- It is the annual Play4Kay "pink" game
- Virginia has lost three of its last four games, but all three losses have come against top-15 teams: No. 4 Louisville, No. 12 Florida State and No. 5 Notre Dame. The Cavaliers play at No. 4 Louisville next Thursday, giving them four games against ranked teams in a stretch of six contests
- Redshirt senior guard J'Kyra Brown scored 17 points against Notre Dame. Brown made just one three-pointer, extending her streak of games in which she has hit at least one trey to 20, but went 5-of-8 from inside the arc and was 4-of-5 from the free throw line
- Brown ranks 11th in the ACC in three-point efficiency, making 38.7 percent of her attempts
- Felicia Aiyeotan scored a season-high 17 points with 11 rebounds against Notre Dame, picking up her seventh double-double of the season. It was her second double-double in the last three games after scoring a then-season-high 15 points with 13 rebounds at Florida State
- Aiyeotan leads the ACC in blocked shots and already ranks fifth in program history with 114 in her career
- Aiyeotan is ninth in the ACC in rebounding, averaging 7.5 per game. Last season, Aiyeotan averaged 4.6 points and 3.7 rebounds per game
- Aiyeotan is shooting 53.2 percent in ACC games this season. Against conference opponents, she is averaging 8.3 points and 7.5 rebounds. Last season in ACC games, Aiyeotan averaged 3.1 points and 3.6 rebounds per game
- Lauren Moses became the 34th player in UVA program history to reach 1,000 career points, reaching the milestone in the fourth quarter against Notre Dame. Aliyah Huland El hit the same benchmark in the Cavaliers' previous home game, the loss to Louisville
- Huland El needs three points to pass Chelsea Shine and move up to 31st on the career scoring list
- Moses is currently tied with Jenny Boucek at No. 33 on the career scoring list. Boucek, a former WNBA head coach - most recently with the Seattle Storm - is a current assistant coach with the Sacramento Kings, one of two active female full-time assistant coaches in the NBA

**TEAM NOTES**

- Virginia is receiving votes in the *USA Today* Coaches' polls this week. This is the seventh-straight week receiving votes in the *USA Today* poll
- The Cavaliers are No. 30 in the RPI rankings (as of 2/16/18) and ranks seventh in strength of schedule. Only Notre Dame (at No. 1) has a higher strength of schedule in the conference. The ACC ranks No. 1 in both conference RPI and conference strength of schedule
- The Cavaliers are tied for fourth place in the ACC with NC State (9-4). Duke is a half-game back at 9-5. Miami is in sixth at 8-5
- Virginia's nine ACC wins are the most since the team went 9-7 in conference play in 2011-12 (Joanne Boyle's first season). The last time the Cavaliers tallied 10 conference wins was the 2007-08 season when they went 10-4 and finished in a tie for third place
- Virginia's 8-1 start to conference play was its best since starting the 1999-00 season at 9-1 in ACC games
- Virginia is third in the ACC in three-point shooting percentage, making 36.6 percent of their attempts
- Notre Dame Quick Recap: The Irish opened the game on a 20-2 run, including scoring the first nine points of the contest and led 27-11 after the first quarter. Virginia outscored the Irish 58-56 in the final three quarters and held a 38-32 edge in rebounding
- Notre Dame shot 55.0 percent (33-of-60) in the game, UVA's only opponent this season to shoot better than 50 percent in a game. The Irish also had the top three-point efficiency of the season, going 45.5 percent from long range (5-of-11)
- Against Virginia Tech, the Cavaliers shot 46.0 percent (23-of-50) in the first three quarters, but went 2-of-10 in the fourth quarter. Against Notre Dame, Virginia shot 27.8 percent in the first quarter (5-of-18) but went 20-of-46 (43.4 percent) the rest of the game, including shooting 50.0 percent in the fourth quarter

**MIAMI HURRICANES**

- Miami has won seven of its last nine games, including an 82-58 win over Pittsburgh on Thursday night. Erykah Davenport scored 20 points on 10-of-12 shooting, her seventh 20-point game of the season
- Davenport leads the team in scoring and rebounding, averaging 12.3 points per game and 8.7 rebounds. Freshman Mykea Gray is second on the team in scoring, averaging 11.8 points per game
- Virginia leads the all-time series 9-8 and is 7-7 in ACC games
- Miami has won seven of the last 10 meetings including a 63-52 game last year in Coral Gables
- Last year, No. 16 Miami opened the game on a 12-2 run, including scoring the first eight points of the game, and led 26-18 at the half. The Cavaliers scored eight-straight points in the third quarter to pull within five, 35-30, but Miami finished the period on a 6-1 run and built up a 54-39 advantage with two minutes remaining. A pair of three-pointers from J'Kyra Brown helped cut the deficit to single-digits, 57-49, with 56 seconds remaining, but Miami converted four free throws in the final 13 seconds to close out the game
- The last time the two teams met in JPJ, Virginia cruised to a 76-56 victory (1/3/16)
- Both Miami head coach Katie Meier and Virginia head coach Joanne Boyle are Duke grads, though they were not teammates. Boyle graduated from Duke in 1985 and Meier received her undergraduate degree in 1989 and her masters as a redshirt senior in 1990. Both Boyle and Meier played in Europe at the same time in the early 1990's with Boyle playing in Luxembourg and Germany and Meier in Belgium.

**QUICK HITTERS AND FUN FACTS ABOUT THE HOOS**

- Members of the team were included in a Good Morning America feature on AD Carla Williams that ran on February 14. Jocelyn Willoughby and Lauren Moses were both featured in the Robin Roberts Black History Month piece on Williams appointment as the first African-American athletics director of a Power-5 conference school
- Sophomore forward/guard Jocelyn Willoughby was appointed as the non-voting, student-athlete member of the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Oversight Committee. Willoughby is the lone student-athlete on the 15-member committee with her tenure running through June 2020. The goals of the committee are to advance the game and perception of women's basketball, improve the student-athlete experience and put an emphasis on the personal growth of student athletes. Along with the goals, it will also work to supervise qualifications and/or selection procedures for the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship and provide direction to the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Rules Committee regarding playing rules
- Willoughby was recently selected to be one of 25 fellows at the University of Virginia's Meriwether Lewis Institute for Citizen Leadership. This is a very prestigious 2.5-year immersive leadership program that brings together a diverse group of UVA students that enroll in a Foundations in Design Thinking class their sophomore year before undertaking a six-week program in the summer before their junior year. As third and fourth year students, the Fellows apply what they've learned to key University issues, participating in independent and small group projects aimed at improving the University
- Aliyah Huland El is majoring in kinesiology and wants to be a pediatrician
- J'Kyra Brown is an accomplished bowler. She took up bowling at four years old and holds several lane records back home at the Rocky Mount Bowling Center. Her all-time best is a 275 and she also has a 248 game. She owns five different bowling balls. The Black Widow is her baby, but she also has a SpongeBob ball that she got when she was 10 that she uses for spares, for straight balls or corner shots
- Dominique Toussaint's dream one-on-one match-up is to go up against Sue Bird. Her favorite sports team is the New York Liberty
- Lauren Moses' brother, Dezman, played for the Green Bay Packers (2012) and the Kansas City Chiefs (2013-15), including seeing action in the 2015 Divisional Playoff against the Patriots
- Felicia Aiyetan did not start playing basketball until she was 15 as "Most schools just have soccer fields. There weren't basketball courts or gyms at my school because it was a public school. They don't have a lot of resources for that. Where I lived, though, there was an outdoor basketball court. I would go there on the weekends because during the week, I had to go to tutoring. At that time I wasn't fully into basketball. Since it was outdoors, the weather would sometimes mess your schedule up because it would rain." She came to the United States before her freshman year in high school. She spent three years at Neumann Goretti High in Philadelphia (where they were the No. 1 team in the nation her junior year before transferring to Blair Academy in New Jersey for her senior year. Pounded Yam Egusi Soup is her favorite dish from home that her mom makes. "Pounded yam looks like dough, like mashed potatoes and then Egusi soup is made out of melon and vegetables. You can add whatever you want, if you want beef or fish, but it is spicy." She really misses the spice of Nigerian food.
- Aiyetan is the tallest active player in NCAA women's basketball right now. The next tallest is Sara Hamson of BYU at 6-7. Nancy Mulkey of Rice is also 6-9, but she is a sophomore transfer from Oklahoma and is sitting out the season
- The Cavaliers took a foreign tour this summer, spending seven days in Costa Rica in August, taking on a Canadian team as well as the Costa Rican National Team. It allowed the squad time to practice as well as the experience of getting three exhibition games under their belt. While in Costa Rica, the team went zip lining through a jungle while others went on an ATV tour. Some of them took surfing lessons as well as seeing wildlife that included a river filled with crocodiles. Their favorite part of the trip, however, was a trip to an orphanage, an activity they enjoyed so much, the itinerary of the trip was altered to allow a return visit to see the kids

Jae'Lisa Allen has been a strong contributor for the team on the practice court and in the locker room for the Cavaliers. Jae has had several memorable performances, including scoring five points with three rebounds against Coppin State this season and scoring the bucket that put the Hoos over the century mark against Delaware State her freshman year. The African-American Studies and African Studies major was averaging a career high in minutes this season before being sidelined by an injury.

J'Kyra Brown is the spark off the bench for the Cavaliers. J'Kyra transferred to UVA from East Carolina after her freshman season and then joined the team on the floor in 2014 after sitting out a year and has been a crucial part of the offense ever since. The sharp-shooting guard has hit at least one three pointer in each of the last 18 games and has ranked in the top-10 in the ACC in three-point shooting percentage this season. Her top performance came in the overtime win this year against Indiana when she scored a career-high 24 points.

Aliyah Huland El became the 33rd member of the Virginia 1,000 point club two weeks ago against Louisville. She is also shooting her way up the program's career list for made three-pointers. The kinesiology major is leading the team in scoring this season while putting up career-best numbers. She has had many memorable games in her career including scoring 23 points in last season against Louisville and her double-double last year against Coppin State when she dished out 10 assists to go with 12 points.

Lauren Moses is just the eighth player in Virginia program history to record 100 or more blocked shots in her career. Lauren made an immediate impact on the program, jumping right into the starting lineup in her very first collegiate game. Since then, Moses has become the 34th member of the Virginia 1,000 point club. She also earned a spot on last year's All-ACC Academic Team and has been named to four different All-Tournament teams, including the MVP of the 2015 Cavalier Classic.


