CAVALIER NOTES

- Virginia is looking to advance to the quarterfinals for the first time since 2019
- The Cavaliers look to advance to the quarterfinals for the 12th time in program history
- Virginia is the 5-seed in the NCAA Championship, the second-straight year earning an overall No. 5 seed. Only the top eight teams earn national seeds. Virginia, as the host team, is the No. 1 seed in the regional
- Duke was the three-seed in the Charlottesville Regional, advancing with a 17-10 against 2-seed James Madison
- Virginia was the No. 7 seed in the eight-team ACC Championship. Duke was the 4-seed
- Virginia is No. 7 in the latest IWLCA rankings. Duke is No. 15
- Sophomore attacker **Madison Alaimo** set the UVA single-game assist record in Friday's 20-6 win against LIU. Alaimo matched her career high with six assists in the first half, adding three more to break the UVA record. Her nine assists also matches the NCAA record for most assists by a player in an NCAA tournament game
- The previous UVA record for assists in a single game was eight, set by Morgan Schwab set March 25, 2024, against Richmond
- Alaimo's nine assists ties Jackie Wolak of Notre Dame for most by a player in an NCAA tournament game. Wolak had nine in a first-round game against Coastal Carolina on May 10, 2024
- With Friday's performance, Alaimo raised her assists per game average to 3.22, ranking seventh in the NCAA. Her 58 assists ranks fifth
- Alaimo also scored two goals against the Sharks, giving her 11 points, the third most in a single game in program history. The record is 14, set by Debbie Easter in 1982
- Alaimo is the second Cavalier second-year to set a program record this year. Midfielder **Kate Galica** set the UVA single-game record for draw controls (17) and the single-season record in the regular-season finale against Virginia Tech
- Galica had 12 draw controls against LIU, her 11th double-digit draw game of the year. She ranks 10th in the nation (No. 1 in the ACC) at 9.56 draws per game
- Sophomore attacker **Jenna DiNardo** had six points against LIU with four goals and two assists. DiNardo also won a career-high 7 draw controls
- Sophomore attacker **Addi Foster** had her 10th hat trick of the season against LIU. Foster is the only Cavalier to have contributed points in every game this season
- Virginia dominated the draw on Friday, winning 23 of 28 draws. DiNardo and Galica combined to win 17 of those

NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP

- Virginia is the No. 5 seed in the NCAA Championship, marking the same seed as last season
- The Cavaliers are set to make their 29th consecutive appearance in the NCAA Women's Lacrosse Championship
- UVA has played the second-most games in the NCAA Women's Lacrosse Championship appearing in 74 contests.
- Virginia owns the third-most wins in the NCAA Women's Lacrosse Championship with 41
- Virginia is hosting first and second round matchups for the third time since 2019
- This is UVA's 37th overall appearance in the NCAA tournament and owns a 40-33 overall record in the tournament
- The Cavaliers have been crowned NCAA champions three times (1991, 1993, 2004)
- The winner of the Charlottesville bracket will face the winner of the Gainesville (Florida) bracket in the NCAA Quarterfinals. The game will be played on the home field of the highest remaining seed
- The NCAA Semifinals and Finals will be held May 23-25 at Gillette Stadium in Foxborough, Mass.

UVA VS DUKE

- In the regular-season meeting, the Cavaliers trailed by as many as seven points in the first half and were down 9-4 at halftime, but outscored the Blue Devils 10-1 in the third quarter to take a 14-10 lead into the final period of play, holding on for the 16-11 victory
- Duke opened the game on a 6-0 run, holding the Cavaliers scoreless for the entire first period. Sophomore midfielder Kate Galica ended the drought, scoring 36 seconds into the second quarter. Duke answered with back-to-back goals, putting the Cavaliers down 8-1 with 10:52 left in the first half, the largest lead of the game for the Blue Devils. Duke led 9-3 heading into the final minute of the period. Manalang scored with 23 seconds remaining to cut the deficit to 9-4 at the break.
- Sophomore attacker Addi Foster ignited the Cavalier offense in the second half, scoring 32 seconds into the period, the first of four goals for the Cavaliers in the opening 3:30 of the period. Another Foster goal pulled the Cavaliers to within one, 9-8, with 11:34 remaining in the third. Manalang tied the game 10-10 with 5:49 left in the third, with Galica giving UVA its first lead 90 seconds later. A free position goal by DiNardo in the final minute was the 10th goal for the Cavaliers in the period who went into the fourth with a 14-10 lead.
- Freshman Gabby LaVerghetta capped what ended up being a 7-0 scoring run with a goal 4:39 into the fourth quarter, putting UVA ahead 15-10. It was her first career goal
- Virginia outshot Duke 21-5 in the second half
- Duke was 0-of-8 on free-position shots

ACC MIDFIELDER OF THE YEAR

- **Kate Galica** was named the 2025 ACC Midfielder of the Year. Galica is the first Cavalier to earn a positional player of the year conference accolade since the ACC split the previous Player of the Year award into separate honors. In 2012, the conference started awarding Offensive and Defensive Player of the Year. In 2017, the ACC began voting for the Attacker of the Year, Midfielder of the Year and Defender of the Year. In 2024, a fourth award, the Goalkeeper of the Year, was added.
- Peggy Boutilier (1998) and Amy Appelt (2004) both earned the ACC Player of the Year award when it was the sole award

1*15*41 AWARD

- Senior goalkeeper **Abby Jansen** was voted this year's recipient of the 1*15*41 award, presented to the UVA student-athlete across all sports and genders who best displayed selflessness, commitment, school pride, and leadership, all while contributing to the betterment of the team

ALL-ACC

- Attacker **Madison Alaimo** and midfielde **Kate Galica** were named to the First Team
- Attacker **Jenna DiNardo** was named to the Second Team
- This is the first time any have been named to the All-ACC team. All three were named to the 2024 All-ACC Freshman Team with Galica voted the ACC Freshman of the Year
- The conference 'of the year' awards will be announced at a later date

UVA IN THE IWLCA RANKINGS

- Virginia is one of five programs in the NCAA to be ranked at least once in every year of the IWLCA Coaches Poll. The poll was created in 1988, with Dartmouth, Maryland, Penn State and Princeton joining Virginia as the only programs to be nationally ranked every year.
- Of those five programs, Virginia is the only program to be ranked in every week of the IWLCA coaches poll, a span of 290-straight polls.
- Of those 292 polls, the Cavaliers have been ranked among the top-10 in the nation on 248 occasions, the second-most among all NCAA programs.
- The Cavaliers have spent 15 weeks ranked No. 1, including the entire 1993 season
- Virginia debuted at No. 7 in the inaugural coaches poll on March 19, 1988. While the Cavaliers have climbed to a No. 1 ranking, the farthest they have ever fallen was to No. 19 on April 23, 2013. Virginia has only spent five weeks ranked outside the top-15.



HEAD COACH SONIA LAMONICA



LaMonica took over UVA's storied program for the 2023-24 season after serving as the head women's lacrosse coach at Towson for 13 seasons and one season at Mt. Saint Mary's. LaMonica enters her second season in charge of the Cavalier program in 2025 owning an all-time coaching record of 162-105.

LaMonica and her team cruised to a 14-6 victory over Liberty in her first game in charge and would go on to win nine of the first 10 games of the season—Virginia's best start to a campaign since the 2007 national runner-up season.

The Cavaliers would go on to stockpile some of the best wins of any team in the country including a road victory over No. 4 Notre Dame, and emphatic dispatching of No. 7 James Madison at home, and a thrilling overtime win over No. 3 Boston College on senior day.

Virginia went 6-3 in ACC play matching a single season program-high for wins in conference play while taking down the likes of Boston College for the first time in eight seasons. The pair of wins over opponents ranked in the top-four marked the first time Virginia accomplished such a feat in nine seasons. The Cavaliers would eventually avenge their regular-season loss to North Carolina with a 13-12 victory in the ACC quarterfinals—their first win over UNC since the 2014 season. UVA reached the ACC Semifinal before falling to Syracuse.

The Cavaliers earned the fifth overall seed in the NCAA Women's Lacrosse Championship, its highest since the 2008 season when Virginia was seeded fourth. The Cavaliers earned the right to host the first two rounds of the tournament for the first time since the 2019 season. The first round featured a 21-6 dispatching of LIU in which Virginia set a program record for most goals scored in an NCAA tournament game. The Cavaliers fell to No. 10 Florida in the second round of the championship.

LaMonica was named ACC Co-Coach of the Year, sharing the honor with former collegiate teammate Acacia Walker-Weinstein of Boston College. Five Cavaliers were named to the All-ACC teams while three were named to the All-Freshman team including ACC freshman of the Year Kate Galica.

Prior to Virginia

During her tenure at Towson, LaMonica led the Tigers to seven NCAA Tournament appearances and four Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) Tournament Championships. She has been named the CAA Coach of the Year five times.

Towson finished first or second in the CAA in 10 of her 14 seasons at the helm and made nine CAA tournament championship game appearances, including six-straight. LaMonica has coached six players to All-America honors and has had numerous All-CAA and All-Region honorees.

LaMonica consistently challenged her teams with tough schedules against top-ranked opponents. Towson finished .500 or better in 12 of the 14 seasons she oversaw the program, with one of the two being cut short due to the pandemic.

A native of Darlington, South Australia, LaMonica (pronounced La – MAHN – ick – uh) was named the 10th head coach in the history of the Towson women's lacrosse program after the 2010 season. She returned to lead the Tigers after a one-year stint as the head coach at Mount St. Mary's.

As the Mountaineers' head coach, LaMonica led Mount St. Mary's to an 8-9 record in 2010 and a berth in the Northeast Conference (NEC) semifinals. She coached five players who earned All-NEC honors.

Prior to becoming the Mountaineers' head coach, LaMonica spent two seasons as a member of Missy Doherty's staff at Towson and helped the Tigers win a pair of Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) championships.

Before joining the Tigers' staff, LaMonica was an assistant coach at the University of Denver, helping the Pioneers to a 15-5 record during the 2006 season. She coached the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation (MPSF) Player and Rookie of the Year along with three all-conference selections and the program's first IWLCA All-West/Midwest region honoree.

LaMonica also served as head coach of the Women's Professional Lacrosse League's (WPLL) Baltimore Brave. LaMonica led the Brave to the league championship in 2019 and guided the team to the title game in the inaugural season a year earlier.

In addition to her success as a coach, LaMonica is a member of the Australian National Team. She helped Australia win the gold medal at the 2005 World Cup Championship and a silver medal at the 2009 World Cup Championship. In the summer of 2013, LaMonica played a key role in helping Australia earn a bronze medal at the World Cup Championship in Canada.

Named to the 2005 IFWLA All-World Team, she was also a member of the U-19 Australian National Team that won the silver medal at the 1999 World Championships and was also the recipient of the U21 South Australian Sportswoman of the Year award.

A 2003 graduate of Maryland, LaMonica was a three-year starter for the Terrapins. She earned first team All-America honors and was a candidate for the Tewaaraton Trophy during her senior season after leading Maryland to the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) championship. A team captain during her senior season, she was a member of three ACC championship teams and helped the Terrapins win the 2000 and 2001 NCAA titles.

LaMonica scored 111 goals in her college career, including 49 goals as a senior, along with 55 assists.
