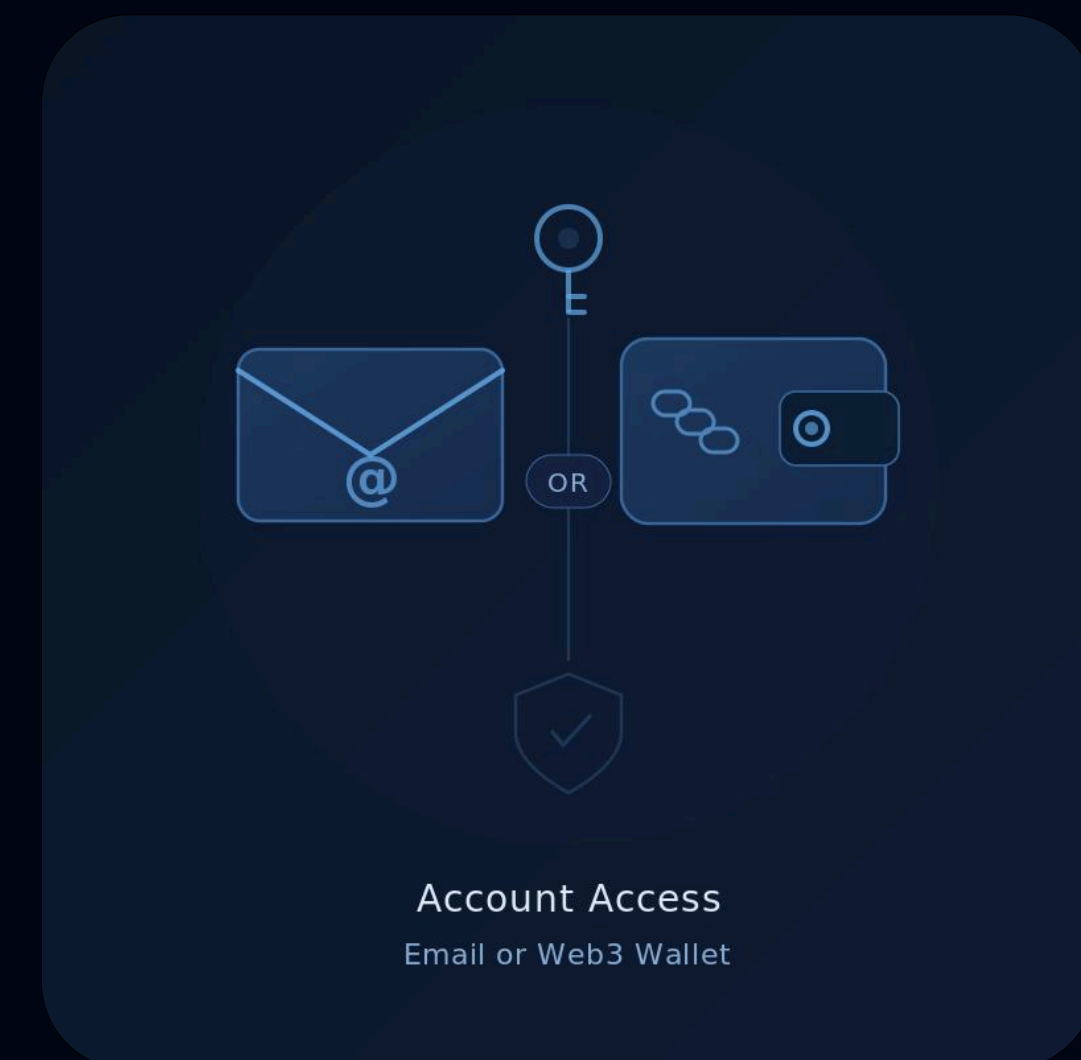
Requirements



A supported Android or iOS smartphone.



A stable internet connection: The Unetwork app works on Wi-Fi. Some tasks may require mobile data, depending on task requirements.



Access to your email address (for email sign-in) and/or access to a Web3 wallet (for wallet sign-in and crypto redemption).

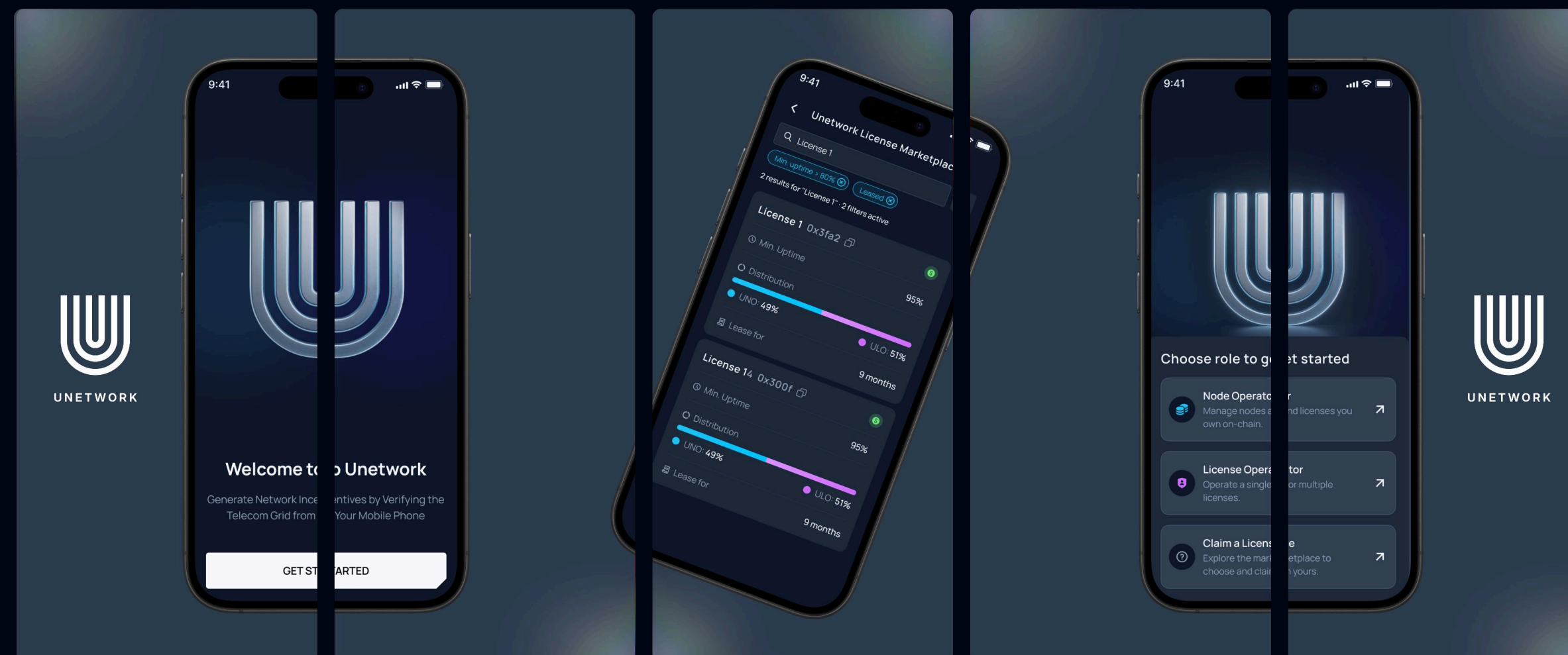

How Licenses Work

Distribution (UNO/ULO)

The percentage split of network incentives between:

- UNO - Unetwork Node Operator
- ULO - Unetwork License Operator (you)

The higher your ULO %, the greater your network incentives.

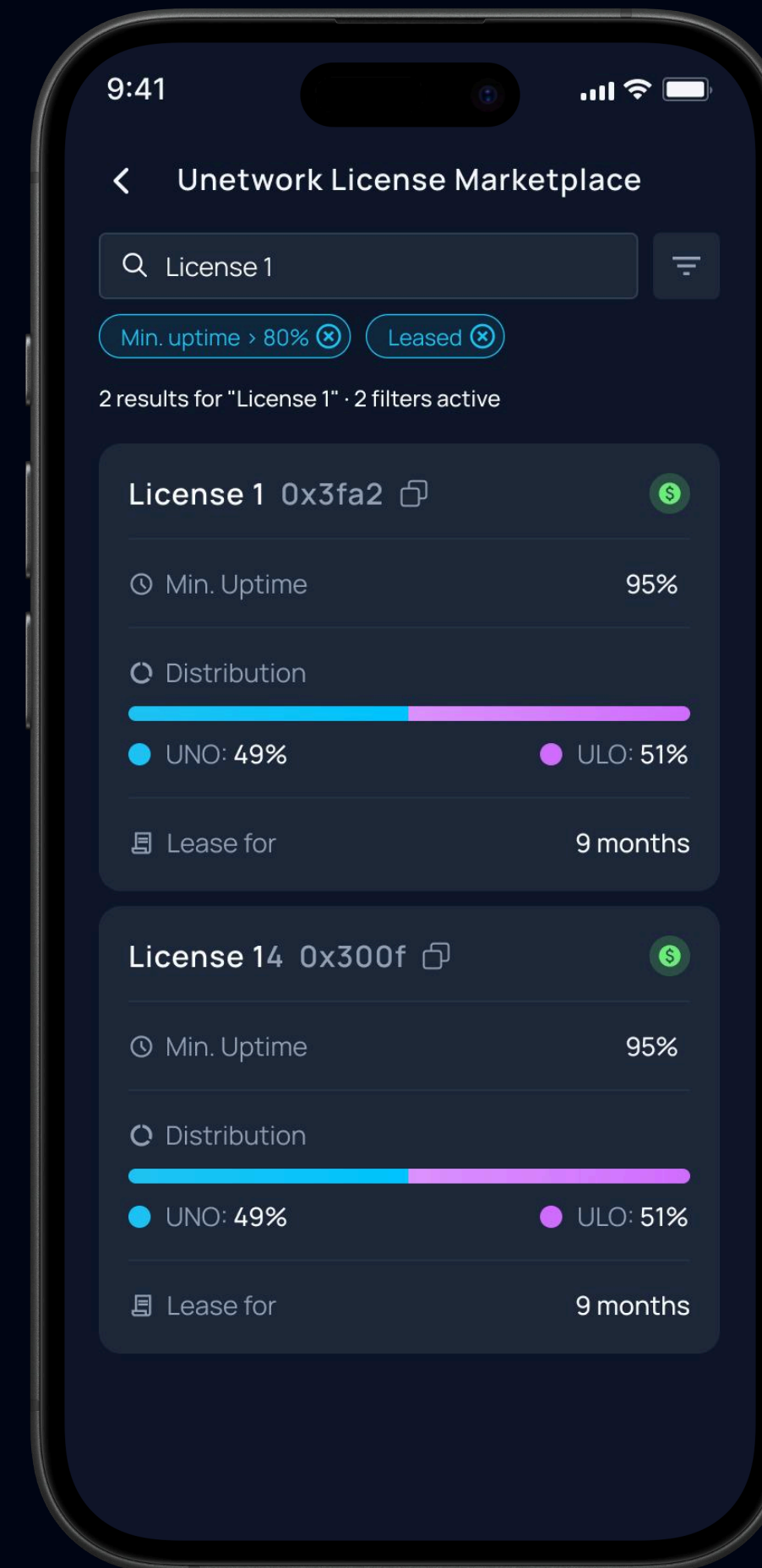
Lease Duration

This shows how long you can operate the license.

A longer lease provides more time to perform verification tasks and receive network incentives.

Minimum Uptime

The minimum time your device must be online and powered on to keep the license active. For example, 95% means your device should be running at least 95% of the time.

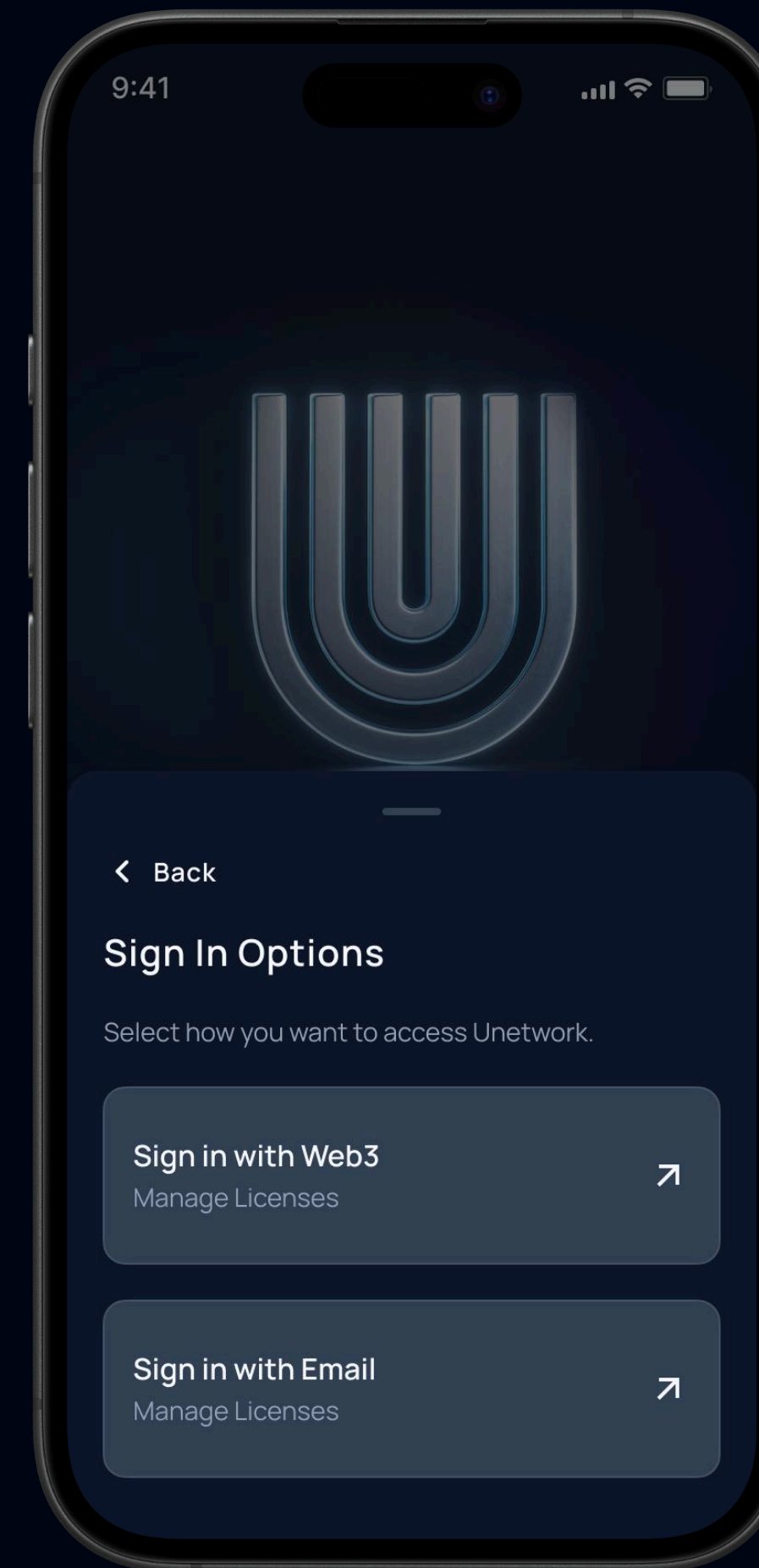

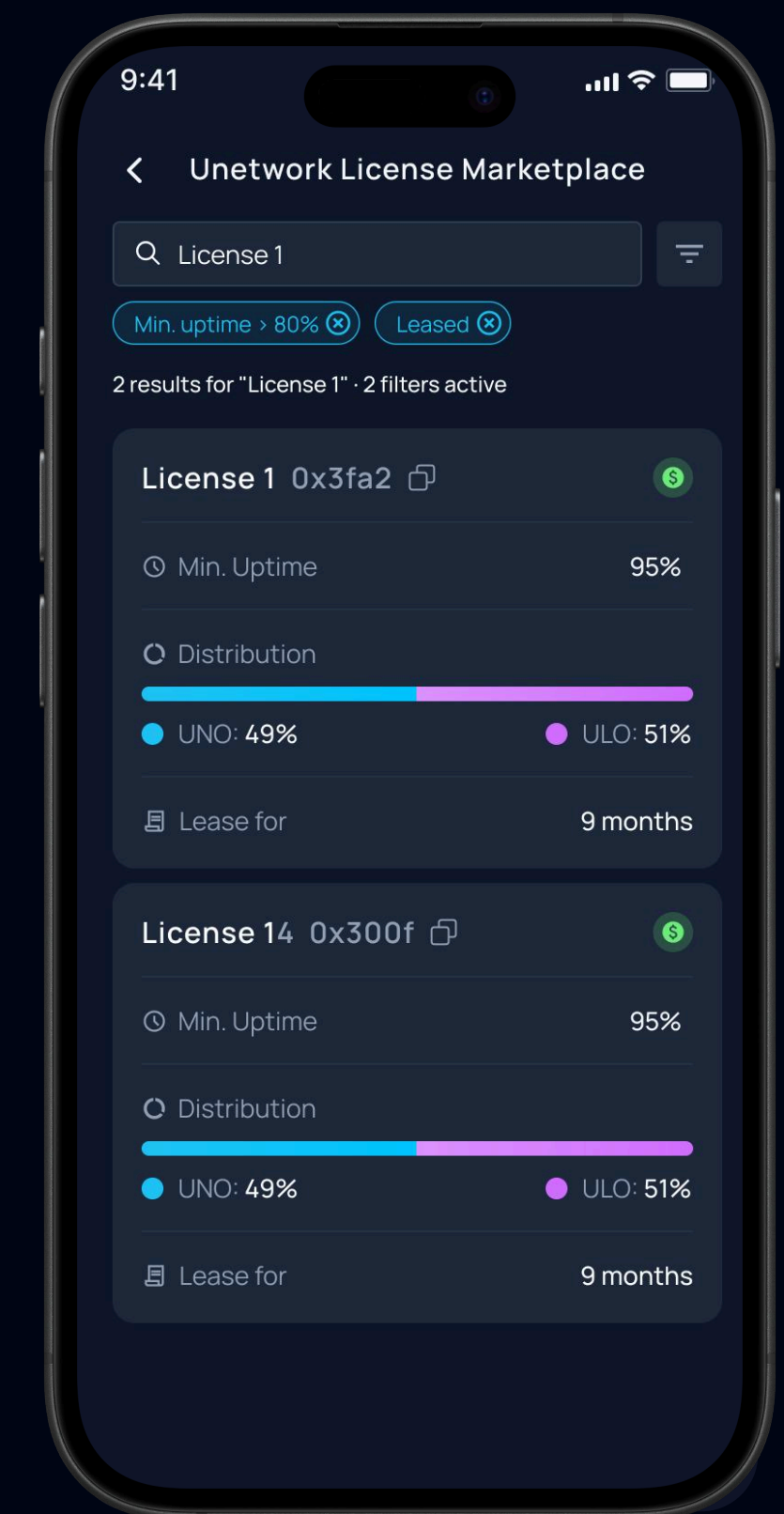
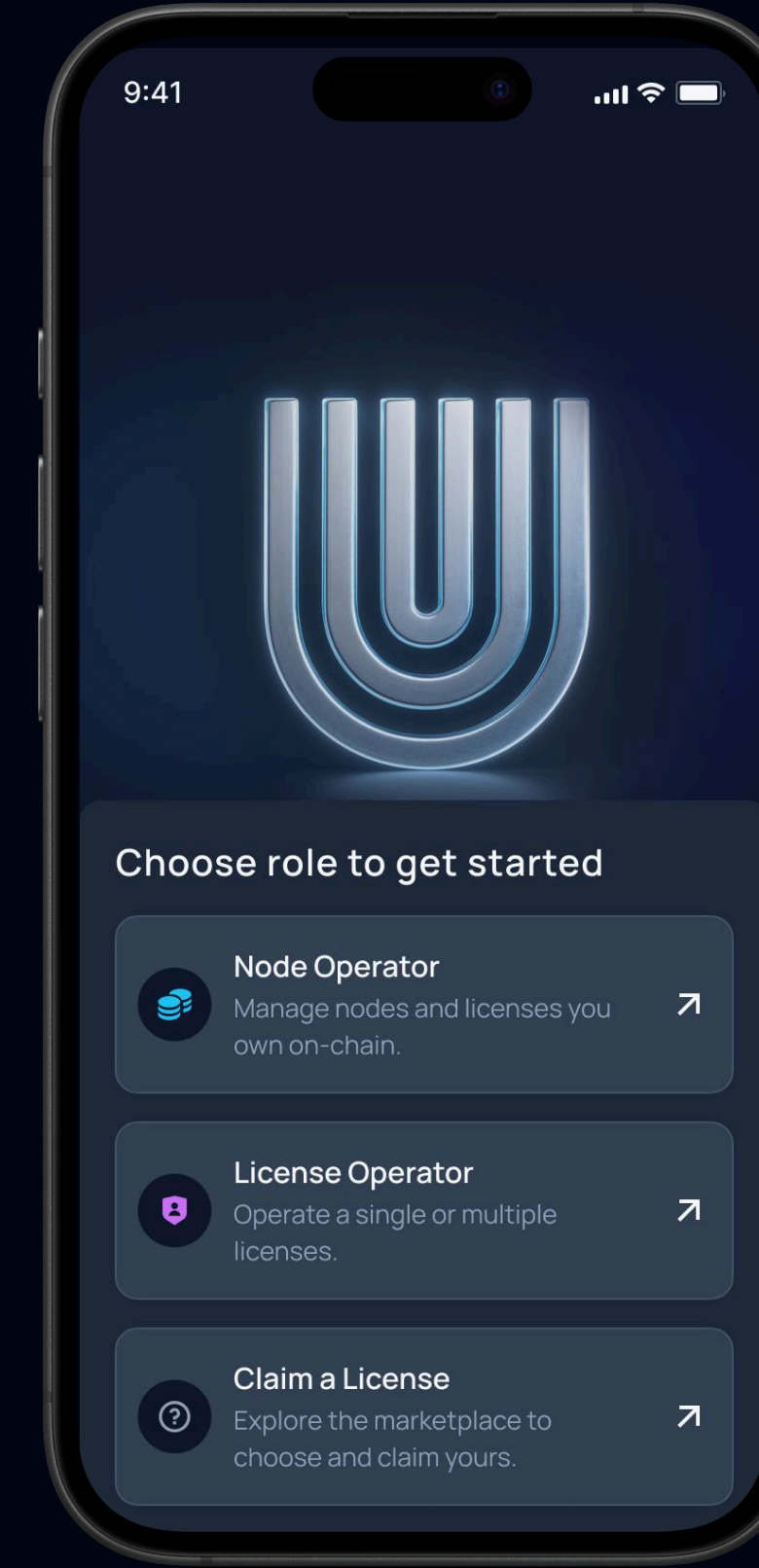

3. Choose a License

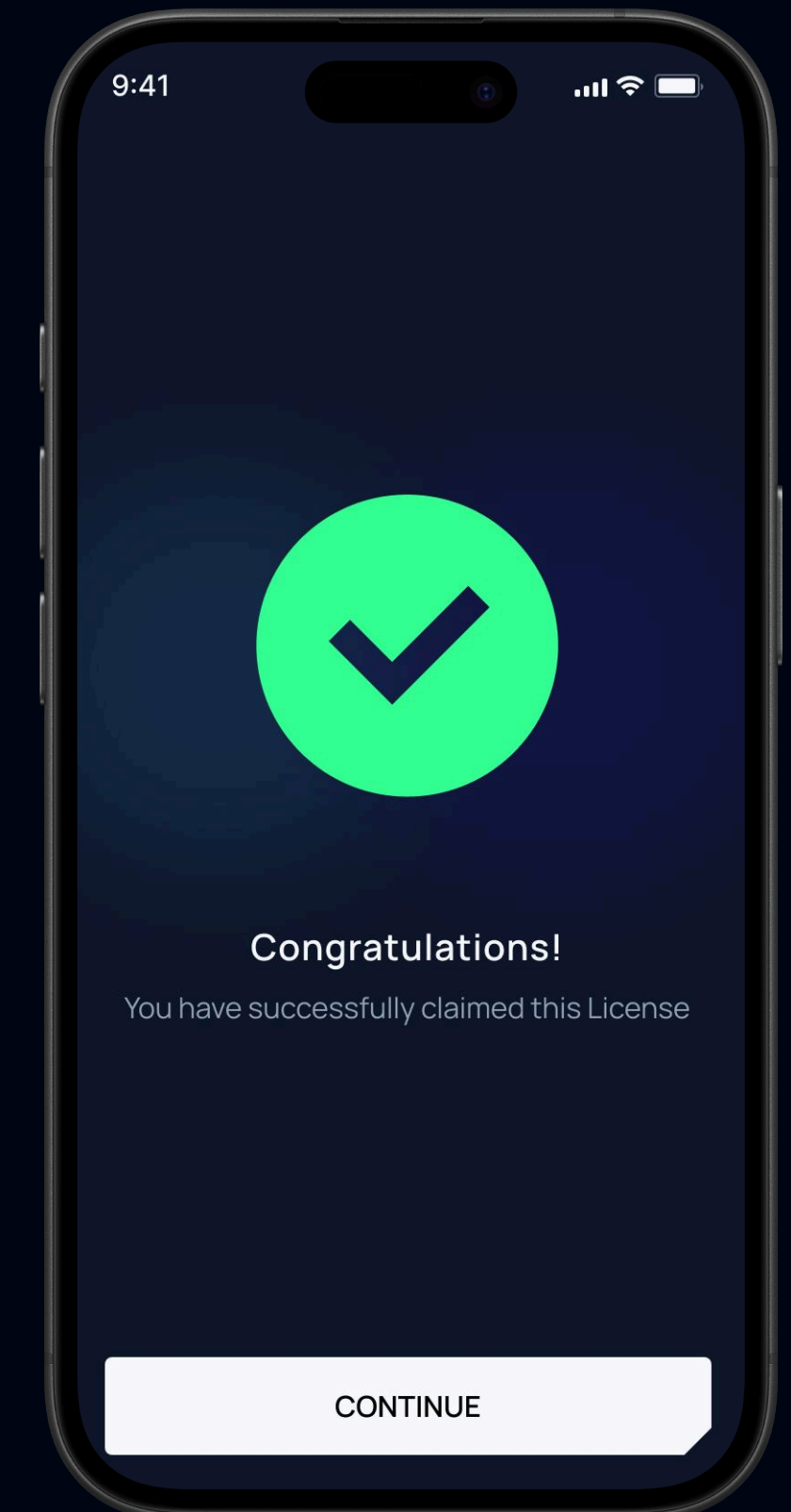
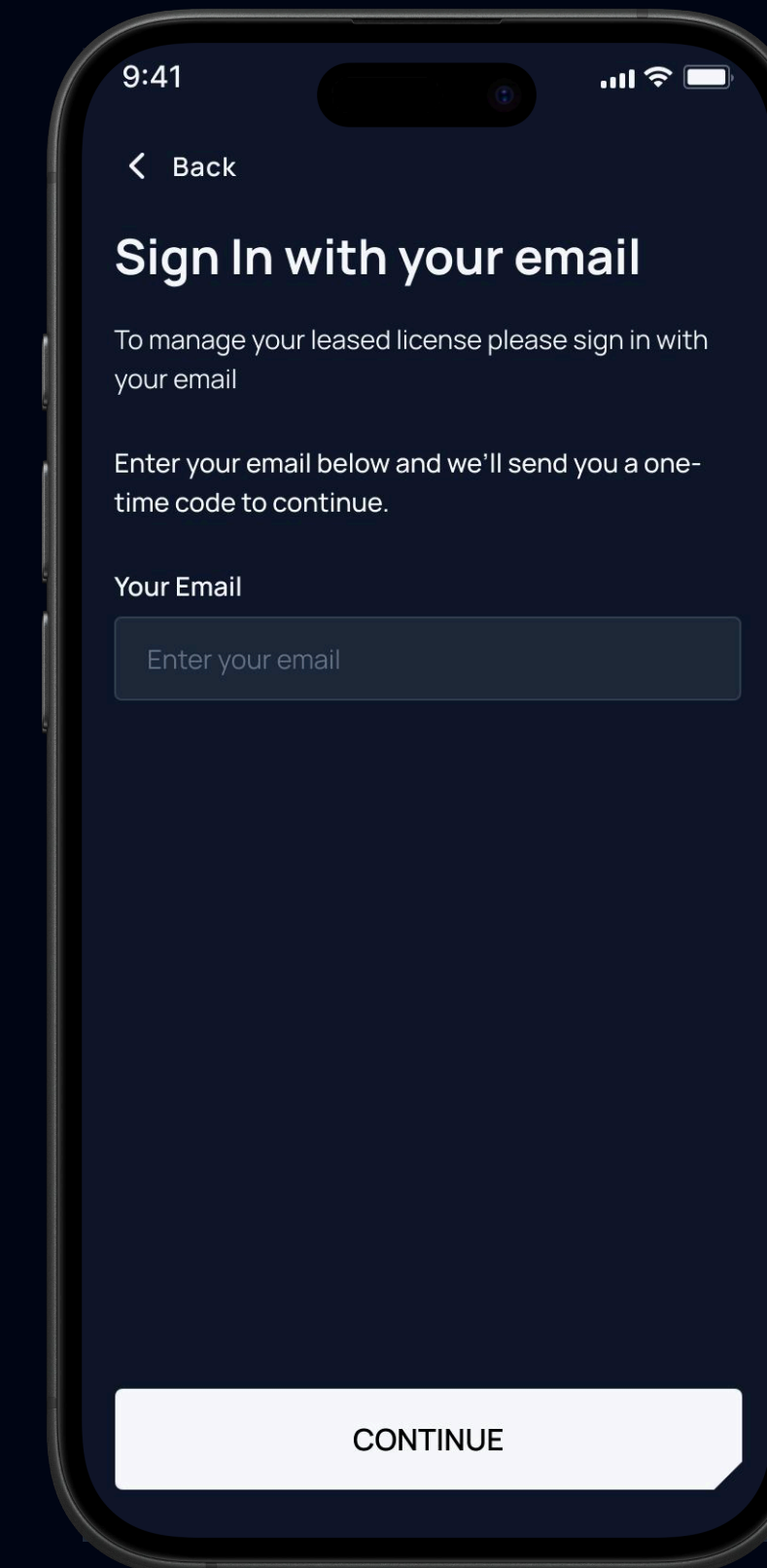
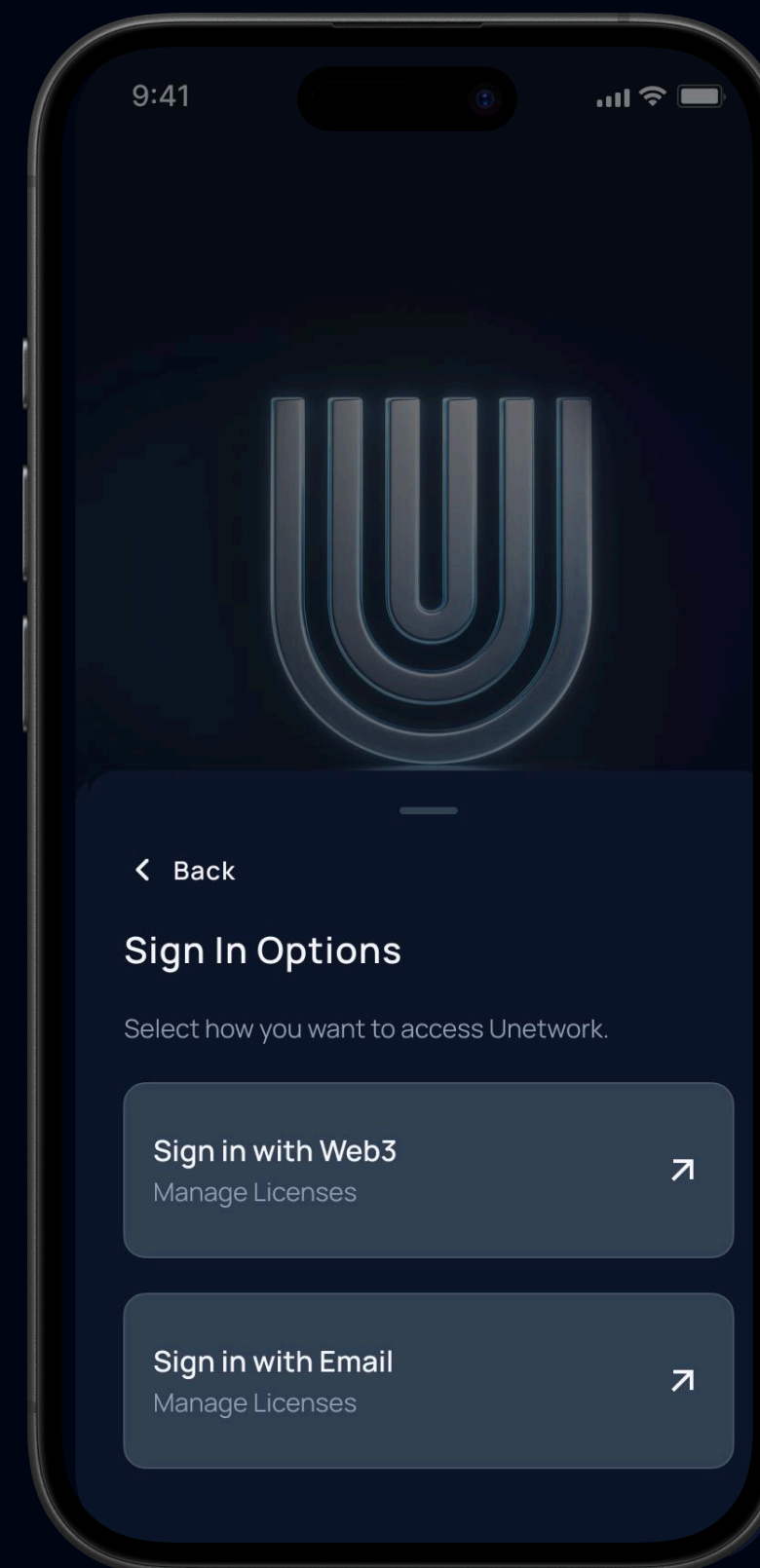

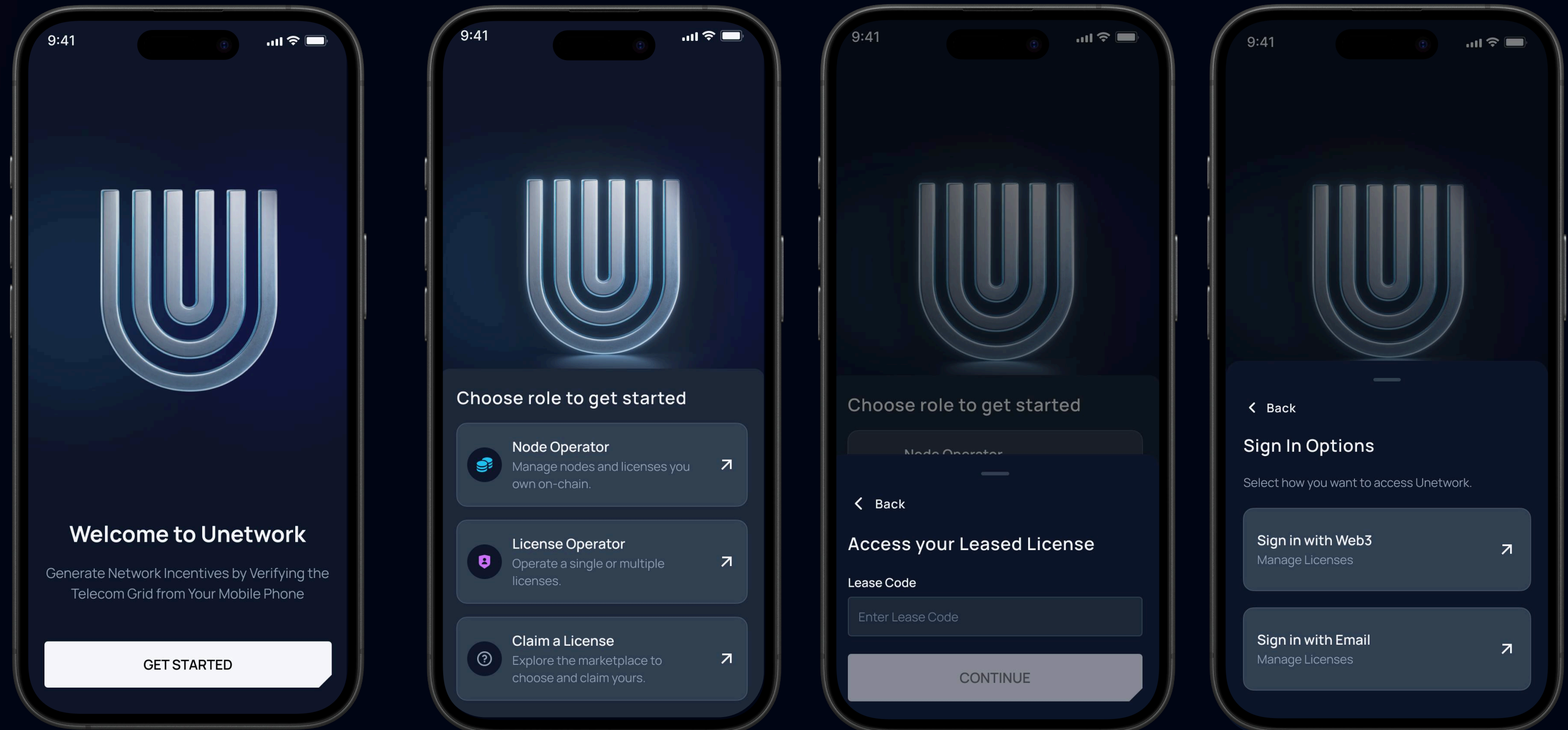
Claim Private License-Code and Log-in

Withdrawal of Incentives

To withdraw your generated Network Incentives as cryptocurrency, use the web management panel.

1. Navigate to <https://manage.unetwork.io/>
2. Log in using your Web3 wallet or email address.
3. Click the "Withdraw Rewards" button to initiate your claim.

8. Review your details and click "Continue Withdraw" to proceed.

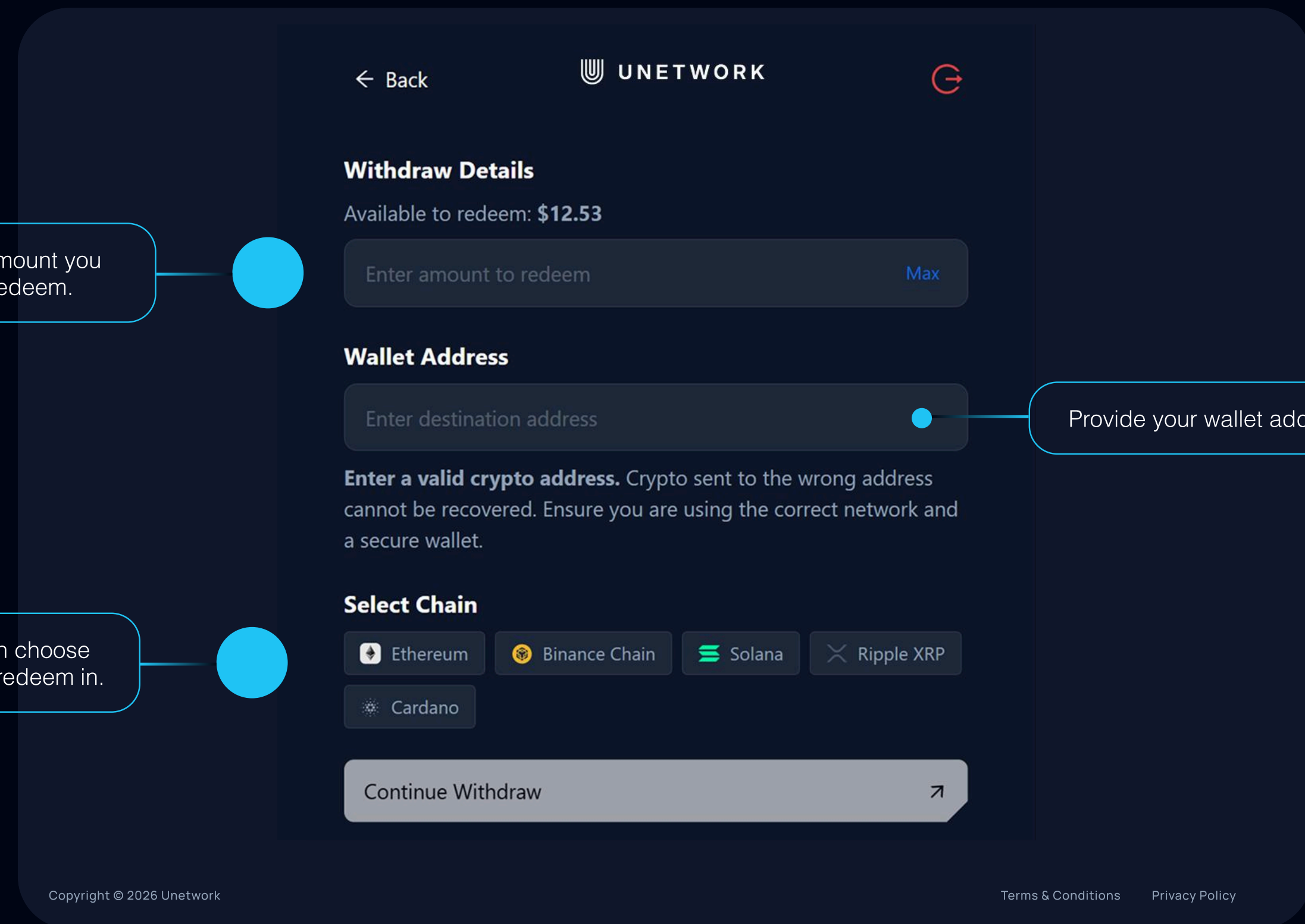

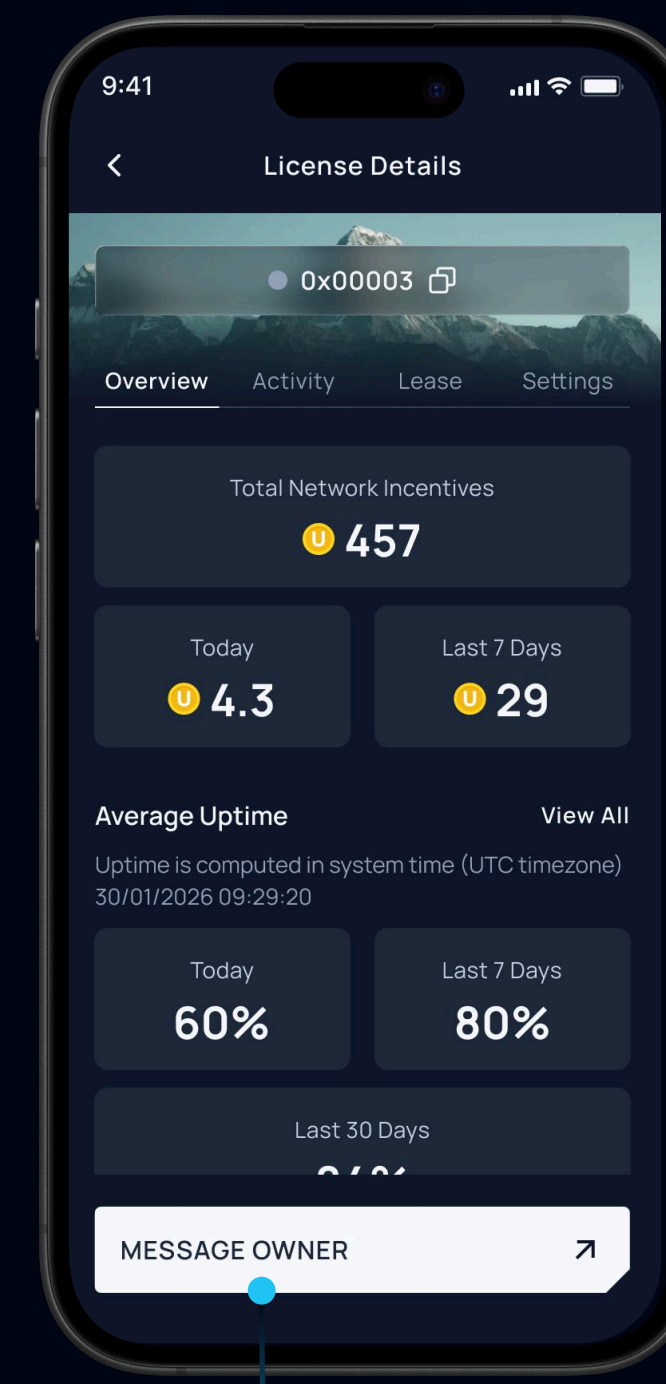
ULO Messaging

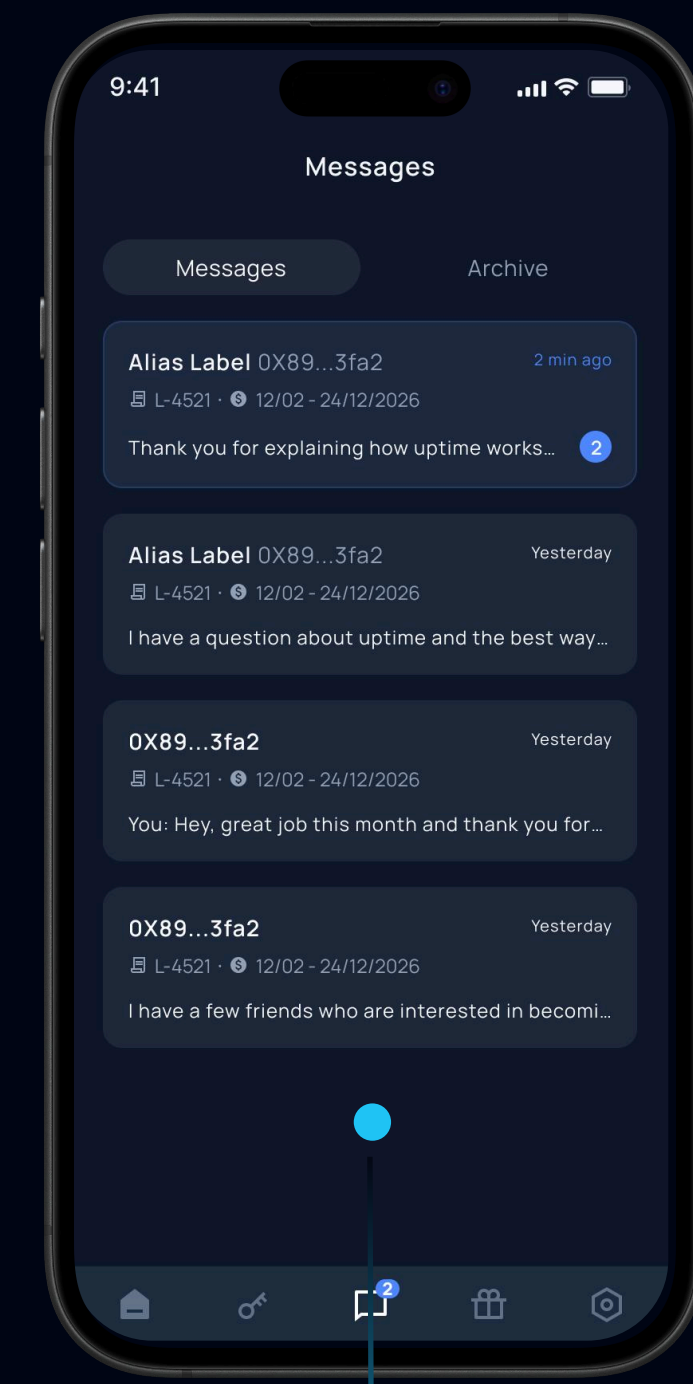

Enable/Disable Messages To Communicate Directly With UNOs



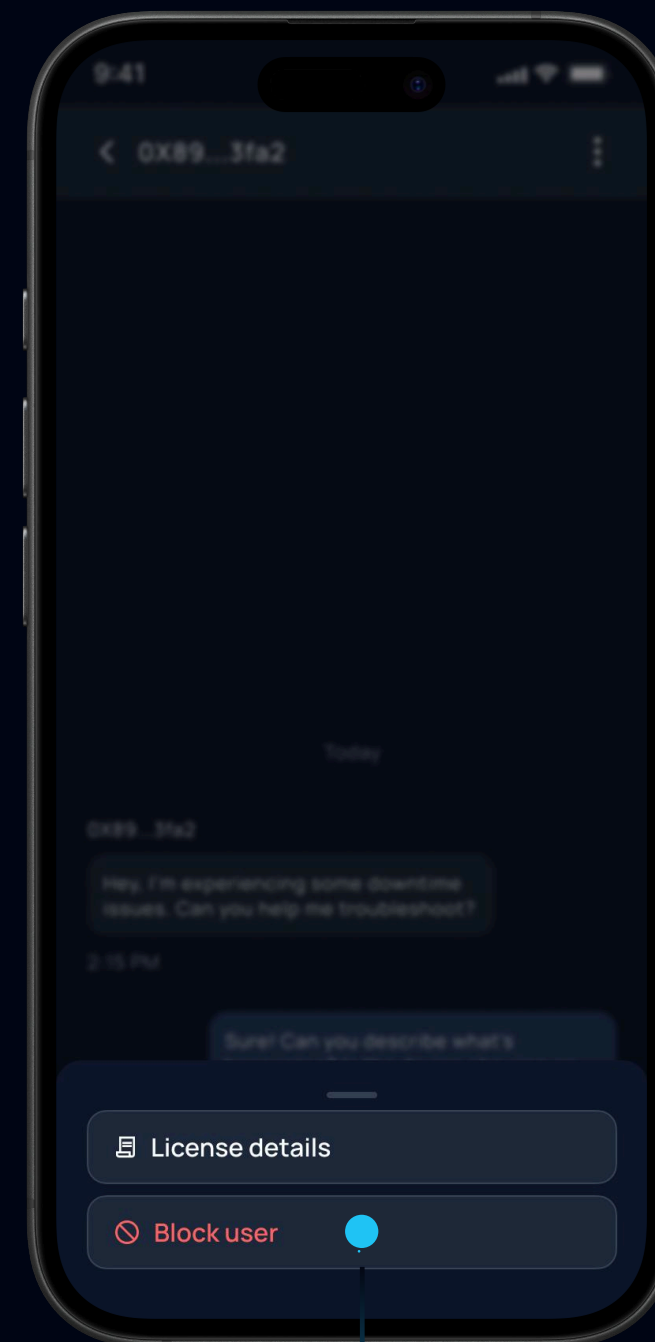

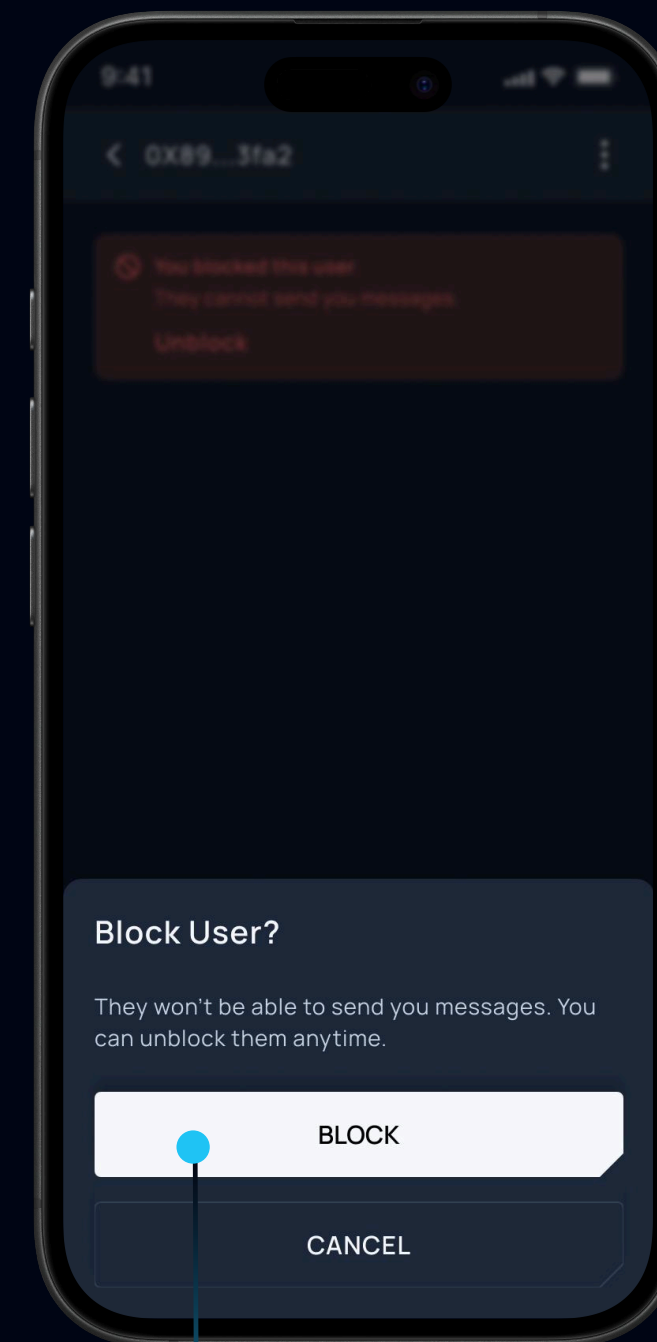

Block, Unblock & Archive

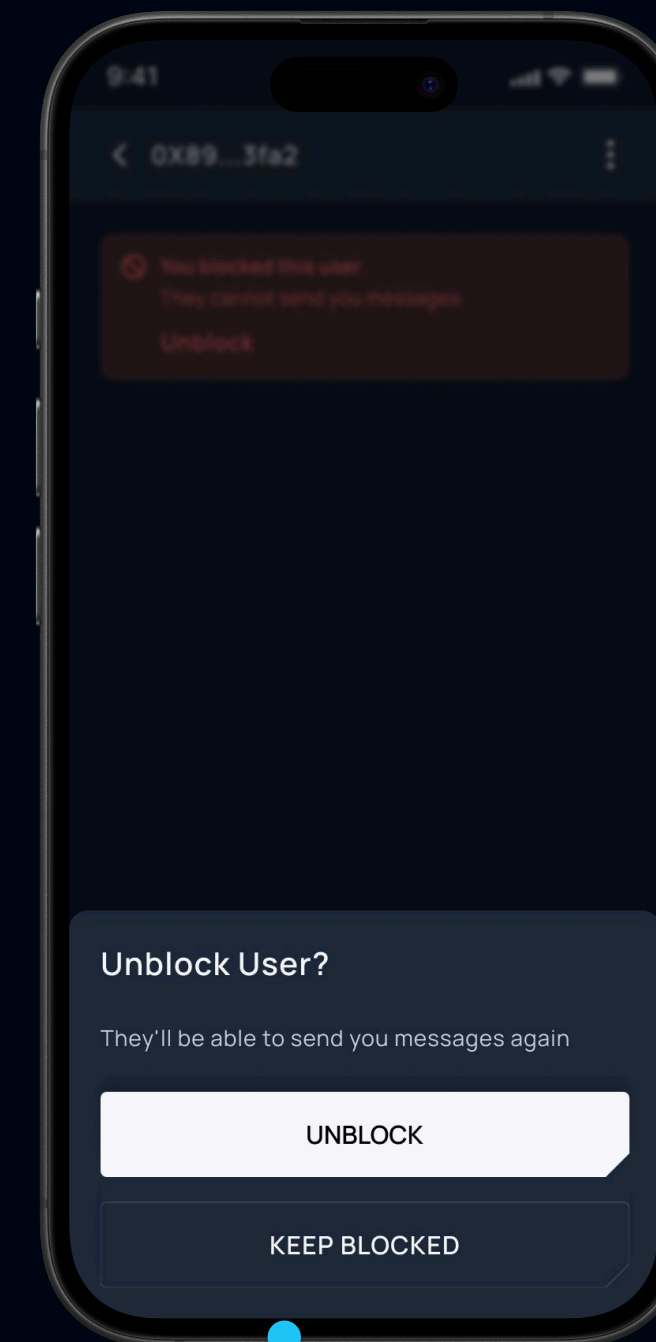
You can block a ULO from messaging you, you can unblock a ULO to resume messaging and messages with a ULO who's lease has expired are archived.



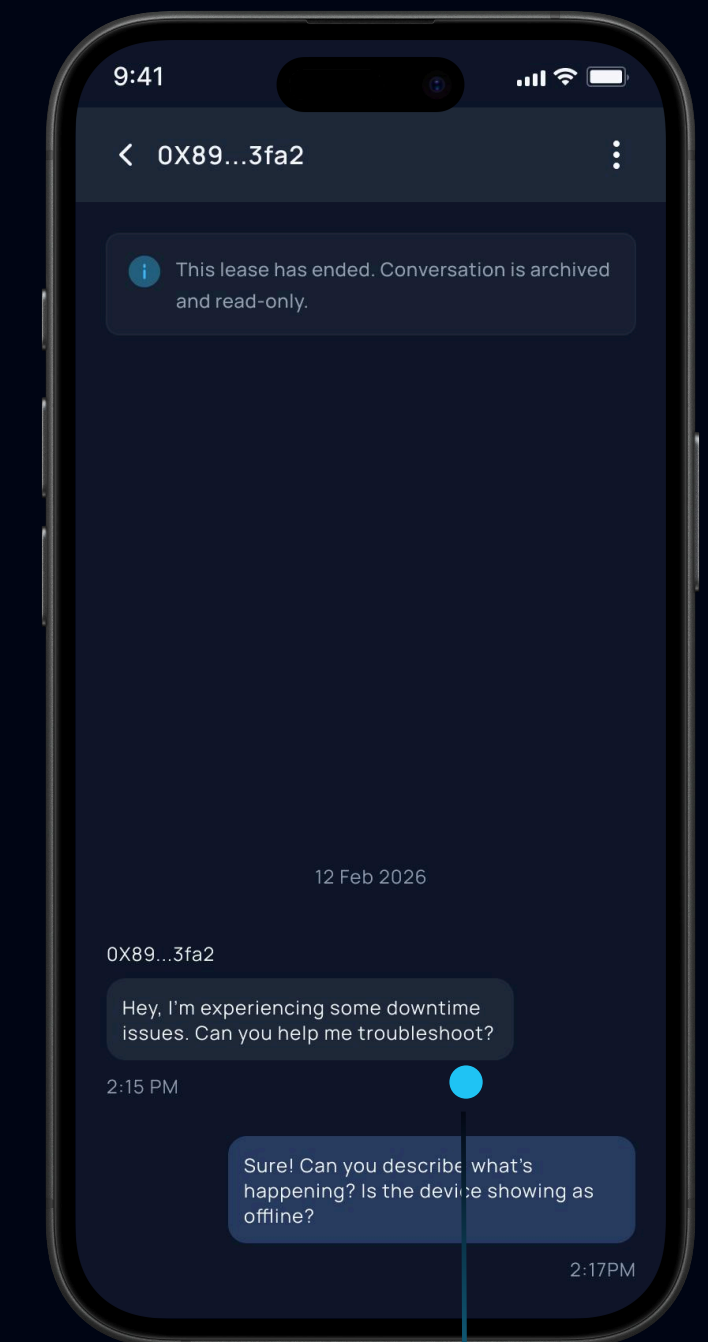

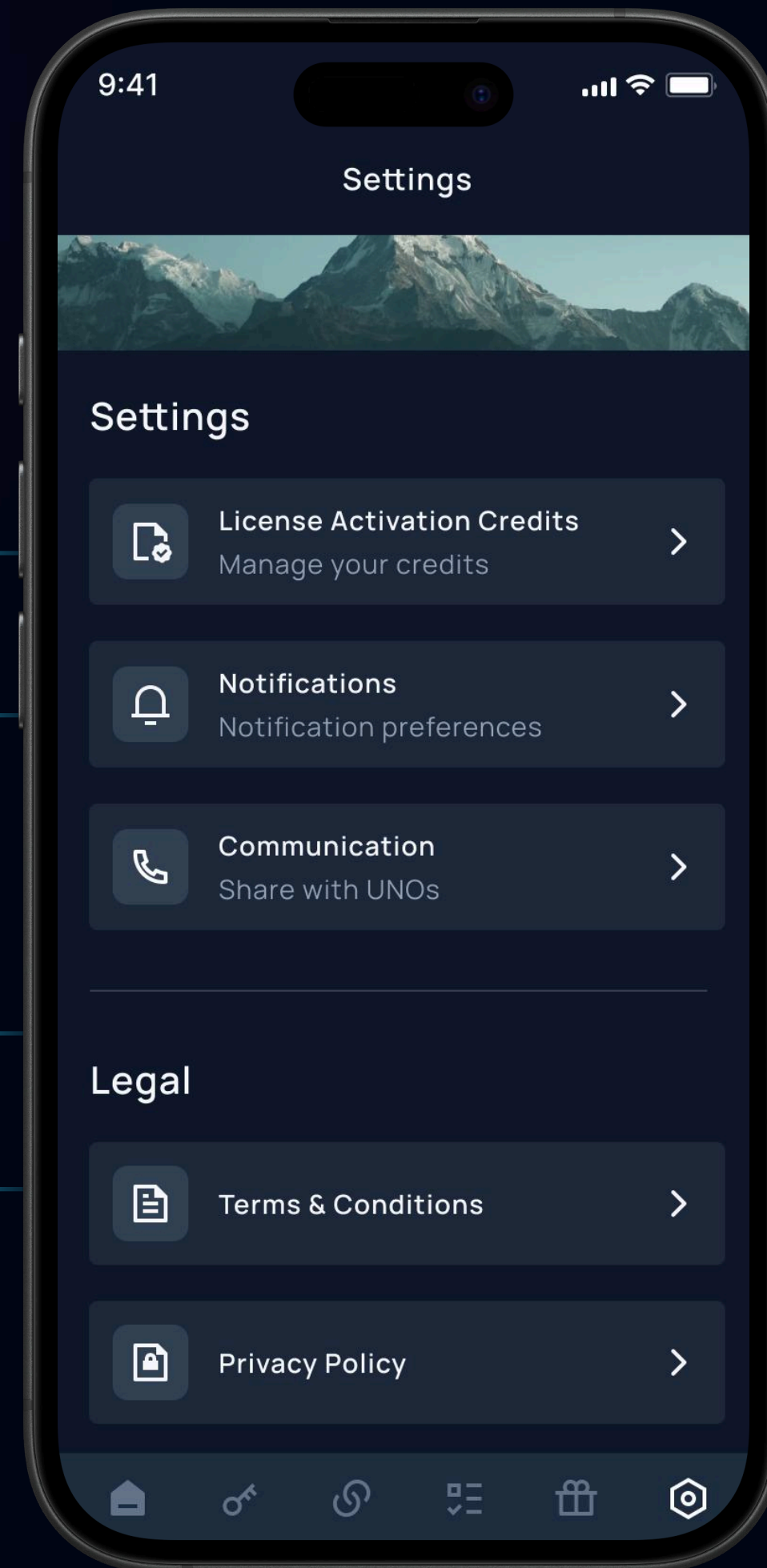

Troubleshooting

If your wallet fails to connect, ensure your Web3 wallet app is unlocked and network settings match Unetwork's supported chain.

If you don't receive the email verification code, check your spam folder or try resending after 60 seconds. For help, contact support@unetwork.io or visit the Help Center.

Security: For your protection, consider enabling wallet-level security options and regularly reviewing connected devices.

Delete Account: This is permanent. Your account data, licenses, and rewards history will be permanently erased.

Adding a License: Go to Marketplace → Claim a License to add a new license.

Network Activation Credits: Each Unetwork Node license requires Unetwork Network credits for operation. You can purchase or add more Unetwork Network credits within the Settings menu. When a license expires or is revoked, you must renew or replace your Unetwork Node license to continue earning network incentives.

Network incentives are distributed in crypto assets (Bitcoin, Ethereum, ADA, select partner assets and USDC).

Ensure your wallet address is correct before claiming - transactions are irreversible.

Minimum claim amount and payout schedules depend on network load and governance policies.



Governance and Transparency

Unity Network Tech Limited (UK) operates and provides services in the United Kingdom in accordance with English law, including the Companies Act 2006, Consumer Rights Act 2015, and all applicable anti-money laundering and data protection legislation (including the UK Data Protection Act 2018 and GDPR-aligned standards).

Unity Network Tech Limited (UK) is a company registered in England & Wales (No. 16821709), providing software-based telecom verification services within the Unetwork Edge Network. The app and Unetwork Node Licenses (UNOs/ULOs) operate exclusively for software testing, analytics, and functional participation; they do not route or transmit user calls or SMS, nor do they provide telecom or investment services. All verification tasks are isolated, opt-in, and do not interfere with normal carrier services.

Unity Network Tech Limited (UK) operates under licence from Unity Network Limited (Hong Kong), the global platform provider, in collaboration with Minutes Network Token X Ltd (St Lucia) and World Mobile Treasury Group Ltd (BVI).

“Utility” denotes solely the operational, non-investment use of the Unetwork app, nodes, and task rewards within the Unetwork Edge Network. Neither the app, UNOs, ULOs, nor any related network incentives are securities, equity, or investment products, and Unetwork is not authorised or regulated by the UK Financial Conduct Authority (FCA). No returns, income, or appreciation are promised or guaranteed; values and network incentives may be zero and payments are at risk, with no guarantee of repayment or profit.

Governance and Transparency

All data handling is compliant with the Data Protection Act 2018, aligned to GDPR standards. Only anonymised telemetry is processed; personal data (PII) is neither stored nor transmitted except as required by UK law, and use of the app invokes the UK Privacy Policy and Cookie & SDK Tracking Policy.

Independent auditors review core operations and contract fulfilment annually to maintain regulatory transparency and safeguard user trust.

By using our app or operating a Unetwork Node, you agree to these terms. Users remain solely responsible for safeguarding devices, passwords, PINs, or wallet keys. Use in breach of UK law, sanctions, or from restricted territories (including where VoIP is prohibited) is strictly forbidden.

Unity Network Tech Limited (UK) is not licensed by the FCA and does not offer investment advice, products, or services. This is not an investment. Network incentives are non-guaranteed and you may lose all sums paid.
