- The Cavaliers have won three-straight games, including a 60-51 upset over No. 4 Florida State on Thursday and a 63-55 victory at Virginia Tech on Sunday
- Senior Breyana Mason led the team in scoring with 13 points. It was her first time pacing UVA in a game since putting up 19 points against BC on Jan. 15
- Mason scored her 1,000th career point on a jumper right before half-time at Virginia Tech, becoming the 32nd player in program history to reach that milestone
- Junior guard J'Kyra Brown scored 11 points, her fourth-consecutive double-digit scoring effort and the sixth time in the last seven games she has finished the game in double figures. Brown has only started two games this season, but is averaging 8.5 points in 24.4 minutes per game
- Lauren Moses did not have a rebound in the win over Florida State. It was only the third time in her career that she had zero rebounds in a contest and snapped a streak of 30-consecutive games with a rebound. Moses, who had eight rebounds in Sunday's game at Virginia Tech, has led the team in rebounding in four of the last five games, the except of course being the Florida State game
- Dominique Toussaint scored 11 points at Virginia Tech, going 3-of-5 from the field and 5-of-5 from the line
- Toussaint has scored in double figures in five of the last six games
- Jocelyn Willoughby scored 10 points at Virginia Tech, her first double-digit scoring effort since putting up 16 at Notre Dame on Jan. 29th
- Willoughby is 8-of-8 from the free throw line in the last two games
- Toussaint ranks second among the ACC freshmen in scoring at 10.0 points per game. Jocelyn Willoughby is third at 9.4 per game. GT's Francesca Pan leads the rookies at 10.6 ppg. In conference contests, however, Toussaint leads the rookies at 10.8 points per game
- Willoughby is second among the ACC freshmen in rebounding at 6.2 per game. Wake's Alex Sharp paces the freshman class at 7.4 per game. Willoughby leads ACC freshmen with 46 steals

**INTERVIEW POLICY**

All interview requests for Virginia women's basketball must be made through Melissa Dudek in the Virginia Athletics Media Relations Office. Players' individual phone numbers will not be given to the media at any time. Game day interviews will not be granted until the postgame press conference opportunity. Please give a minimum of 24 hours notice for all interview requests.

**TEAM NOTES**

- Virginia leads the ACC and is second in the country in three-point shooting defense with opponents making just 25.0 percent of their attempts from long range. St. John's leads the nation by limiting opponents to 24.2 percent three-point shooting
- Virginia is second in the ACC and 15th in the nation in scoring defense, limiting opponents to 54.9 points per game
- UVA is second in the ACC and 22nd in the nation in field goal shooting defense with opponents making 35.6 percent of their attempts
- The Cavaliers are receiving votes in this week's USA Today Coaches poll and have moved up to No. 45 in the RPI. After the loss to Louisville on Jan. 5, Virginia was No. 91 in the RPI
- Virginia is alone in eighth place in the ACC standings heading into the last week of the regular season. Louisville is ranked 14th in both polls and is tied with NC State in fourth place in the ACC
- The Cavaliers are guaranteed to finish no lower than ninth in the conference, guaranteeing that they will have a first-round bye in next week's ACC Tournament. The bracket for the ACC Tournament, which runs from March 1-5 at the HTC Center in Conway, S.C., will be released on Sunday evening (Feb. 26)
- Both Louisville and Virginia bring three-game win streaks into the game, the third-longest current win streaks among ACC teams
- The Cavaliers have the third-highest three-point shooting percentage in ACC games at 35.9 percent. Louisville has the top efficiency at 37.0 percent
- Virginia ranks eighth in rebounding in the ACC at 39.0 rebounds per game. The Cavaliers average that exact same number of rebounds in conference games this season, but that ranks fourth among the ACC teams in rebounding in conference contests
- The Cavaliers have a balanced scoring attack with four players averaging 9.4 points per game or higher. UVA is also the only team to not have an individual ranked in the top-30 in scoring in the conference
- The Cavaliers have two players ranked in the ACC top-20 in rebounding with Jocelyn Willoughby at No. 15 (6.2 per game) and Lauren Moses at No. 18 (5.9)

**LOUISVILLE CARDINALS**

- The Cardinals lead the all-time series, 4-2 and are 4-1 in ACC games
- Virginia fell 86-81 in overtime against Louisville in the first meeting of the season (Jan. 5).
  - The Cavaliers led by 15 points with 3:51 remaining in the third quarter, but needed a buzzer-beating three from freshman guard Dominique Toussaint to force OT against the Cardinals
  - Virginia went 9-of-18 (50.0 percent) from three-point range against Louisville
- The Cavaliers scored 81 points against Louisville, only the third time since the start of the 2014-15 season that a Cardinals' opponent has scored more than 80 points in a game against Louisville
- Junior guard Aliyah Huland El scored a career-high 23 points while grabbing a season-high eight rebounds against Louisville.
- The Cavaliers upset the then-No. 8 Cardinals, 75-59, at JPJ in the final game of the 2014-15 season behind 23 points from Faith Randolph and 22 points and 17 rebounds from Sarah Imovbioh. The Cavaliers outscored the Cardinals 28-10 over the final 8 minutes
- Louisville leads the ACC in rebounding, averaging 42.6 per game and is third with a +7.8 rebounding margin
- The Cardinals are second in the ACC with a 1.2 assist-to-turnover ratio
- Asia Durr ranks third in the ACC in scoring, averaging 18.3 points per game
- Myisha Hines-Allen is third in the ACC in rebounding, averaging 9.0 per game

- Ranks third in the ACC in blocked shots
- Her 46 blocked shots this season is tied for eighth place in the Virginia record book for blocked shots in a single season with Schuye LaRue who had 46 in the 2000 season. The Virginia freshman record is held by DeMya Walker who blocked 68 in her rookie campaign in 1996. Aiyeotan already has more blocked shots this season than the entire team did in 2013-14
- Made her collegiate debut in season-opener against Middle Tennessee, scoring four points with four blocks in four minutes (11/11)
- Came off the bench to log a double-double with 23 points and 12 rebounds in 22 minutes against Coppin State (11/13)
- Made her first seven field goal attempts against UIC, going 8-of-9 overall for 16 points in 16 minutes (12/16)
- Scored 10 points in 11 minutes at Syracuse (1/2)

- Played her senior season at Blair Academy (N.J.), averaging 14.0 points per game


