**FOR OPENERS**

- UVA meets Butler for the second time and first since 2016.
- UVA has scored 80+ points in its first five games for the first time since in school history.
- Ryan Odom is the first UVA coach to start his tenure 5-0, surpassing the Cavaliers' first coach Henry Lannigan who started 4-0 in 1905-06.
- UVA ranks fourth nationally in offensive rebounds per game (18.2), fifth in rebound margin (16.4), seventh in blocks per game (7.4), 11th in rebounds per game (46.6) and 24th in scoring margin (24.4).
- UVA made 30 free throws (36 attempts) against Northwestern for the first time since sinking 31 vs. Tennessee (3/18/07).
- Thijs De Ridder has tallied four 20-point games, including a career-high 26 vs. Northwestern on Nov. 21.

**HOW ARE THESE CAVALIERS?**

- The 2025-26 roster is highlighted by 12 newcomers, including Dallin Hall (BYU), Malik Thomas (San Francisco), Devin Tillis (UC Irvine), Jacari White (North Dakota State), Ugonna Onyenso (Kansas State), Sam Lewis (Toledo) and Martin Carrere (VCU).
- UVA added European imports Thijs De Ridder (Bilbao Basket), Johann Grünloh (RASTA Vechta) and true freshmen Silas Barksdale (Woodside High School), Chance Mallory (St. Anne's Belfield) and Owen Odom (Collegiate School).
- Redshirt sophomores Elijah Gertrude, Carter Lang and Desmond Roberts are the lone returners from last year's team.
- UVA returned four points (all from Roberts) from 2024-25.
- De Ridder leads four players averaging double figures at 19 ppg, followed by Thomas (12.4 ppg), Mallory (11.4 ppg) and Lewis (10.4 ppg).
- Grünloh leads the team in rebounding (7.4 rpg) and blocks (3.8 bpg), while Hall has a team-best 4.6 assists per game.
- UVA is averaging 89.2 points per game and limiting its opponents to 64.8 ppg.

**CRASH THE GLASS**

- UVA has 49 or more rebounds in four games and has enjoyed a +16.4 rebound margin.
- UVA out-rebounded Hampton (49-25), NCCU (48-34), Rider (49-32), Marshall (38-35) and Northwestern (49-25).
- UVA has 20 or more offensive rebounds in three games, including 20 or more in back-to-back games (Rider and NCCU) for the first time since November of 2007 (25 at Penn and 20 against Seton Hall).

**THE VIRGINIA STANDARD**

- The Virginia Standard is to pursue excellence and is built on the six pillars of humility, passion, unity, servanthood, thankfulness and accountability.
- We play with pace, share the basketball and our defensive style is to dictate and disrupt.

**LAST TIME OUT**

- Thijs De Ridder scored 26 points and Chance Mallory scored 16 points off the bench to lead Virginia to an 83-78 win over Northwestern on Nov. 21 at the Skechers Greenbrier Tip-Off.
- UVA rallied from a 55-48 deficit to secure its fifth straight win.
- Malik Thomas (14) and Dallin Hall (11) also reached double figures and Sam Lewis chipped in nine points.
- De Ridder and Mallory each had eight rebounds as UVA out-rebounded Northwestern 49-25, including 21 offensive boards.

**NEW SHERIFF IN TOWN**

- Ryan Odom was named the University of Virginia's Dean and Markel Families Men's Head Basketball Coach on March 22.
- He spent the last two seasons at VCU, leading the Rams to a 52-21 record and 2025 NCAA Tournament berth.
- VCU won the 2025 Atlantic-10 Tournament and shared the A-10 regular-season championship.
- UVA is Odom's fifth stint as a collegiate head coach. In 12 seasons, he has compiled a record of 224-127, including stops at Utah State (2021-23), UMBC (2017-2021), Lenoir-Rhyne (2016), Charlotte (2015, interim).
- Odom led UMBC, Utah State and VCU to the NCAA Tournament during his second season at those schools.
- Odom coached UMBC to an upset against Virginia in 2018 NCAA Tournament, marking the first time a No. 16 seed defeated a No. 1 seed in the event's history.

**LET IF FLY**

- Virginia is averaging 28 3-point attempts per game.
- UVA attempted 30 or more 3-pointers in back-to-back games (Rider and NCCU) for the first time since March of 2021 (Syracuse and Ohio).
- UVA's 36 3-point attempts vs. NC Central were its most since 38 against Virginia Tech on Feb. 10, 2018.
- UVA is shooting 35.7 percent (50 of 140) from 3-point range.
- Jacari White, Malik Thomas and Sam Lewis lead the team with nine 3-pointers each, while Dallin Hall and Chance Mallory have eight and seven 3-pointers, respectively.

BLOCK PARTY

- Johann Grünloh and Ugonna Onyenso have provided elite rim protection for UVA.
- Grünloh leads UVA with 3.8 blocks per game, while Onyenso has averaged 2.0 blocks.
- Onyenso and Grünloh each had four blocks against Hampden, marking the first time since Dec. 22, 1998, a pair of UVA teammates each had four or more blocks (Kris Hunter 5, Chris Williams 4).
- Grünloh's seven blocks against NC Central were most for a UVA player since Ryan Dunn had seven vs. Wake Forest on Feb. 17, 2024.
- Grünloh's seven blocks were most by a Cavalier freshman since Jason Clark's eight blocks vs. VMI on Jan. 24, 2002.
- Grünloh has two or more blocks in each game.

VIRGINIA VS. THE BIG EAST CONFERENCE

- UVA meets its only BIG EAST Conference member of 2025-26.
- The Cavalier went 1-1 vs. the BIG EAST in 2024-25, defeating Villanova 70-60 and falling to St. John's 80-55.
- UVA is 30-38 all-time against current BIG EAST Conference members (11-12 vs. Georgetown, 6-3 vs. Villanova, 5-3 vs. Providence, 3-1 vs. Marquette, 2-6 vs. UConn, 1-0 vs. Butler, 1-2 vs. Xavier, 1-8 vs. St. John's, 0-2 vs. DePaul and 0-3 vs. Seton Hall).

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 260-63 (.805), including a 4-0 mark in 2025-26, in 20 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- UVA is 44-10 in its last 54 home contests.
- UVA is 108-11 in non-league action at JPJ since 2009-10.
- UVA has won 10+ home games for 16 straight seasons.

WINNING WAYS

- Devin Tillis, Dallin Hall, Martin Carrere, Malik Thomas and Jacari White competed on teams that won 21 or more games in 2024-25.
- Tillis led the way with 32 wins at UC Irvine followed by Hall with 26 at BYU. Carrere was part of the 26-win team at VCU, while Thomas won 25 at San Francisco and White 21 at North Dakota State.

OTHER SEASON STORYLINES

- Chance Mallory (Charlottesville), Silas Barksdale (Newport News), Carter Lang (Charlottesville) and Desmond Roberts (Charlottesville) are Virginia natives.
- Mallory, Lang and Roberts played high school basketball at St. Anne's-Belfield School in Charlottesville and were all teammates during the 2022-23 season.
- Ryan Odom's son, Owen Odom, is a freshman on the team, and his father, Dave Odom, served as an assistant coach at Virginia from 1983-89.
- Ryan Odom and UVA associate head coach Griff Aldrich were college teammates at Hampden-Sydney from 1993-96. The duo helped Hampden-Sydney to a 79-31 record and two NCAA tournament appearances.
- Aldrich served as head coach at Longwood University the past seven seasons, posting a 127-100 record along with two Division I NCAA Tournament appearances, two Big South Championships, a Big South regular-season title and three consecutive 20-win campaigns for the first time in team history.

MORE ON THE COACH RYAN ODOM

- Ryan Odom grew up in Charlottesville (third through 10th grades) while his father, Dave Odom, served as an assistant basketball coach on Terry Holland's staff from 1982-89.
- Odom frequently rode his bicycle to practices at University Hall and served as a ball boy for Cavalier home games.
- Odom's start in coaching featured another UVA connection. His first position was as an administrative assistant at South Florida for head coach Seth Greenberg. Greenberg was a one-time Virginia assistant who also coached under Holland.
- When Greenberg first arrived in Charlottesville, he temporarily lived in the Odoms' home. Odom later coached on Greenberg's staff at Virginia Tech (2004-2010).
- Odom was an assistant coach at Charlotte for five seasons (2011-15) and served as the 49ers' interim head coach for the final 19 games of the 2014-15 campaign. In 2013, he helped Charlotte earn a bid to the postseason NIT.
- Prior to his tenure in Charlotte, Odom spent seven years (2004-10) on the coaching staff at Virginia Tech and was part of a Hokie team that earned a berth to the NCAA Tournament in 2007 and beat Illinois in the first round.
- Odom was also an assistant coach at American for three years (2001-03), at UNC Asheville for one season (2000) and at Furman for two years (1998-99). He also served as an administra-

- tive assistant at South Florida for one season (1997).
- Odom graduated from Hampden-Sydney in 1996 with a bachelor's degree in economics and was a four-year starting point guard on the men's basketball team. He served as team captain his senior season and led Hampden-Sydney to an 79-31 record during his playing career, including two berths in the NCAA Division III Tournament.
- In addition, Odom finished his career as the school's all-time leader in 3-pointers made and placed fourth in assists.

WORLDWIDE HOOS

- Virginia's roster features student-athletes from five different countries - Belgium (De Ridder), France (Carrere), Germany (Grünloh), Nigeria (Onyenso) and the United States.

HOOS PUT PREMIUM ON 3-POINT SHOOTING

- Virginia targeted 3-point shooting in the transfer portal with the additions of Sam Lewis, Malik Thomas, Dallin Hall, Devin Tillis, Jacari White and Martin Carrere.
- Lewis (44.4%), Thomas (39.4%), Hall (35.3%), Tillis (39.5%) and White (39.8%) each shot better than 35 percent from 3-point range in 2024-25, while Carrere shot 38.9 percent from 3-point range for Limoges CSP Elite U21 in the Betclic Elite U21 league in France in 2023-24.
- Thijs De Ridder and Johann Grünloh shot 39.1 percent and 33.3 percent, respectively, from 3-point range in 2024-25.
- In 2025-26, Chance Mallory (50%), Lewis (47.4%), DeRidder (41.7%), White (36%) and Thomas (36%) are each shooting 36 percent or better from distance.

ABOUT THE 2025-26 SCHEDULE

- Four of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the latest AP Top-25 preseason poll (Duke, Louisville, North Carolina, NC State), while Ohio State, Virginia Tech and Stanford received votes.

THOMAS NAMED TO WEST AWARD WATCH LIST

- Virginia's Malik Thomas was one of 20 players named to the preseason watch list for the 2026 Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award on Oct. 28.
- Thomas transferred to Virginia from San Francisco after leading the West Coast Conference in scoring at 19.9 points per game in 2024-25. Thomas shot 44.4 percent from the field, 39.4 percent from 3-point range and 85.1 percent from the free throw line. He reached double figures in 31 of 34 games and ended the season with a career-high 36 points in an NIT second round contest against Loyola Chicago.
- Players can play their way onto and off the list at any point in the 2025-26 season. In late January, the watch list of 20 players for the 2026 Jerry West Award will be narrowed to 10, and then in late February, to just five. In March, the five finalists will be presented to West's family and the Hall of Fame's selection committee to determine the winner.

UVA PICKED FIFTH IN THE ACC FOR SECOND STRAIGHT YEAR

- UVA was selected fifth in the 2025-26 ACC Preseason Poll.
- Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by Louisville, North Carolina, NC State and Virginia.
- ACC preseason voters selected SMU sixth, followed by Clemson, Miami, Syracuse and Notre Dame. Wake Forest was picked 11th, while Virginia Tech, Georgia Tech, Pitt, Florida State, Cal, Stanford and Boston College rounded out the voting.
- The Cavaliers were selected fifth in the 2024-25 ACC Preseason Poll and tied for ninth (8-12) in the standings.
- The Cavaliers have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in 14 of the last 17 seasons.

SUPER 70s AND AWESOME 80s

- Virginia is 182-13 when scoring 70 or more points since 2009-10 (5-0 in 2025-26).
- UVA is 53-1 when scoring 80 or more points (5-0 in 2025-26) since 2009-10 (93-81 loss at UNC in 2012-13).
- UVA has scored 80 or more points in its first five games for the first time in school history.
- UVA scored 80 or more points in five straight games for the first time since seven straight in 2001 (Florida State, Missouri, UNC, Clemson, Maryland, Wake Forest and NC State).

CAVALIERS IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

- Virginia received two votes in the 2025-26 preseason AP Top-25 poll and one vote in the Nov. 17 poll.
- UVA hasn't been ranked in the AP Top-25 since a No. 21 ranking on Feb. 17, 2024.

2024-25 SEASON IN REVIEW

· Virginia finished its 120th season of men's basketball with a 15-17 record and 8-12 mark in the ACC.

· The Cavaliers earned the No. 9 seed in the ACC Tournament and their season ended with the 66-60 loss to No. 8 seed Georgia Tech in the second round.

· Ron Sanchez served as interim head coach after Tony Bennett retired prior to the season. Sanchez was relieved of his duties after the ACC Tournament loss to Georgia Tech.

· UVA's Isaac McKneely was named All-ACC Honorable Mention and NABC All-District East Second Team after leading the Cavaliers in scoring at 14.4 points per game.
