VINSON HALL IS DEDICATED TO BE A LEADER IN CREATING AND DELIVERING INNOVATIVE SOLUTIONS SO INDIVIDUALS CAN LIVE LIFE "THEIR WAY". AS OF DECEMBER 31, 2019 VINSON HALL HAS 246 INDEPENDENT LIVING UNITS PROVIDING SERVICES TO INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE SERVED AS A UNIFORMED OFFICER OR CAREER GOVERNMENT OFFICER AND THEIR IMMEDIATE FAMILY.
