#### BOSTON COLLEGE VS. VIRGINIA - ALL-TIME SERIES

- Today's game is the 26th all-time meeting between the two teams.
- Boston College is 8-17 all-time against Virginia.
- In ACC regular season play, BC is 7-13 against Virginia.
- Last year, UVA earned a 61-49 win on Jan. 9, 2021 at Conte.
- On Jan. 7, 2020, the Eagles snapped a six-game losing streak vs. the Cavaliers with a 60-53 win at home.

#### BOSTON COLLEGE IN ACC REGULAR SEASON PLAY

- Boston College is 95-186 in 16+ seasons in the ACC.
- BC won its ACC opener, 73-57, at home vs. Notre Dame.
- BC's best ACC mark came in its inaugural season, going 11-5 in conference play in 2005-06 en route to a third place finish. BC tied for third in 2006-07 (10-6) and was fourth in 2010-11 (9-7).

#### SUB-60 OPPONENTS IN ACC PLAY

- Boston College has held its last two ACC opponents under 60 points.
- Pittsburgh scored 56 points on Jan. 30 and UNC had 58 on Jan. 26.
- It marks the first time since the 2018-19 season that Boston College held consecutive ACC opponents under 60 points on the scoreboard.
- BC held Pitt and Miami to 57 points apiece from Feb. 12-19, 2018.
- In total in 2021-22, BC has held three ACC foes below 60 points.
- Dating back to Boston College's first season in the ACC in 2005-06, the Eagles have held consecutive conference foes below 60 points on four occasions.
- During the 2011-12 season, the Eagles did so twice - Jan. 12-14, 2012 vs. Clemson (57) and Miami (59) and from Feb. 1-4, 2012 against N.C. State (56) and Georgia Tech (51).

#### TIME TO START TALKING MAKAI FOR ACC MOST IMPROVED

- Makai Ashton-Langford is a strong candidate for the ACC's most improved player.
- The senior guard has shown marked statistical improvement, year over year.
- Ashton-Langford is close to 5.0 more points per game, leading BC at 13.0 ppg.
- His rebounding per game figures are also improved by almost 1.0 per game.
- Ashton-Langford has posted three 20+ performances in his last eight games.
- In his previous 90 games, he had scored 20 points or more one time.
- Ashton-Langford has scored in double digits in 16 of 20 games for BC in 2021-22.
- From 2017-20, he scored in double figures 14 times in a 78-game span.
- He has led the team in scoring six times in 2021-22; just twice from 2017-20.
- In ACC games, Ashton-Langford is averaging +4.3 ppg year over year - 14.3 in 2021-22 vs. 10.0 in 2020-21.
- His points/rebounding averages are also improved year over year in ACC play: 14.3/4.0 in 2021-22 vs. 10.0/3.3 in 2020-21.

## TODAY'S BOSTON COLLEGE NOTE(S) YOU CAN'T LIVE WITHOUT

- Jaeden Zackery is averaging nearly 6.0 of his 9.2 points per game in the second half.
- While 12 of his 24 made 3-point field goals have come in the second half, seven of those 12 have come in the final 5:00.
- Quinten Post's six 3-pointers made tie him for second in BC history for the most 3FG made by a true 7-footer.
- Nate Doornkamp made eight 3-pointers during the 2004-05 season and finished his BC career with 16 3FGM.

## ON THIS DATE: FEBRUARY 1

- Boston College is 13-11 all-time - and 1-4 in ACC play - in games played on the February 1 calendar date.
- February 1 marks the celebration of National Dark Chocolate Day.
- Several notable events in history occurred on February 1 - 1790 - The U.S. Supreme Court convenes for the first time in New York; 1862 - Julia Howe publishes the "Battle Hymn of the Republic"; 1964 - The Beatles' see their first Billboard #1 song "I Want to Hold Your Hand"; 1972 - Neil Young releases "Harvest," the best-selling album in the U.S. that year; 1978 - Harriet Tubman becomes the first African-American woman to be honored on a U.S. postage stamp.
- Notable February 1 birthdays: singer Harry Styles; former MMA champion Ronda Rousey; musician Rick James; actress Sherilyn Fenn; poet Langston Hughes; actor Sherman Hemsley; rapper Big Boi..

## BOARD MAN BICKERSTAFF

- T.J. Bickerstaff registered his second 17-rebound game of the season at North Carolina.
- Bickerstaff is one of 12 players nationally - two in the ACC (Bacot - UNC) to have multiple games with 17 rebounds or more.
- Fourteen of Bickerstaff's 17 rebounds came on the defensive glass versus the Tar Heels.
- The last BC player to grab at least 14 defensive boards in a game - Ky Bowman (16) - against Notre Dame on Jan. 12, 2019.
- The 17 rebounds tied for the fifth-most rebounds in a game in Boston College history.
- Danya Abrams holds the BC rebounding record, grabbing 20 boards at home vs. Providence on Jan. 22, 1994.
- Bickerstaff also corralled 17 boards at home vs. Columbia - the fourth-most in a single-game in Conte Forum history.
- The last BC player to have at least two games with 17+ rebounds - Ryan Anderson - during the 2012-13 season.
- Bickerstaff has registered four games with at least 15 rebounds this season - tied for most in the ACC this season (Bacot).
- The last BC player to have at least four games with 15+ rebounds - Craig Smith - during the 2005-06 season.
- The Atlanta product has six double-digit rebounding games so far in 2021-22.
- The last BC player to have at least six games with double-digit rebounds - Steffon Mitchell - during the 2019-20 season.
- Bickerstaff has two double-doubles on the season, most recently at Louisville, finishing with 12 points and 15 rebounds.
- He registered his first collegiate double-double - 22 points/15 rebounds - and three steals and two blocks at Rhode Island.
- Bickerstaff is one of only four players nationally to have a stat line with at least 22-15-3-2 in a single game.
- He leads BC and ranks sixth in the ACC in overall rebounding (8.0), including ranking fourth in OReb (2.8).

## KARNIK CAREER NIGHT; CAREER MILESTONE VS. VT

- James Karnik poured in a career-high 26 points - including his 1,000th point - in a win over Virginia Tech on Jan. 22.
- Karnik was 10-of-12 from the floor, scoring his milestone basket on a stepback 3-pointer. He was also 5-of-6 from the foul line.
- Karnik narrowly missed a double-double, grabbing nine boards in 30 minutes of play.
- He posted an efficiency rating of 32 (EFF is calculated: PTS + REB + AST + STL + BLK - Missed Shots - TO).
- The 26 points were the most by a Boston College player this season.

## TWO-MAN GAME

- James Karnik (26) and Makai Ashton-Langford (18) accounted for 44 of Boston College's 68 points vs. Virginia Tech.
- It is the second time this season that they accounted for better than 50% of the team's scoring.
- At Clemson, Karnik (17) and Ashton-Langford (19) combined for 36 of BC's 70 points.
- In BC's four ACC wins, Ashton-Langford is averaging 17.0 points, 4.8 rebounds, and 3.3 assists in BC's four league wins.
- Karnik is averaging 15.0 points and 7.3 rebounds, while shooting 72.2% (26-36) from the floor.

## ANOTHER COMEBACK DOWN DOUBLE DIGITS - EAGLES ERASE 11-POINT HOLE TO BEAT VIRGINIA TECH

- Boston College again erased a double-digit deficit to win, this time against Virginia Tech.
- The Eagles trailed 19-8 with 8:24 remaining in the first half, before closing the half on a 23-14 push, trailing 33-31 at the break.
- BC would lead by as many as five points in the second half - which ended as the final margin of victory.
- A 3-pointer by James Karnik with 14:33 gave the Eagles a 42-41 lead and they would not trail the rest of the way.

## COMEBACK FOR THE AGES - DOWN 23, WIN BY TWO

- Boston College erased a 23-point deficit to win, 70-68, at Clemson.
- Trailing 34-11, with 7:11 remaining in the first half, BC outscored Clemson by 25 - 59-34 - over the next 33 minutes.
- BC took its first lead on a Brevin Galloway 3-pointer - his fifth of the night - with 26 seconds left, giving BC a 69-68 advantage.
- Makai Ashton-Langford tacked on a free throw with 15 seconds left, making it 70-68.
- At the time of Clemson's 34-11 lead, the **Tigers held a 99.5% win probability rate**.
- It tied as the largest comeback in an ACC game in conference history.**
- Duke erased a 23-point deficit at Louisville (2/13/19), while UVA overcame a 23-point hole vs. Duke in 2OT on Jan. 14, 1995.
- It is the largest comeback in a game in Boston College program history.**
- Previously, the biggest comeback was 18 points, coming on Dec. 29, 2004 at home against Kent State.
- BC trailed, 41-23, in the first half, before rallying for the 67-65 win, capped by a Craig Smith 12-footer at the buzzer for the win.
- It tied for the largest comeback in an ACC game for Boston College since Jan. 27, 2009.**
- The Eagles erased a 16-point first half deficit in College Park, holding the Terps to only 27 second half points.
- It is the largest comeback in regulation in 2021-22.** JMU erased a 23-point deficit to beat W&M in OT this past Saturday.
- The largest deficit overcome in Division I was 34. Drexel overcame a 53-19 deficit to beat Delaware, 85-83 on Feb. 22, 2018.

## MORE ABOUT THE WIN AT CLEMSON

- The win snapped Boston College's 13-game road losing streak, dating back to Feb. 12, 2020.
- The win snapped Boston College's nine-game losing streak vs. the Tigers - the longest such streak vs. an opponent.
- The win saw Boston College's NET improve 39 points (198 to 159) and KenPom ranking 15 points (147 to 132).

### WITH A WIN AT VIRGINIA...

- BC would move to 10-11 overall and 5-6 in ACC play
- The Eagles would improve to 2-6 (2-4 ACC) on the road
- Boston College would move to 9-17 all-time vs. the Cavaliers, including 8-12 in ACC play and 3-9 at UVA
- Boston College would move to 1-0 in February
- Head coach Earl Grant would earn his 10th victory at Boston College and his 137th as a collegiate head coach
- BC would earn win #1,234 all-time dating back to 1904-05 and win #96 in ACC play dating back to 2005-06

### WITH A LOSS AT VIRGINIA...

- BC drops to 9-12 overall and 4-7 in ACC play
- The Eagles would fall to 1-7 (1-5 ACC) in road games

## KAI, KARNIK KEY TO COMPLETING CLEMSON COMEBACK

- Makai Ashton-Langford played all 20 minutes of the second half at Clemson, helping to complete the BC comeback.
- Ashton-Langford had 17 points, a career-high seven rebounds, three assists, and a steal over the final 20 minutes of play.
- His second half efficiency rating was a team-best 25 (Pts+Reb+Ast+Stl+Blk-Misses-Turnovers) and he was +9.
- One of those three assists went to James Karnik, who had 10 points and five boards in 18 minutes in the second half.
- Karnik made 5-of-7 shots from the floor, registering an EFF mark of 13.

## CAREER NIGHT FOR QP VERSUS GEORGIA TECH

- Quinten Post scored a career-high 24 points - against Georgia Tech. Post scored 18 of his 24 in the second half.
- The 7-footer from Amsterdam connected on 10-of-14 shots from the floor - tying for the most FG by a BC player in 2021-22.
- Post also corralled nine rebounds in the Georgia Tech game, while dishing out two assists.
- Between 2020-21 and this season, Post is averaging +6.0 points and +3.0 rebounds per game.
- Percentage-wise, Post and is shooting nearly +4.0% better from the floor and +15.0% better from the free throw line.
- Post ranks fourth on BC in scoring (8.9 ppg) and is second in rebounding (5.4 rpg) this season.

## COBRA KAI - EFFICIENT PERFORMANCE AT PITTSBURGH

- At Pitt, Makai Ashton-Langford put forth one of the most efficient performances by a point guard in the nation in 2021-22.
- Ashton-Langford finished the game with 23 points (4 3FG), 3 rebounds, 4 assists (1 turnover), 1 block, and 3 steals.
- His EFF rating (PTS + REB + AST + STL + BLK - Missed Shots - TO) was a team-best 24, while his offensive rating was 133.8.
- The 23 points - and four 3-pointers made - were new career-highs for the 6-3 point guard.
- He is one of only two players to post that statistical line on the box score this season (A.J. Walker of Air Force).
- Dating back to 1996-97, Troy Bell was the only Boston College player to post at least those totals in a single game.
- Bell did it twice - Jan. 11, 2003 against Syracuse and Jan 29, 2003 versus Virginia Tech.
- Among all ACC players since 1996, eight players have registered those totals in a single game.
- They are (in chronological order): Coby White (UNC) vs. Virginia Tech; Dennis Smith Jr. (NCST) vs. McNeese; Angel Rodriguez (Miami) vs. Duke; Lamar Patterson (Pitt) vs. Texas Tech; Tim Pickett (FSU) vs. UNC; Mike Dunleavy Jr. (Duke) vs. NC State; Shane Battier (Duke) vs. N.C. A&T. Four of those eight performances came in an ACC game.

## BOO FROM THE WOO - LANGFORD JR. SHINING IN SECOND SEASON

- Through 20 games, DeMarr Langford Jr. is settling into his sophomore season.
- He helps lead a balanced BC attack, averaging 10.5 points - second on BC - with 4.5 rebounds and 2.3 assists per game.
- Langford Jr. kickstarted the Jan. 30 win over Pitt, scoring 11 of his 17 points in the first half.
- He averaged 17.3 points per game while shooting nearly 63.3% (19-30) from the floor in the Eagles' first three wins.
- Langford Jr. scored a career-high 20 points (6-9 FG; 8-8 FT) in 31 minutes vs. Holy Cross.
- The sophomore connected 13 of his first 15 field goal attempts on the season, making his first five shots vs. Holy Cross.
- He opened the season with a 16-point performance vs. Dartmouth, making 8-of-10 shots on the night.
- Since 1996-97, only 23 Boston College players have shot at least 80% while attempting at least 10 field goals in a game.
- Last season as a freshman, he averaged 6.7 points and 4.2 boards while adding 1.4 assists, and 1.1 steals per game.
- Langford Jr. - nicknamed Boo by his grandmother - is the younger brother of starting point guard Makai Ashton-Langford.
- On Nov. 26, 2020 vs. Rhode Island, they became the first brothers from Massachusetts to start in the same game for BC.

## ZACKERY MAKING AN IMPACT

- Jaeden Zackery ranks third on BC in scoring (9.1), second in assists (2.5), and tied for first in steals (1.4) so far this season.
- Among all ACC first-year players, Zackery ranks sixth in scoring, second in assists, and second in steals.
- He has reached double-digits nine times and has led the Eagles in scoring on four occasions.
- The Salem, Wisc. product has registered an effective FG% of 52.4% and a true shooting percentage of 54.4% in 20 games.
- Zackery is connecting on better than 47% of his 3-point attempts on the season, knocking down 24-of-51.
- **He is one of 40 players - and eight freshmen nationally - to shoot 47% or better from 3FG (24 3FGM min).**
- He was named to the Sunshine Slam All-Tourney team, after scoring a season-high 19 points against Rhode Island.
- The 6-2 guard added 15 points (3-4 3FG) vs. Utah the night before in the semifinal round of the Sunshine Slam tourney.
- In three Sunshine Slam games: 15.7 points, 2.7 rebounds, 2.7 assists, 1.7 steals, 64% (16-25) FG, 63.6% (7-11) 3FG.
- Earlier this season, he became the first BC freshman to dish out at least six assists in consecutive games in nearly a decade.
- In 2012-13, Boston College's Joe Rahon had six dimes against Providence (12/21/12) and Holy Cross (12/29/12).
- Zackery was a 2020-21 NJCAA Third Team All-American out of Chipola College in Florida.

## KARNIK POSTING DOUBLE-DOUBLES

- James Karnik registered his second double of the season against Notre Dame - finishing with 17 points and 13 rebounds.
- Karnik was 8-of-11 from the floor vs. ND, connecting on a 3-pointer. He also had two steals and two blocks.
- The senior from Surrey, B.C. logged 11 points and 11 rebounds in 10 minutes of play in the first half vs. the Irish.
- He had his first double-double in a BC uniform, logging 15 points and 13 boards vs. Rhode Island at the Sunshine Slam.
- Since that game vs. Rhode Island, Karnik is averaging nearly 9.0 points and 6.0 rebounds.
- Prior to that, through the first five games of the season, Karnik was averaging 5.0 points and 2.8 boards.

## G ON IT

- Gianni Thompson tied his season-high with six points vs. Pittsburgh. He also had three boards and an assist in the win.
- Thompson's previous scoring high came against North Carolina, knocking down a season-best two 3-pointers on Jan. 2.
- In that game, the Newton product was the first Eagle off the bench, playing 10 minutes.
- It was his first extended action (10+ minutes of playing time) in 50 days - between Holy Cross and North Carolina.
- The 6-8 freshman has made 3-of-5 attempts from beyond the arc in ACC play.

## JUSTIN TIME

- Justin Vander Baan saw a career-high 15 minutes of playing time at Pittsburgh.
- The sophomore 7-footer logged four points, two boards, an assist, and a blocked shot in the second half.
- Vander Baan was the team's primary 5-man after Quinten Post and James Karnik were each fouled out of the game.

- From Nov. 26-Dec. 3, BC limited opponents to 55.3 ppg - the lowest three-game scoring defense mark in over a decade.
- During the 2010-11 season, the Eagles yielded 55.0 ppg over a three-game stretch.
- During that span, BC held No. 19 North Carolina to 48 points, Miami to 73, and Virginia to 44 between Feb. 19-20, 2011.
- Since the 1996-97 season, BC's lowest three-game span of opponent scoring was 48.7 (Feb. 22-March 3, 2004).

### THE TALLEST COLLEGE DORM ROOM IN THE COUNTRY

- Justin Vander Baan and Quinten Post are what is believed to be the tallest pair of roommates in America.
- The pair of 7-footers live together on campus - and mark the first time since 2014-15 that BC has two 7-footers on its roster.
- Dennis Clifford and Kyle Caudill were together on the BC roster from 2011-15.
- Prior to that, Nate Doornkamp and Kirsten Zoellner played together from 2001-03.
- Boston College is one of seven schools with at least two 7-footers on its roster in 2021-22. Florida State tops the list, with four.
- According to Google, there are approximately 2,800 7-footers in the world. @BCMBB has two of them.

### INSIDE THE METRICS - STYLE OF PLAY (per KenPom)

- Earl Grant-coached teams have shown a strong ability to take care of the ball.
- Through 18 games, BC is averaging 11.5 turnovers per outing - including lows against USF (6), UNC (8), and Holy Cross (9).
- Boston College ranks 53rd nationally in fewest turnovers per game (11.5) - more than 2.0 TO/game fewer than last season.

### BOSTON COLLEGE ANNOUNCES NATIONALLY-RANKED RECRUITING CLASS

- Boston College has secured one of its highest-rated recruiting classes in program history.
- The quartet of Prince Aligbe, D.J. Hand, Chas Kelley, and Armani Mighty - rank 26th nationally as a class per Rivals.com.
- Aligbe is a 6-7, 215 lb. forward from Minnehaha Academy in Minneapolis, Minn. and is a four-star rated recruit.
- He averaged 11.2 points per game as a junior in a program that has featured two of the top prep players in the country over the past two seasons - Jalen Suggs and Chet Holmgren, both of Gonzaga.
- Hand is a 6-5, 180 lb. guard from Landstown H.S. in Virginia Beach, Va. and is also a four-star ranked player.
- One of the top shooting guards in the country, Hand averaged nearly 33 points per game as a junior and was a First Team All-State selection.
- Kelley is a 6-5, 180 lb. guard from Houston who is playing his final prep season at The Phelps School in Malvern, Pa.
- A high three-star rated recruit, Kelley played his first two seasons of prep basketball at Cy-Creek H.S. in Houston, averaging nearly 16 points, five rebounds, five assists, and four steals as a sophomore.
- Mighty is a 6-10, 220 lb. center from Toronto and United Scholastic Academy.
- Born in Jamaica, the three-star rated big man has been playing organized basketball for only three years and shined on the grassroots circuit this past summer with Canada Elite - the country's top AAU program.
- Head coach Earl Grant on his four-player class: *"We believe that we added four high character guys to our program. They are welcome additions and we look forward to seeing the impact they will have in Boston!"*

### BOSTON COLLEGE SEVENTH-LOWEST PERCENTAGE OF MINUTES RETURNING

- Boston College has the seventh-lowest percentage nationally of minutes played returning for 2021-22.
- Returning BC players accounted for 27.6% of minutes played a season ago.
- This ranks fourth-lowest among power conferences, behind Creighton (18%), Missouri (19.7), and Iowa State (25.1).
- The Eagles return 30.3% of its scoring, 37.2% of its rebounding, and 39.1% of its assists from last season.

# EARL GRANT

## THE CLEMENT AND ELIZABETH IZZI FAMILY HEAD MEN'S BASKETBALL COACH



On March 17, Earl Grant was introduced as The Clement and Elizabeth Izzi Family Head Men's Basketball Coach at Boston College. Grant brings an impressive track record to BC after he turned the College of Charleston men's basketball program into a consistent championship contender in the Colonial Athletic Association.

Under Grant's leadership, the College of Charleston was one of only 21 NCAA Division I schools to have players drafted in both the 2019 and 2020 NBA Drafts. Grant led the Cougars to a top-four finish in the CAA in each of the last five seasons, including the 2018 regular season and conference tournament championship.

A finalist for the 2019 Skip Prosser Man of the Year Award, presented annually to a coach who not only achieves success on the basketball court, but who also displays moral integrity off the court, Grant led the Cougars to a memorable run in 2017-18 that included the program's second-straight 25-win campaign, an impressive 26-8 overall record and 14-4 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play. The co-regular-season champions earned the No. 1 seed in the CAA Men's Basketball Championship and defeated No. 2 seed Northeastern in an overtime thriller to punch the program's first ticket to the NCAA Tournament since 1999.

Grant is the 13th head coach in Boston College men's basketball history.

"When we began our search for a new head men's basketball coach, we set out to find a leader of young men, someone who shares our vision and our values, who could lead our program to championships while ensuring a world-class student-athlete experience and education for our players," said Kraft. "After a comprehensive national search, it was clear that Earl is exactly what we were looking for and what our basketball program needs at this moment and I am confident he will have tremendous success in Chestnut Hill, on the court and off."

Grant guided the Cougars to three 20-win campaigns and a 67-22 home-court winning record over the previous six years and produced 12 all-conference honorees.

"My family and I are really excited about the opportunity to start a new journey," Grant said. "I look forward to representing such a prestigious academic institution, to coach in the top basketball conference in America, and do it in one of the best cities in the world. I can't wait to meet and develop a relationship with all who have worked so hard over the years to make BC a special place. I am thankful to Pat Kraft, Father Leahy and the Board of Trustees for affording me this tremendous opportunity."

For the first time in program history, College of Charleston's men's basketball was recognized by the NCAA for the 2018-19 academic year. Under the guidance of Grant, the programs' four-year rolling APR was in the Top 10% of all men's basketball programs in the country. The Cougars were one of only 51 men's basketball programs honored nationally. In all, 24 players have gone on to earn their degree at The College.

In 2018-19, CofC posted a 24-9 overall record with non-conference victories over Rhode Island, VCU and Memphis. Two players – Grant Riller and Jarrell Brantley – were named to the All-CAA First Team. Known for their gritty defense, the Cougars led the CAA in scoring defense for the fourth-straight year holding opponents to 68.6 points per game. CofC also ranked No. 17 in the nation in turnovers per game (10.5 avg.) and No. 16 in free-throw percentage (76.4%).

Known as a player's coach, Grant and his staff helped develop Brantley into a 2019 NBA Draft Pick and Riller into a 2020 NBA Draft Pick - the third and fourth-ever College of Charleston players to be drafted. Brantley is currently a two-way player with the Utah Jazz and was named to the 2020 NBA G League First Team and All-Rookie Team as a member of the Salt Lake City Stars. He was second in voting for NBA G League Rookie of the Year honors. Riller was selected in the second round by the Charlotte Hornets giving the Cougars back-to-back NBA Draft picks for the first time in school history.

In 2016-17, Grant led the Cougars to a 25-10 overall record and 14-4 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play. It marked the program's first 20-win campaign since 2013. Charleston, seeded a program-best No. 2, advanced to the championship game of the CAA Tournament for the first time since CofC joined the Colonial in 2013. They were also selected and made their fifth all-time appearance in the Postseason NIT. It was their first postseason berth (NCAA or NIT) since 2011.

In his second season with the Cougars, Grant and his staff turned the program into one of the most improved in NCAA Division I and developed four all-conference players including Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year and All-CAA Third Team selection Jarrell Brantley – the first freshman to receive such honors since 2006.

Known as a top recruiter, Grant has shown impressive credentials in both identifying and developing top-flight talent. No stranger to the ACC, he previously spent four seasons as an assistant coach at Clemson under Brad Brownell, where he made a positive impact on the Tiger men's basketball program, both in recruiting and with player development. He worked primarily with Clemson's point guards.

He recruited 2014 first-team All-ACC selection K.J. McDaniels to Clemson, where he ultimately ended up averaging 17 points per game as a junior and was named ACC Defensive Player of the Year, before declaring early for the NBA Draft. McDaniels was selected 32nd overall in the 2014 NBA Draft by the Philadelphia 76ers.

Several Tiger point guards have flourished under Grant's mentoring including incumbent starter Rod Hall. After recruiting the Augusta, Ga., native to Clemson, Grant has seen Hall develop into one of the leaders of the program. During the 2013-14 season, Hall was second on the team in scoring average and ranked among the ACC's top 10 in both assists per game and assist-to-turnover ratio.

In 2010-11, Grant worked with Demontez Stitt, who was named third-team All-ACC and was a member of the All-ACC Tournament Team. That same season, Grant helped Andre Young to an ACC-leading 2.55 assist-to-turnover ratio. Young went on to lead the conference in steals per game as a senior in 2011-12, earning All-ACC Defensive Team honors. He also led the Tigers in scoring under Grant's direction.

Clemson put together strong team results with Grant in the fold as well. In 2013-14, the Tigers went 23-13 overall and recorded a 10-win improvement from the previous season. Clemson advanced to the NIT semifinals and was 10-8 during the ACC regular season.

In Grant's first season in 2010-11, Clemson put together a 22-12 overall record and 9-7 league mark in the ACC. The Tigers earned the No. 4 seed at the ACC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals in Greensboro, N.C. Clemson also went to a fourth-consecutive NCAA Tournament and won its first-round game over UAB, 70-52, in Dayton, Ohio.

Clemson was strong defensively in four seasons with Grant part of its coaching staff. In 2010-11, the Tigers ranked No. 24 nationally in scoring defense. In 2011-12, Clemson yielded just 60.6 points per game to the opposition, the second-best figure among ACC schools. In 2012-13, the Tigers dropped their average even further to 60.1 points per game. That figure dropped to an ACC era-best at Clemson – 58.4 points per game – in 2013-14. The Tiger perimeter defense was No. 1 nationally defending the three-pointer (.286).

Grant personally signed 10 of Clemson's 15 players recruited by Brownell's staff. He was Clemson's lead recruiter for players such as Austin Ajukwa, Jaron Blossomgame, Gabe DeVoe, Ibrahim Djambo, Sidi Djitte, Hall, K.J. McDaniels and Patrick Rooks.

Prior to Clemson, Grant served as an assistant coach first at Winthrop and then at Wichita State. He helped the Eagles to three consecutive Big South championships and three straight NCAA Tournament appearances. In 2004-05, the Eagles were 27-6 overall. The next season, Winthrop finished the year with a 23-8 overall record and came within two points of upsetting Tennessee in the NCAA Tournament. In 2007, Grant helped the Eagles to a 29-5 overall record and unblemished 14-0 mark in Big South play.

The 2007 campaign was a memorable one for Winthrop. With Grant's assistance, the Eagles claimed a 74-64 upset over No. 6 seed Notre Dame in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament. It was Winthrop's first-ever NCAA Tournament win in seven tries.

Grant was at Wichita State from 2007-10, when the Shockers made gradual improvement each season. In 2008-09, Wichita State made its first postseason appearance in three years and also defeated one of the nation's top mid-major programs in Siena during the regular season. In 2009-10, Wichita State improved its win total by eight and finished 25-10 overall, 12-6 in the Missouri Valley Conference. The Shockers advanced to the championship game of the conference tournament and also earned a bid to the National Invitation Tournament.

Prior to his stint at Winthrop, Grant was an assistant coach at The Citadel from 2002-04. Grant played two years at the Division II level at Georgia College. He led the school to two appearances in the NCAA Tournament and to consecutive Peach Belt Conference championships (1999, 2000). In 2000, the Bobcats advanced to the Elite Eight of the Division II national tournament.

A native of North Charleston, S.C., Grant earned his bachelor's degree in psychology from Georgia College in 2000. He and his wife, Jacci, have three sons: Trey, Ezyaiah and Elonzo.
