- The Cavaliers lead the ACC and are eighth in the nation in scoring defense at 53.9 points per game. The Cavaliers also lead the ACC and are ranked fourth in the nation in three-point field goal percentage defense (25.5 percent). Virginia is second in the ACC and 11th in the nation in field goal percentage defense with opponents shooting 34.7 percent against the Cavaliers
- This game will be a battle of the top two defenses in the ACC with Duke ranking second in scoring defense, allowing 54.3 points per game. The Blue Devils lead the ACC in field goal percentage defense with opponents shooting 33.4 percent against them. Duke is second in three-point defense at 25.8 percent
- The Blue Devils are second in the conference in scoring margin, out-scoring opponents by 19.6 points per game. Virginia is +12.4 in scoring margin
- Virginia is coming off a 65-64 overtime victory on Thursday against Georgia Tech. The Cavaliers are 4-2 in their last six games
- Freshman guard Dominique Toussaint led the Cavaliers with 16 points, including scoring UVA's final eight points of the first quarter
- Junior guard J'Kyra Brown had the first double-double of her career, scoring 12 points with 10 rebounds
- Brown has scored in double-figures in three of the last four games, averaging 11.25 points per game in that span
- Brown has come off the bench to lead the team in rebounding in two of the last four games. In four of the last five games, a non-starter has led or been tied for the team lead in rebounding with Lisa Jablonowski at Clemson and Felicia Aiyetan against Virginia Tech
- Senior guard Breyana Mason scored 15 points against Georgia Tech, her third-straight game scoring in double figures
- Mason is 37 points shy of becoming the 32nd member of UVA's 1,000-career point club, and would join, among others, Chelsea Shine Wilson, who finished her career with 1,023 points
- Jocelyn Willoughby is the reigning ACC Freshman of the Week after scoring 18 points against the Hokies and 16 against Notre Dame

**INTERVIEW POLICY**

Please give a minimum of 24 hours notice for all interview requests.

**TEAM NOTES**

- Virginia leads the ACC in scoring defense and ranks eighth in the nation, allowing 53.4 points per game. The Virginia men's team leads the nation in scoring defense at 53.4 points per game
- The Cavaliers last led the ACC in scoring defense in 2012 when the team held opponents to 54.1 points per game in Joanne Boyle's first season in Charlottesville
- Virginia has limited three of its last five opponents to two-made three-pointers in the game (Clemson, Virginia Tech and Georgia Tech)
- Virginia has led by 10 or more points in 17 games this season
- Virginia has only trailed at the half three times this season, dropping all three of those contests
- Virginia is in the midst of a five-game stretch in which they are playing four ranked opponents: No. 19 VT, No. 8 Notre Dame, unranked Georgia Tech, No. 15 Duke and No. 16 Miami
- Virginia is tied with Wake Forest for eighth place in the ACC while Duke is tied for third with Louisville, NC State and Syracuse

**QUICK LOOK AT THE GEORGIA TECH GAME**

- Virginia led by 22 points two minutes into the third quarter. After GT cut the deficit down to seven, 50-43, with nine seconds remaining in the third period, UVA scored the final basket of the frame and the first four points of the fourth quarter to lead 54-43 with 9:31 remaining in the game. GT initially tied the game on a layup from Zaire O'Neil with 1:35 remaining. J'Kyra Brown hit a jumper with 1:09 remaining to give UVA a two-point lead, but O'Neil tied the game with a layup in the final second to send it to overtime.
- Georgia Tech scored 19 second-chance points, including six during their fourth-quarter comeback
- Georgia Tech held a 46-39 rebounding edge including a 21-13 offensive rebounding differential

**DUKE BLUE DEVILS**

- Duke has won the last 24-consecutive meetings between the two teams and is 29-1 in the last 30 meetings. The series, which began in 1997, was 31-7 in Virginia's favor until 1998, the start of the recent 30-game stretch
- Virginia's last victory in the series was a 61-49 game on January 30, 2000
- Last season, the Cavaliers fell 67-52 at Duke but battled in the ACC Tournament with the Blue Devils coming away with a 57-53 victory
- The 2016 ACC Tournament was the closest game between the two since a 60-59 loss on Jan. 9, 2003. In the last 10 years, only two games have been decided by less than 10 points, the ACC Tournament game and a 78-70 game in 2008
- Virginia head coach Joanne Boyle was a four-year letterwinner at Duke, graduating in 1985 with a degree in economics.
- Boyle was as an assistant coach at Duke from 1993 to 2002
- Boyle is 0-6 coaching against her alma mater

**NATIONAL GIRLS AND WOMEN IN SPORTS DAY**

- For the last 22 years, the Virginia Department of Athletics and the Maxine Platzer Lynn Women's Center have collaborated in a celebration of the National Girls and Women in Sports Day, an event that brings national attention to the achievements of female athletes and to issues facing girls and women in sport.
- This year's theme is Achieving Your Dreams with two-time Olympic Medalist and current Virginia swimmer Leah Smith being honored in a halftime ceremony and will also sign autographs after the game
- Leah is a fourth-year who became the first Cavalier female swimmer to win two Olympic medals. Smith capped off an amazing 2016 by becoming a two-time individual world champion. During her career, Leah has won four NCAA titles with a chance to add to that total next month in Indianapolis at her final NCAA Championships

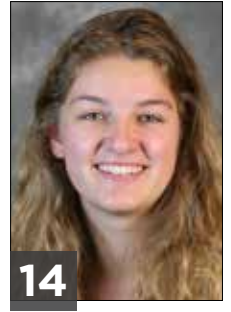
