### MS Program in Disaster Risk Reduction and Resilience Regulations for the Establishment of the Student Admissions Committee

- Article 1 National Taiwan University ("NTU" or "the University") International College MS Program in Disaster Risk Reduction and Resilience ("the Program") formulates the *Regulations for the Establishment of the Student Admissions Committee* ("the Regulations") in accordance with Article 5 of the *NTU Directives for the Formation of the Student Admissions Committee* to establish its Student Admissions Committee ("the Committee") and handle matters related to student admission in the Program.
- Article 2 The Committee consists of 5 members, including one ex officio member and 4 elected committee members as follows:
1. The ex officio member: The director of the Program shall serve as convener and chair of the Committee's meetings.
  2. Elected committee members: Four committee members selected from and recommended by the Program's full-time faculty members or jointly appointed full-time faculty members of the current academic year.
- Article 3 Members of the Committee shall serve a one-year term and may serve consecutive terms if reappointed.
- Article 4 The responsibilities of the Committee shall be as follows:
1. Formulating regulations for student recruitment and determining admission quota, and submitting the matters to the Program Affairs Committee for resolution.
  2. Handling screening and test procedures for the student admission to the Program.
  3. Other matters related to the student admission of the Program.
- Article 5 The quorum for a Committee meeting shall be at least half the members of the Committee; a resolution may only be passed by more than half of the votes from the attending members.
- Article 6 The members of the Committee shall adhere to related recusal principles.
- Article 7 Matters not addressed herein shall be subject to the applicable regulations of the University.

Article 8 The Regulations shall be passed by the Program Affairs Committee and the College Affairs Meeting, submitted to the University Student Admissions Committee for reference, and then implemented on the date of promulgation.
