CAVALIERS AT THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS

- Virginia is sending seven wrestlers to the NCAA Championships, all automatic qualifiers by virtue of their finishes at the ACC Championships.
- This marks the seventh straight year that at least six UVa wrestlers have qualified for NCAAs.
- UVa owns five straight top-30 team finishes (15th in 2010, t23rd in 2011, t28th in 2012, 21st in 2013, 23rd in 2014).
- Virginia's best finish at NCAAs was a 10th-place tie in 1957.
- This marks the 34th year Virginia has had at least one qualifier at NCAAs.

CAVALIERS BOAST 16 ALL-AMERICANS IN PROGRAM HISTORY

- Sixteen Virginia wrestlers have earned All-America honors in the program's history, with nine coming in the last 11 years, including seven during Steve Garland's tenure as head coach.
- UVa has had at least one All-American in five of the last six seasons.
- UVa's best individual finish is second by heavyweight Henry Jordan in 1957 and current UVa head coach Steve Garland (125 pounds) in 2000.
- Nick Sulzer earned his second straight All-America honor at 165 last year with a fourth-place finish.

SULZER LOOKS TO FINISH UVA LEGACY ON TOP

- · Looking to finish his career as a three-time All-American, senior Nick Sulzer has moved into second place on the all-time wins list at Virginia.
- Sulzer is looking to join Henrich as the lone three-time All-Americans in program history.
- With 116 career wins, Sulzer is tied with Chris Henrich (2008-11) for second on the all-time UVa wins list.
- A two-time All-American, Sulzer is 26-2 this year and 116-25 in his career, including a 58-7 mark in UVa duals.

VIRGINIA CLAIMS FIRST ACC CHAMPIONSHIP SINCE 2010

- Virginia claimed its fifth ACC team championship and first since 2010 when it won the title on March 8 in Pittsburgh.
- UVa scored 85.5 points as it easily outdistanced the field; Pitt was second with 71 points.
- All 10 UVa competitors scored points and finished in fourth place or better. Six Cavaliers reached the finals.
- George DiCamillo (133) and Nick Sulzer (165) each earned their second ACC individual championships.

QUICK NOTES

- Nick Sulzer and Joe Spisak became the seventh and eighth UVa wrestlers to compete in four NCAA Championships.
- Sulzer is seeded for the third time, while George DiCamillo and Blaise Butler each earned their second seed.
- UVa was No. 18 in the final USA Today/ NWCA Coaches Poll.
- UVa took 28th place in 2012 in the last NCAA Championships held in St. Louis.
- UVa finished 15th in 2010 in Omaha following its last ACC Championship.
- Six of UVa's final eight duals were decided by three points or fewer, including three one-point matches.
- Virginia wrestled its toughest schedule in program history, taking on nine ranked opponents; the Cavaliers were 4-5 against ranked foes.

- Six Virginia wrestlers return with previous NCAA Championships experience.
- Redshirt freshman Andrew Atkinson (157) is the lone newcomer to the mix for the Cavaliers.
- With 16 career matches, Nick Sulzer (9-7 record) boasts the most NCAA experience of any current UVa wrestler and the second most in program history.
- With five more NCAA matches, Sulzer will match Chris Henrich (13-8) for the most NCAA Championship bouts in school history.
- He needs four more NCAA wins to tie Henrich for the most in school history.

BUTLER CONTINUES STELLAR FIRST YEAR AT 174

- The reigning ACC champion at 157 pounds, Blaise Butler made the unusual move to go up two weight classes to 174 this season and is 18-4 and ranked eighth nationally by InterMat.
- Butler is 11-3 against 2015 NCAA qualifiers this season, including 5-3 against seeds.
- He topped then-No. 1 Logan Storley of Minnesota, 9-7 in sudden victory time, in the semifinals of the Las Vegas Cliff Keen Invitational.

DICAMILLO CONTINUES COMEBACK

- After missing the 2013-14 season with injuries, George DiCamillo has bounced back for a great 2014-15 season.
- He is 26-7 on the year, including a 5-0 mark in ACC duals (he recorded bonus points in three of his five ACC duals).
- DiCamillo was the 2013 ACC champion at 133 pounds as a true freshman. He was UVa's first ACC champion since Joe Alexander won the 133-pound title in 2002.
- DiCamillo reached the round of 12 at the 2013 NCAA Championships, falling one win shy of All-America status.

CHALLENGING SCHEDULE PREPARES UVA FOR POSTSEASON COMPETITION

- Virginia has seen its share of quality opponents this season, particularly since the start of the new year.
- Virginia faced four conference champions in duals this season Ohio State and Iowa (Big Ten), Edinboro (EWL) and North Dakota State (NCAA West Region/WWC).
- In addition to wrestling one in one of the nation's best tournaments, the Southern Scuffle, Virginia faced eight ranked teams in duals since Jan. 1.
- UVa went 3-5 against those squads, with wins over Rider (then-No. 17), Edinboro (10) and Pitt (10).
- UVa also wrestled then-No. 23 North Dakota State and then-No. 4 Ohio State in home duals in November, with a win over the Bison and a defeat to the Buckeyes.

FOUR PUSH TOWARD MASTER'S DEGREES

- Four Cavaliers are on track to earn their master's degrees from UVa in May, continuing a tradition established under Steve Garland.
- Billy Coggins, Derek Papagianopoulos, Joe Spisak and Nick Sulzer all are slated to earn degrees in Higher Education/Administration from UVa's Curry School of Education.
- Since 2008, 19 Cavaliers have earned master's degrees.

INJURIES PLAGUE CAVALIERS IN 2014-15

- Virginia's lineup has been beset by injuries this season.
- The Cavaliers did not have their full starting lineup for a dual this year.
- Joe Spisak (141) was out for all of January and part of Feburary before returning at lowa.
- Blaise Butler (174) and Zach Nye (197) each missed several weeks earlier this year because of injuries.
- Three starters are out for the year: seniors Gus Sako (149), Billy Coggins (184) and Derek Papagianopoulos (285).

ALL-AMERICA COACHING STAFF

- Virginia's coaching staff consists of three former All-Americans, including a pair of national champions.
- Head coach Steve Garland was the national runner-up at 125 pounds in 2000.
- Assistant coach Jordan Leen was the 2008 national champion at 157 pounds for Cornell.
- First-year assistant coach Keith Gavin was the 2008 national champ at 174 for Pitt. He remains active in wrestling and is a member of the U.S. National Freestyle Wrestling Team.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH STEVE GARLAND

- Head coach Steve Garland is in his ninth year at the helm of his alma mater.
- Garland led Virginia to the 2015 ACC Championship, his second at Virginia (2010).
- In his tenure Garland has posted an 126-54 dual record and is the second winningest coach in program history.
- His UVa wrestlers have won seven All-America honors and 14 ACC titles.
- Garland guided UVa to its fifth straight top-30 finish at the NCAA Championships last year (23rd), marking the first time UVa has recorded five straight NCAA top-30 finishes in program history.
- The 2010 ACC Coach of the Year, Garland led Virginia to an ACC championship and a 15th-place finish at NCAAs in 2010 (UVa's best NCAA finish since 1957).
- He is an alum of the program and was the NCAA runner-up at 125 pounds in 2000 and the 1997 ACC champ at 126 pounds.
