MS Program in Disaster Risk Reduction and Resilience Regulations for the Establishment of Scholarships and Assistantships

- Article 1 The National Taiwan University (NTU or "the University") International College MS Program in Disaster Risk Reduction and Resilience ("the Program") formulates the Regulations for the Establishment of Scholarships and Assistantships ("the Regulations") in accordance with Article 6 of NTU International College MS Program in Disaster Risk Reduction and Resilience Program Committee Rules to establish a Scholarship Committee ("the Committee"). The Committee is responsible for handling matters related to scholarships and assistantships.
- Article 2 The Committee shall consist of 5 members, including 1 ex officio member and 4 elected members.
 - 1. Ex Officio Member: The Director of the Program shall serve ex officio as the convener of the Committee and preside as the chairperson over related meetings.
 - 2. Elected Members: Full-time or jointly-appointed faculty members for the academic year shall nominate and elect four representatives among themselves to serve as elected members of the Committee.
- Article 3 The term of service for elected members of the Committee shall be one academic year. These members may be reappointed subject to reelection.
- Article 4 The duties of the Committee include the following:
 - 1. To establish the regulations for all scholarships and assistantships offered by the Program
 - 2. To review scholarship and assistantship applications, assess candidates, and finalize the roster of recipients.
- Article 5 A Committee meeting shall only proceed with a quorum defined as more than half of the Committee members present. A resolution shall be considered adopted only with the approval of more than half of the Committee members in attendance.
- Article 6 Committee members shall recuse themselves from any meeting where matters pertaining to their own interests are being reviewed or discussed. Should a member not voluntarily recuse themselves, the chairperson of the Committee may request the member do so.

Members of the Committee who are recused as described in the preceding provision shall not be counted towards the quorum required for attendance and for voting.

- Article 7 Matters not addressed herein shall be handled in accordance with relevant University regulations.
- Article 8 The Regulations shall be passed by the Program Affairs Committee, the College Affairs Meeting, and the Administrative Meeting, then implemented on the date of promulgation.
