### FOR OPENERS

- Virginia meets West Virginia for the first time in 31 seasons.
- UVA returns to Madison Square Garden for the first time since suffering a 61-59 loss to Michigan State in the 2014 NCAA East Regional semifinals.
- All-American Malcolm Brogdon has four 20-point games and leads UVA in scoring for the third straight season at a career-best 17.3 points per game.
- Junior point guard London Perrantes missed the Ohio State and William & Mary games (appendectomy) and his status for the West Virginia game is to be determined.
- UVA ranks sixth nationally in scoring defense at 57.5 points per game.
- UVA is shooting 50 percent from the field (best since 52.3% in 1982-83), 38.3 percent from 3-point range (best since 38.8% in 2010-11) and 75.8 percent from the free throw line (best since 76.2% in 1978-79).

### ALL-TIME VS. WEST VIRGINIA

- Virginia is 8-8 all-time vs. West Virginia in the series that dates back to the 1915-16 season.
- The Cavaliers and Mountaineers are meeting for the first time since Jan. 15, 1985, when UVA topped West Virginia 56-55 in the first round of the NIT in Morgantown.
- UVA is 3-2 in its last five games vs. West Virginia.

### LAST TIME VS. WEST VIRGINIA

- Jim Miller tallied 16 points and nine rebounds to lead Virginia to a 56-55 win at West Virginia in the first round of the National Invitation Tournament.
- Olden Polynice added eight points and 10 rebounds for Virginia, which shot 18-22 from the free throw line in the win.
- Lester Rowe led West Virginia with 13 points and Dale Blaney added 10.

### AGAINST THE BIG 12 CONFERENCE

- West Virginia is the lone Big 12 Conference opponent on Virginia's 2015-16 schedule.
- UVA meets a Big 12 Conference foe for the first time since dropping a 60-47 decision to Iowa State on Dec. 30, 2010.
- UVA is 12-16 all-time against current Big 12 Conference members (0-1 vs. Baylor, 1-2 vs. Iowa State, 1-2 vs. Kansas, 2-1 vs. Oklahoma, 0-1 vs. Oklahoma State, 0-1 vs. TCU and 8-8 vs. West Virginia).

### VIRGINIA ALL-TIME AT MADISON SQUARE GARDEN

- Virginia has a 5-7 all-time record at Madison Square Garden.
- The Cavaliers return to the Garden for the first time since dropping an NCAA regional semifinal game to Michigan State (61-59) on March 28, 2014.
- UVA won the 1980 and 1992 NIT titles at MSG.
- Tony Bennett had his NBA Playoff career high at MSG, scoring nine points (4-4 FG, 1-1 3FG) vs. the Knicks on May 9, 1993.

### VIRGINIA'S RANKED NO. 10 IN LATEST POLLS

- UVA is ranked No. 10 in the latest Associated Press and USA Today Coaches' polls for the second straight week.
- UVA was ranked No. 12 in both polls on Nov. 23, falling out the top 10 for the first time since Feb. 24, 2014.
- UVA had been ranked in the top 10 in 25 consecutive AP polls since March 3, 2014, its longest span since 49 consecutive polls from 1980-83.
- The Cavaliers' No. 6 preseason ranking was UVA's best since a No. 1 ranking to start the 1982-83 season.
- Virginia has been ranked in the preseason top-10 in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 1981-82 and 1982-83.
- UVA has finished in the top 10 (No. 3 in 2014 & No. 6 in 2015) in the final AP rankings in back-to-back seasons for the first time since three straight seasons from 1981-83.

**UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS**

- UVA meets its first ranked opponent of the season.
- UVA went 4-4 vs. ranked foes in 2014-15, defeating Maryland, Notre Dame, North Carolina and Louisville.
- Virginia is 14-21 against ranked opponents, including a 2-6 mark vs. top-5 foes, in the Tony Bennett era.
- Virginia is 129-316 vs. ranked opponents, including a 25-119 mark against top-5 foes, since 1953-54.
- The Cavaliers are 1-26 vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).

**LAST TIME OUT**

- Malcolm Brogdon and Anthony Gill tallied 16 points each to lead Virginia to a 67-52 non-conference win over William & Mary on Dec. 5.
- Darius Thompson added 12 points and a season-high four steals and Isaiah Wilkins chipped in eight points, a career-high four steals and three rebounds.
- UVA's 15 steals were its most since 16 vs. NC State in 2008.

**BACK TO THE FUTURE**

- Virginia's 77.1 points per game average is its highest under Tony Bennett and highest since averaging 79.6 points in 2001-02.
- Virginia has scored 80 or more points in five games, the most under Tony Bennett and most since five in 2008-09 and 11 in 2007-08.
- The Cavaliers scored 82 or more points in three straight games (Nov. 19-22 at Charleston Classic) for the first time since the first three games of the 2001-02 season.

**VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT**

- Head coach Tony Bennett sports a 143-65 mark in seven seasons at Virginia and 212-98 career mark in 10 seasons.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett was also named ACC Coach of the Year, NABC District 2 Coach of the Year and USBWA District 3 Coach of the Year for the second consecutive year.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season for the first time in school history.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to four consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014 and 2015, and NIT in 2013).
- Bennett-coached teams are 76-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 10-year coaching career.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense three times (2008-09, 2013-14 & 2014-15), and finished in the top five nationally in six of nine seasons.
- Bennett is one of 26 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- UVA is 75-24 (.757) in non-conference action and 88-20 (.815) at home under Tony Bennett.

**'HOO ARE THESE WAHOOS?**

- UVA is averaging 77.1 points per game and yielding 57.5 ppg (sixth nationally and most since 62.4 in 2010-11).
- The Cavaliers lead the nation in assist-to-turnover ratio at 2.12 and are tied for ninth in turnover margin at +5.8.
- Senior All-America candidate Malcolm Brogdon leads UVA in scoring for the third consecutive season at a career-best 17.3 points per game, while All-ACC performer Anthony Gill is averaging 12.6 points and 5.8 rebounds.
- Brogdon has four 20-point efforts, including a career-high 28 at George Washington, and Gill has reached double figures in scoring in all eight games.
- London Perrantes is averaging career highs in points (10.0), assists (5.3) and assist-to-turnover ratio (4.57).
- Marial Shayok has reached double figures in scoring in three of the last six games, including a career-high 17 vs. Long Beach State, since joining the starting lineup.
- UVA has out-rebounded its opponents in six of its seven wins and has a +8.4 rebounding margin overall.
- Nine players are averaging 10 or more minutes per game.
- The Cavaliers have shot 50 percent or better from 3-point range in three of their last five games.

**ALL-AMERICAN BROGDON LEADS CAVALIERS INTO ACTION**

- Preseason co-ACC Player of the Year Malcolm Brogdon leads UVA into action this season.
- Brogdon is averaging a team-leading 17.3 points and 4.6 rebounds per game in 2015-16.
- Brogdon's 17.3 scoring average is the highest for UVA since Mike Scott's 18.0 ppg in 2011-12.
- Brogdon was named a preseason All-American by The Sporting News (1st team), Blue Ribbon Yearbook (1st team), CBSSports.com (2nd team), NBCEsports.com (2nd team), Bleacher Report (2nd team), USA Today (3rd team) and CollegeInsider.com.
- In 2014-15, Brogdon averaged 14.0 points and 3.9 rebounds en route to All-America second-team and All-ACC first-team accolades.
- The two-time All-ACC performer, who was a John Wooden Award finalist last season, ranks 27th on UVA's all-time scoring list with 1,277 points in 108 career games (11.8 career ppg).
- Brogdon ranks second on UVA's career free-throw percentage list at 85.7% (300-for-350).
- Brogdon, who is a candidate for the 2016 Senior CLASS Award and Wooden Citizen Cup Award, was named to the 2014 Allstate NABC Good Works Team.
- Brogdon helped Team USA to a bronze medal at the 2015 Pan American Games in Toronto.
- The redshirt senior earned a degree in history and is pursuing a master's degree in public policy from the Frank Batten School of Leadership and Public Policy.

## LONDON CALLING THE SHOTS

- Despite missing the past two games, junior point guard London Perrantes is enjoying a breakout season in 2015-16.
- Perrantes has hit double figures in scoring in three of his last four games, including a season-high 16 points vs. George Mason.
- He tallied his second career double-double with 16 points and a career-high 11 assists against George Mason en route to MVP honors at the Charleston Classic.
- Perrantes is shooting a career-best 47.8 percent (11-23) from 3-point range.
- Perrantes has a career 3.3 assist-to turnover ratio (320 assists, 96 turnovers) in 75 career games.
- Perrantes averaged 6.4 points and 4.6 assists en route to honorable mention All-ACC honors last season.
- He set career highs in points (26) and 3-pointers (5) at Miami (1/3/15).
- Perrantes earned All-ACC Freshman Team honors in 2013-14.

## DT SHOWING HIS VERSATILITY

- Darius Thompson has averaged 8.3 points, 2.6 rebounds, 2.2 assists and 1.3 steals in 24.1 minutes in his first season at UVA.
- He has matched a season high with 12 points in each of the last three games.
- Thompson sat out as a transfer last season after averaging 2.6 points and 2.4 assists in 37 games at Tennessee in 2013-14.
- Thompson had 12 points, six rebounds, four assists and three steals in his UVA debut as a starter vs. Morgan State.

## HIGH POINT MAN TO THE GILLS

- Preseason All-ACC second-team selection Anthony Gill, who is averaging 12.6 points and 5.8 rebounds, is Virginia's top frontcourt player.
