FOR OPENERS

· UVA meets Northwestern for the first time since 2007.

UVA has scored 80+ points in its first four games for the first time since 2006 (Arizona, Morgan St., UNC Asheville and UMES) Ryan Odom is the second UVA coach to start his tenure 4-0, joining Henry Lannigan (1905-06, 4-0).

· UVA ranks fourth nationally in blocks per game (8.1), eighth in offensive rebounds per game (17.5), 14th in field goal percentage defense (34.9%), 16th in scoring margin (29.3), 17th in rebounds per game (46.0) 18th in rebound margin (14.5) and 21st in scoring defense (61.5).

HOO ARE THESE CAVALIERS?

·The 2025-26 roster is highlighted by 12 newcomers, including Dallin Hall (BYU), Malik Thomas (San Francisco), Devin Tillis (UC Irvine), Jacari White (North Dakota State), Ugonna Onyenso (Kansas State), Sam Lewis (Toledo) and Martin Carrere (VCU).

· UVA added European imports Thijs De Ridder (Bilbao Basket), Johann Grünloh (RASTA Vechta) and true freshmen Silas Barksdale (Woodside High School), Chance Mallory (St. Anne's Belfield) and Owen Odom (Collegiate School).

· Redshirt sophomores Elijah Gertrude, Carter Lang and Desmond Roberts are the lone returners from last year's team.

UVA returned four points (all from Roberts) from 2024-25.

· De Ridder leads five players averaging double figures at 17.3 ppg, followed by Thomas (12 ppg), Lewis (10.8 ppg), Grünloh (10.3 ppg) and Mallory (10.3 ppg).

· Grünloh leads the team in rebounding (7.5 rpg) and blocks (4.3 bpg), while Hall has a team-best 5.5 assists per game. · UVA is averaging 90.8 points per game and limiting its opponents to 61.5 ppg.

THE VIRGINIA STANDARD

·The Virginia Standard is to pursue excellence and is built on the six pillars of humility, passion, unity, servanthood, thankfulness and accountability.

· We play with pace, share the basketball and our defensive style is to dictate and disrupt.

LAST TIME OUT

·Thijs De Ridder scored 23 points to lead Virginia to an 104-78 win over Marshall on Nov. 15 at John Paul Jones Arena.

· Dallin Hall and Malik Thomas each added 18 points as UVA scored its most points since dropping 107 vs. VMI in 2008.

· UVA matched a JPJ record with 61 points in the first half.

 Rookie Johann Grünloh chipped in 16 points, seven rebounds and three blocks.

NEW SHERIFF IN TOWN

- · Ryan Odom was named the University of Virginia's Dean and Markel Families Men's Head Basketball Coach on March 22.
- · He spent the last two seasons at VCU, leading the Rams to a 52-21 record and 2025 NCAA Tournament berth.
- ·VCU won the 2025 Atlantic-10 Tournament and shared the A-10 regular-season championship.
- · UVA is Odom's fifth stint as a collegiate head coach. In 12 seasons, he has compiled a record of 224-127, including stops at Utah State (2021-23), UMBC (2017-2021), Lenoir-Rhyne (2016), Charlotte (2015, interim).
- Odom led UMBC, Utah State and VCU to the NCAA Tournament during his second season at those schools.
- · Odom coached UMBC to an upset against Virginia in 2018 NCAA Tournament, marking the first time a No. 16 seed defeated a No. 1 seed in the event's history.

ALL-TIME VS. NORTHWESTERN

· Virginia holds a 3-0 advantage against Northwestern in a series that dates back to 2004-05.

·The teams meet at a neutral site for the first time with all three career meetings coming in the former ACC/Big Ten Challenge.

·The Cavaliers are 2-0 against the Wildcats in Charlottesville and 1-0 in Evanston, III.

· UVA posted a 48-44 win in the inaugural meeting on Dec. 4, 2004 in Evanston.

·The Cavaliers added 72-57 (2005) and 94-52 (2007) home wins in the series.

LAST TIME VS. THE WILDCATS

· Mamadi Diane tallied 22 points and seven rebounds to lead Virginia to a 94-52 win over Northwestern in an ACC/Big Ten Challenge contest on Nov. 27, 2007 at John Paul Jones Arena. · Calvin Baker scored 16 points and Sean Singletary added 14 as UVA drilled 16 3-pointers in the win.

· Michael Thompson scored 14 points for the Wildcats.

CRASH THE GLASS

- · UVA has 48 or more rebounds in three games and has enjoyed a +14.5 rebound margin.
- · UVA out-rebounded Hampton (49-25), NCCU (48-34), Rider (49-32) and Marshall (38-35).
- · UVA grabbed 20 or more offensive rebounds in back-to-back games (Rider and NCCU) for the first time since November of 2007 (25 at Penn and 20 against Seton Hall).

ABOUT THE 2025-26 SCHEDULE

 \cdot Four of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the latest AP Top-25 preseason poll (Duke, Louisville, North Carolina, NC State), while Ohio State, Virginia Tech and Stanford received votes.

LET IF FLY

- · Virginia is averaging 29 3-point attempts per game.
- · UVA attempted 30 or more 3-pointers in back-to-back games (Rider and NCCU) for the first time since March of 2021 (Syra-
- · UVA's 36 3-point attempts vs. NC Central were its most since 38 against Virginia Tech on Feb. 10, 2018.
- · UVA is shooting 38.8 percent (45 of 116) from 3-point range.
- · Jacari White lead the team with nine 3-pointers, while Malik Thomas and Sam Lewis each have eight 3-pointers.

BLOCK PARTY

- · Johann Grünloh and Ugonna Onyenso have provided elite rim protection for UVA.
- · Grünloh leads UVA with 4.3 blocks per game, while Onyenso has averaged 2.5 blocks.
- · Onyenso and Grünloh each had four blocks against Hampton, marking the first time since Dec. 22, 1998, a pair of UVA teammates each had four or more blocks (Kris Hunter 5, Chris Williams 4).
- · Grünloh's seven blocks against NC Central were most for a UVA player since Ryan Dunn had seven vs. Wake Forest on Feb. 17, 2024.
- · Grünloh's seven blocks were most by a Cavalier freshman since Jason Clark's eight blocks vs. VMI on Jan. 24, 2002.
- Grünloh has three or more blocks in each game.

VIRGINIA VS. THE BIG TEN CONFERENCE

- · UVA meets its first Big Ten Conference opponent since Nov. 20, 2023, when the Cavaliers dropped a 65-41 decision to Wisconsin at the Fort Myers Tip-Off in Florida.
- · UVA is 114-135 all-time against current Big Ten opponents (76-105 vs. Maryland, 5-3 vs. Penn State, 5-2 vs. Minnesota, 4-0 vs. Rutgers, 4-3 vs. Wisconsin, 3-0 vs. Nebraska, 3-0 vs. Oregon, 3-2 vs. Michigan, 3-3 vs. Ohio State, 2-2 vs. Purdue, 1-0 vs. Illinois, 1-0 vs. USC, 1-1 vs. Washington, 1-2 vs. Indiana, 1-3 vs. Iowa, 0-5 vs. Michigan State, 0-1 vs. Nebraska and 0-1 vs. UCLA).

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- ·Virginia is 259-63 (.804), including a 3-0 mark in 2025-26, in 20 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- · UVA is 43-10 in its last 53 home contests.
- · UVA is 107-11 in non-league action at JPJ since 2009-10.
- · UVA has won 10+ home games for 16 straight seasons.

- · Devin Tillis, Dallin Hall, Martin Carrere, Malik Thomas and Jacari White competed on teams that won 21 or more games in 2024-25.
- ·Tillis led the way with 32 wins at UC Irvine followed by Hall with 26 at BYU. Carrere was part of the 26-win team at VCU, while Thomas won 25 at San Franciso and White 21 at North Dakota

MORE ON THE COACH RYAN ODOM

- · Ryan Odom grew up in Charlottesville (third through 10th grades) while his father, Dave Odom, served as an assistant basketball coach on Terry Holland's staff from 1982-89.
- · Odom frequently rode his bicycle to practices at University Hall and served as a ball boy for Cavalier home games.
- · Odom's start in coaching featured another UVA connection. His first position was as an administrative assistant at South Florida for head coach Seth Greenberg. Greenberg was a one-time Virginia assistant who also coached under Holland.
- · When Greenberg first arrived in Charlottesville, he temporarily lived in the Odoms' home. Odom later coached on Greenberg's staff at Virginia Tech (2004-2010).
- · Odom was an assistant coach at Charlotte for five seasons (2011-15) and served as the 49ers' interim head coach for the final 19 games of the 2014-15 campaign. In 2013, he helped Charlotte earn a bid to the postseason NIT.
- · Prior to his tenure in Charlotte, Odom spent seven years (2004-10) on the coaching staff at Virginia Tech and was part of a Hokie team that earned a berth to the NCAA Tournament in 2007 and beat Illinois in the first round.
- · Odom was also an assistant coach at American for three years (2001-03), at UNC Asheville for one season (2000) and at Furman for two years (1998-99). He also served as an administrative assistant at South Florida for one season (1997).
- · Odom graduated from Hampden-Sydney in 1996 with a bach-

elor's degree in economics and was a four-year starting point guard on the men's basketball team. He served as team captain his senior season and led Hampden-Sydney to an 80-30 record during his playing career, including two berths in the NCAA Division III Tournament.

· In addition, Odom finished his career as the school's all-time leader in 3-pointers made and placed fourth in assists.

UVA PICKED FIFTH IN THE ACC FOR SECOND STRAIGHT YEAR

- · UVA was selected fifth in the 2025-26 ACC Preseason Poll. \cdot Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by Louisville, North Carolina, NC State and Virginia.
- · ACC preseason voters selected SMU sixth, followed by Clemson, Miami, Syracuse and Notre Dame. Wake Forest was picked 11th, while Virginia Tech, Georgia Tech, Pitt, Florida State, Cal, Stanford and Boston College rounded out the voting.
- \cdot The Cavaliers were selected fifth in the 2024-25 ACC Preseason Poll and tied for ninth (8-12) in the standings.
- ·The Cavaliers have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in 14 of the last 17 seasons.

WORLDWIDE HOOS

· Virginia's roster features student-athletes from five different countries - Belgium (De Ridder), France (Carrere), Germany (Grünloh), Nigeria (Onvenso) and the United States.

OTHER SEASON STORYLINES

- · Chance Mallory (Charlottesville), Silas Barksdale (Newport News), Carter Lang (Charlottesville) and Desmond Roberts (Charlottesville) are Virginia natives.
- Mallory, Lang and Roberts played high school basketball at St. Anne's-Belfield School in Charlottesville and were all teammates during the 2022-23 season.
- · Ryan Odom's son, Owen Odom, is a freshman on the team, and his father, Dave Odom, served as an assistant coach at Virginia from 1983-89.
- · Ryan Odom and UVA associate head coach Griff Aldrich were college teammates at Hampden-Sydney from 1993-96. The duo helped Hampden-Sydney to a 79-31 record and two NCAA tournament appearances.
- · Aldrich served as head coach at Longwood University the past seven seasons, posting a 127-100 record along with two Division I NCAA Tournament appearances, two Big South Championships, a Big South regular-season title and three consecutive 20-win campaigns for the first time in team history.

HOOS PUT PREMIUM ON 3-POINT SHOOTING

- $\cdot \mbox{Virginia}$ targeted 3-point shooting in the transfer portal with the additions of Sam Lewis, Malik Thomas, Dallin Hall, Devin Tillis, Jacari White and Martin Carrere.
- · Lewis (44.4%), Thomas (39.4%), Hall (35.3%), Tillis (39.5%) and White (39.8%) each shot better than 35 percent from 3-point range in 2024-25, while Carrere shot 38.9 percent from 3-point range for Limoges CSP Elite U21 in the Betclic Elite U21 league in France in 2023-24.
- ·Thijs De Ridder and Johann Grünloh shot 39.1 percent and 33.3 percent, respectively, from 3-point range in 2024-25.
- · In 2025-26, Chance Mallory (60%), Lewis (53.3%), DeRidder (45.5%) and White (40.9%) are each shooting 40 percent or better from distance.

HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

- · UVA is 118-2, including a 3-0 mark in 2024-25, when limiting foes to fewer than 50 points since 2009-10.
- · UVA is 29-0 when holding foes to fewer than 40 since 2010.

THOMAS NAMED TO WEST AWARD WATCH LIST

- · Virginia's Malik Thomas was one of 20 players named to the preseason watch list for the 2026 Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award on Oct. 28.
- ·Thomas transferred to Virginia from San Francisco after leading the West Coast Conference in scoring at 19.9 points per game in 2024-25. Thomas shot 44.4 percent from the field, 39.4 percent from 3-point range and 85.1 percent from the free throw line. He reached double figures in 31 of 34 games and ended the season with a career-high 36 points in an NIT second round contest against Loyola Chicago.
- · Players can play their way onto and off the list at any point in the 2025-26 season. In late January, the watch list of 20 players for the 2026 Jerry West Award will be narrowed to 10, and then in late February, to just five. In March, the five finalists will be presented to West's family and the Hall of Fame's selection committee to determine the winner.

2024-25 SEASON IN REVIEW

- · Virginia finished its 120th season of men's basketball with a 15-17 record and 8-12 mark in the ACC.
- ·The Cavaliers earned the No. 9 seed in the ACC Tournament and their season ended with the 66-60 loss to No. 8 seed Georgia Tech in the second round.
- · Ron Sanchez served as interim head coach after Tony Bennett retired prior to the season. Sanchez was relieved of his duties after the ACC Tournament loss to Georgia Tech.
- · UVA's Isaac McKneely was named All-ACC Honorable Mention and NABC All-District East Second Team after leading the Cavaliers in scoring at 14.4 points per game.

SUPER 70s AND AWESOME 80s

- · Virginia is 181-13 when scoring 70 or more points since 2009-10 (4-0 in 2025-26).
- · UVA is 52-1 when scoring 80 or more points (4-0 in 2025-26) since 2009-10 (93-81 loss at UNC in 2012-13).
- · UVA has scored 80 or more points in four straight games for the first time since 2015 (Bradley, Long Beach State, George Mason and Lehigh)
- · UVA has scored 80 or more points in its first four games for the first time since 2006 (Arizona, Morgan State, UNC Asheville and UMES).

· Reece Beekman (Orlando), Ryan Dunn (Phoenix), Anthony Gill (Washington), Kyle Guy (Indiana), Sam Hauser (Boston), Jay Huff (Indiana), De'Andre Hunter (Cleveland), Ty Jerome (Memphis), Braxton Key (Memphis) and Trey Murphy III (New Orleans) are former Cavaliers who are currently wth NBA organizations in 2025-26.
