

# Precautions

## Danger

When the surface of the optical lens is polluted, use special lens paper to wipe it carefully;
- 10) Do not place the battery in a high temperature or near a high-temperature object;
- 11) Do not short circuit the positive and negative poles of the battery;
- 12) Do not expose the battery to moisture or water.

# Introduction

The product is designed for professional infrared temperature measurement. The infrared detector of high sensitivity and resolution provides clearer infrared image and higher accuracy of temperature measurement. The Android operating system, large-size screen and detachable lens make the product powerful and easy to use. Visible light and infrared image can be captured synchronously and the key observation positions can be displayed in PIP or MIF. It can be used as a multipurpose mobile infrared thermography application platform through the open Android Platform.

# Storage and Transportation

## **Storage:**


The packaged products shall be stored in a well-ventilated and clean indoor place with an ambient temperature of -40°C~60°C, a relative humidity of not more than 95% and free of condensation and corrosive gas.

## **Transportation:**

The products shall be protected from rain, water, inversion, violent vibration and impact during transportation, and shall be handled with care. Throwing is not allowed.



## Real-time image interface




1. Status bar: battery capacity, WiFi, 4G network (support some models), location;
2. Compass information: Go to Settings - Image Tags to turn on/ff, or long press  in the real-time interface to go to Image Tags to turn on/off.
3. Time and date: Go to Settings - General - Date & Time, or long press  in the real-time interface to go to Date & Time interface.
4. Image mode: infrared, visible light, MIF, PIP;
5. Temperature measurement parameters: set the reflected temperature, atmospheric temperature, relative humidity, target distance, atmospheric transmissivity, etc.;
6. Palette: set and add custom colors;
7. Analysis target: set the analysis target, such as the point, line, circle, rectangle, outline and temperature difference;
8. Isotherm: upper isotherm, lower isotherm and isotherm within the range;
9. Settings: conduct system settings;
10. LEVEL SPAN mode: switch between automatic, semi-automatic and manual modes through the buttons or touch screen;
11. Switch the basic colors and custom colors in real time;
12. Emissivity: set the emissivity based on the target;
13. Shortcut menu: slide down the touch screen in the main preview interface to go to the Shortcut menu.

## Main interface of the gallery

Press the "Gallery" button on the device to go to the gallery to view or edit the photos or videos.







1. Click any photo in the photo preview interface to go to the photo editing interface, and click the area outside the menu to preview the current infrared photo in full screen;
2. Click [Heart] to add the current photo to your Favorites;
3. Click [Edit] to edit the name of the current photo. The device support text recognition, keyboard input and voice input;
4. Click [Info] to view the detailed information of the current photo;
5. Click [Text] to add text notes to the current photo;
6. Click [Voice] to add voice notes to the current photo;
7. Click [Image] to add visible light notes to the current photo;
8. Click [Scribble] to add scribbling notes to the current photo;
9. Click [Analysis] to add or change the analysis object, change the isotherm and change the temperature difference between two points;
10. Click [Bluetooth] to transfer the current photo via Bluetooth;
11. Click [PDF] to make a PDF report of the current photo;
12. Click [File] to move the current photo to the specified album folder;
13. Click [Upload] at the lower right corner to upload the current photo to the cloud server;
14. Click [Move] at the lower right corner to move the current photo to other storage path;
15. Click [Delete] at the lower right corner to delete the current photo;
16. Click the visible light thumbnail at the lower right corner to preview the corresponding visible light photo in full screen.

## Photo editing


This function is to edit the saved photos, including photo analysis, thermometric analysis, parameter modification, photo outline, isotherm, temperature difference, etc.



Click [X] or press the [Back] button on the device to exit the edit menu and back to the real-time preview interface.



## Shortcut drop-down menu



In the real-time image interface, slide down from the top of the screen to pop up the shortcut menu. You can view the capacity internal storage or the external SD card or do some shortcut actions, including the brightness, volume, Bluetooth, WIFI, PAN, super-resolution, etc.




# Observation

## Switch the image mode


### Infra-Red mode

Select the "IR" icon to switch the real-time preview screen to Infra-Red mode.




### Visible light mode

Select the "VL" icon to switch the real-time preview screen to visible light mode.




## MIF mode

Select the "MIF" icon to switch the real-time preview screen to MIF mode, which can achieve the fusion of VL and IR photos.



## PIP mode

Select the "PIP" icon to switch the real-time preview screen to PIP mode.




# Manual focus/Semi-auto focus/Touch focus/Continuous auto-focus

There are two focus modes: image contrast focus and laser focus:

## Manual focus:

Manually rotate the [Focusing ring] to conduct manual focus and keep the image in the observation interface is clear.



## Touch focus:

In the real-time preview interface, tap the screen to focus.

## Semi-auto focus:

Press the auxiliary trigger button to turn on focus, and the image will sharpen automatically.

1. Go to [Settings] - [Focus Mode], set the corresponding focus mode (laser focus and image focus), and press the [Focus] button in the real-time preview interface to realize auto focus;
2. When the image focus is selected, press the [Focus] button in the real-time image interface to realize fast focus based on the scene;
3. When the image focus is selected, press the [Focus] button in the real-time image interface to display laser points and realize fast focus.

## Laser focus

This function is recommended for ranging of targets that can effectively reflect the light in non-strong light exposure (such as the white paper, cable, indoor scenes). Ranging of targets that cannot reflect the light or directly absorb the light or lessen the light is not recommended (such as the transparent glass, sky, etc.).

## Image contrast focus


This function enables the thermographic camera to focus the target by comparing the image brightness and contrast parameters in the observation interface to keep the image in the observation interface clear.

## Continuous auto focus:

1. The thermographic camera automatically focuses the target based on the changes of the observation interface to keep the image in the observation interface clear, which is suitable for use when the thermographic camera is still;
2. Notes: Auto focus shall be turned off when moving the thermographic camera, otherwise the normal use of the device will be affected;
3. Manual focus cannot be performed during auto focus;
4. Go to [Settings] - [Save Parameters] and enable [Continuous Auto Focus] to realize continuous and fast focus.

## Digital zoom



Touch the screen with two fingers to zoom in/out to view the image details.



# Shooting

This function includes: photo, panoramic stitching, timed photo, video recording, timed video recording, super-resolution.

## Photo




Go to [Settings] - [Photo Mode] and click [Photo] to go to [Single Frame] and select the corresponding photo mode, and then back to the main interface to adjust the imaging to the clearest state and press [Photo] button, and save the target scene.

## Panoramic stitching


Panoramic stitching: Stitch two or more photos taken by the device into one panoramic photo to keep the details of the original images and provide better image of the scene.

In real-time image interface, slide down from the top of the screen to pop up the shortcut menu. Touch to open [ ] and the device automatically backs to the main interface and enters "Panoramic" mode, and click [ ] or [ ] to select the photo mode and stitching will be completed after photos are taken.



## Super-resolution


Super-resolution: Zoom in the original image to a high resolution image that can be edited.

In the real-time image interface, slide down from the top of the screen to pop up the shortcut menu and click "Super-Resolution" to enter the "Super-Resolution" mode.




## Timed photo

Go to [Settings] interface, click [Photo Mode] and select [Timed Photo] to set the interval and total number of photos. Press the Back button to go back to the real-time preview interface, and press [Photo] to take a photo and save the target scene.



## Video recording

Go to [Settings] interface and click [Video Mode]. Touch to start [Video Recording] and press the "Back" button to go back to the real-time preview interface. Press [Trigger Button] to record the current target scene and press [Trigger Button] again to end recording.



## Timed video recording


Set the latency and duration for different demands and scenes to record videos;

Go to [Settings] interface, click [Video Mode] and select [Timed Video Recording] to set the latency and duration. Press the Back button to go back to the real-time preview interface, and press [Trigger Button] to start video recording.




# Analysis Operation

## Temperature measurement parameters

The temperature measurement parameters include: emissivity, reflected temperature, atmospheric temperature, relative humidity, target distance, optical transmittance and dew point;

Click [ ] in the real-time interface to go to the secondary menu and change the parameters as demanded.



Parameters

### Emissivity

Users can set the emissivity based on the target material to ensure the temperature measurement accuracy;

Click [ ] to go to the emissivity settings and select "Materials" and [User Defined]. Slide to change the values within 0.01-1.00, and touch other areas or press [Back] to exit and save.



Reflected temperature: When there is a high-temperature target in the scene and the emissivity of the observed target is low, and the observed target reflects the high-temperature target, the reflected temperature needs to be set. The reflected temperature shall be set at the temperature of the high-temperature target. Users can change the parameters (-40~2,000) based on the actual conditions.

Atmospheric temperature: The atmospheric temperature of the current observation environment. Users can change the parameters based on the actual conditions, and the range is -40-2,000.

Relative humidity: Users can change the parameters based on the actual conditions, and the range is 0-100;

Target distance: The distance between the observation target and the thermographic camera. Users can set the distance parameters as demanded. Users can set the close-up, distant and general distance based on the actual conditions, and the range is 0.1-1,000;


Optical transmittance: The transmittance of the germanium glass between the thermographic camera and the observed target, and the range is 1-100;

Dew point: The temperature required for the vaporous water in the current ambient air to condense into liquid water. This temperature shall be calculated with the corresponding formula and cannot be changed.

## Palette


Users can select different colors for different application scenarios.

1. Click the palette area on the right of the screen in real-time image status to pop up the palette options, and select the color for the scene from White hot, Oxide red, Arctic pole, Hot iron, Rainbow 1, Rainbow 2, Lava, Medical, Red tint, Black hot, Blue hot, Dark brown, Green hot, Fire and ice, Amber and Custom colors (the options vary for some models).
2. Long touch to move and adjust the color.



3. Click [+] to create custom colors.


- 1) In real-time image mode, click [+] in the color options interface to go to the palette adding interface. The image on the left automatically maps the effect based on the settings.
- 2) Two color codes are displayed by default to map the colors of low temperature to high temperature from the bottom to top. Select the first color code and zoom in by default.




# Real-time analysis

## Add/Delete analysis object

1. Click  at the bottom of the screen in real-time image status to open the analysis object menu interface;



2. This device supports the temperature measurement of various analysis objects, such as the dot, line, circle and rectangle, and supports the customized display of the maximum temperature, the minimum temperature and the average temperature.
3. Long touch any analysis object on the screen and the system will automatically pop up the analysis object editing page;  
Temperature mark: Maximum temperature, minimum temperature, average temperature;  
Emissivity: The emissivity of the analysis object;  
Area/Length: Enable the laser ranging function to obtain the target distance to analyze the area or length of the analysis object;  
Center: Center the analysis object;  
Delete: Delete the current analysis object.




## Change the analysis object size

1. Touch to select the line, circle, rectangle or polygon analysis object and the selected points will be marked blue;
2. Move any point to change the area of the analysis object.




## Line analysis object

Add a line analysis object and select to display the temperature trend of it.



## Image outline

1. Click [ ] to go to image outline and manually draw the interested target outline, and click “✓” to complete. You can also analyze the selected object;




2. Long press the outline object to pop up the object menu;

Temperature mark: Maximum temperature, minimum temperature, average temperature;

Emissivity: The emissivity of the analysis object;

Delete: Delete the current analysis object.



## Isotherm

Set the "Upper isotherm", "Lower isotherm", "Isotherm within the range" and "Isotherm beyond the range" to make the target temperature area matches the set color. The high temperature value and low temperature value can be adjusted by moving or by the five-way button.

The manual/semi-automatic mode does not support isotherms. Notes: Isotherms cannot be added in manual mode.

### Upper isotherm

1. Click the shortcut menu [•••] at the bottom of the interface and click [🌡];
2. Click [⬆] at the isotherm column to enter the upper isotherm real-time image mode.

### Lower isotherm

1. Click the shortcut menu [•••] at the bottom of the interface and click [🌡];
2. Click [⬇] at the isotherm column to enter the lower isotherm image mode.

### Isotherm beyond the range


1. Click the shortcut menu [•••] at the bottom of the interface and click [🌡];
2. Click [➡] at the isotherm column to enter the image mode with isotherm beyond the range.

### Isotherm within the range

1. Click the shortcut menu [•••] at the bottom of the interface and click [🌡];
2. Click [⬅] at the isotherm column to enter the image mode with isotherm within the range.

### Disable isotherm

1. Click the shortcut menu [•••] at the bottom of the interface and click [🌡];
2. Click [✖] at the isotherm column to cancel the isotherm image mode.




## Temperature difference analysis

Add at least 2 analysis objects and click " $\Delta T$ " icon, and select the analysis objects of the same temperature data (such as Max, MIN) to compare.




Exit temperature difference analysis: Click " $\Delta T$ " icon to exit temperature difference mode.




## LEVEL/SPAN

Users can select different dimming type for different light conditions to achieve the best shooting effect.

1. Click [A] [S] and [M] in the real-time preview status to switch among semi-auto [S], manual [M] and automatic [A];
2. When level/span is in semi-auto mode, adjust  $\Delta T$  value with the "Up button" or "Down button" in the five-way button or set the  $\Delta T$  value by sliding the screen, and the image dimming changes synchronously.  $\Delta T=T_{max}-T_{min}$ .




3. When level/span is in manual mode, adjust the "level" with the "Up button" or "Down button" in the five-way button. The "Up button" can also increase the  $T_{max}$  and  $T_{min}$  value and the "Down button" can reduce the  $T_{max}$  and  $T_{min}$  value. The image dimming changes synchronously;
4. Click the maximum temperature or minimum temperature value on the color bar to pop up the value options to select the appropriate maximum or minimum temperature value. The image dimming changes synchronously.




## Gallery


1. Press [Gallery] button on the device to go to the gallery preview interface;



2. Click "Select" at the upper right corner to select images to transfer via Bluetooth, generate a PDF report, upload to the cloud disk, add to the album, cut and delete;




3. Select local, SD card (the device can identify the SD card only after the SD card installed) or cloud disk (the cloud disk will display after login) to display the files in the corresponding path.



# Image analysis

## Photo editing

1. Click any photo in the photo preview interface to go to the photo editing interface;
2. You can add text, voice, visible light and scribbling notes to the current photo;
3. You can add the current photo to "Favorites", rename it, transfer via Bluetooth and generate a pdf report;
4. Click [ ] to add or change the analysis object, change the isotherm, change the temperature difference and change the temperature measurement parameters of the current photo.




## Image zoom in/out

In image editing mode, touch the screen with two fingers and spread the fingers to zoom in the photo and fold the fingers to zoom out the photo. When the infrared image is zoomed in, slide on the screen with one finger to move the image.

## PDF creating

1. In image preview interface;



2. Click "Select" to select up to 9 images;
3. Click "PDF" to generate a PDF preview file.





## Video editing


1. Click "Video" to go to the video preview interface;




2. Click any video file to view the details;

4. You can change the analysis object, isotherm, temperature difference and temperature measurement parameters of the video (only support videos in irgd format).




Click "Album" to go to the album gallery, and "Favorites", "My Tasks" and the albums created by the user will display.

Click "Search" to go to the album interface and enter the photo name, time and tag to search for the corresponding file.






Go to [Settings] and select [Temperature Measurement Range] to pop up the selection box. Users can select the appropriate temperature measurement range for the target.




## Temperature alarm

Temperature alarm includes high temperature alarm, low temperature alarm and high-low temperature alarm. The device will alarm if the alarm switch is turned on and the corresponding temperature threshold is triggered.

The alarm modes include sound alarm and light alarm.




Click the alarm icon in the real-time preview interface to turn off temperature alarm.





## Image tags




Select to display the maximum temperature, minimum temperature or average temperature;




## Image watermark

1. Click "Image Watermark" to display the watermark options, including logo, date, location, orientation, emissivity, relative humidity, reflected temperature, atmospheric temperature and target distance. Users can enable the options as demanded, which will be displayed on the image;

3. Press the Playback button and go to the photo preview interface and select the photo just taken to preview;





## Auxiliary buttons

2. Then back to the real-time image interface and press the auxiliary button to respond to the settings;




## Ledger management






1. Click "Task Photo" to display the photos taken at this measuring point under all task modes in the current ledger;








## Task management



2. Select a point and click "Start Tasks" and go to the main preview interface to take photos;




3. Click "Task Photo" to go to the photo details page to view the photo information of the selected point;

## AI voice


Enable AI voice with the "Auxiliary Button" function. "Identifying..." is displayed when there is a voice command. Operation stops when an AI order is identified.

The designated names include: Photo, Video, Focus, Calibrate, Change Ribbon, IR, VL, PIP, MIF, Fusion, Light On, Light Off, Start Task and End Task.




## Unit switching

Users can select the temperature unit (degree centigrade, Fahrenheit, Kelvin) based on the operation habits;




## Save parameters

Enable the laser ranging function and back to the real-time image interface. Press [] to obtain the distance/area information.




## Report parameters

Set the PDF report parameters, including the Logo, title, header, footer and PDF template.




## Preference settings

## Shutdown and sleep


Users can set the timed shutdown and sleep time based on the operation habits, including never/5min/10min/20min/30min/40min/50min/1h.



## Cloud service


Log in to Alibaba Cloud server and upload the photos in this device to the server, and then log in to the analysis software on PC to download the device files to perform analysis and output reports.

## Network connection


Mobile network: Connect to external 4G mobile network (including China Mobile, China Unicom and China Telecom).

Insert the SIM card to the device and click [•••] at the bottom of the real-time preview interface and click [⚙️], and find [Network Connection] in settings interface and click it to open the mobile network and search for network signals.


After successfully connecting to network, the device can upload photos to the cloud service and ensure normal function of the OCR function.

### WiFi hotspot:


3. AP is disabled by default. When it is enabled, the personal WiFi hotspot is enabled by default. Infrared analysis software and phone APP can be connected for real-time video. After AP is enabled, users can connect the device network by entering the correct user name and password on the analysis software to display the real-time images.



## Local IP

Users can customize the IP address and DNS server address.



## Bluetooth


1. Enable the Bluetooth of the target device;


## General


## Take out the SD card
