1 Concept of Liberty (Core Anchor)

Meaning of Liberty

- Liberty is the **opportunity to develop oneself fully** within the framework of law.
- It is **not absolute freedom** or absence of restraint.
- True liberty exists only when **individual freedom is harmonized with social good**.

2 Types of Liberty

A. Negative Liberty

- Freedom **from** interference
- Protection against **tyranny and arbitrary authority**

B. Positive Liberty

- Freedom **to** develop potential
 - Access to **opportunities, rights and enabling conditions**

3 Relationship Between Law and Liberty

Core Principle

- Law is the **guardian of liberty**, not its enemy.

Correct Relationship

- **If there are no laws, there is no liberty.**

Why?

- Law:
 - Prevents chaos
 - Protects rights
 - Regulates competing freedoms

4 Best Safeguard of Liberty in a Liberal Democracy

Key Factor

- **Separation of Powers**

Explanation

- Prevents concentration of authority
- Ensures checks and balances among:
 - Legislature
 - Executive

Main Features

- **Limitation of powers**
- **Equality before law**

Constitutional Basis

- Reflected in:
 - **Preamble** – Liberty of thought, expression, belief, faith, worship
 - **Fundamental Rights** – Articles 19–22

Judicial Protection

- Enforced through **Judicial Review**
