FOR OPENERS

- UVA meets Maryland for the second time in the ACC/B1G Challenge.
- UVA owns a nation-leading 24-game winning streak in November dating back to the 2015-16 season.
- UVA captured its sixth consecutive Thanksgiving holiday tournament championship (Battle 4 Atlantis, NIT Season Tip-Off, Emerald Coast Classic, Charleston Classic, Barclays Center Classic and Corpus Christi Challenge).
- UVA has started 6-0 for the third straight season and is 120-35 (.774) in non-conference action under Tony Bennett.
- UVA meets its second ranked opponent of 2018-19 and is 32-31 against ranked opponents in the Bennett era (1-0 in 2018-19).
- De'Andre Hunter is the reigning ACC Player of the Week.

LAST TIME OUT

- Tournament MVP De'Andre Hunter tallied 20 points and nine rebounds to lead then-No. 4 Virginia to a 53-46 win over then-No. 25 Wisconsin as the Cavaliers captured the Battle 4 Atlantis title.
- Ty Jerome added 11 points and five assists and Kihei Clark had five points, five rebounds and three steals in his first career start.
- Virginia jumped to a 33-18 halftime lead and limited the Badgers to 18.3 percent from 3-point range.
- Ethan Happ led Wisconsin with 22 points, 15 rebounds, six assists and four blocked shots.

UVA ALL-TIME IN THE ACC/B1G CHALLENGE

- The Cavaliers have a 12-6 record, including a 5-4 road mark, in the ACC/B1G Challenge.
- Virginia has a four-game winning streak in the Challenge, defeating Maryland (2014), Ohio State (2015 and 2016) and Wisconsin (2018).
- UVA defeated Wisconsin 49-37 in last year's Challenge.
- The ACC leads the Big Ten in the Challenge 12-5-2 in 20 years of competition between the two conferences.
- The ACC captured the Commissioner's Cup for the second straight year last season, winning 11 of the 14 matchups.
- The ACC won 10 straight challenges from 1999-2008.

ALL-TIME VS. THE TERRAPINS

- Virginia is 75-107 all-time vs. Maryland, including a 76-65 road win in the last meeting, in a series that dates back to 1912-13.
- The Cavaliers have won seven of the last eight meetings and are 1-0 vs. Maryland in the ACC/B1G Challenge.
- The Cavaliers are 7-6 vs. the Terrapins at Xfinity Center, including a 4-1 mark in the last five contests.
- Head coach Tony Bennett is 7-4 all-time vs. Maryland.

UVA RANKED NO. 4 IN AP POLL

- Virginia is ranked No. 4 in the AP poll for the third straight week.
- UVA was ranked No. 5 in the preseason polls and has been ranked in the top 10 in the preseason rankings in four of the past five seasons.
- In 2017-18, Virginia became the fourth team in the Top 25 era to earn a No. 1 ranking after being unranked in the preseason.
- UVA has been ranked in the AP poll for 20 straight weeks and has been ranked in the top 10 in each of the past 16 polls.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Three-time National and ACC Coach of the Year Tony Bennett has a 225-86 (.724) mark in 10 seasons at Virginia and 294-118 (.714) career mark in 13 seasons overall.
- In 2017-18, Bennett led Virginia to its eighth ACC regular-season title, third ACC Tournament championship, school-record 31 wins, ACC-record 17 league wins and ACC-record 9-0 mark on the road.
- Bennett was named the USBWA Henry Iba National Coach of the Year for the third time to rank second all-time behind legendary John Wooden, who captured the award six times.
- Bennett also earned Division I National Coach of the Year honors from the AP, USA Today and NABC.
- He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018).
- Bennett has guided UVA to five straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history and has led UVA to a school-record six straight seasons with 23 or more wins.
- Bennett is the sixth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Vic Bubas, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-best 16 or more ACC wins in three of the last five seasons.
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-record six straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- He has led UVA to a school-best seven straight 20-win seasons.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons from 2014-16, eclipsing 88 wins from 1981-83.
- Bennett has led UVA to seven consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018 and NIT in 2013).
- In 2015-16, Bennett led UVA to its first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 1995 with 29 wins.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year and ACC Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a then-school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons (2014-2015) for the first time in school history.
- UVA is 118-35 (.770) in non-conference action, 105-51 (.673) in ACC play and 131-25 (.840) at home under Tony Bennett.
- Bennett ranks sixth all-time in winning percentage at .673, among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC regular-season wins.

UVA IN THE NATIONAL STATISTICAL RANKINGS

- As of Nov. 26, UVA ranks first nationally in turnovers per game (8.0) and winning percentage (100%), second in scoring defense (49.3 ppg), fourth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.98), fifth in fouls per game (13.8), eighth in turnover margin (6.8), ninth in fewest turnovers (48) and 12th in scoring margin (23.8).

GETTING DEFENSIVE

- UVA is allowing 49.3 points per game (best in school history).
- UVA has held three opponents to fewer than 50 points (Coppin State, Towson and Wisconsin).
- UVA has held 25 foes to less than 43 percent shooting.
- UVA has held four opponents to 40 percent or less shooting.
- UVA has out-rebounded five of its six opponents.
- The Cavaliers are 79-2 when holding foes to fewer than 50 points in the Tony Bennett era.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense five times and finished in the top-five nationally in nine of 12 seasons.
- Bennett-coached teams are 104-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 13-year coaching career.

HOW ARE THESE CAVALIERS?

- Virginia is led by Ty Jerome, Kyle Guy, De'Andre Hunter and Jack Salt.
- Hunter leads UVA in scoring (16.8) and rebounding (6.3).
- Jerome is averaging 14 points and team-high 4.5 assists.
- Guy is averaging 12.2 points, while Salt anchors UVA's defense.
- Alabama transfer Braxton Key has averaged 5.8 points and 5.3 rebounds, while Mamadi Diakite has averaged 7.3 points and 2.2 rebounds.
- Newcomer Kihei Clark is averaging 6.0 points and 2.8 rebounds, and Jay Huff is averaging 4.6 points and 2.4 rebounds.
- Marco Anthony and Kody Stattmann provide depth and Francisco Caffaro is redshirting the 2018-19 season.
- Redshirt freshman Francesco Badocchi has taken an indefinite leave of absence from the team due to medical issues.
- Manager Grant Kersey has appeared in three home games.

AGAINST THE BIG TEN CONFERENCE

- UVA is 104-129 all-time vs. current Big Ten Conference opponents.
- The Cavaliers meet their second Big Ten opponent, defeating Wisconsin in the Battle 4 Atlantis championship game.
- The Cavaliers are 10-5 against Big Ten opponents under head coach Tony Bennett, including wins against Iowa, Maryland, Minnesota, Michigan, Ohio State (2), Rutgers and Wisconsin (3).

TYING US TOGETHER

- Point guard Ty Jerome is averaging a career-high 14 points, 4.5 assists and 3.2 rebounds.
- Jerome has reached double figures in five of six games, including back-to-back 20-point efforts in the first two contests.
- Jerome is the first Cavalier to score 20 or more points in the first two games of a season since Sylvan Landesburg in 2008-09 (28 vs. VMI and 21 vs. USF).
- Ty Jerome sank 10 of 14 3-pointers in UVA's first two games and is the first Cavalier to make 10 3-pointers in the first two games of a season since Curtis Staples (10 of 24) in 1997-98.
- Jerome was named to the Battle 4 Atlantis All-Tournament team.
- In 2017-18, Jerome earned All-ACC third-team honors after averaging 10.6 points and 3.9 assists.

THIS GUY GETS BUCKETS

- Kyle Guy is third on the team in scoring (12.2 ppg), highlighted by his seventh career 20-point effort vs. George Washington.
- Guy has shot 42.2 percent (145 of 338) from 3-point range during his career and has made five or more 3-pointers in seven games.
- Guy ranks second on UVA's career 3-point percentage list at 42 percent, trailing Keith Freely's (2000-01) mark of 42.1 percent.
- Guy has scored 20 or more points in seven career games (4 in 2017-18), including a career-high 29 points at VCU (11/17/17).
- In 2017-18, Guy reached double figures in 28 games and led the Cavaliers in scoring in 15 contests.
- Guy averaged 16.7 points to earn ACC Tournament MVP honors.

DRE'S WAY

- De'Andre Hunter has reached double figures in every game, averaging a team-leading 16.8 points and 6.3 rebounds.
- He earned Battle 4 Atlantis MVP honors and ACC Player of the Week accolades after averaging 19.3 points and 7.7 rebounds in the tournament.
- Hunter has three 20-point games (Coppin State, Dayton and Wisconsin), matching a career-high 23 points against Dayton.
- Hunter recorded a career-high nine assists vs. Middle Tennessee.
- Hunter recorded his second career double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds vs. Towson.
- He is shooting 61.3 percent from the floor and 75 percent from the charity stripe.
- Hunter averaged 9.2 points and 3.5 rebounds in 2017-18.
- Hunter reached double figures in 16 games, including a career-high 23 against Monmouth and ACC-high 22 against Miami.
- Hunter was named ACC Co-Rookie of the Week following his 22-point performance at Miami.
- Hunter fractured his left wrist during the ACC Tournament and missed the NCAA Tournament.

HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

- Virginia has held three opponents (3-0) to fewer than 50 points and is 79-2 when achieving the mark in the Tony Bennett era.
- Bennett-coached teams are 104-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points (25-1 in three years at Washington State).
- UVA is 22-0 under Bennett when limiting foes to 40 or fewer points.

THE ELECTRIC 70s, AWESOME 80s & DIVINE 90s

- Virginia has scored over 70 points in four games and is 111-6 when scoring at least 70 points under Tony Bennett and 114-80 when scoring under 70 points under Bennett.
- UVA scored 97 points against Coppin State and is 3-0 when scoring 90 or more points under Bennett.
- UVA's lone loss under Bennett when scoring 80 or more was a 93-81 loss at UNC in 2012-13.
- UVA was the first ACC team to win seven straight conference games (Jan. 6-27, 2018) while scoring fewer than 70 points in any game.

- Virginia is 169-41 (.804), including a 3-0 mark in 2018-19, in 13 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.

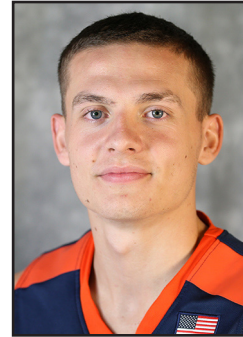

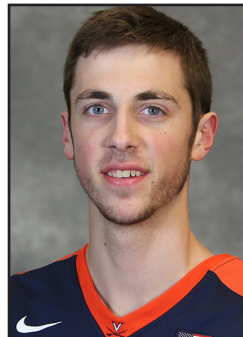
