



If you were a victim of any of the following crimes,

...you may be eligible to receive legal immigration status and protection from deportation if you are willing to assist law enforcement in detection, investigation or prosecution. The qualifying criminal activities are:

- rape*
 - torture*
 - trafficking*
 - incest*
 - domestic violence*
 - sexual assault*
 - abusive sexual contact*
 - prostitution*
 - sexual exploitation*
 - female genital mutilation*
 - being held hostage*
 - peonage*
 - involuntary servitude*
 - slave trade*
 - kidnapping*
 - abduction*
- unlawful criminal restraint*
 - false imprisonment*
 - blackmail*
 - extortion*
 - manslaughter*
 - murder*
 - felonious assault*
 - witness tampering*
 - obstruction of justice*
 - perjury*
- *solicitation to commit any of the above-mentioned crimes, or any similar activity in violation of federal, state, or local criminal law.*

Are you or a close family member a victim of one the above-listed qualifying criminal activities?

If you said YES, you and/or your family member may be eligible to apply for a U-Visa, a temporary visa that the United States Congress created to encourage victims of crime to come forward and report crimes without the fear of deportation. The U-Visa provides immigrant crime victims legal immigration status, work authorization and protection from deportation for 4 years if they are being, have been or are willing to be helpful to law enforcement in the detection, investigation, prosecution, conviction or sentencing related to criminal activity.
