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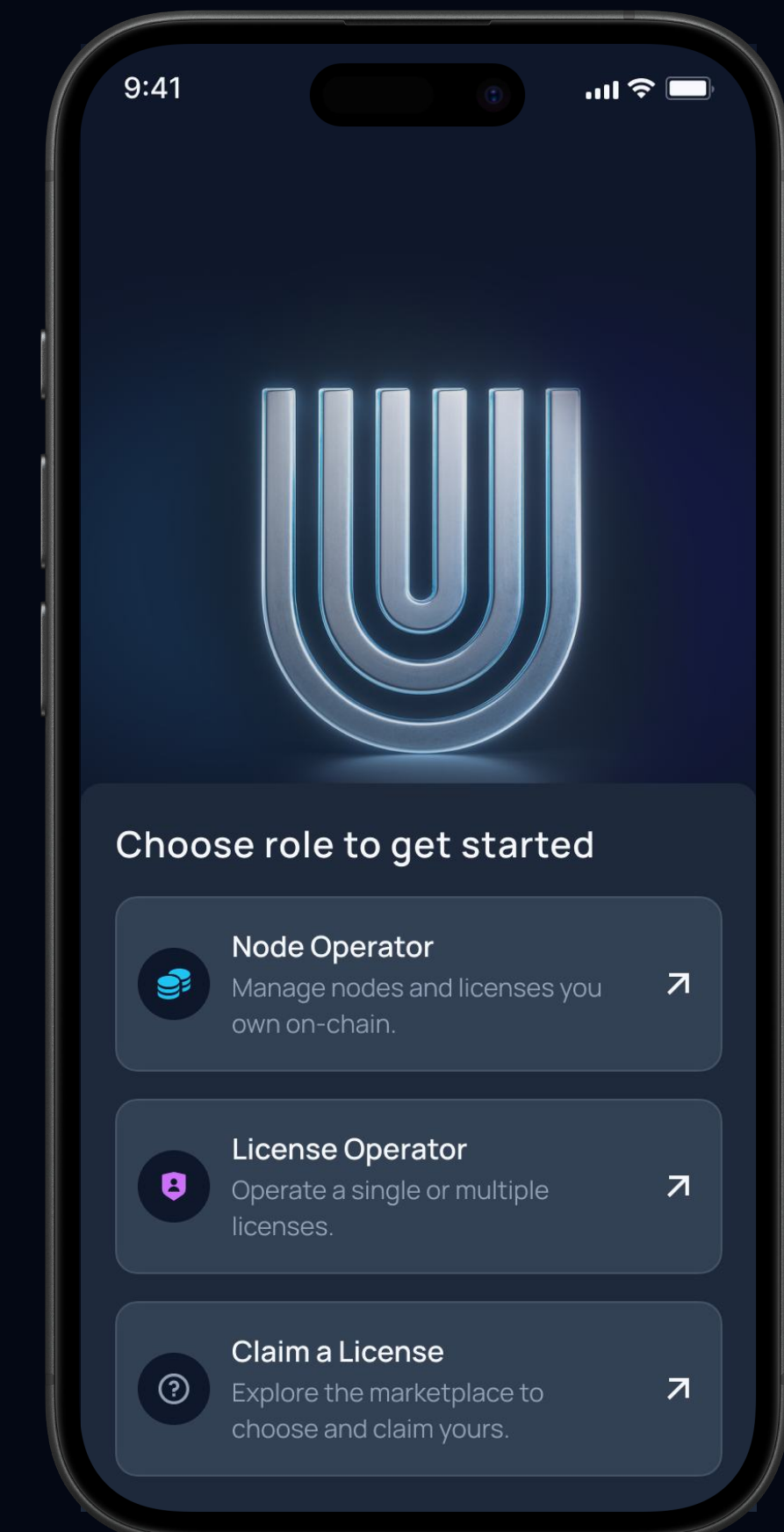
Welcome to Unity

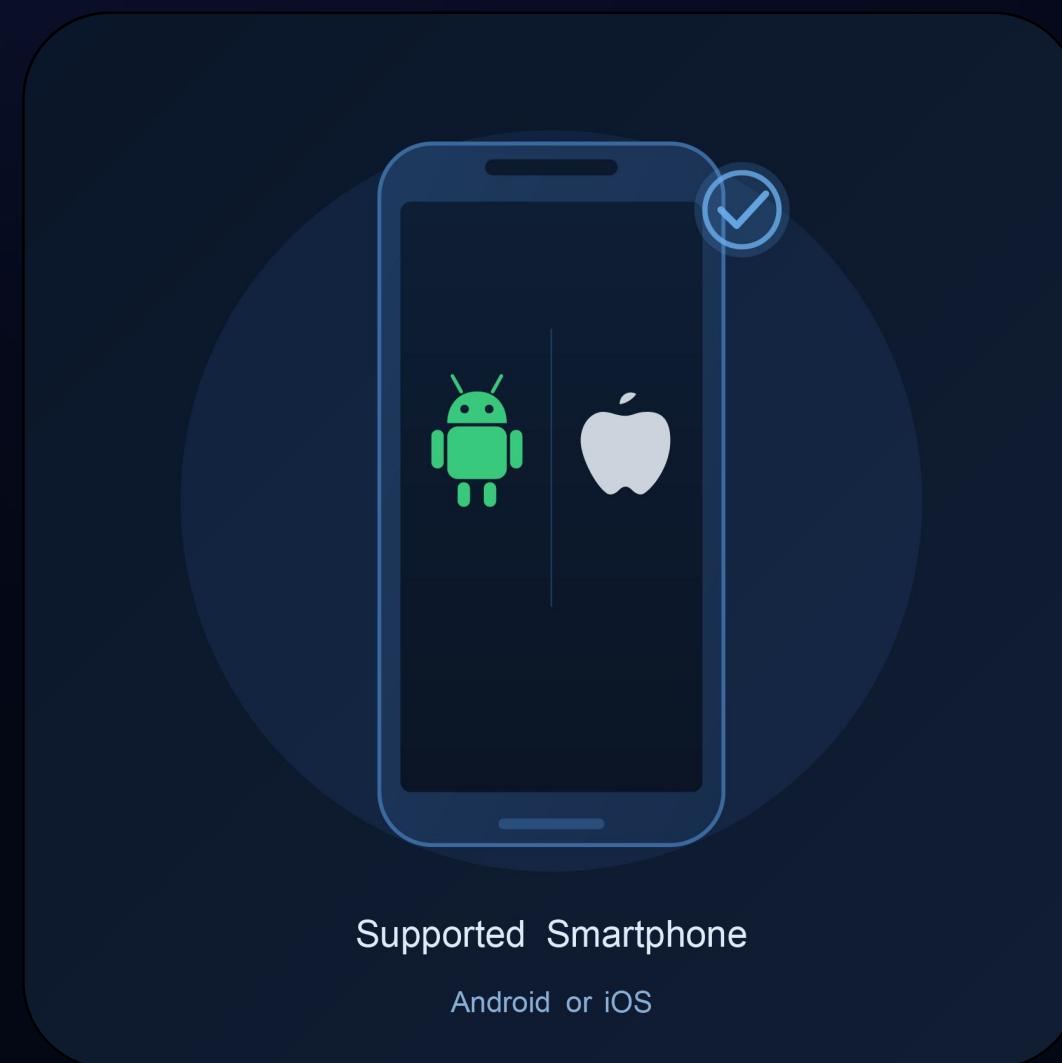
What Is a Unity License Operator (ULO)?

A Unity License Operator (ULO) is anyone who operates a Unity Operator Software License on a smartphone using the Unity app.

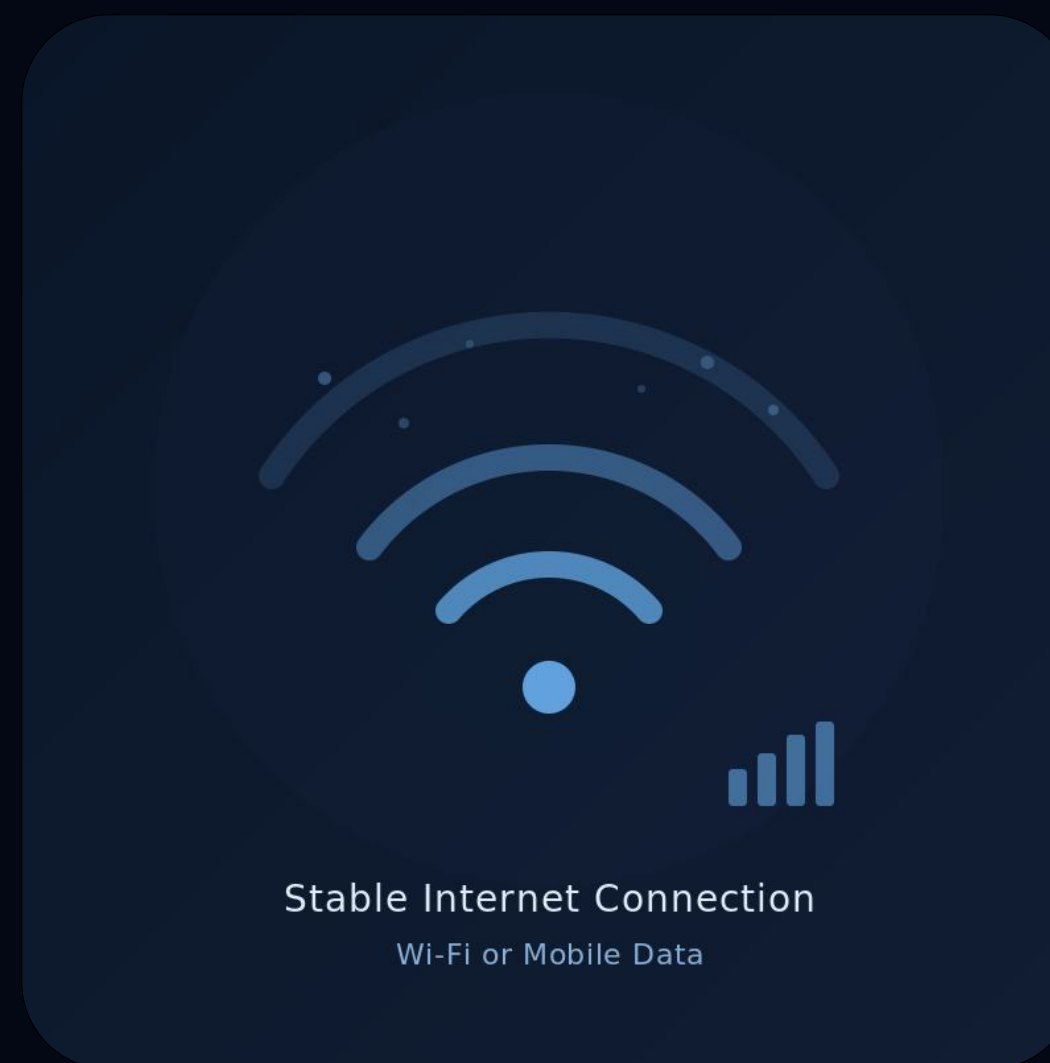
As a ULO, you contribute to Unity's global edge network by performing verification tasks from your smartphone and receiving network incentives for verified participation.



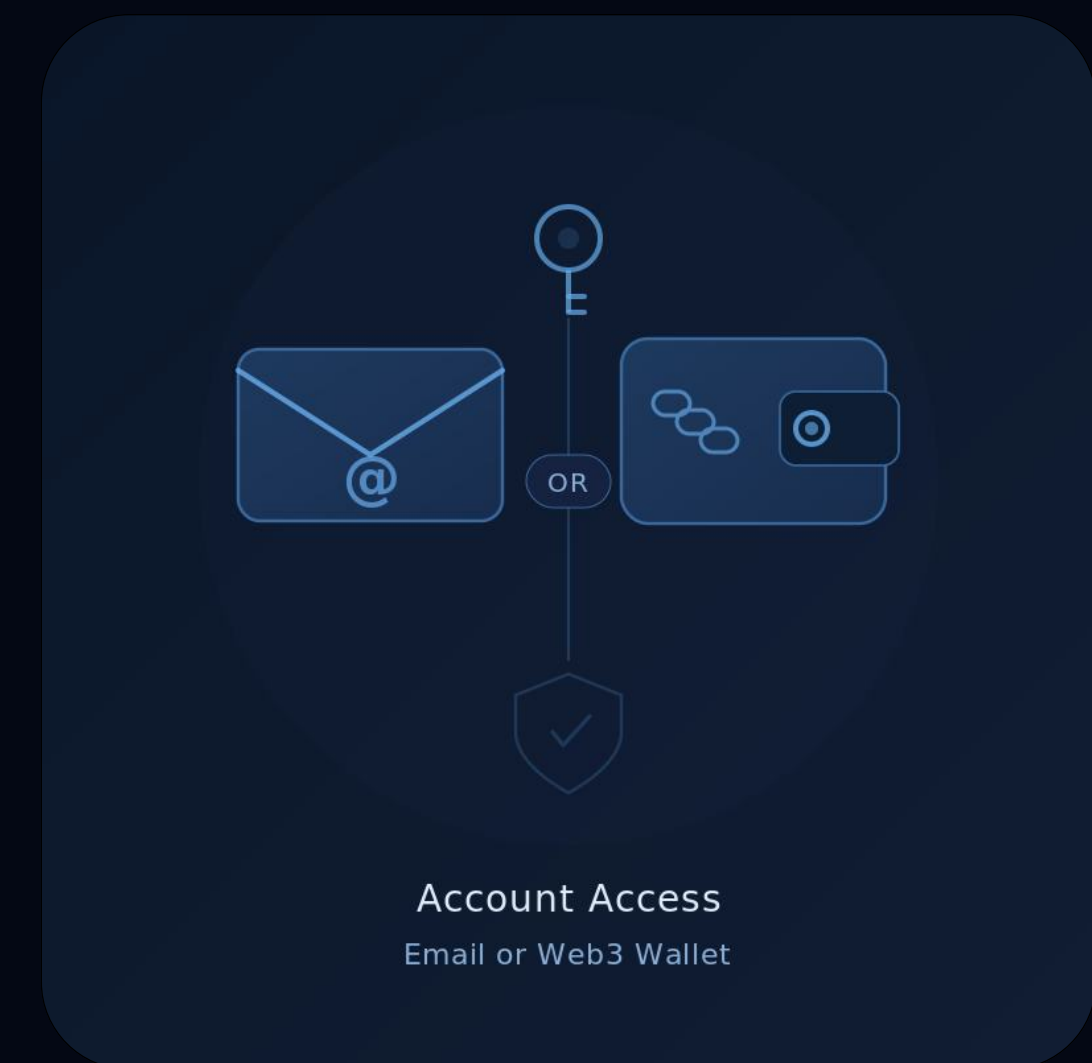
Requirements



A supported Android or iOS smartphone.



A stable internet connection: The Unity app works on Wi-Fi. Some tasks may require mobile data, depending on task requirements.



Access to your email address (for email sign-in) and/or access to a Web3 wallet (for wallet sign-in and crypto redemption).

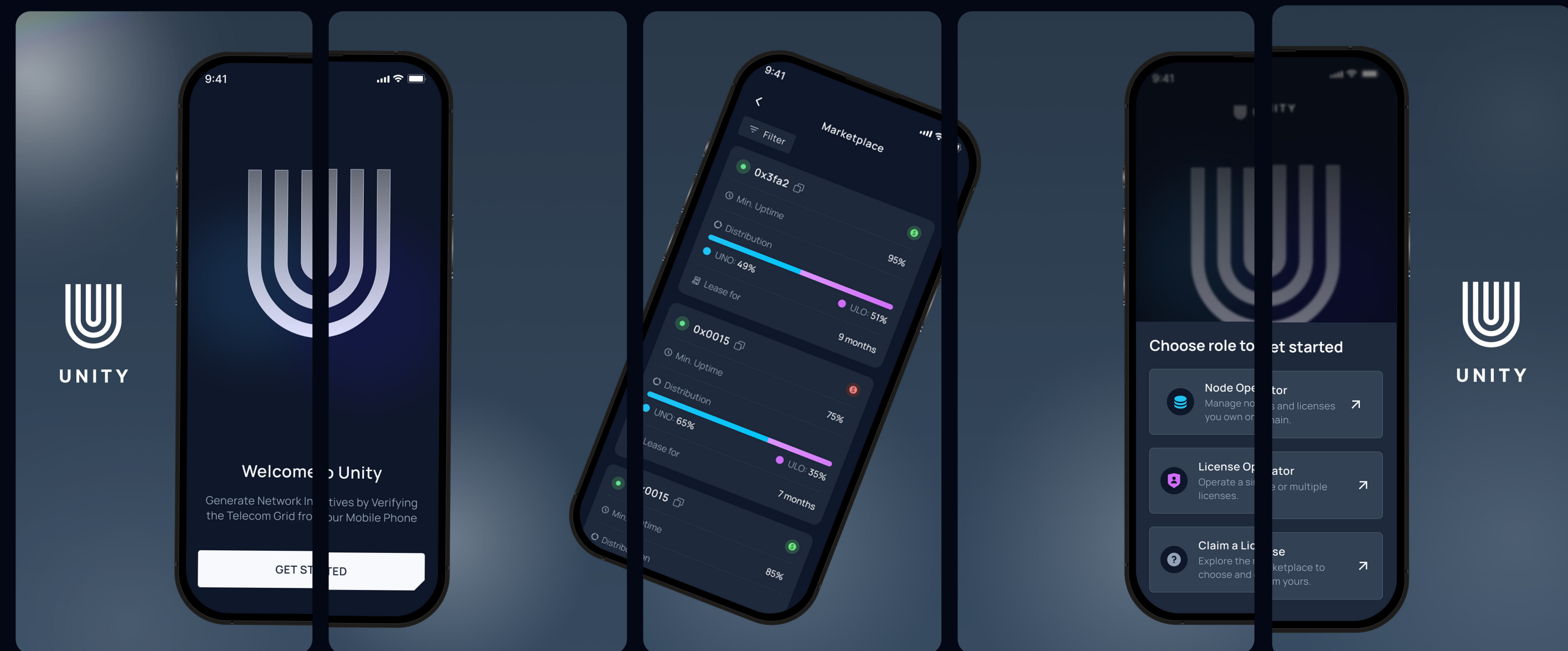

How Licenses Work

Distribution (UNO/ULO)

The percentage split of network incentives between:

- UNO - Unity Node Operator
- ULO - Unity License Operator (you)

The higher your ULO %, the greater your network incentives.

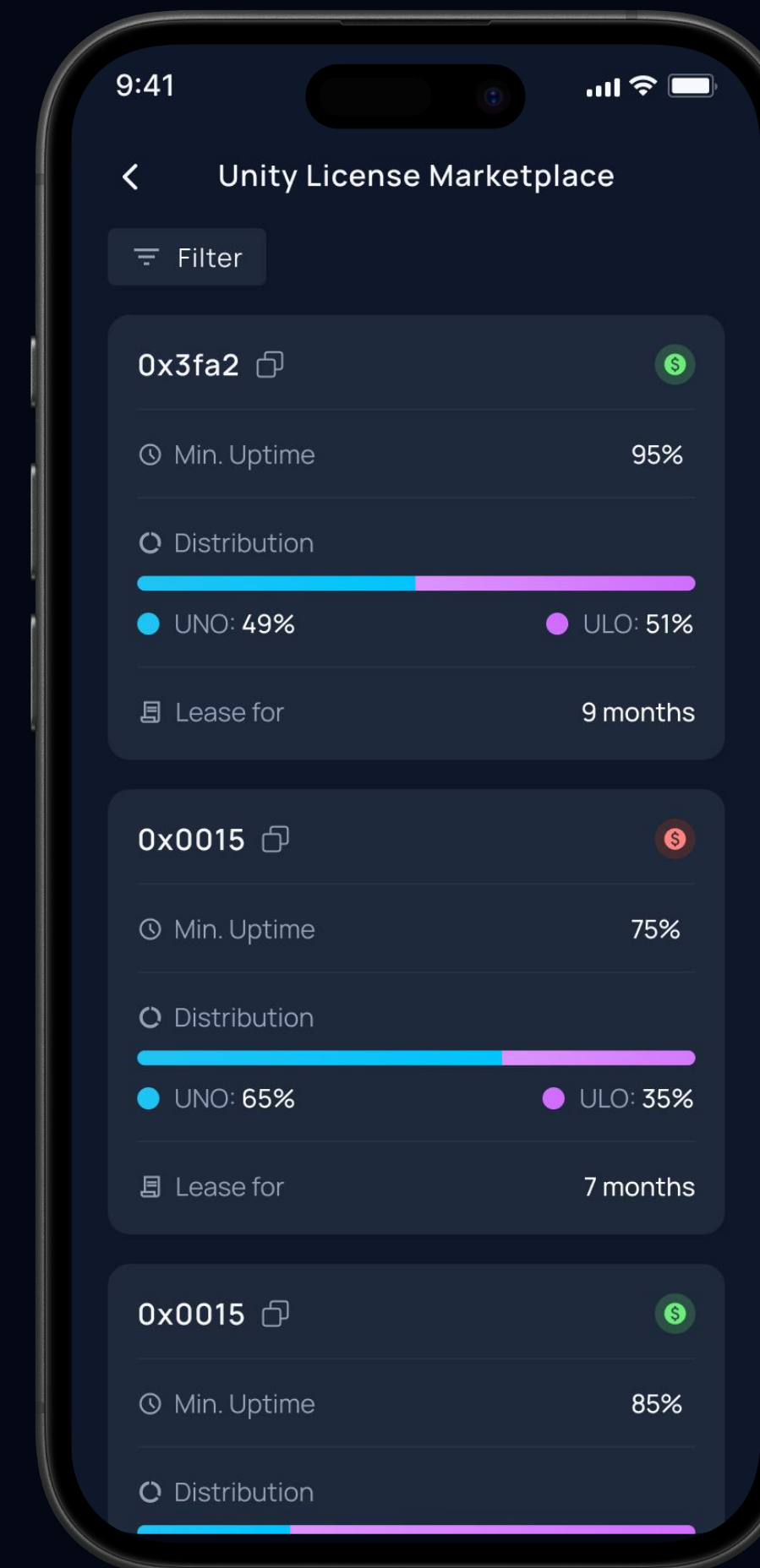
Lease Duration

This shows how long you can operate the license.

A longer lease provides more time to perform verification tasks and receive network incentives.

Minimum Uptime

The minimum time your device must be online and powered on to keep the license active. For example, 95% means your device should be running at least 95% of the time.

Login Method: Email or Web3 Wallet

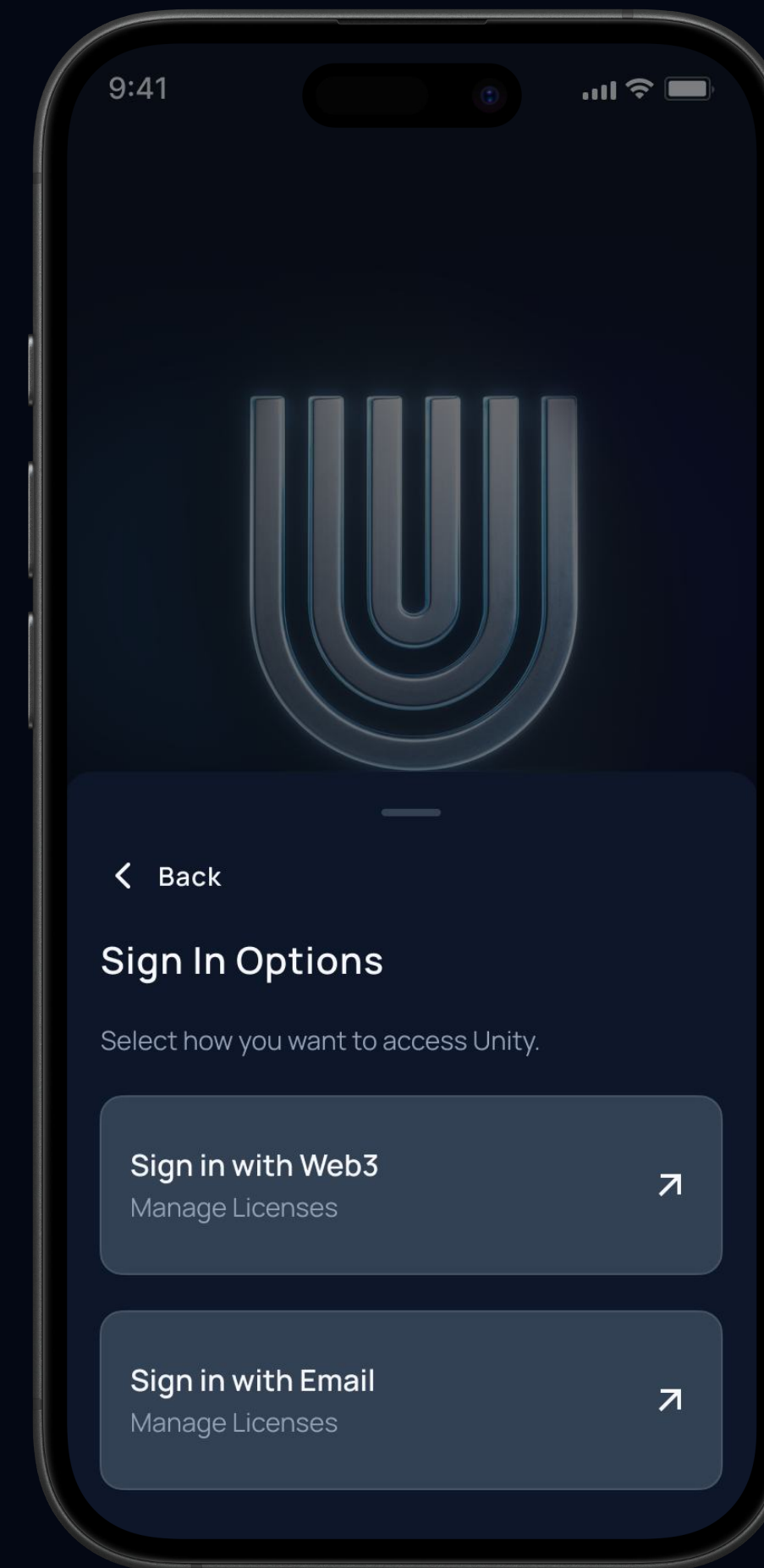
You can operate Unity using either method.

1. Email Sign-In (Recommended for starters)

- Instant login via your existing email address
- Operate multiple licenses across multiple devices under one account

2. Web3 Wallet Sign-In (Advanced Users)

- Any popular Web3 wallet can be used
- Instant login via your existing wallet address
- Operate multiple licenses across multiple devices under one account
- Allows you to participate in tasks

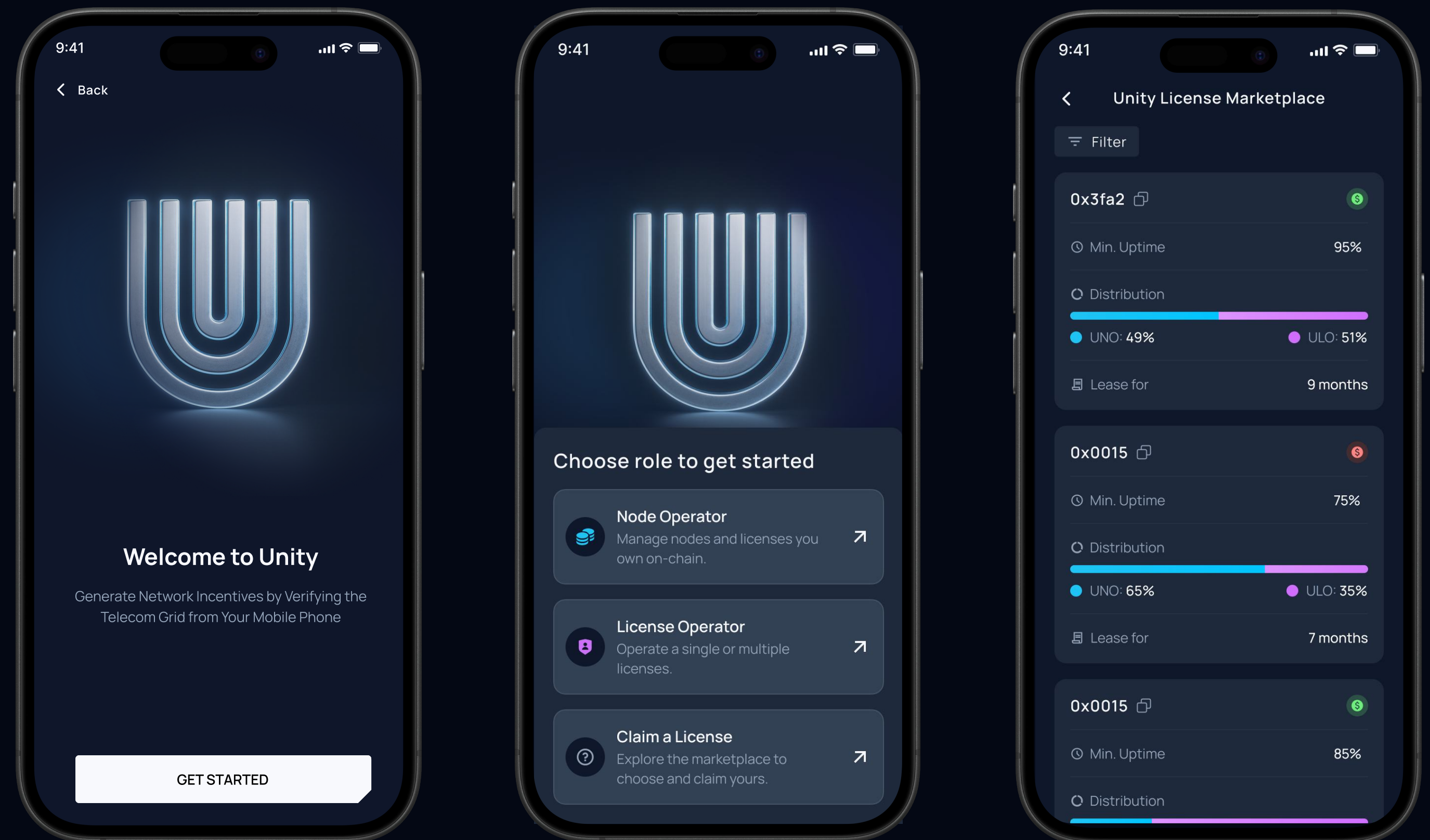

Get a ULO License & Login

The quickest way to claim a ULO lease license on your device, is by choosing the “Claim a License” button from the menu.

When prompted to choose a role:

1. Click “Get Started”
2. Click “Claim a License”
3. Choose a License

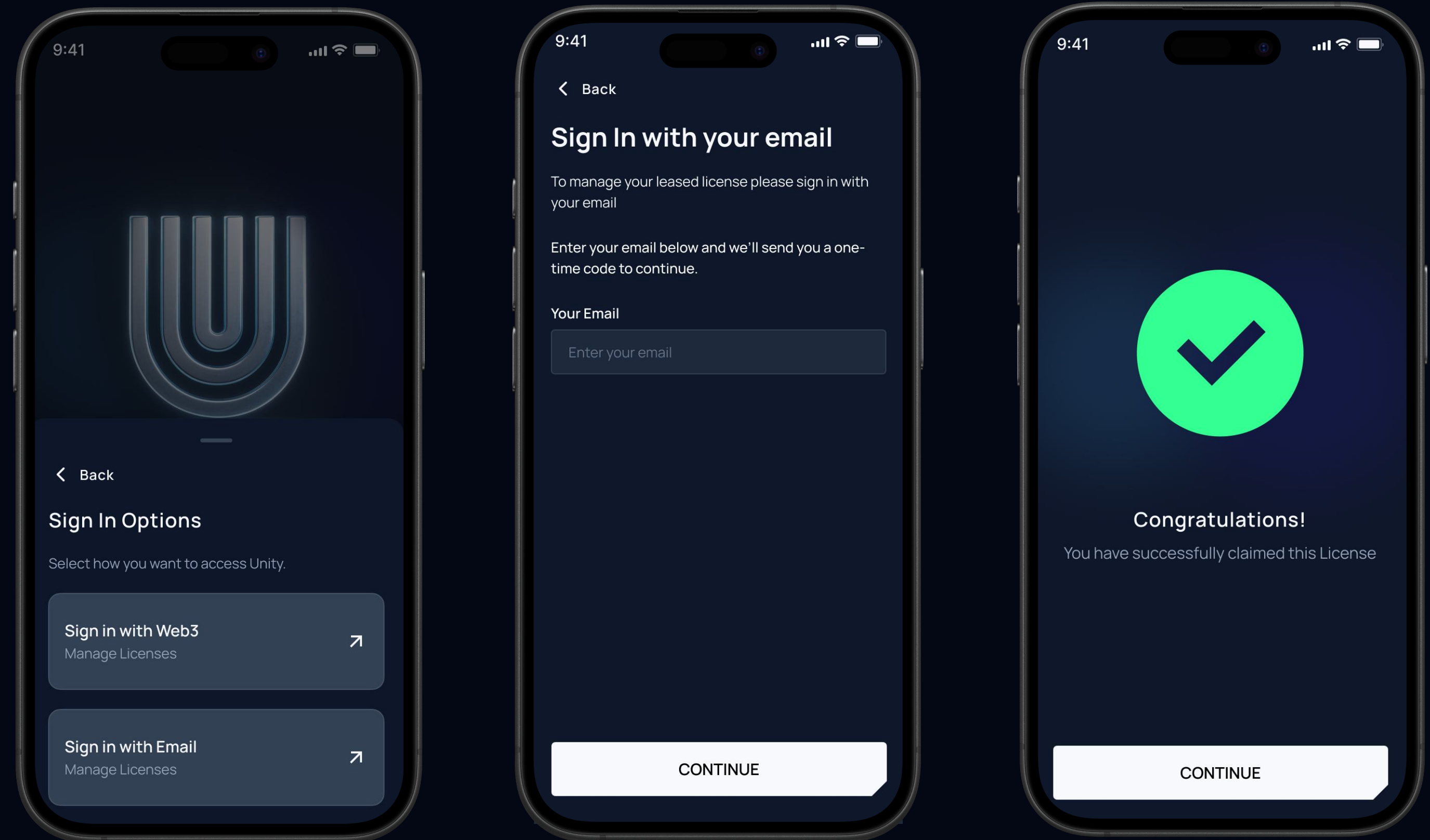


Get a ULO License & Login

5. Sign in with your email.
6. Enter your email address and OTP code.
7. License claimed, you're logged in.

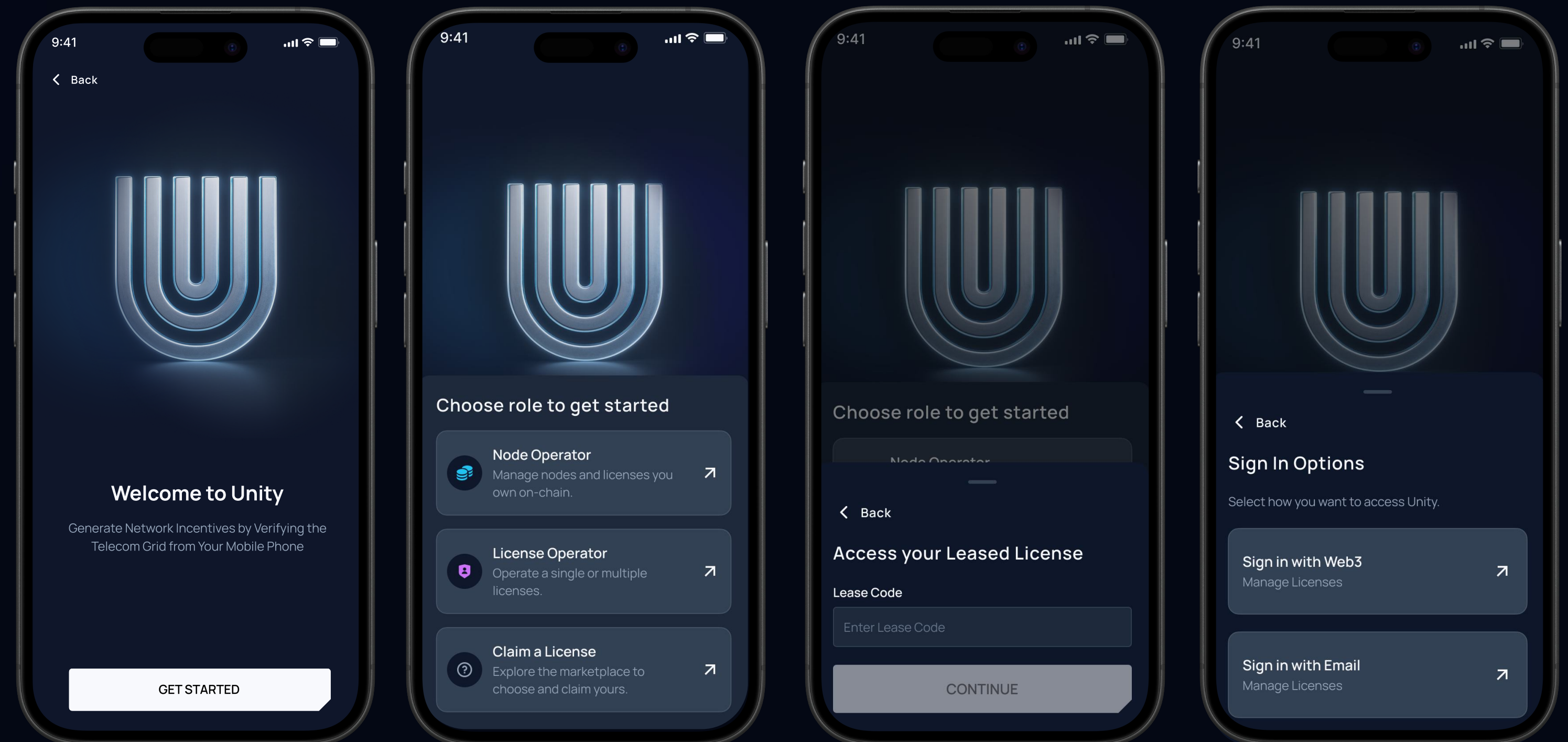
Claim Private License-Code and Log-in

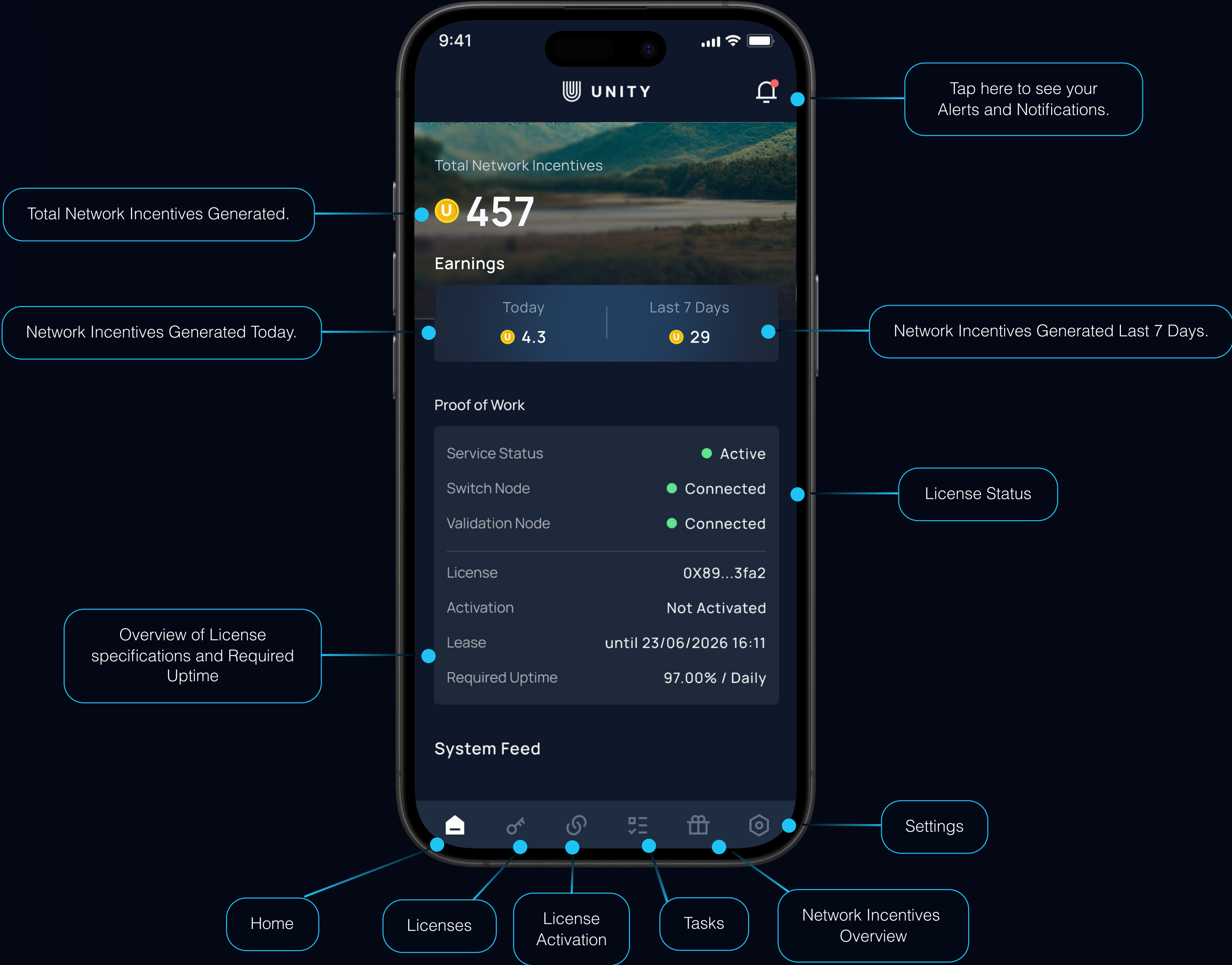

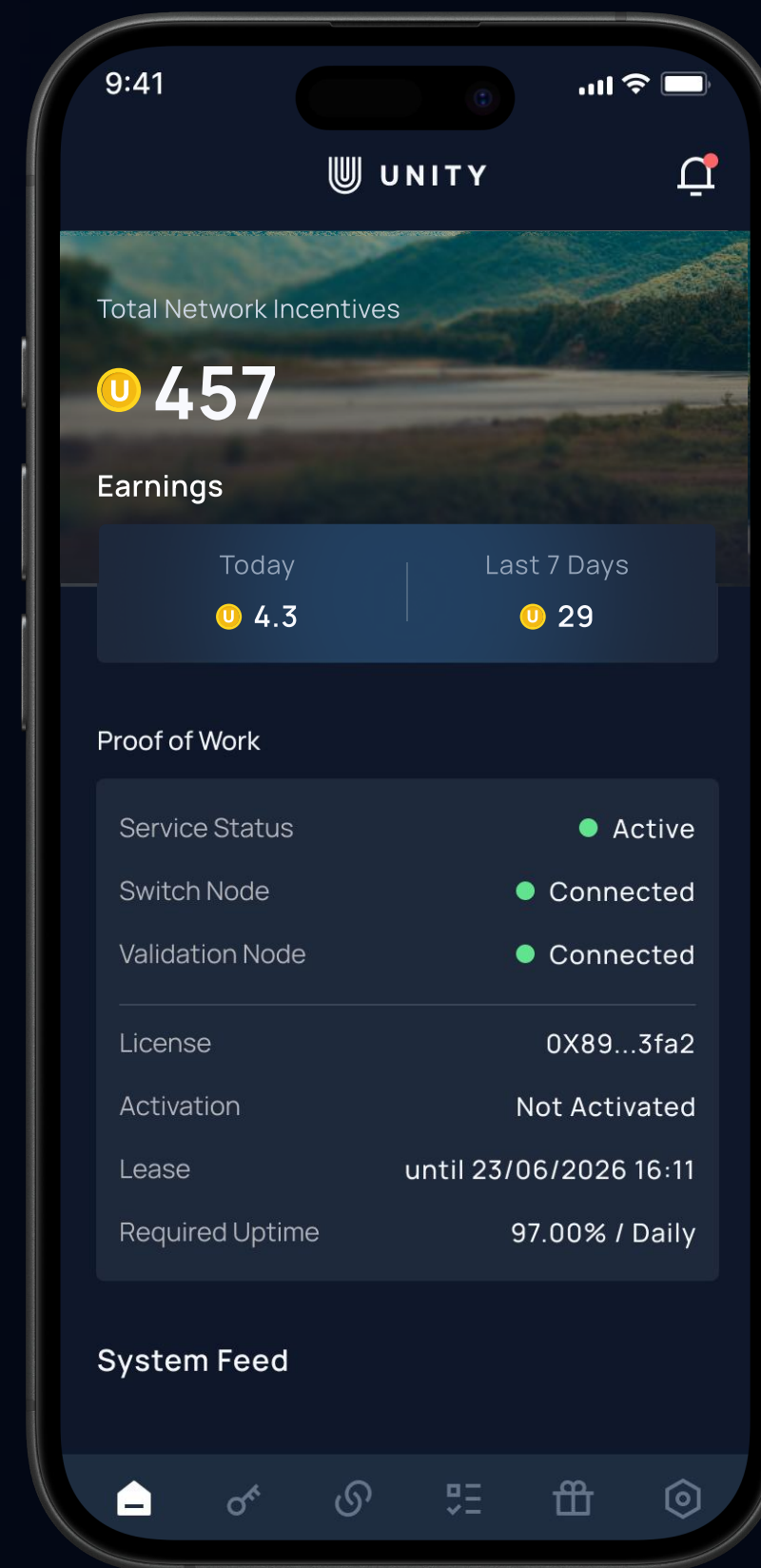

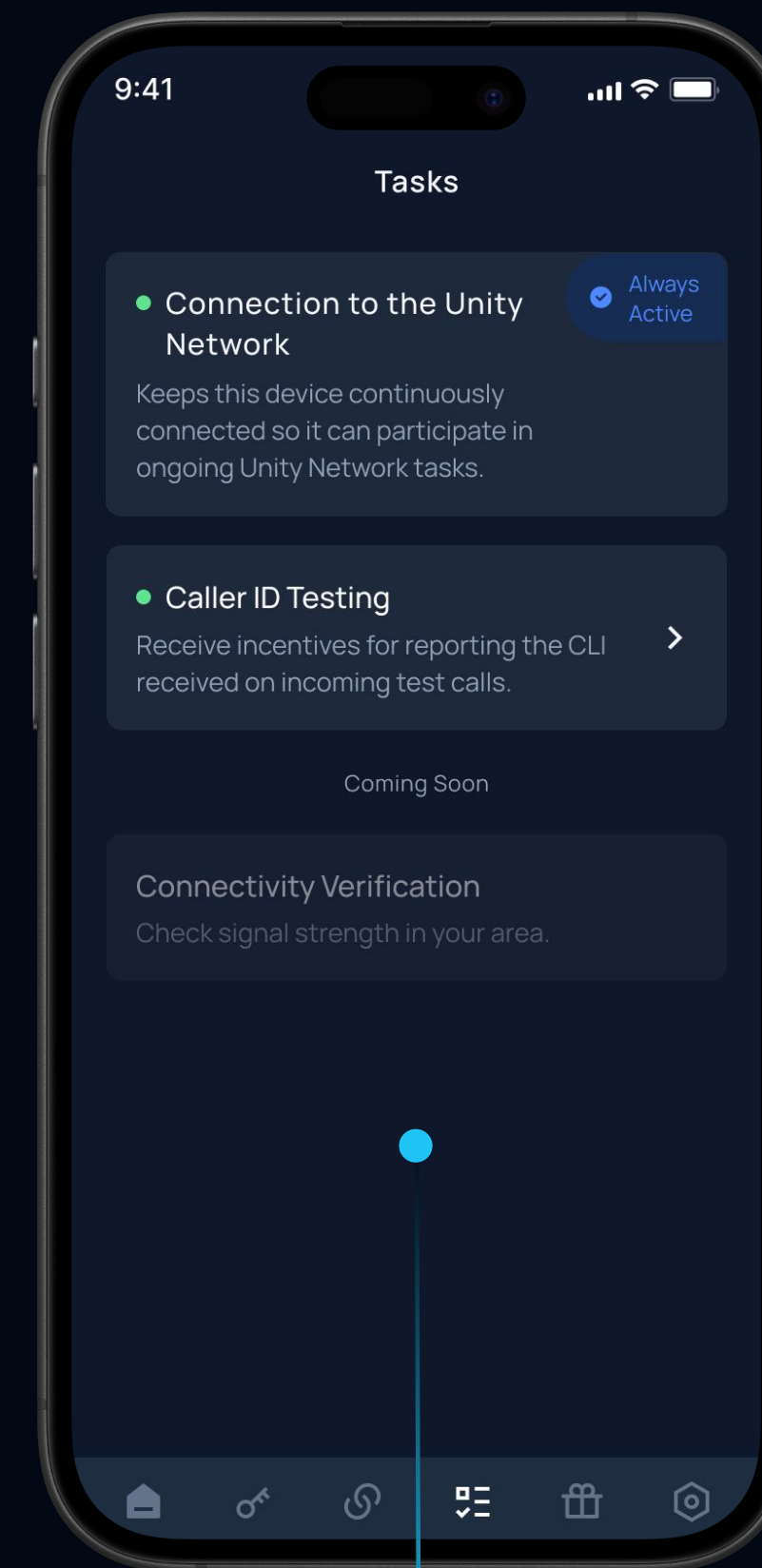

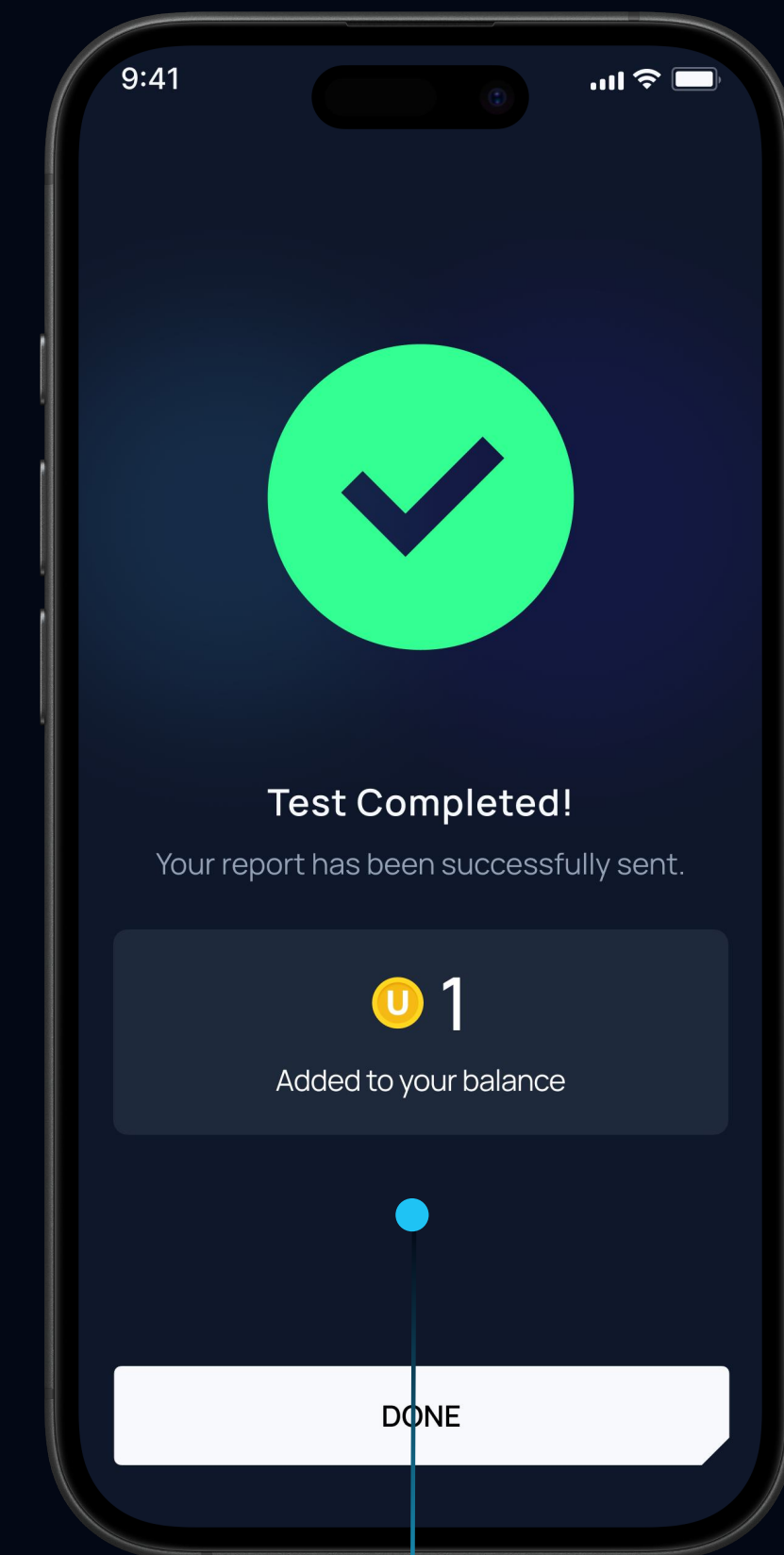

View a summary of cumulative generated incentives across all devices linked to your email address or Web3 wallet.

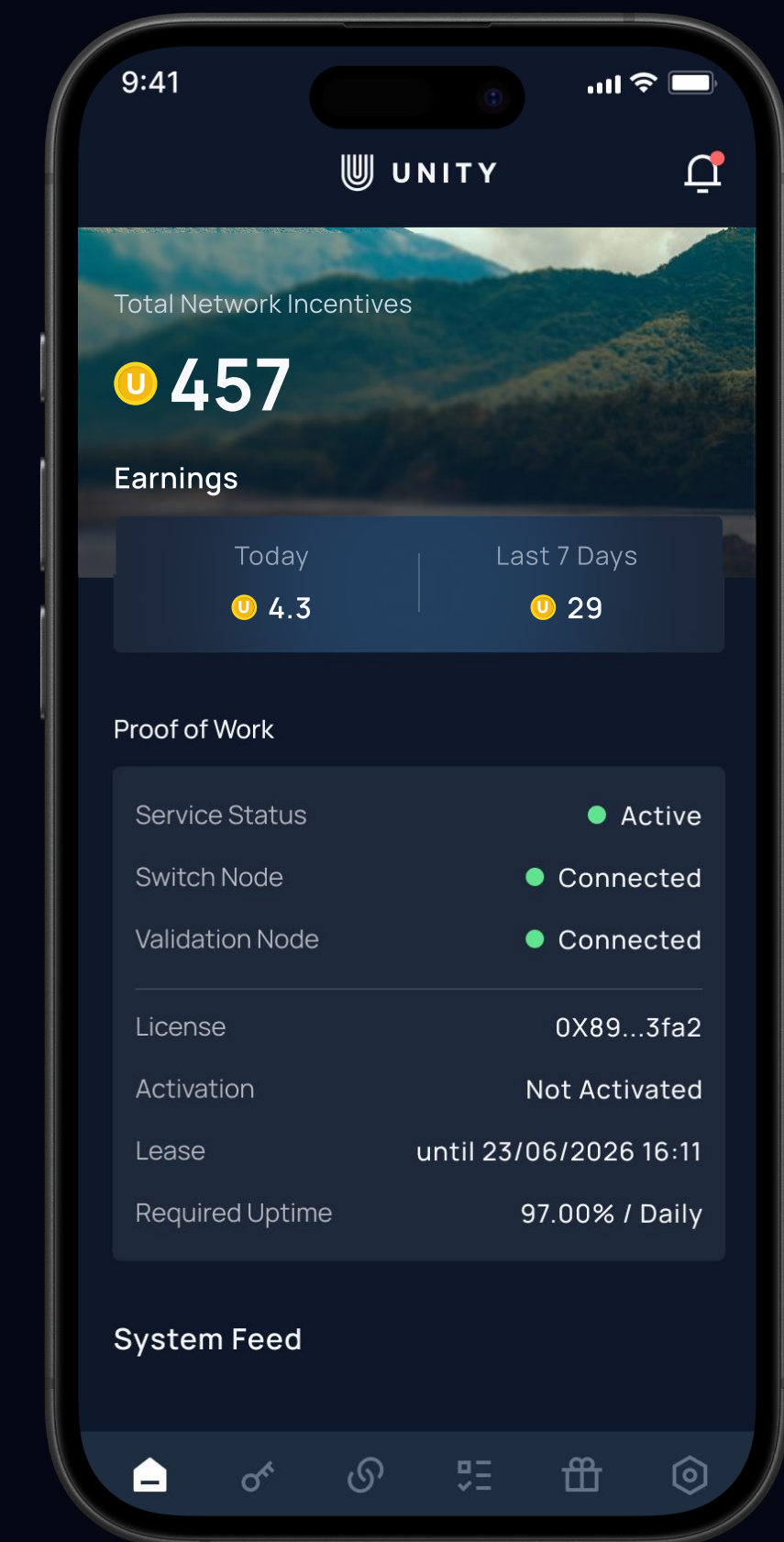
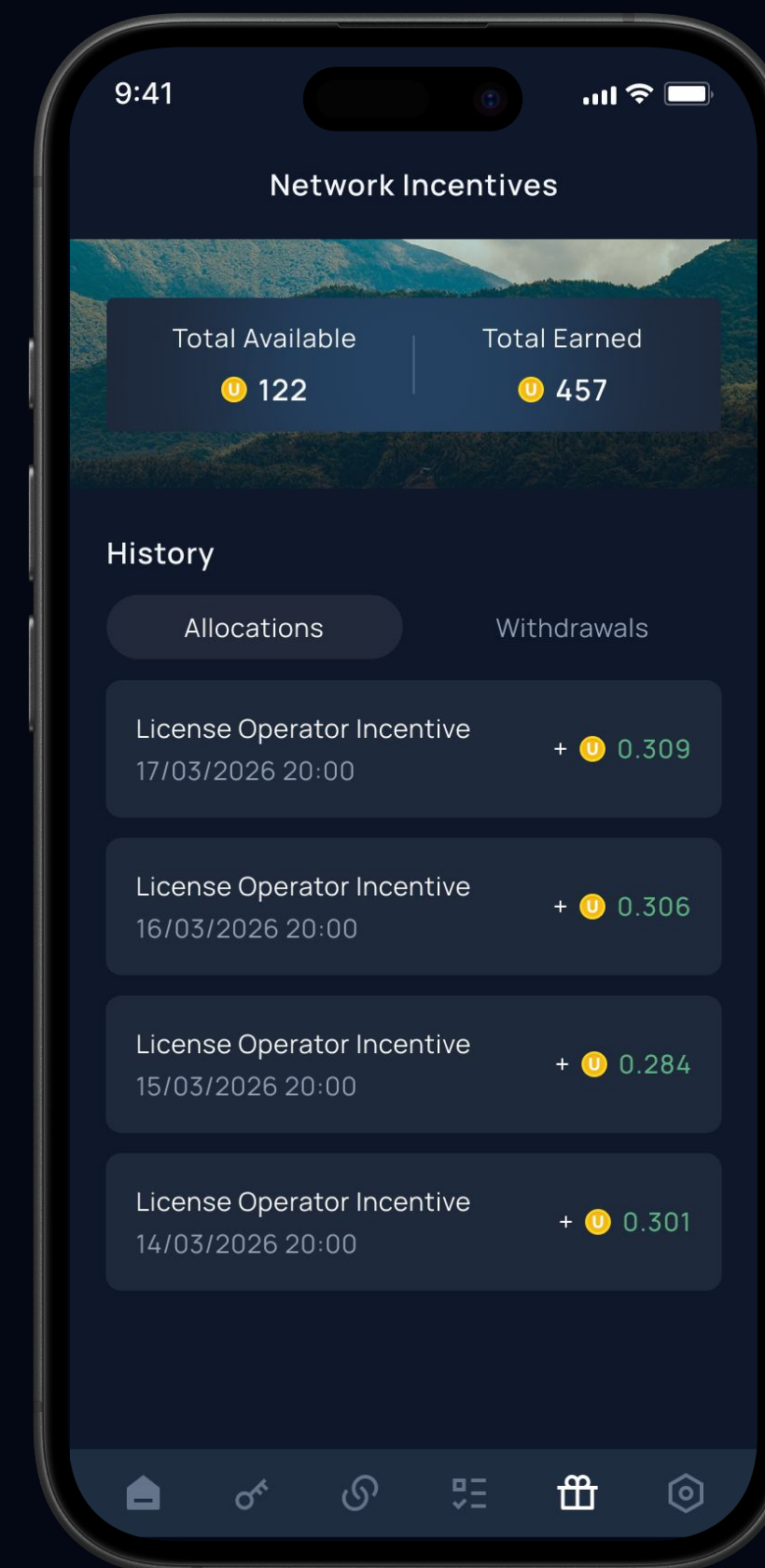
Track your generated Network Incentives for Today, the Last 7 Days, and All Time.

Withdrawal of Incentives

To withdraw your generated Network Incentives as cryptocurrency, use the web management panel.

1. Navigate to <https://manage.unitynodes.io/>
2. Log in using your Web3 wallet or email address.
3. Click the "Withdraw Rewards" button to initiate your claim.

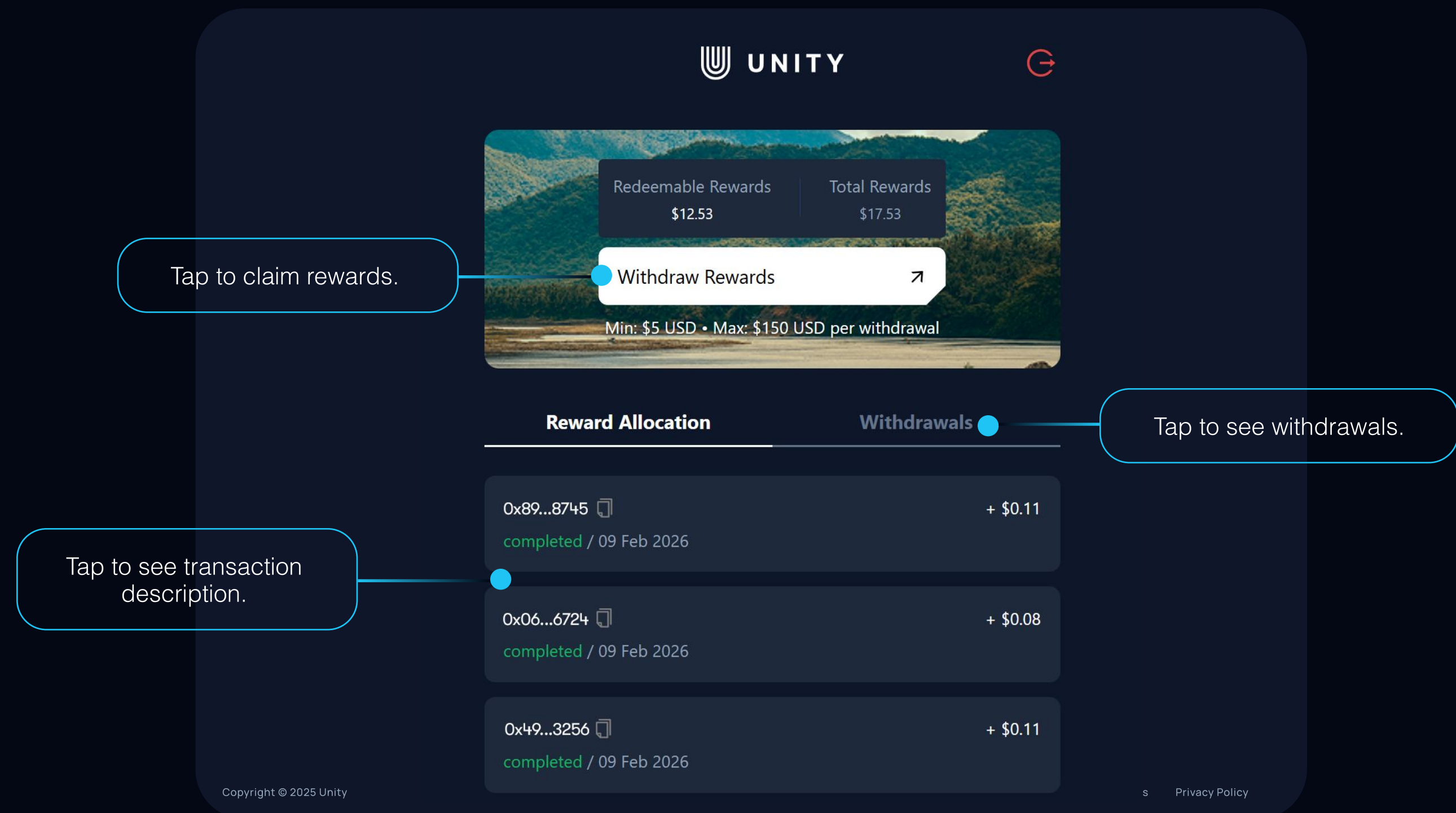
Notes:

- The minimum withdrawal amount is \$5.00 USD.
- 1 UP = \$1.00 USD.

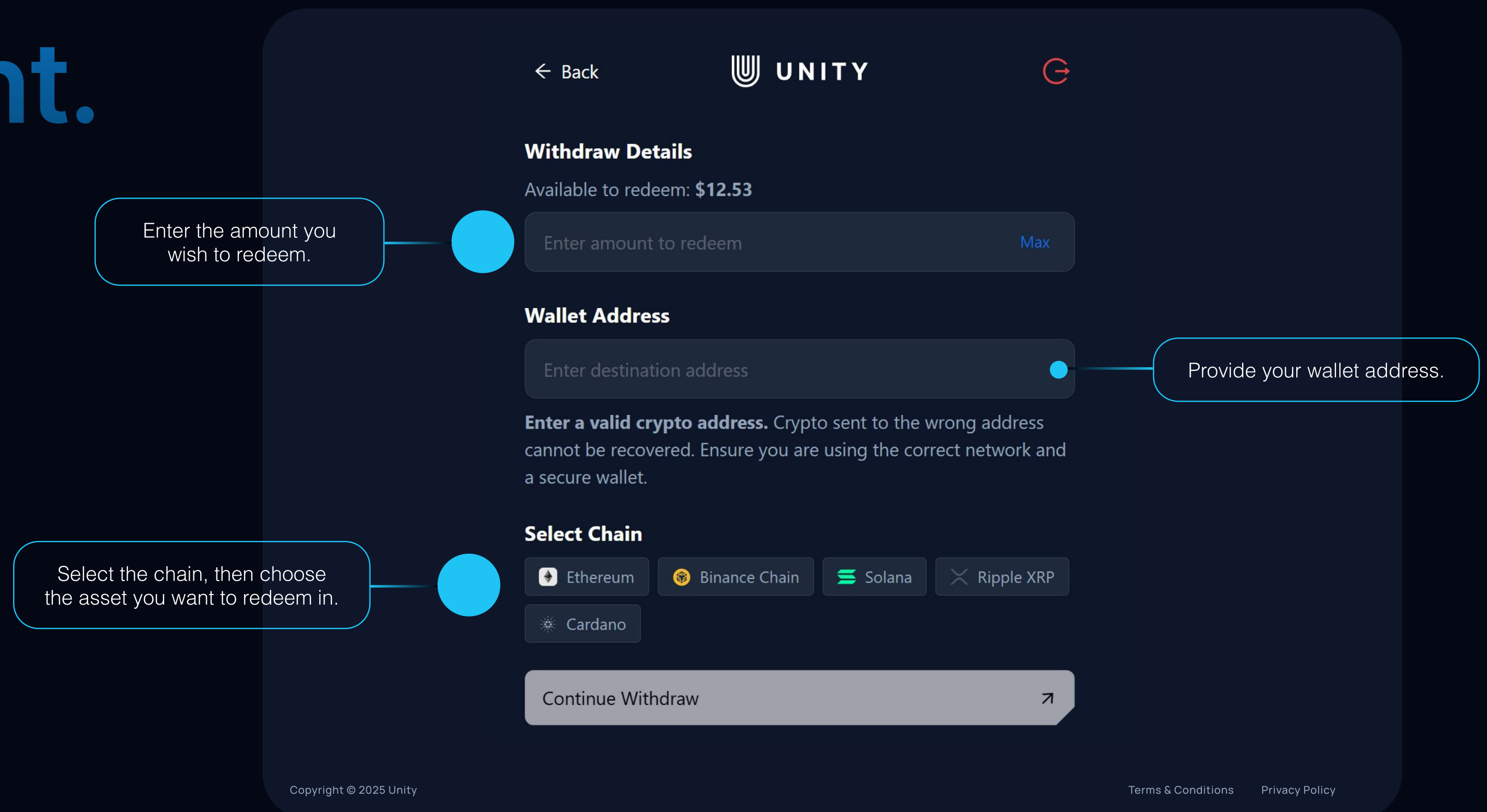


Withdrawal of Incentives cont.

4. Enter the amount you wish to redeem.
5. Provide your wallet address.
6. Select your preferred blockchain network.
7. Select the desired asset.
8. Review your details and click "Continue Withdraw" to proceed.

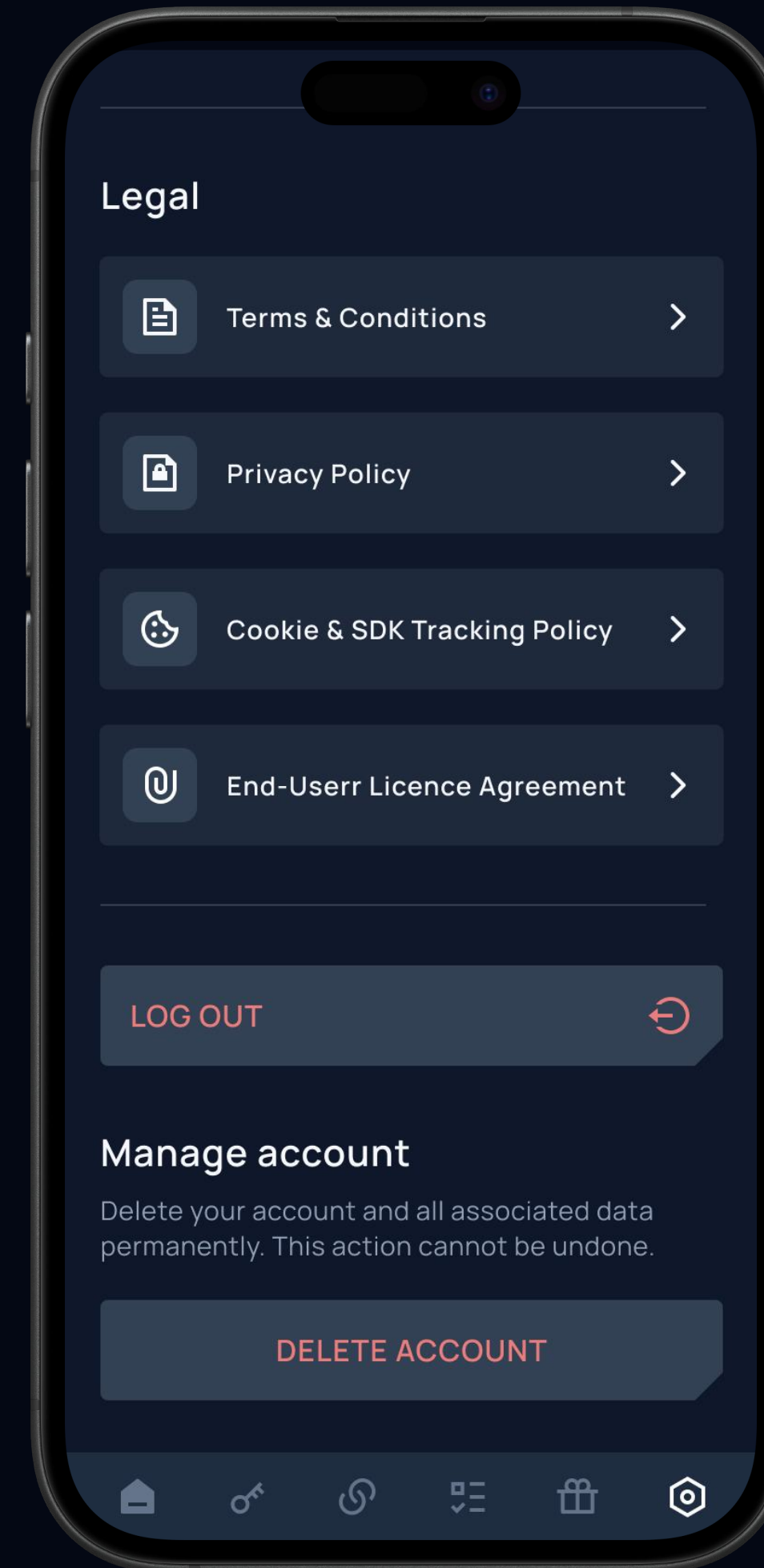
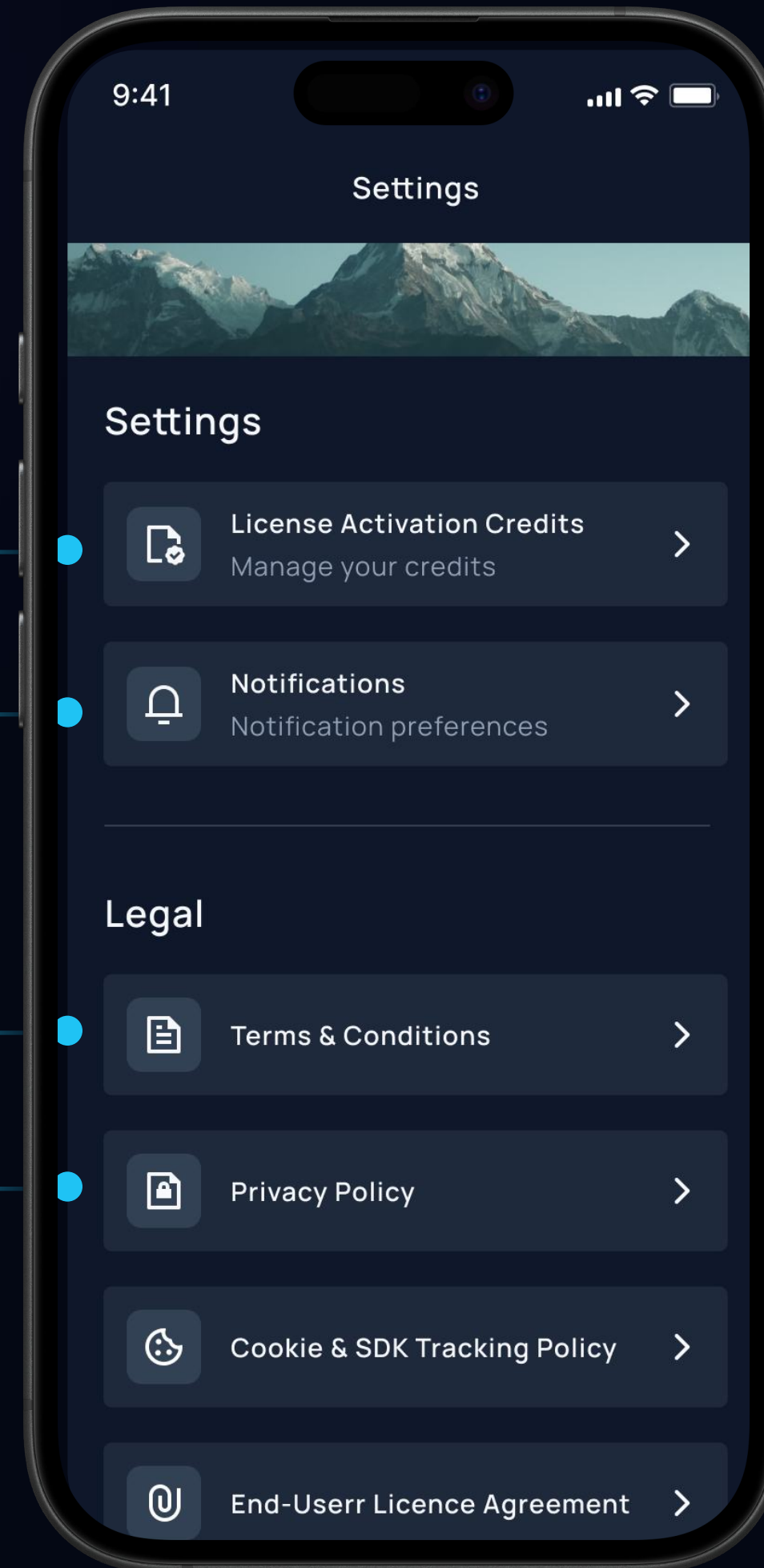
