Team Notes

- The Cavaliers improved to 11-12 overall, 4-8 ACC
- UVA is 3-7 away from home, including a 2-5 mark in ACC road games
- UVA shot 56 percent from the field, including 45.5 percent from 3-point range (10 of 22)
- UVA's first half 17-0 scoring run was its longest since another 17-point run at Georgia Tech on Jan. 20, 2024
- UVA lead 34-19 at the half, shooting 56.5 percent from the field
- The 19 first-half points by Pitt marked a season low for UVA in ACC play
- UVA (10 3-pointers) has made six or more 3-pointers in 21 games
- Virginia is 174-12 all-time when scoring 70 or more points since 2009-10 (6-1 in 2024-25)
- UVA won the rebound battle 33-21

Series Notes

- UVA is 20-6 all-time vs. Pitt in the series that dates to 1957
- UVA is 9-4 against the Panthers in Pittsburgh
- The win ended Pitt's two-game win streak in the series
- UVA has won nine of the last 11 contests in the series
- Virginia has won 16 of the last 19 games against Pitt
- UVA is 13-3 against Pitt since 2013-14 when the Panthers joined the ACC

Player Notes

- Double Figure Scorers: Dai Dai Ames (27), Blake Buchanan (10)
- Ames scored a career-high 27 points
- Ames shot 11 of 16 from the field, including 3 of 6 from 3-point range and 2 of 2 from the foul line
- Ames scored 16 of his points in the first half
- Ames reached double figures for the sixth time (14 career)
- Isaac McKneely (8 points) has made multiple 3-pointers in 16 games
- Blake Buchanan reached double figures for the fifth time (6 career)
- Buchanan added 11 rebounds for his second double-double
- Andrew Rohde (9 points, 9 assists, 7 rebounds) returned to the starting lineup after coming off the bench against Virginia Tech
- Rohde had a career-high nine assists
- Anthony Robinson scored a season-high nine points off the bench
- Elijah Saunders missed his third straight game due to injury
