MATCHUP AT A GLANCE

• Saturday's matchup with Virginia will be the 106th overall meeting between the two schools with the Hokies holding a 62-38-5 advantage in a series that dates to 1895.

• The Commonwealth Cup has been awarded to the winner of the annual game since 1996.

• The Hokies have won four in a row against their rivals, and 23 of the last 25 contests.

• Tech won 15 in a row from 2004 to 2018, claiming the longest winning streak in the series.

• The Hokies have a record of 19-1 against Virginia as members of the ACC.

• Tech won the last meeting 37-17 in the 2024 season, led by Pop Watson who threw for 254 yards and a touchdown while rushing for another score, helping the Hokies achieve bowl eligibility.

• The Hokies have won 25 of the 46 meetings in Charlottesville, including a 55-17 decision to end the 2023 regular season.

• The last time the Hokies and 'Hoos met when both teams were ranked was in 2011. Tech was #6 while UVA was #24, and the Hokies pitched a 38-nothing shutout in Charlottesville.

• The last time Virginia was ranked and Tech was not was in 1991, when #20 UVA blanked the Hokies 38-nothing at Scott Stadium.

• The Hokies and Cavaliers have met 23 times at neutral sites, including Roanoke (17 times), Richmond, and Norfolk (three times each).

• Virginia Tech Assistant Head Coach/Offensive Recruiting Coordinator/Wide Receivers Coach, Fontel Mines was a four-year letterwinner as a wide receiver at the University of Virginia, Mines caught 68 passes in his career for 737 yards with five touchdowns from 2002 to 2006.

► EXIT LIGHT, ENTER HOKIES

WELCOME, JAMES FRANKLIN

• Signaling a new era for Virginia Tech Football, Board of Visitors Rector John Rocovich, President Tim Sands and Director of Athletics Whit Babcock announced the hiring of James Franklin as the next head coach of the Hokies. A proven program-builder with a national reputation for elevating teams to championship contention, Franklin arrives in Blacksburg as a direct result of the collective commitment of the Virginia Tech Board of Visitors, University leadership, and the distinguished Search Committee — all aligned behind an ambitious, Invest to Win vision for the Hokies.

• Franklin brings more than 30 years of coaching experience at the collegiate level, most recently serving as head coach at Penn State. Franklin's career head coaching record is 128-60 and he is one of three active FBS coaches with a 68-plus winning percentage and 14-plus years of head coaching experience. His 104 wins in his 12 seasons as head coach at Penn State are the second most wins in school history.

• During his tenure in State College, Franklin revived the Nittany Lions into a consistent force. Under Franklin's direction, Penn State finished in the top 12 of the final College Football Playoff rankings in seven of the last nine seasons, earned berths in seven New Year's Six bowl games with four wins, and won the 2016 Big Ten Championship.

• Prior to Penn State, Vanderbilt University experienced a record setting transformation on the gridiron under James Franklin's leadership from 2011 through 2013. In three seasons at the helm, Coach Franklin became the first Vanderbilt coach to guide the team to bowl games in each of his first three campaigns. In 2012, the Commodores posted a 9-4 mark, earned entries in both the AP Top 25 and Coaches Polls for the first time since 1948. The nine wins was most since 1915 and the five SEC victories, a feat not achieved by Vanderbilt since 1935. That same season featured the longest winning streak by a Vanderbilt team since 1948, the longest road

winning streak since 1950, and the first home victory over Tennessee in 30 years. Coach Franklin followed with another 9-win season in 2013, including a decisive 41-24 win in the BBVA Compass Bowl, marking the program's first back-to-back 9-win campaigns in school history.

MONTGOMERY LEADING THE HOKIES

• Offensive coordinator Philip Montgomery was named Tech's interim head coach for the remainder of the season on Sept. 14. He coached his 100th game as a head coach against Georgia Tech, and has led the Hokies to a 3-4 record, including a 2-4 start in ACC play.

• The Eastland, Texas native is now in his 32nd year as a coach, spanning a career that includes positions at Houston, Baylor, and Auburn University.

• Montgomery served as the head coach at Tulsa University from 2015-22. His second year in 2016 was his most successful, a season that saw his Golden Hurricane team achieve nine regular season wins and a 55-10 thumping of Central Michigan in the Miami Beach Bowl. The 2016 squad scored an average of 42.4 points per game and put up 50 or more points four times.

• During his time at Baylor (2008-14), Montgomery oversaw the development of the offense in a variety of roles. As the co-offensive coordinator in 2011, the coaching veteran mentored then-Baylor quarterback Robert Griffin III, who won the Heisman Trophy behind 3,998 passing yards and 36 passing touchdowns.

• Montgomery was the head coach at Tulsa who opposed the Hokies' Frank Beamer in the 2015 Independence Bowl won by Tech 55-52 in Beamer's final game as head coach.

KYRON IN COMMAND

• Redshirt senior QB Kyron Drones has tallied nine rushing touchdowns this season, tied for fifth-most in the ACC and second among conference quarterbacks.

- His 16 passing touchdowns rank tied for fifth-most in the ACC.

- Drones is now in 5th place all-time at Virginia Tech in completions with 476.
- The signal caller has accounted for a total of 64 touchdowns in his Tech career, 43 passing, 20 rushing, and a receiving score.

GREENE MEANS GO

- WR Ayden Greene tallied five more receptions for 95 yards against Miami last Saturday, including a 39-yard reception.

- Greene now has 31 receptions this season for 516 yards to lead the Hokies. He is averaging 16.6 yards per reception and his three touchdowns are tied for the team lead.

MARCELLOUS IN MOTION

- RB Marcellous Hawkins has been the Hokies' most productive running back in 2025. Hawkins has tallied 118 carries for 749 yards and a touchdown for an average of 6.3 yards a carry.

- His 101-yard outing at Florida State was his second 100-yard rushing effort of the season.

- Hawkins has recorded 23 runs of 10+ yards this season, and 12 of more than 15 yards.

- The transfer from Central Missouri has forced 44 missed tackles and gained 562 yards after first contact.

- Hawkins has also registered 12 receptions out of the backfield for 86 yards and a touchdown through 11 games.

- The Hokies have 2,070 rushing yards on the season, averaging 188.2 yards per game, ranking third in the ACC after rushing for 194 against Miami, who was only allowing 81 rushing yards per game coming in.

- Since Philip Montgomery took over as interim coach, Tech hasn't had fewer than 152 rushing yards in a game.

UNLEASH THE HULK

- DT Kemari Copeland is known for his weight room exploits but has emerged as a disruptor on the defensive line.

- Copeland added another six tackles against Miami.

- Against Cal, the Virginia Beach, Virginia native became the first Tech defensive tackle to have at least three sacks in a game since his position coach, J.C. Price, had four sacks vs. Miami in 1995.

- Copeland was named the ACC Defensive Lineman of the Week for his efforts against Cal.

- He leads the Hokies with 4.5 sacks and 7.0 TFLs.

IN LOVE WE TRUST

- Virginia Tech placekicker John Love now has 54 field goals in his career, spanning 63 attempts for a make percentage of 85.7.

- The redshirt junior ranks sixth all-time in scoring at Virginia Tech with 275 points and has made 113 straight PAT attempts, never missing in college.

- The product of Spartanburg, South Carolina, was named to the Lou Groza Award watch list this summer.

- Love has made five field goals of 50 yards or longer in his career, including two this season.

SPENCER STRONG

- LB Kaleb Spencer registered six more tackles against Miami.

- The Miami transfer's 60 stops this season (28 solo) lead the way. Spencer also has 8.0 TFLs and a half sack.

HUISMAN TROPHY

- North Dakota State transfer DT Kody Huisman had his best outing as a Hokie against California, recording four tackles and the highest *PFF* defensive score of his career at 84.8 in 39 defensive snaps.

- Huisman followed that up with another solid performance against Louisville by making back-to-back stuffs on third- and fourth-down runs late in the first half.

- Huisman turned in another outstanding effort against FSU with a *PFF* score of 71.8 and continues to grade out as one of the Hokies best defensive linemen.

SCORING STREAK IS ALIVE

- Virginia Tech's 17-point game against Miami marked the 394th consecutive game during which the Hokies have scored.

- On both the active and all-time lists, Virginia Tech's current streak ranks as the fourth longest.

- During the Hokies' scoring streak, they have shut out their opponent 34 times.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Like Antwaun Powell-Ryland, Kelvin Gilliam and Kaleb Spencer before them, four members of Virginia Tech's 2025 transfer class have returned home to the Commonwealth of Virginia after starting their careers out of state:

- **S - Jordan Bass (Hampton, Va.):** Spent the past two seasons at Pitt, where he played in 19 games, recording 25 tackles, 5.5 TFLs and a sack. Bass is a former four-star recruit and was the No. 4 player from Virginia in the Class of 2023 according to *247Sports*.

- **S - Sherrod Covil (Chesapeake, Va.):** Arrives in Blacksburg following three seasons at Clemson. The senior played in 32 games with the Tigers, registering 36 tackles (14 solo), 1.0 TFL and a pass breakup. Covil was a top-10 player from Virginia in the Class of 2022.
- **DL - Immanuel Hickman Sr. (Chesterfield, Va.):** Joins Virginia Tech after starting his career at East Carolina, playing in 31 games through three seasons, making 16 starts. Hickman spent the 2023 and 2024 seasons at South Florida where he saw action in 14 games with the Bulls.

- **WR - Cameron Seldon (Browns Store, Va.):** Spent the previous two seasons at Tennessee, playing in 19 games at running back (despite making the move to wide receiver). Seldon carried the ball 48 times for the Volunteers, totaling 224 rushing yards and a touchdown, averaging 5.1 yards per carry during the 2024 season. The junior was the top ranked player from Virginia in the Class of 2023 according to *247Sports*.

TRUE FRESHMEN IN THE MIX

- Through 11 games in 2025, 12 true freshman have taken the field for the Hokies, including LB Noah Chambers, DL Zeke Chinwike, LB Brett Clatterbaugh, OL Gavin Crawford, CB Jojo Crim, CB Jahmari DeLoatch, OL Christian Evans, CB Knahlij Harrell, S Brennan Johnson, RB Jeffrey Overton, WR Shamarius Peterkin, and S Sheldon Robinson.

- Chambers has tallied 36 tackles in seven games, making his fifth start against Miami. He also has a sack, two QB hurries and two pass breakups.

- Robinson has 20 tackles in seven games, including 1.0 TFL.

OVERTON MAKES DEBUT

- Highly touted RB Jeffrey Overton made his Hokie debut against Louisville after suffering a knee injury during January bowl prep.

- Overton garnered four carries for nine yards against the Cardinals.

- Overton registered three carries for 15 yards against

Florida State and hauled in a 36-yard reception on a swing pass to setup a touchdown.

- Overton's most productive outing came last Saturday against Miami. He registered seven carries for 69 yards and a 38-yard touchdown run, the first of his career.

- The Woodbridge, Virginia product is a former 4-star recruit who rushed for more than 8,000 yards, winning two state championships.

GOOD WORKS NOMINEE

TYSON FLOWERS

Safety **Tyson Flowers** has been nominated for the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team, and is on the watch list for the Wuerffel Trophy, college football's highest community service honor.

The Allstate AFCA Good Works Team is comprised of 22 college football student-athletes and one honorary head coach who make outstanding contributions in the areas of volunteerism and civic involvement, 11 of which are FBS players. These individuals embody the true spirit of teamwork and giving back through commendable acts of kindness. The Allstate Wuerffel Trophy is presented to the FBS player who best combines exemplary community service with leadership achievement on and off the field.

Flowers, from Fort Worth, Texas, transferred this offseason to Virginia Tech from Rice where he played in 10 games, making 38 tackles, recording two interceptions, two breakups and a forced fumble en route to being named All-AAC Honorable Mention by College Football Network.

During his time in Blacksburg, Flowers has embraced the university's **Ut Prosim** motto, "That I may serve," making a positive impact in the New River Valley and surrounding area. Among his efforts he has volunteered with Night to Shine, a program of the Tim Tebow Foundation that provides a prom-night experience for people with special needs, ages 14 and older. Tyson's role involved greeting guests, assisting with activities, and ensuring each participant felt celebrated and included throughout the night.

Flowers has also given his time to visit students at Pulaski County Schools and created Valentine's Day cards for patients at Warm Hearth Village Senior Living and Carilion Children's Hospital, in addition to volunteering for the Ronald McDonald House of SW Virginia. He helped celebrate their annual "Tab Top" recycling event, by greeting families, signing autographs and inspiring young fans. The event allows elementary schools and local businesses to collect aluminum tab tops from any container (soda pop, soup, pet food, etc.) and work with a local recycling company to turn those tabs into money for families of hospitalized children.

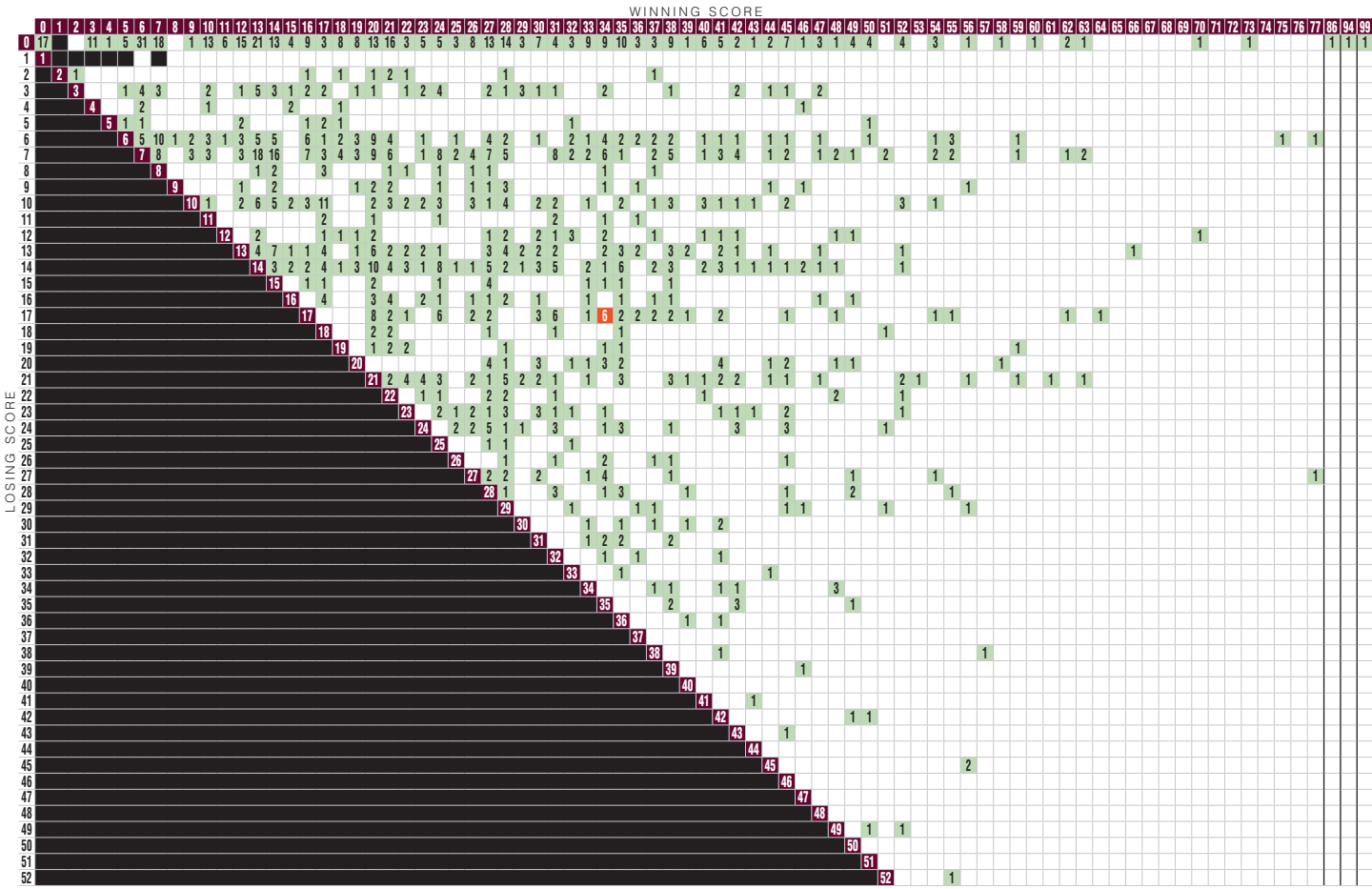

What is Scorigami?
Scorigami is the art of building final scores that have never happened before. The concept was thought of by Jon Bois who sought to find unique scores in NFL history. In this case, we use it to see how often a score or range of points scored occurs, essentially creating a heat map of results across Virginia Tech football's history. Each data point is the final score of a Virginia Tech football game.

How do I read this chart?
The winning team's score is along the top (horizontal axis) and the losing team's score is along the left (vertical axis). Scores marked in green have happened, scores in white have not yet happened, scores in black are impossible. The bottom half is all black because the losing team can not score more points than the winning team. The orange square is the most recent game. The numbers inside the squares are the amount of times that score has happened. The higher the number in the square, the more common the score.

The Hokies have scored in the first quarter **287** times during the streak, and have had it extended by halftime in **374** of the **394** games.
