- Forward Veronica Latsko was named the United Soccer Coaches National Player of the Week on Tuesday
- She was also named the ACC Offensive Player of the Week by the league office for her efforts
- The senior tallied a hat trick and added two assists to lead UVA to a 7-0 win on the road at Pittsburgh
- Latsko's eight points matched the single-game point record for UVA, tying Makenzy Doniak for the mark

# **HOOS IN THE RPI**

- The latest edition of the RPI has been released by the NCAA with the Cavaliers coming in at No. 22 overall
- Virginia's schedule features six matches against teams in the top 15 of the RPI's and nine in the top 36
- Four of those are non-conference foes: West Virginia (5), UCLA (11), Penn State (12), Wisconsin (34)

# **HOOS SET SCORING STANDARD NATIONALLY SINCE 2011**

- Virginia has had a high-powered offense under head coach Steve Swanson, but especially since 2011
- Over the last seven seasons, the Cavaliers lead the nation with 444 goals, the only team over 400 goals
- Virginia led the nation in goals scored in 2014 with 88 goals on the way to an NCAA runner-up finish
- UVA also led the nation in goals scored with 78 goals scored throughout the 2013 campaign

# **KLÖCKNER STADIUM KIND TO CAVALIERS**

- Virginia has had success at Klöckner Stadium with a 251-50-22 record (.811) since it opened in 1992
- In ACC matches played at Klöckner Stadium, UVA holds an 81-25-12 record (.737) through 25 years
- UVA won 38 straight home matches (2013-2015), the sixth-longest home win streak in NCAA history

# **CAVALIERS CONTINUE TREND OF CHALLENGING SCHEDULE**

- Virginia continues its trend of challenging schedules with the slate for the 2017 season
- The Cavaliers face seven teams that finished the 2016 season ranked among the top 25 nationally
- UVA also faces 10 teams from the 2016 NCAA Tournament six who went to the Sweet 16
- In addition to the rugged ACC schedule, UVA traveled to face 2016 NCAA runner-up West Virginia and hosted 2015 NCAA Champion Penn State and 2013 NCAA Champion UCLA

# HOOS GRAB ACC WEEKLY HONORS IN SECOND WEEK OF PLAY

- A pair of UVA players garnered weekly honors from the ACC after the wins over W. Virginia and Liberty
- Laurel Ivory was named ACC Defensive Player of the Week, sophomore Taylor Ziemer was co-Offensive
- Ivory posted three saves vs. WVU and a clean sheet against Liberty as the Cavaliers went 2-0 on the week
- Ziemer delivered one of the two goals at WVU and added an assist on the game winner vs. Liberty

# **HAZELRIGG GETS FIRST GOAL SINCE 2014 SEASON**

- Senior Olivia Hazelrigg scored her first goal since 2014 on Sunday when she hit a PK Sunday at Pittsburgh
- The midfielder has battled injury throughout her career, missing all of 2015 and part of the 2016 season
- Hazelrigg scored her first goal in 2014 as a freshman, hitting the game-winner against Miami
- Last season, Hazelrigg added an assist in a 3-0 win over Michigan State last season in her return to action

# VIRGINIA BREAKS 50 WINS VS. TOP 10 TEAMS ALL-TIME

- UVA's win at No. 2 West Virginia in week two was the 51st win over a top 10 team in program history
- The program's first win came at No. 6 UMass on Sept. 9, 1989 a 2-0 victory for the Cavaliers
- Virginia's first home win over a top 10 team was vs. No. 10 UMass on Sept. 29, 1990 another 2-0 win
- With a 3-2 win over No. 5 Penn State on Sunday (9/10) the Cavaliers have 52 wins over top-10 programs
- Head coach Steve Swanson has led the Cavaliers to 36 of those 52 wins over top-10 programs

# **CAVALIERS VS. THE NATION'S NO. 1 TEAM**

- The Cavaliers have picked up four wins over teams ranked at the top of the national polls all-time
- The first win for UVA over a No. 1 team was vs. Boston College in 2010, a 3-2 overtime win at home
- The Cavaliers then went on the road and defeated No. 1 UCLA in the 2014 NCAA Elite Eight
- The win over the Bruins in 2014 propelled UVA into the Final Four on the way to an NCAA runner-up finish
- UVA's third win over a top-ranked team came with a 1-0 win over FSU in the 2015 season at home
- This season UVA went on the road and beat West Virginia, who was ranked No. 1 in the coaches poll

# **HOOS IN OVERTIME**

- Virginia has gone into overtime in five matches already this season, going 2-0-4 in those matches
- The first overtime match this season was a 2-1 win at West Virginia in the second week of play
- UVA posted a pair draws with NC State, East Carolina, Notre Dame and Clemson
- The Hoos' second OT win was a 1-0 victory over Louisville on a goal in the 99th minute from Latsko
- Virginia is 19-11-44 in overtime games under head coach Steve Swanson
- The Cavaliers played a school-record 10 overtime games in the 2007 season, going 2-2-6 that season


