FOR OPENERS

- UVA meets George Washington for the 51st time.
- UVA is 115-35 (.767) in non-conference action under Tony Bennett.

ALL-TIME VS. THE COLONIALS

- UVA is 26-24 all-time against George Washington in the series that dates back to the 1906-07 season.
- The Cavaliers meet the Colonials for the first time since dropping a 73-68 road decision in the 2015-16 season.
- Virginia is 16-10 against George Washington in Charlottesville, including a 1-0 record at John Paul Jones Arena.
- The Cavaliers have won seven of the last eight meetings.
- Head coach Tony Bennett is 1-1 all-time vs. George Washington.

LAST TIME VS. GEORGE WASHINGTON

- UVA suffered a 73-68 loss at George Washington on Nov. 16, 2015.
- Malcolm Brogdon led UVA in points (28), rebounds (6) and assists (4) in the loss.
- Tyler Cavanaugh (18), Patricio Garino (18), Paul Jorgensen (10) and Joe McDonald (10) each scored in double figures for George Washington.
- The Colonials out-rebounded Virginia 37-33 and went 23-28 from the charity stripe.
- UVA shot 40.3 percent from the field, including 25 percent (5-20) from 3-point range.
- The loss ended Virginia's seven-game winning streak vs. George Washington.

LAST TIME OUT

- Ty Jerome matched a career high with six 3-pointers en route to a game-high 20 points in No. 5 Virginia's 73-42 win over Towson on Nov. 6.
- De'Andre Hunter added 13 points and 10 rebounds for his second career double-double and Braxton Key had seven points and nine rebounds in his UVA debut.
- Tobias Howard led the Tigers with 10 points.
- Kihei Clark had a game-high six assists in his collegiate debut.
- Virginia shot 48.1 percent from the floor and canned 10 3-pointers.

ALL-TIME VS. ATLANTIC 10 CONFERENCE OPPONENTS

- Virginia is 120-80 all-time against current Atlantic 10 members (13-4 vs. Davidson, 2-0 vs. Dayton, 0-3 vs. Fordham, 8-1 vs. George Mason, 26-24 vs. George Washington, 1-2 vs. LaSalle, 2-0 vs. UMass, 2-1 vs. Rhode Island, 52-36 vs. Richmond, 2-6 vs. Saint Joseph's, 0-1 vs. Saint Louis and 12-2 vs. VCU).
- The Cavaliers meet an A-10 opponent for the first time since defeating Davidson 80-60 last season.
- UVA went 3-0 against A-10 foes last season, defeating VCU (76-67), Rhode Island (70-55) and Davidson (80-60).
- Tony Bennett is 10-3 all-time vs. Atlantic 10 opponents at UVA.

HOO ARE THESE CAVALIERS?

- Virginia returns starters Ty Jerome (All-ACC Second Team), Kyle Guy (All-ACC First Team) and Jack Salt and ACC Sixth Man of the Year De'Andre Hunter from last year's team that won a school-record 31 games and captured the ACC regular-season and tournament titles.
- Mamadi Diakite, Jay Huff and Marco Anthony also return to the Cavaliers, who finished first nationally in scoring defense for the fourth time in the past five seasons.
- Transfer Braxton Key gained immediate eligibility after averaging 9.8 points and 5.5 rebounds in two seasons at Alabama.
- Newcomer Kihei Clark is expected to contribute immediately after averaging 19.4 points, 7.2 assists & 2.9 steals as a high school senior in 2017-18.
- Kody Stattmann, Austin Katstra and Jayden Nixon provide depth and Francisco Caffaro is redshirting the 2018-19 season.
- Redshirt freshman Francesco Badocchi has taken an indefinite leave of absence from the team due to medical issues.
- Manager Grant Kersey made his collegiate debut against Towson and will dress for home games.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 167-41 (.802), including a 1-0 mark in 2018-19, in 13 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- UVA was 16-1 at JPJ last season and is 129-25 (.838), including a 94-10 (.904) mark the past seven seasons, at home under Bennett.
- Virginia is an ACC-leading 49-5 (.907) in league home games over the past six seasons. Duke is second at 48-6 (.889).
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for nine straight seasons.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Three-time National and ACC Coach of the Year Tony Bennett has a 220-86 (.719) mark in 10 seasons at Virginia and 289-118 (.710) career mark in 13 seasons overall.
- In 2017-18, Bennett led Virginia to its eighth ACC regular-season title, third ACC Tournament championship, school-record 31 wins, ACC-record 17 league wins and ACC-record 9-0 mark on the road.
- Bennett was named the USBWA Henry Iba National Coach of the Year for the third time to rank second all-time behind legendary John Wooden, who captured the award six times.
- Bennett also earned Division I national coach of the year honors from the AP, USA Today and NABC.
- He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018).
- Bennett has guided UVA to five straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history and has led UVA to a school-record six straight seasons with 23 or more wins.
- Bennett is the sixth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Vic Bubas, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-best 16 or more ACC wins in three of the last five seasons.
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-record six straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- He has led UVA to a school-best seven straight 20-win seasons.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons from 2014-16, eclipsing 88 wins from 1981-83.
- Bennett has led UVA to seven consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018 and NIT in 2013).
- In 2015-16, Bennett led UVA to its first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 1995 with 29 wins.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year and ACC Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a then-school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons (2014-2015) for the first time in school history.
- UVA is 115-35 (.767) in non-conference action, 105-51 (.673) in ACC play and 129-25 (.838) at home under Tony Bennett.
- Bennett ranks sixth all-time in winning percentage at .673, among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC regular-season wins.

UVA RANKED NO. 5 IN PRESEASON RANKINGS

- Virginia is ranked No. 5 in the Associated Press and USA Today Coaches' preseason polls.
- UVA has been ranked in the top 10 in the preseason ranking in four of the past five seasons.
- The Cavaliers were unranked in the 2017-18 preseason polls, but became the fourth team in the Top 25 era (1990-present) to earn a No. 1 ranking after being unranked in the preseason (Kansas, 1990; Syracuse, 2010; Baylor, 2017).
- Dating back to last season, UVA has been ranked in the AP poll for 17 straight weeks and has been ranked in the top 10 in each of the past 13 polls.

VIRGINIA PICKED 2ND IN THE ACC

- Virginia was picked to finish second in the ACC preseason poll.
- The Cavaliers, who were picked sixth and finished first last season, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in nine of the last 10 seasons.
- Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by Virginia, North Carolina, Syracuse, Virginia Tech, Clemson, Florida State, NC State, Notre Dame, Miami, Louisville, Boston College, Georgia Tech, Wake Forest and Pittsburgh.

ABOUT THE 2018-19 SCHEDULE

- Seven of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the AP Top-25 preseason poll (Duke, North Carolina, Virginia Tech, Syracuse, Florida State and Clemson), while six (Maryland, Notre Dame, Louisville, Miami, NC State and Marshall) received votes.
- The Cavaliers will play 12 games against 2018 NCAA Tournament teams: home games against Duke, Florida State, Marshall, Miami, Syracuse and Virginia Tech; road contests at Clemson, Duke, North Carolina, NC State, Syracuse and Virginia Tech.

- UVA could meet NCAA Tournament teams Butler, Florida and Oklahoma in Battle 4 Atlantis.
- Four opponents (Boston College, Middle Tennessee, Notre Dame and Louisville) participated in the 2018 National Invitation Tournament.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

- UVA allowed 42 points in its season opener and are 77-2 when holding foes to fewer than 50 points in the Tony Bennett era.
- The Cavaliers limited Towson to 31.7 percent shooting from the floor and 28.6 percent from 3-point range.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense five times and finished in the top-five nationally in nine of 12 seasons.
- Bennett-coached teams are 102-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 12-year coaching career.

TYING US TOGETHER

- Point guard Ty Jerome opened the season with 20 points vs. Towson.
- In 2017-18, Jerome earned All-ACC third-team honors after averaging 10.6 points and 3.9 assists.
- Jerome was an ACC Tournament second-team selection.
- Jerome ranked fourth in the ACC in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.44) and seventh in steals (1.62).

THIS GUY GETS BUCKETS

- Kyle Guy led UVA in scoring (14.1 ppg) and 3-pointers (83) in 2017-18
- Guy averaged 16.7 points to earn ACC Tournament MVP honors.
- Guy has scored 20 or more points in six career games (4 in 2017–18), including a career-high 29 points at VCU (11/17/17).
- In 2017-18, Guy reached double figures in 28 games and led the Cavaliers in scoring in 15 contests.
- Guy made at least one 3-pointer in UVA's first 28 games, which marked the fourth longest streak in UVA history.
- Guy has shot 42.3 percent (135 of 330) from 3-point range during his career and has made five or more 3-pointers in seven games.
- Guy holds UVA's career 3-point percentage record, edging Keith Freel's (2000-01) mark of 42.1 percent.

DRE HAD HIS WAY

- De'Andre Hunter tallied his second career double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds vs. Towson.
- Hunter averaged 9.2 points and 3.5 rebounds in 2017-18.
- He shot 48.8 percent from the field, 38.2 percent from 3-point range and 75.5 percent from the free throw line.
- Hunter reached double figures in 16 games, including team highs against Monmouth (career-high 23), Georgia Tech (17), Virginia Tech (14), Syracuse (15), Miami (ACC-high 22) and Pitt (14, including career-high 10 rebounds).
- Hunter was named ACC Co-Rookie of the Week following his 22-point performance at Miami.
- He banked in the game-winning 3-pointer at Louisville (3/1/18).
- Hunter fractured his left wrist during the ACC Tournament and missed the NCAA Tournament.

THREE CAVALIERS EARN PRESEASON ALL-ACC HONORS

- The Cavaliers' Kyle Guy joined preseason ACC Player of the Year Luke Maye (North Carolina), RJ Barrett (Duke), Tyus Battle (Syracuse) and Ky Bowman on the All-ACC first team.
- Virginia's De'Andre Hunter and Ty Jerome were joined on the second team by Zion Williamson (Duke), Justin Robinson (Virginia Tech) and Marcquise Reed (Clemson).

WATCH ME NOW

- Ty Jerome (Bob Cousy Award), Kyle Guy (Jerry West Award) and De'Andre Hunter (Julius Erving Award) were named to Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame preseason award watch lists.
- Guy and Hunter are among 50 players to watch for the 2019 Citizen Naismith Trophy Men's Player of the Year honor and 20 players fore the NABA Division I Player of the Year award.

2017-18 IN REVIEW

- Virginia claimed its eighth ACC regular-season title and third ACC Tournament title.
- The Cavaliers won a school-record 31 games and earned their first No. 1 ranking in the AP poll since 1982.
- UVA earned its school-record fifth consecutive NCAA Tournament bid, earning its first No. 1 overall seed and sixth No. 1 seed overall.
- The Cavaliers led the nation in scoring defense for the fourth time under head coach Tony Bennett at 54 points per game. UVA also ranked first in the nation in turnovers per game at 8.5 per game.
- Tony Bennett was named the NCAA Division I Coach of the Year by the Associated Press, United States Basketball Writers Association (USBWA), National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC), Naismith, Basketball Times, USA Today and Sports Illustrated.
- Kyle Guy became Virginia's ninth All-America selection, earning third-team honors from the NABC and AP.

- Bennett-coached teams are 102-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points (25-1 in three years at Washington State).

WORLD WIDE CAVALIERS

THE ELECTRIC 70s AND AWESOME 80s

- Virginia scored 73 points in its opener and is 108-6 when scoring at least 70 points under Tony Bennett and 112-80 when scoring under 70 points under Bennett.
- UVA scored 80 or more points in three games last season and is 26-1 under Bennett when scoring 80 or more.
- UVA's lone loss under Bennett when scoring 80 or more was a 93-81 loss at UNC in 2012-13.
- UVA was the first ACC team to win seven straight conference games (Jan. 6-27, 2018) while scoring fewer than 70 points in any game.

CAVALIERS IN THE NBA

- Justin Anderson (Atlanta), Malcolm Brogdon (Milwaukee), Joe Harris (Brooklyn) and Mike Scott (Los Angeles) are former Cavaliers who are playing in the NBA this season.
- Brodgon, who earned NBA Rookie of the Year honors for Milwaukee in 2016-17, is in his third season with the Bucks.
- Scott is in his seventh season (first with Los Angeles) and Harris is in his fifth NBA season (third with Brooklyn), while Anderson is in his fourth season (first with Atlanta).
- In addition, Dallas head coach Rick Carlisle is a Virginia alum who helped the Cavaliers to their last NCAA Final Four in 1984.

50-40-75 CLUB

- Virginia is 31-0 when shooting at least 50 percent from the field, 40 percent from 3-point range and 75 percent from the free throw line in the same game under head coach Tony Bennett.
- UVA was 5-0 last season when achieving the 50-40-75 mark (Austin Peay, VCU, Rhode Island, Davidson, NC State and Louisville).
