MS Program in Disaster Risk Reduction and Resilience Regulations for the Joint Appointment of Faculty Members

March 23, 2023 Passed by the 3rd Program Preparatory Committee Meeting

May 09, 2023 Passed by the 3rd College Affairs Meeting, Academic Year 2022-23

May 10, 2023 Promulgated all articles

- Article 1 The MS Program in Disaster Risk Reduction and Resilience ("the Program") of the International College, National Taiwan University (NTU or "the University") formulates the *Regulations for the Joint Appointment of Faculty Members* ("the Regulations") in order to expand its faculty, encourage collaboration in teaching, and establish the rights and obligations of the Program's jointly-appointed faculty members.
- Article 2 "Jointly-appointed faculty members" herein refers to all full-time faculty members and research fellows from NTU departments and units outside of the Program who have been jointly appointed by the Program in accordance with the *NTU Regulations Governing the Joint Appointment of Full-time Faculty Members and Research Fellows*.
- Article 3 The nomination of jointly-appointed faculty members shall be carried out by the Program Curriculum Committee with due consideration to the Program's curricular needs. The Program Curriculum Committee shall draft a list of prospective faculty members to be jointly appointed in accordance with the relevant procedures.
- Article 4 The rights and obligations of jointly-appointed faculty members are as follows:
1. Jointly-appointed faculty members may be nominated to serve on any committee established by the Program.
 2. Jointly-appointed faculty members shall be given priority in the use of the Program's teaching and research resources.
 3. Jointly-appointed faculty members may serve as academic advisors to graduate students of the Program.
 4. Jointly-appointed faculty members shall undertake teaching responsibilities within the Program during their tenure as joint faculty. In principle, jointly-appointed faculty members shall offer or co-instruct one course per academic year.
- Article 5 Matters not addressed herein shall be subject to other applicable regulations.
- Article 6 The Regulations shall be passed by the Program Affairs Committee and College Affairs Meeting of the International College, and then implemented on the date of promulgation.
