### **FOR OPENERS**

- · UVA meets Tennessee for the first time since suffering an 87-52 road loss to the Volunteers on Dec. 30, 2013. UVA would embark on a 13-game ACC streak after the loss en route to the ACC regular season and tournament titles.
- · Tennessee's Igor Milicic Jr. played at Virginia in 2021-22 and Charlotte from 2022-24, including one season under Ron Sanchez in 2022-23.
- · Sanchez is 3-0 as interim head coach at UVA.
- · UVA ranks eighth nationally in 3-point shooting at 44.6 percent. · The Cavaliers seek their ninth November tournament championship in the last 11 years (Emerald Coast Classic, Charleston Classic, Barclays Center Classic, Corpus Christi Challenge, NIT Season Tip-Off, Battle 4 Atlantis, Legends Classic and Continental Tire Main Event).
- · UVA is 178-54 (.767) in non-conference play since 2009-10.

### **ALL-TIME VS. TENNESSEE**

- •The Cavaliers own an 8-5 advantage over the Volunteers in the all-time series that dates back to 1917.
- $\cdot \text{Tennessee defeated Virginia } 87\text{-}52 \text{ in the last meeting between the teams at Thompson-Boling Arena on Dec. } 30, 2013, in Knoxville, Tenn.}$
- · UVA is 3-1 against Tennessee on neutral courts, including a 62-48 win in the 1981 NCAA Tournament Regional Semifinals in Atlanta, Ga., and a 54-51 win in the 1982 NCAA Tournament Second Round in Indianapolis, Ind.
- The Cavaliers also topped the Volunteers 107-89 on Dec. 19, 2000, in East Rutherford, N.J.
- The Cavaliers are 5-1 against the Volunteers in Virginia, including a 46-38 win at John Paul Jones Arena in 2012.
- · UVA is 0-3 against Tennessee in true road games.

# LAST TIME AGAINST THE VOLUNTEERS

- · Jordan McRae (21 points), Josh Richardson (20 points) and Jarnell Stokes (20) led Tennessee to an 87-52 victory over the Cavaliers at Thompson-Boling Arena on Dec. 30, 2013.
- •The 35-point defeat marked the second-largest loss during the 15-year Tony Bennett era at UVA.
- Tennessee made 11 3-pointers, including eight in the first half. • Antonio Barton added 14 points as four Volunteers landed in double figures.
- · Justin Anderson led the Cavaliers with 11 points and Mike Tobey chipped in 10 points and seven rebounds.
- · UT held UVA's Joe Harris to seven points on 2 of 9 shooting.

#### <u>LAST TIME OUT</u>

- · Isaac McKneely scored 23 points on 8 of 9 shooting, including a school-best 6 of 6 from 3-point range, to lead Virginia (3-0) past Villanova 70-60 in a Hall of Fame Series event in Baltimore, Md., on Friday, Nov. 15.
- Andrew Rohde added 13 points and Jacob Cofie chipped in 12 points and six rebounds in the non-conference win.
- · UVA shot 51 percent, including 56 percent (14 of 25) from 3-point range.
- •The Cavaliers enjoyed a 26-10 advantage in bench points, led by Cofie's 12 points.
- · Eric Dixon led Villanova with 20 points and eight rebounds.

#### REPLACING A LEGEND

- · Ron Sanchez was named Dean and Markel Families Men's Interim Head Basketball Coach on Oct. 18 after three-time National Coach of the Year Tony Bennett retired.
- · Sanchez, who spent 10 seasons on Bennett's staff at UVA in two different stints (2009-19 & 2023-24), posted a 72-78 record as head coach at Charlotte from 2018-23.
- · Bennett, who is UVA's all-time winningest men's basketball coach, posted a 364-136 mark in 15 seasons at UVA and 433-169 career mark in 18 seasons overall.
- The three-time National (2007, 2015 and 2018) and four-time ACC Coach of the Year (2014, 2015, 2018 and 2019) guided UVA to its 10 NCAA tournaments and a pair of NIT berths.
- · Bennett led the Cavaliers to six ACC regular-season titles (2014, 2015, 2018, 2019, 2021, 2023), two ACC Tournament titles (2014 and 2018) and one NCAA national championship (2019).

### **SEATTLE'S BEST COFIE**

NOTES

- Seattle, Wash., native Jacob Cofie has enjoyed a hot start to his collegiate career.
- · Cofie leads UVA in rebounding (7.7 rpg), steals (2.0 spg) and blocks (1.7 bpg), and ranks second in scoring (13 ppg).
  · He is the first UVA freshman to reach double figures in scoring in each of the first three games since Sylven Landesberg in 2008-09.
- $\cdot$  Cofie's 16 points (7 of 8 FGs) in his collegiate debut were the most in a UVA debut since transfer Jayden Gardner had 18 vs. Navy in 2021-22.
- · Cofie's 11-point, 11-rebound double-double against Coppin State was the first by a UVA freshman since redshirt freshman De'Andre Hunter had 14 points and 10 rebounds vs. Pitt on Feb. 24, 2018.

### VIRGINIA INTERIM HEAD COACH RON SANCHEZ

- Ron Sanchez is in his 11th year with the Virginia men's basketball program and first as Dean and Markel Families Men's Interim Head Basketball Coach.
- Sanchez served nine seasons on Bennett's staff from 2009-18, the last three as associate head coach. During his time on Grounds, the Cavaliers won 212 games, three ACC regularseason titles and two ACC Tournament titles while making six appearances in the NCAA Tournament and one NIT appearance. The Cavaliers earned three No. 1 seeds in the NCAA Tournament and won 29 or more games four times. UVA won 31 games and reached No. 1 in the AP rankings for the first time since 1982-83 during Sanchez' last season at UVA in 2017-18.
- · He returned to UVA as associate head coach in 2023-24 as the Cavaliers posted a 23-11 record and 13-7 mark in the ACC.
- Sanchez served as head coach at Charlotte from 2018-23, posting a 72-78 record over five seasons.
- · Under Sanchez' leadership at Charlotte, the 49ers won 16 or more games in three seasons, including a 22-14 record in 2022-23. His last season at Charlotte was highlighted by the 49ers' first-ever postseason tournament title when they won four games in five days in Daytona Beach, Fla., at the 2023 Discount Tire College Basketball Invitational.
- Sanchez also served as an assistant coach on Tony Bennett's staff for three seasons at Washington State from 2006-09, helping the Cougars to a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances and one NIT berth. Washington State reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament in 2007 and Sweet 16 in 2008. The Cougars tied the school record with 26 wins in 2006-07 and 2007-08.

### **HOW ARE THESE CAVALIERS?**

- · Virginia returns two starters (Isaac McKneely and Andrew Rohde) along with Blake Buchanan and Taine Murray from last season's team that finished third in the ACC (13-7) and advanced to the NCAA First Four.
- · In 2023-24, McKneely started 33 games and averaged 12.3 points and shot 44.5 percent from 3-point range, while Rohde started 27 games and averaged 4.3 points and 2.7 assists.
- · Buchanan averaged 3.4 points and 3.1 rebounds in 15 minutes per game, while Murray netted 3.3 points per game.
- McKneely leads UVA in scoring at 16 points per game, while shooting a blistering 64.7 percent from 3-point range.
- · Jacob Cofie (13 ppg, 7.6 rpg) has reached double figures in all three games off the bench.
- $\cdot$  Elijah Saunders (10.3 ppg, 5.3 rpg), Buchanan (5.7 ppg, 5 rpg, 1.7 bpg) and TJ Power (3.7 ppg, 3.3 rpg) have started both games.
- · Andrew Rohde (7 ppg, 4.5 apg) and Dai Dai Ames (7.7 ppg, 2.3 rpg) have shared point guard duties.
- · Ishan Sharma, Taine Murray and Anthony Robinson have seen action off the bench, while Christian Bliss awaits his UVA debut after redshirting last season.
- Promising sophomore Elijah Gertrude will miss the 2024-25 after suffering an offseason knee injury.
- · Point guard Jalen Warley (Florida State) transferred out of the program on Oct. 29.

### THE VIRGINIA WAY

- The Virginia Way is built on former head coach Tony Bennett's five pillars of humility, passion, unity, servanthood and thankfulness.
- •The Virginia Way is playing defense, taking quality shots, sharing and taking care of the basketball, stopping transition, rebounding and playing more defense.
- UVA has finished in the top six nationally in scoring defense in each of the past 13 seasons and led the nation in the category six times.

### **OUR DEFENSE NEVER RESTS**

- · UVA ranks 11th nationally in scoring defense at 53.7 points per game and 12th in field goal percentage defense at 33.8 percent.
- •The Cavaliers have limited each of its opponent to 60 or fewer points and out-rebounded two foes.
- $\cdot$  UVA has forced a pair of shot clock violations and is averaging 10.7 points off turnovers.
- · In 2023-24, UVA ranked third nationally in scoring defense (59.7 ppg), seventh in fouls per game (13.5), 19th in field goal percentage defense (40.6), 20th in blocks per game (5.0) and 25th in 3-point field goal percentage defense (30.5).
- •The Cavaliers ranked sixth nationally in scoring defense from 2021-23.

- $\cdot$  UVA's 11 ranked wins in 2018-19 marked a school record.
- · UVA is 164-341 vs. ranked opponents since 1953-54.
- $\cdot$  UVA is 1-31 all-time vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 win vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).

### **UVA VS. THE SEC**

- · The Cavaliers meet their first of two SEC opponents (Tennessee and Florida).
- · UVA defeated two SEC opponents in the 2023-24 season. The Cavaliers downed Florida 73-70 in the Hall of Fame Series and Texas A&M 59-47 in the ACC/SEC Challenge.
- · UVA is 70-62 all-time vs. SEC opponents (26-25 vs. South Carolina, 8-5 vs. Tennessee, 4-1 vs. Missouri, 4-3 vs. Arkansas, 4-4 vs. Georgia, 4-4 vs. Auburn, 3-0 vs. LSU, 3-1 vs. Oklahoma, 3-4 vs. Alabama, 3-6 vs. Kentucky, 2-2 vs. Florida, 2-2 vs. Mississippi State, 2-5 vs. Vanderbilt, 1-1 vs. Mississippi and 1-1 vs. Texas ARM).
- · Interim head coach Ron Sanchez meets his first SEC opponent in Tennessee.

- · St. John's defeated Virginia 64-58 in the series' lone neutralsite matchup that took place in New York, N.Y., in 1986.

- ·Tony Bennett's son, Eli, is a practice player on the team and iunior at UVA.
- · Eli Bennett was also a practice player at Charlotte for Ron Sanchez as a freshman in 2022-23.

### 2023-24 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

- · Virginia earned its 26th NCAA Tournament berth and 12th consecutive postseason berth in 2023-24.
- · UVA won 23 or more games for the 10th time under former head coach Tony Bennett and 13 or more ACC games for the ninth time under Bennett.

### **VIRGINIA PICKED FIFTH IN THE ACC**

- · Virginia was fifth in the 2024-25 ACC Tipoff Preseason Poll.
- · Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by North Carolina, Wake Forest, Clemson and Virginia in the top five.
- · Preseason voters selected Miami sixth, followed by NC State, Pittsburgh, Louisville and Notre Dame. Syracuse was picked 11th, while Georgia Tech, SMU, Virginia Tech, Florida State, California, Stanford and Boston College rounded out the
- ·The Cavaliers were selected fourth in the 2023-24 ACC Preseason Poll and finished third (13-7) in the standings.
- ·The Cavaliers have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in 14 of the last 16 seasons.

### THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- ·Virginia is 248-56 (.815), including a 2-0 mark in 2024-25, in 19 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- · UVA went 15-2 at JPJ last season and is 31-3 in its last 34 home contests.
- · UVA is 210-40 (.840) overall and 100-10 (.909) in nonconference action in its last 16 seasons at JPJ.
- · UVA has an ACC-leading 96 wins in league home games over the past 11 seasons. Duke is second at 94.
- · UVA has won 10+ home games for 15 straight seasons.

### RETURN OF THE MOP

· Former UVA All-American Kyle Guy has returned to UVA as an Athlete Development Mentor/Special Assistant. Guy was the Most Outstanding Player at the 2019 NCAA Final Four as UVA captured its first national championship. Guy played professionally for five seasons from 2019-24. He was selected by the New York Knicks with the 55th pick in the second round of the 2019 NBA Draft and played three seasons in the NBA including two years with Sacramento (2019-21) and one with Miami (2021-22). 




