- · Virginia begins its 121st season of men's basketball, sporting a 1.760-1.234 (.588) all-time record.
- · UVA is 25-2 in its last 27 season-opening games.
- ·The Cavaliers are 97-23 all-time in 120 season-opening games.
- · UVA is 104-11 at JPJ in non-conference play since 2009-10. · Rider's Maurizio D'Alessandro is a Charlottesville native.
- D'Alessandro played youth basketball with and against UVA's
- Carter Lang, Desmond Roberts and Chance Mallory.
- D'Alessandro's father, Ben, served as a graduate assistant coach at Virginia in 1998-99 under Head Coach Pete Gillen, his coach as a player at Providence.
- \cdot Ryan Odom is 5-5 all-time in season-opening games as a head coach (2-3 at UMBC, 1-1 at Utah State, 1-1 at VCU and 1-0 at Lenoir-Rhyne).

ALL-TIME VS. RIDER

- · Virginia is 1-0 all-time vs. Rider, defeating the Broncs 76-49 at John Paul Jones Arena on Nov. 19, 2009.
- · Mike Scott tallied 17 points on 8 of 9 shooting to lead Virginia.
- · Sammy Zeglinski added 12 points, while Jeff Jones added 11 points and Sylven Landesberg chipped in 10.
- · UVA shot 51.8 percent from the field, went 7 of 16 from 3-point range, and won the rebound battle, 42-27.

NEW SHERIFF IN TOWN

- Ryan Odom was named the University of Virginia's Dean and Markel Families Men's Head Basketball Coach on March 22.
- · Odom became the 13th head coach in the program's history.
 · He spent the last two seasons at VCU, leading the Rams to a
- He spent the last two seasons at VCU, leading the Rams to a 52-21 record and 2025 NCAA Tournament berth.
- · VCU won the 2025 Atlantic-10 Tournament and shared the A-10 regular-season championship.
- · UVA is Odom's fifth stint as a collegiate head coach. Over the past 11 seasons, he has compiled a career record of 222-127, including stops at Utah State (2021-23), UMBC (2017-2021), Lenoir-Rhyne (2016) and Charlotte (2015, interim head coach). · Odom led UMBC, Utah State and VCU to the NCAA Tournament during his second season at those schools.
- He led Lenoir-Rhyne to the NCAA Division II Sweet 16 in 2016.
 Odom coached UMBC to a stunning upset against Virginia in the first round of the 2018 NCAA Tournament in Charlotte, marking the first time a No. 16 seed defeated a No. 1 seed in the event's history.

- ·The 2025-26 roster is highlighted by 12 newcomers, including transfers Dallin Hall (BYU), Malik Thomas (San Francisco), Devin Tillis (UC Irvine), Jacari White (North Dakota State), Ugonna Onyenso (Kansas State), Sam Lewis (Toledo) and Martin Carrere (VCU).
- · UVA added European imports Thijs De Ridder (Bilbao Basket), Johann Grünloh (RASTA Vechta) and true freshmen Silas Barksdale (Woodside High School), Chance Mallory (St. Anne's Belfield) and Owen Odom (Collegiate School).
- · Redshirt sophomores Elijah Gertrude, Carter Lang and Desmond Roberts are the lone returners from last year's team.
- · UVA returns four points (all from Roberts) from 2024-25.

- · Devin Tillis, Dallin Hall, Martin Carrere, Malik Thomas and Jacari White competed on teams that won 21 or more games in 2024-25.
- ·Tillis led the way with 32 wins at UC Irvine followed by Hall with 26 at BYU. Carrere was part of the 26-win team at VCU, while Thomas won 25 at San Franciso and White 21 at North Dakota State.

VIRGINIA VS. THE METRO ATLANTIC ATHLETIC CONFERENCE

- · UVA meets its only MAAC opponent of the season in Rider. · UVA defeated Manhattan 74-65 at John Paul Jones Arena in its last meeting against a MAAC foe during the 2024-25 season.
- · UVA is undefeated against MAAC opponents, sporting a 10-0 all-time record (Canisius 1-0, Fairfield 3-0, Iona 1-0, Manhattan 2-0, Mount St. Mary's 1-0, Rider 1-0, Siena 1-0).

HOOS NET EXHIBITION WIN OVER VILLANOVA

- · UVA defeated Villanova 75-72 in exhibition action on Oct. 24.
- · Malik Thomas led UVA with 16 points and Johann Grünloh added 12 points and eight rebounds.
- ·The Cavaliers went 10 of 26 from 3-point range and won the rebounds battle, 39-32.

MORE ON THE COACH RYAN ODOM

- · Ryan Odom grew up in Charlottesville (third through 10th grades) while his father, Dave Odom, served as an assistant basketball coach on Terry Holland's staff from 1982-89.
- · Odom frequently rode his bicycle to practices at University Hall and served as a ball boy for Cavalier home games.
- · Odom's start in coaching featured another UVA connection. His first position was as an administrative assistant at South Florida for head coach Seth Greenberg. Greenberg was a one-time Virginia assistant who also coached under Holland.
- · When Greenberg first arrived in Charlottesville, he temporarily lived in the Odoms' home. Odom later coached on Greenberg's staff at Virginia Tech (2004-2010).
- · Odom was an assistant coach at Charlotte for five seasons (2011-15) and served as the 49ers' interim head coach for the final 19 games of the 2014-15 campaign. In 2013, he helped Charlotte earn a bid to the postseason NIT.
- · Prior to his tenure in Charlotte, Odom spent seven years (2004-10) on the coaching staff at Virginia Tech and was part of a Hokie team that earned a berth to the NCAA Tournament in 2007 and heat Illinois in the first round.
- · Odom was also an assistant coach at American for three years (2001-03), at UNC Asheville for one season (2000) and at Furman for two years (1998-99). He also served as an administrative assistant at South Florida for one season (1997).
- · Odom graduated from Hampden-Sydney in 1996 with a bachelor's degree in economics and was a four-year starting point guard on the men's basketball team. He served as team captain his senior season and led Hampden-Sydney to an 80-30 record during his playing career, including two berths in the NCAA Division III Tournament.
- · In addition, Odom finished his career as the school's all-time leader in 3-pointers made and placed fourth in assists.

UVA PICKED FIFTH IN THE ACC FOR SECOND STRAIGHT YEAR

- · UVA was selected fifth in the 2025-26 ACC Preseason Poll.
- · Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by Louisville, North Carolina, NC State and Virginia.
- · ACC preseason voters selected SMU sixth, followed by Clemson, Miami, Syracuse and Notre Dame. Wake Forest was picked 11th, while Virginia Tech, Georgia Tech, Pitt, Florida State, Cal, Stanford and Boston College rounded out the voting.
- ·The Cavaliers were selected fifth in the 2024-25 ACC Preseason Poll and tied for ninth (8-12) in the standings.
- ·The Cavaliers have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in 14 of the last 17 seasons.

THOMAS NAMED TO WEST AWARD WATCH LIST

- · Virginia's Malik Thomas was one of 20 players named to the preseason watch list for the 2026 Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award on Oct. 28.
- ·Thomas transferred to Virginia from San Francisco after leading the West Coast Conference in scoring at 19.9 points per game in 2024-25. Thomas shot 44.4 percent from the field, 39.4 percent from 3-point range and 85.1 percent from the free throw line. He reached double figures in 31 of 34 games and ended the season with a career-high 36 points in an NIT second round contest against Loyola Chicago.
- \cdot Players can play their way onto and off the list at any point in the 2025-26 season. In late January, the watch list of 20 players for the 2026 Jerry West Award will be narrowed to 10, and then in late February, to just five. In March, the five finalists will be

· Virginia's roster features student-athletes from five different countries - Belgium (De Ridder), France (Carrere), Germany (Grunloh), Nigeria (Onyenso) and the United States.

OTHER SEASON STORYLINES

- · Chance Mallory (Charlottesville), Silas Barksdale (Newport News), Carter Lang (Charlottesville) and Desmond Roberts (Charlottesville) are Virginia natives.
- · Mallory, Lang and Roberts played high school basketball at St. Anne's-Belfield School in Charlottesville and were all teammates during the 2022-23 season.
- · Ryan Odom's son, Owen Odom, is a freshman on the team, and his father, Dave Odom, served as an assistant coach at Virginia
- · Ryan Odom and UVA assoicate head coach Griff Aldrich were college teammates at Hampden-Sydney from 1993-96. The duo helped Hampden-Sydney to a 79-31 record and two NCAA tournament appearances.
- · Aldrich served as head coach at Longwood Univesity the past seven seasons, posting a 127-100 record along with two Division I NCAA Tournament appearances, two Big South Championships, a Big South regular-season title and three consecutive 20-win campaigns for the first time in team history.

HOOS PUT PREMIUM ON 3-POINT SHOOTING

- · Virginia targeted 3-point shooting in the transfer portal with the additions of Sam Lewis, Malik Thomas, Dallin Hall, Devin Tillis, Jacari White and Martin Carrere.
- · Lewis (44.4%), Thomas (39.4%), Hall (35.3%), Tillis (39.5%) and White (39.8%) each shot better than 35 percent from 3-point range in 2024-25, while Carrere shot 38.9 percent from 3-point range for Limoges CSP Elite U21 in the Betclic Elite U21 league in France in 2023-24.
- ·Thijs De Ridder and Johann Grünloh shot 39.1 percent and 33.3 percent, respectively, from 3-point range in Europe in

2024-25 SEASON IN REVIEW

- · Virginia finished its 120th season of men's basketball with a 15-17 record and 8-12 mark in the ACC.
- ·The Cavaliers earned the No. 9 seed in the ACC Tournament and their season ended with the 66-60 loss to No. 8 seed Georgia Tech in the second round.
- · Ron Sanchez served as interim head coach after Tony Bennett retired prior to the season. Sanchez was relieved of his duties after the ACC Tournament loss to Georgia Tech.
- · UVA's Isaac McKneely was named All-ACC Honorable Mention and NABC All-District East Second Team after leading the Cavaliers in scoring at 14.4 points per game.

SUPER 70s AND AWESOME 80s

- · Virginia is 177-13 all-time when scoring 70 or more points since 2009-10 (9-2 in 2024-25).
- \cdot UVA was 11-0 when scoring 70 or more points in 2023-24. · UVA is 48-1 all-time when scoring 80 or more points (2-0 in 2024-25) since 2009-10 (93-81 loss at UNC in 2012-13).
