CAVALIERS AT THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS

- UVA is making a 10th consecutive appearance at the NCAA Championships.
- Virginia finished 19th at the 2015 NCAA Championships.
- The Cavaliers' best finish in the NCAA Championships under head coach Steve Garland is 15th in 2010.
- George DiCamillo is one of three Cavaliers making his third appearance in the NCAA Championship. DiCamillo appeared in 2013, 2015 and this season. Also making their third appearances are Nick Herrmann at 125 pounds and Zach Nye at 197 pounds.
- Appearing for the second time is Andrew Atkinson at 157 pounds, while Patrick Gillen is making his first appearance at 285 pounds.

UVA AT THE 2015 NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP

- Virginia sent seven wrestlers to the NCAA Tournament in 2015: Herrmann (125), DiCamillo (133), Joe Spisak (141), Atkinson (157), Nick Sulzer (165), Blaise Butler (174) and Nye (197).
- Sulzer finished as an All-American, earning the honor for a third time.
- Virginia finished 19th in the standings with 26.5 points.

DICAMILLO CLIMBING WINS LEDGER

- After repeating as the 133-pound ACC champion, junior George DiCamillo is moving toward the top 15 in all-time wins at Virginia.
- With 8 career wins, Sulzer needs three victories to match current head coach Steve Garland (1996-2000) and Nick Nelson (2007-12) in a three-way tie for 14th on the all-time list at 91 wins.
- A three-time ACC Champion, DiCamillo is 25-3 this year and 88-22 in his career, including a 35-7 mark in UVA duals.

ATKINSON CONTINUES TO THRIVE AT 157 POUNDS

- Lauded as one of the most improved wrestlers last season by head coach Steve Garland, RS-So Andrew Atkinson has continued to thrive in 2015-16.
- After going 15-12 a year ago, Atkinson is 24-9 this season.
- Atkinson claimed the Championship at the Clarion Open to start the season and placed fourth at the Cliff Keen Las Vegas Invitational.

QUICK NOTES

- UVA turned in its best finish in the NCAA Tournament with a 15th-place finish in the 2010 NCAA Championships.
- UVA dropped its final two dual match of the season by less than two points, falling in the final match of the day in each case to lose the dual match.
- UVA finished 4th in the ACC Championship this season, paced by ACC Champion George DiCamillo at 133 pounds and third-place finishers Chris Yankowich at 149 pounds and Tyler Askey at 174 pounds.
- Virginia wrestled one of its toughest schedules in program history, taking on eight ranked opponents; the Cavaliers were 2-6 against ranked foes.
- Virginia has nine Virginia natives on its roster – its most of any state.

CAVALIERS LOOKING TO IMPROVE ON 2015

- With four wrestlers making a return trip to the NCAA Championship in 2016, the Cavaliers are looking to build on last year's appearance.
- DiCamillo is the highest seed for UVA at sixth at 133 pounds and went 2-2 last season. He was a 12 seed in 2015.
- Nye and Atkinson both look to rebound from tough 2015 appearances that saw both wrestlers go 0-2. Nye ran into Mogan McIntosh of Penn State early in the bracket and also fell to Jake Smith of West Virginia. Nye is the 14 seed at 197 pounds.
- Herrmann also went 2-2 in the 2015 NCAA Championship and looks to build on that outing in his final season.

DICAMILLO LOOKS TO BREAK THROUGH

- With his highest seed at No. 6 in this year's event, George DiCamillo is looking to break through to All-America status.
- DiCamillo went 2-2 in 2015, narrowly missing All-America status as a redshirt sophomore.
- UVA has had an All-American in six of the last seven seasons.

DICAMILLO CONTINUES COMEBACK

- After missing the 2013-14 season with injuries, George DiCamillo bounced back for a great 2014-15 season. He has continued that excellence in 2015-16.
- He is 27-3 on the year, including a 4-0 mark in ACC duals (he missed the finale at No. 24 Pitt).
- DiCamillo was the 2013 ACC champion at 133 pounds as a true freshman. He was UVA's first ACC champion since Joe Alexander won the 133-pound title in 2002.
- DiCamillo followed that up as the 2015 ACC champion at 133 pounds in 2014-15 after missing the previous year and repeated as ACC Champion this season.

CHALLENGING SCHEDULE CONTINUES

- Virginia has seen its share of quality opponents this season, starting with a strong fall and closing with a solid ACC schedule.
- In addition to wrestling one in one of the nation's best tournaments, the Southern Scuffle, Virginia faced eight ranked teams in its 13 duals. A ninth squad, Chattanooga,

has been in and out of the rankings, though it wasn't ranked at the time of the match.

- UVA started the dual season with back-to-back matches at No. 25 North Dakota State and No. 24 Minnesota, splitting those contests. UVA also wrestled at No. 5 Ohio State and came home to face No. 15 Old Dominion. Virginia was 2-2 in those contests.
- The spring saw UVA face four more nationally-ranked teams in ACC play, dropping two in the last bout of the day.

NYE PUSHES TOWARD MASTERS DEGREE

- Zach Nye slated to earn degrees in Higher Education/Administration from UVA's Curry School of Education, continuing a tradition established under Steve Garland.
- Since 2008, 23 Cavaliers have earned master's degrees.

ALL-AMERICA COACHING STAFF

- Virginia's coaching staff consists of three former All-Americans, including a pair of national champions.
- Head coach Steve Garland was the national runner-up at 125 pounds in 2000.
- Assistant coach Jordan Leen was the 2008 national champion at 157 pounds for Cornell.
- Second-year assistant coach Keith Gavin was the 2008 national champ at 174 for Pitt. He remains active in wrestling and is a member of the U.S. National Freestyle Wrestling Team.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH STEVE GARLAND

- Head coach Steve Garland is in his 10th year at the helm of his alma mater.
- In his tenure Garland has posted an 132-61 dual record and is the second winningest coach in program history.
- His UVA wrestlers have won eight All-America honors and 16 individual ACC titles.
- Garland guided UVA to its sixth straight top-30 finish at the NCAA Championships last year (19th), marking the first time UVA has recorded six straight NCAA top-30 finishes in program history.
- The 2010 ACC Coach of the Year, Garland led Virginia to an ACC championship and a 15th-place finish at NCAAs in 2010 (UVA's best NCAA finish since 1957).
- He is an alum of the program and was the NCAA runner-up at 125 pounds in 2000 and the 1997 ACC champ at 126 pounds.
