FOR OPENERS

- No. 12 Virginia returns home for a non-conference game against Lehigh (0-4) of the Patriot League.
- Virginia has scored 80 or more points in three consecutive games for the first time under Tony Bennett and for the first time since totaling 80 or more in the first four games of the 2006-07 season.
- UVA is 72-24 (.750) in non-conference action under Tony Bennett.
- UVA has captured non-conference, regular-season tournament titles in each of the last three seasons (2015 Charleston Classic, 2014 Barclays Center Classic and 2013 Corpus Christi Challenge).

VIRGINIA'S RANKED NO. 12 IN LATEST POLLS

- UVA is ranked No. 12 in the latest Associated Press and USA Today Coaches' polls, marking the first poll UVA has been ranked out of the top 10 since March 3, 2014.
- UVA had been ranked in the top 10 in 25 consecutive AP polls since March 3, 2014, its longest span since 49 consecutive polls from 1980-83.
- The Cavaliers' No. 6 preseason ranking was UVA's best since a No. 1 ranking to start the 1982-83 season.
- Virginia has been ranked in the preseason top-10 in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 1981-82 and 1982-83.
- UVA has finished in the top 10 (No. 3 in 2014 & No. 6 in 2015) in the final AP rankings in back-to-back seasons for the first time since three straight seasons from 1981-83.

ALL-TIME VS. LEHIGH

- Virginia meets Lehigh for the second time in the series that dates back to 1973-74.
- The Cavaliers defeated Lehigh 87-60 on Dec. 11, 1973.
- Gus Gerard had 22 points and nine rebounds to lead UVA, which out-rebounded Lehigh 48-30 in the contest.

ABOUT THE 'HOOS

- UVA is averaging 81.2 points per game and yielding 59.2 ppg (most since 62.4 ppg in 2010-11).
- Senior All-America candidate Malcolm Brogdon leads UVA in scoring for the third consecutive season at a career-best 15.3 points per game, while All-ACC performer Anthony Gill is averaging 13.0 points and a team-high 5.8 rebounds.
- Brogdon has tallied a pair of 20-point efforts (career-high 28 vs. GW and 21 vs. George Mason) and Gill has reached double figures in scoring in all four games.
- Charleston Classic MVP London Perrantes is averaging a career-best 10.8 points and has a 3.43 assist-to-turnover ratio.
- Mike Tobey, who was replaced in the starting lineup by Jack Salt vs. George Mason, had 14 points against the Patriots and has scored in double figures in three games.
- Marial Shayok replaced Darius Thompson in the starting lineup at the Charleston Classic and had a career-high 17 points vs. Long Beach State.
- UVA has out-rebounded its opponents in its four wins and has a +10.6 rebounding margin overall.
- Nine players are averaging 10 or more minutes per game.
- The Cavaliers have shot 50 percent or better in each of their last three games for the first time since a four-game stretch last season (Dec. 3-21, 2014).
- UVA is shooting 51.5 percent from the field, 40.2 percent from 3-point range and 77.4 percent from the free throw line.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett sports a 140-65 mark in seven seasons at Virginia and 209-98 career mark in 10 seasons.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett was also named ACC Coach of the Year, NABC District 2 Coach of the Year and USBWA District 3 Coach of the Year for the second consecutive year.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season for the first time in school history.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to four consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014 and 2015, and NIT in 2013).
- Bennett-coached teams are 76-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 10-year coaching career.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense three times (2008-09, 2013-14 & 2014-15), and finished in the top five nationally in six of nine seasons.
- Bennett is one of 26 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.

ALL-AMERICAN BROGDON LEADS CAVALIERS INTO ACTION

- Preseason co-ACC Player of the Year Malcolm Brogdon leads UVA into action this season.
- Brogdon is averaging a team-leading 15.4 points and 4.6 rebounds per game in 2015-16.
- Brogdon was named a preseason All-American by The Sporting News (1st team), Blue Ribbon Yearbook (1st team), CBSSports.com (2nd team), NBCSports.com (2nd team), Bleacher Report (2nd team), USA Today (3rd team) and CollegeInsider.com.
- In 2014-15, Brogdon averaged 14.0 points and 3.9 rebounds en route to All-America second-team and All-ACC first-team accolades.
- The two-time All-ACC performer, who was a John Wooden Award finalist last season, ranks 34th on UVA's all-time scoring list with 1,211 points in 104 career games (11.6 career ppg).
- Brogdon ranks second on UVA's career free-throw percentage list at 86.0% (296-for-344).
- Brogdon, who is a candidate for the 2016 Senior CLASS Award and

- Brogdon helped Team USA to a bronze medal at the 2015 Pan American Games in Toronto.
- The redshirt senior earned a degree in history and is pursuing a master's degree in public policy from the Frank Batten School of Leadership and Public Policy.

HIGH POINT MAN TO THE GILLS

- Preseason All-ACC second-team selection Anthony Gill, who is averaging 13.0 points and 5.8 rebounds, is Virginia's top frontcourt offensive player.
- Gill, a High Point, N.C., native, averaged 11.6 points and 6.5 rebounds en route to All-ACC third-team (media) honors in 2014-15.
- Gill's team-leading 29 steals helped earn him a spot on the coaches' All-ACC Defensive Team in 2014-15.
- Gill, who has led UVA in field goal percentage in each of the past two seasons, is shooting 58.4 percent during his UVA career.
- Gill earned MVP honors at the 2014 Barclays Center Classic and ranked 13th in the ACC in rebounding.
- Gill has amassed 1,014 career points in three seasons at UVA and one at South Carolina.

LONDON CALLING THE SHOTS

- Junior point guard London Perrantes is enjoying a breakout season in 2015-16.
- Perrantes has hit double figures in scoring in three straight games, including a season-high 16 points vs. George Mason.
- He tallied his second career double-double with 16 points and career-high 11 assists against George Mason en route to MVP honors at the Charleston Classic.
- Perrantes is shooting a career-best 55 percent (11-20) from 3-point range.
- Perrantes has a career 3.25 assist-to-turnover ratio (312 assists, 96 turnovers) in 74 career games.
- Perrantes averaged 6.4 points and 4.6 assists en route to honorable mention All-ACC honors last season.
- He set career highs in points (26) and 3-pointers (5) at Miami (1/3/15).
- Perrantes earned All-ACC Freshman Team honors in 2013-14.

VIRGINIA PICKED 2ND IN THE ACC

- Virginia was picked to finish second in the ACC preseason poll.
- The second-place preseason selection is UVA's highest since being selected first in 1982-83.
- The Cavaliers, who were picked fourth and finished first in each of the last two seasons, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in each of the last six seasons.
- North Carolina is the preseason favorite, followed by Virginia, Duke, Notre Dame, Miami, Florida State, Louisville, NC State, Syracuse, Pitt, Wake Forest, Clemson, Georgia Tech, Virginia Tech and Boston College.

GETTING SALTY

- Redshirt freshman center Jack Salt earned a starting role vs. George Mason because of his defensive presence.
- Salt has averaged 4.2 points and 2.0 rebounds in 10.8 minutes per game.
- Salt has converted 66.7 percent from the field, has three blocked three shots and one steal.
- Salt played at the same high school as former All-Big 10 player and current New Zealand pro basketball player Kirk Penney, whom Tony Bennett coached while an assistant at Wisconsin.

HALL OF A SPARK OFF THE BENCH

- Redshirt sophomore Devon Hall has earned increased playing time this season for UVA.
- Hall has played in all five games this season and is averaging 18.2 minutes after averaging 10.6 minutes in 23 contests last season.
- Hall netted a career-high 13 points vs. Morgan State and drained a career-best four 3-pointers for 12 points vs. Long Beach State.

DT AND REUTER ALSO CONTRIBUTING

- Darius Thompson and Jarred Reuter are making strong contributions for UVA this season.
- Thompson had 12 points, six rebounds, four assists and three steals in his UVA debut vs. Morgan State, while Reuter posted eight points and six rebounds in his debut the same night.
- Thompson sat out as a transfer last season after averaging 2.6 points and 2.4 assists in 37 games at Tennessee in 2013-14.
- Reuter helped Brewster Academy to back-to-back national prep titles.

BROGDON AND GILL ON WOODEN AWARD WATCH LIST

- Malcolm Brogdon and Anthony Gill are among 50 players on the preseason 2016 John R. Wooden Award Watch List, honoring the nation's top player.
- Gill earns his first preseason Wooden Award Watch List honor, while Brogdon was a Wooden Award All-American and finalist last season.

BROGDON ON EARLY SEASON WEST WATCH LIST

- Malcolm Brogdon is one of 20 players on the preseason Jerry West Award Watch List, honoring the nation's top shooting guard.
- Brogdon was a candidate for the 2015 Jerry West Award after leading UVA in scoring at 14 points per game.

ABOUT THE 2015-16 SCHEDULE

- Six of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the top 17 of the latest AP preseason poll (Duke, Villanova, North Carolina, California, Miami and Notre Dame), while four (George Washington, West Virginia and Louisville) received votes.
- The Cavaliers will play nine games against 2015 NCAA Tournament teams: home games against North Carolina, Louisville, Villanova, Notre Dame and NC State, road contests at Duke, Louisville and Ohio State, and a neutral-site tilt against West Virginia in the Jimmy V Men's Basketball Classic at Madison Square Garden.
- Four opponents (George Washington, Miami, Pitt, William & Mary) participated in the National Invitation Tournament.

HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

- Virginia is 51-2 when holding opponents under 50 points in the Tony Bennett era.
- UVa is 35-1 over the past four seasons when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points.
