

Velostrata V4.2 Hotfix #135093085

Affected versions: Velostrata V4.2 builds prior to 25715

In version 4.2 builds prior to 25715, migration detach or prepare to detach tasks would hang until detach eventually failed. When this happened, the exporter component would be marked as impaired.

The issue has been fixed in build 25715, released on 6/13/2019. If you have a previous build of version 4.2, use the hotfix instructions below to fix the issue.

To apply the hotfix

1. Run the [Cancel Detach](#) operation on all VMs that are in the **Ready to Detach** state.
2. Using SSH, log in to the Velostrata Manager VM instance in your project.
 - a. See the following instructions for common ways to connect to your instance:

3. Run the following command line:

```
sudo sh -c "mv /opt/velostrata/deploy/exporter.tar.gz
/opt/velostrata/deploy/exporter.tar.gz.old && cd /opt/velostrata/deploy/ &&
wget
https://storage.googleapis.com/velostrata-release/V4.2.0/4.2%20Revision%20Hot%
20Fix%20135093085/exporter.tar.gz && chown tomcat8:tomcat8
/opt/velostrata/deploy/exporter.tar.gz /opt/velostrata/deploy/ && echo
Success"
```

Once completed, for VMs that are in the fully cached state, you can run the [Prepare to Detach and Detach](#) operations.
