- The Cavaliers had an eight-game win streak snapped with a 55-48 loss at No. 16 Duke last Sunday. It was the Cavaliers' longest win streak since winning nine straight in 2008-09. Virginia's started ACC play 5-0 start for the first time since the 2000 season when the team started with nine straight conference wins
- Jocelyn Willoughby posted back-to-back double-doubles last week, scoring a team-high 18 points with 10 rebounds at BC and following with 11 points and 10 rebounds at Duke
- Willoughby has converted her last 13 free throw attempts
- Willoughby is shooting 55.2 percent (15-of-29) from the field in her last three games
- Willoughby is averaging 6.5 rebounds per game in ACC contests this year
- Felicia Aiyeotan became the seventh player in program history to record 100 or more blocked shots as a Cavalier, picking up her 100th at Duke. Aiyeotan leads the ACC with 46 blocked shots this season, already tied for 10th most in a single season in UVA program history
- Aiyeotan is 10th in the ACC in rebounding, averaging 7.5 per game. Last season, Aiyeotan averaged 3.7 rebounds per game
- The Cavaliers made a season-high 10 three-pointers at Duke, the most since making 10 in their 2015 game against Clemson
- J'Kyra Brown has hit at least one three-pointer in each of the last 13 games
- Jocelyn Willoughby is shooting 53.1 percent from three-point range this season (17-of-32). In the last three games, Willoughby is 7-of-11 from three-point range (63.6 percent)
- Virginia has had the same starting lineup for the last nine games. Willoughby is the only Cavalier to start every game this season. She also started every game her freshman season. Toussaint has started all but one game, Rutgers, where she was limited because of an injury
- Dominique Toussaint has 29 assists to 11 turnovers in ACC games this season (2.6 ratio) and has improved her assist-to-turnover ratio to 1.4 overall

TEAM NOTES

- Duke quick recap: In a game with seven lead changes, the Cavaliers held an early 11-point advantage in the first quarter after shooting 70.0 percent in the period, but the Blue Devils came back to hold a 24-23 lead at halftime. Virginia tied the game, 32-32, in the third quarter, but the Blue Devils built back up a 43-36 lead early in the fourth quarter. UVA rallied, pulling to within one, 49-48, with 1:12 remaining. Duke went 6-of-8 from the free throw line down the stretch while the Cavaliers missed three shots in the final 30 seconds as the Blue Devils held on for the victory.
- The Cavaliers did not go to the line at all against Duke. It was only the second time in program history, and the first time since January 29, 1975 that the Cavaliers did not have at least one free throw attempt in a game
- Four of Virginia's five ACC victories have been by double-digits
- Virginia leads the ACC in scoring defense in conference games, holding opponents to 54.8 points per game, and is second in field goal percentage defense with ACC opponents shooting 37.6 percent from the field
- The Cavaliers were -1.8 in rebounding margin through the first 10 games of the season. During their eight-game win streak, the Cavaliers are +8.3 on the boards.
- Virginia scored an average of 61.2 points per game in their first 10 games of the season. During their eight-game win streak, they are averaging 71.1 points per game with a +14.6 scoring margin
- The Cavaliers have moved up to No. 44 in the RPI rankings (1/19/18)
- Virginia is receiving votes in this week's *USA Today* Coaches' Poll for the third straight week

VIRGINIA TECH HOKIES

- Virginia leads the all-time series against the Hokies, 46-12, and is 21-4 in ACC contests
- Virginia Tech is coming off an 86-75 loss to Duke on Thursday. The Hokies fell despite a 30-point performance from junior guard Taylor Emery. The Hokies took a program-record 33 three-point attempts in the game, making 13
- Emery has nine games scoring 20 or more points this season. She is averaging 16.7 points per game, ranking ninth in the ACC
- Tech is 1-3 in its last four games, but those four losses are to then-No. 3 Louisville, No. 13 Florida State and No. 15 Duke
- The Hokies were 11-2 in non-conference games this year, including victories over Auburn and Illinois
- Last season, UVA swept the series, including Virginia downing a then-ranked No. 19 Virginia Tech, 76-27. The 27 points scored by Virginia Tech were the fewest by a Cavalier opponent since UVA held Norfolk State to 23 points on Dec. 28, 2012. Virginia Tech scored two points in the third quarter. The 49-point margin of victory against the Hokies matches the second-largest for the Cavaliers in an ACC game in program history, topped only by a 57-point victory over Wake Forest on Jan. 5, 1995
- The Cavaliers had won 18-straight match-ups in the series prior to being swept by the Hokies in 2015-16

THE COMMONWEALTH CLASH

- The Commonwealth Clash presented by Virginia529 is a head-to-head, points-based competition between the athletic teams at University of Virginia and Virginia Tech. The Commonwealth Clash encourages a friendly, statewide rivalry between the two schools across all school-sponsored sports with 21 individual event points on the line. The school that accumulates 11 points or more will be crowned the winner and take home the Virginia529 Commonwealth Clash trophy. - Virginia currently trails in this year's Clash, 4 to 1.5

- Sophomore forward/guard Jocelyn Willoughby was appointed as the non-voting, student-athlete member of the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Oversight Committee. Willoughby is the lone student-athlete on the 15-member committee with her tenure running through June 2020. The goals of the committee are to advance the game and perception of women's basketball, improve the student-athlete experience and put an emphasis on the personal growth of student athletes. Along with the goals, it will also work to supervise qualifications and/or selection procedures for the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship and provide direction to the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Rules Committee regarding playing rules
- Aliyah Huland El is majoring in kinesiology and wants to become a pediatrician
- J'Kyra Brown is an accomplished bowler. She took up bowling at four years old and holds several lane records back home at the Rocky Mount Bowling Center. Her all-time best is a 275 and she also has a 248 game. She owns five different bowling balls. The Black Widow is her baby, but she also has a SpongeBob ball that she got when she was 10 that she uses for spares, for straight balls or corner shots
- Dominique Toussaint's dream one-on-one match-up is to go up against Sue Bird. Her favorite sports team is the New York Liberty
- Lauren Moses can juggle. Moses also uses these three words to describe herself: motivated, resilient, goofy
- The 1992-93 ACC Champion Cavalier team will be honored on January 21 (Virginia Tech game) as part of this year's National Girls and Women in Sports Day celebration. National Girls and Women in Sports Day brings national attention to the achievements of female athletes and to issues facing girls and women in sport. The event is co-sponsored by the University of Virginia Athletics Department and Women's Center. Their favorite part of the trip, however, was a trip to an orphanage, an activity they enjoyed so much, the itinerary of the trip was altered to allow a return visit to see the kids



- Recent honorees at Virginia's National Girls and Women in Sports Day celebration include Leah Smith (Olympic gold medalist), the 1991 NCAA Champion women's lacrosse team, Megan O'Leary (former two-sport student-athlete and current member of USRowing Board of Directors), two-time volleyball MVP and philanthropist Amy (Mitchell) Griffin, Olympic-gold-medal swimmer Lauren Perdue, Paige Selenski and Michelle Vittese (members of the Cavalier field hockey team and gold-medal winners at the 2011 Pan Am games with USA Field Hockey), Natalie Randolph (former UVA track standout and varsity football coach at Calvin Coolidge High School in Washington, D.C.) and Lindsay Shoop (former UVA rower and Olympic gold medalist).
- The 1992-93 Virginia women's basketball team that won the regular-season and ACC Tournament Championships will be honored on National Girls and Women in Sports Day when the Cavaliers host Virginia Tech on Sunday, Jan. 21 at 12:30 p.m. at John Paul Jones Arena

1992-93 VIRGINIA CAVALIERS

- This season marks the 25th anniversary of the 1992-93 Virginia women's basketball team
- Won the ACC regular-season, going 13-3
- Won the ACC Tournament Championship for the second consecutive season.
- The Cavaliers were 26-6 overall, defeating four ranked conference opponents on its run to the regular-season championship.
- The Cavaliers cruised to a 74-46 win over Wake Forest in the first round and topped Clemson 79-71 in overtime to set up a championship game against Maryland.
- The Cavaliers won their third ACC Championship by outlasting Maryland in a triple-overtime thriller in Rock Hill, S.C.
- This showdown was voted last year to be one of the top moments in the history of ACC women's basketball during the 40th Anniversary of the league as it took three overtimes before the Cavaliers topped the Terrapins to win the title.
- Dena Evans was named the MVP of the tournament after playing 55 minutes and scoring 19 points, including hitting the game-tying three-pointer with 12 seconds remaining in regulation.
- Evans, who was named the Naismith Player of the Year for most outstanding player under 5-foot-6 that year, was just one of the phenomenal players on that team. She was also named to the All-ACC team and earned two player of the week honors that season.
- Heather Burge earned Kodak District All-American honors, setting the single-season record for field goal percentage. Heather was awarded the ACC Player of the Year and first team All-ACC.
- Boucek was named to the ACC All-Tournament team alongside, Dena and Heather.
- Palmer, a future two-time All-American by multiple outlets, was an ACC-All Freshman Team selection, and three-time rookie of the week.
- Heather Burge, Wendy Palmer, Dena Evans and Jenny Boucek would all go on to be named ACC Legends
- Jenny Boucek is an assistant player development coach for the Sacramento Kings, just the third-ever female full-time assistant in the NBA. She has 18 years of professional coaching experience and two WNBA championships under her belt, most recently served the head coach of the WNBA's Seattle Storm for three seasons (2015-17) before landing with the Kings
- Boucek was involved in the WNBA since its inaugural season, suiting up for the Cleveland Rockers in 1997. Following a career-ending injury in 1998, she began her WNBA coaching career as an assistant with the Washington Mystics in 1999. She then spent three seasons (2000-02) in the same capacity with the Miami Sol. In her first stint with Seattle from 2003-05, Boucek was an assistant coach on staff that included the franchise's first WNBA Championship in 2004. The Storm won their second WNBA crown in 2010 with Boucek on staff in a similar role. Boucek is distinguished as the first athlete to play in the WNBA and subsequently serve as both an assistant and head coach in the league.


